Some had cast similarities with the great Dubai Millennium (GB) prior to yesterday and Khalid Abdullah's brilliant **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) lived up to

all the hype and mass of expectation with a ruthless demonstration of galloping in the G1 Qipco 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. He had hinted at something special to come during a pioneering two-year-old campaign and in his warm-up run in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury two weeks ago, but few expected this unprecedented show of superiority. In front from the outset, jockey Tom Queally let the 1-2 favorite--the shortest-priced since the beaten Apalachee in 1974--use his impressive stride and he had buried all opposition before he reached the quarter pole. Only **Dubawi Gold (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and **Native Khan (Fr)** (Azamour {Ire}) could emerge from the pack to chase after that in complete vain. **Cont. p2**

'HAV' YOU SEEN HER?

Every spring, there is a significant betting move on one of Newmarket's Classic hopefuls, and a few weeks ago, the money was down on James and Anita Wigan's **Havant (GB)** (Halling) ahead of the G1 Qipco 1000 Guineas. Something of a dark horse entering today's renewal, the unbeaten Sir Michael Stoute trainee had the subsequent UAE Derby winner Khawlah (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) five lengths behind on the second of her two winning efforts in the G3 Oh So Sharp S. over seven furlongs here at the beginning of October. Up against some talented and proven fillies here, she has it to prove, but her conditioner believes she won't be lacking in the class department. "She is a scopey filly, is very straightforward, and put up two very good performances last year," Stoute said recently. "They were on ground that was softer than good on both occasions, so she loves that, and I'm a little bit concerned with the way the weather is behaving. She wouldn't want it too fast, but we'll see. I've always found it so difficult training these Guineas fillies, and it's just happening for her now. The trip should not be a problem." **1000 Guineas field p4; Editorial cont. p5**

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# English 2000 Guineas cont.

Bobby Frankel was a vital cog in the Juddmonte workings for a long time and it was always going to take an unusual specimen to be named after the hall-of-famer. From the first instance, the equine namesake showed that honor was not wasted on him and he went from a super-smooth introduction over a mile on the July Course here in August--where he earned

☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status--to display electric speed when following up in a seven-furlong conditions event at Doncaster Sept. 10. Just 15 days later, he turned Ascot's G2 Royal Lodge S. into a procession with a 10-length victory made even more extraordinary by a final-turn move which killed the contest. When his margin was only 2 1/4 lengths to Roderic O'Connor (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the

G1 Dewhurst S. here in October, it was almost an anti-climax and probably cost him the outright Juvenile Champion title which he shared with Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}).

After a perfect return in Newbury's G3 Greenham S. a fortnight ago, Henry Cecil had stated at a press conference to launch the Champions' Series this week that his colt could make his own running and that was the clearest indicator that his homework had hinted at something extraordinary to come. If his pacemaker **Rerouted** (Stormy Atlantic) ever actually led Frankel, it was for a matter of seconds as Tom Queally quickly established his intentions on the hot favorite which drew Frankie Dettori and **Casamento** (Ire) (Shamardal) into early action. By the halfway mark, where his rider had a glance back, Godolphin's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner was already beaten and those who had tried to stay relatively close were beginning to pay the price. His rider could not have heard anything coming inside the final quarter mile, but for safety, Frankel received some light slaps with the whip and maintained the momentum all the way to the finish.

"To win a Classic is special, and I'm glad that he did it like that, as the media were building him up to be something super-equine," Queally added. "They were right. It would have been an anti-climax to win by a length. He loves galloping--they might have been expecting me to get cover, so I caught them on the hop. I know the horse and have a lot of confidence in him--it may have looked like I wasn't hanging about, but he feels like he is doing it a lot steadier than he is. He showed a lot of speed today, and we learned that he is able to motor--in the last furlong he was just idling and it's great to sit on something so great so early in my career." After greeting his third and most important Guineas winner, Henry Cecil added, "I think I might have actually got the plan wrong, as we had planned to

kill them all with his gallop, but in the last furlong he was waiting for them," said the conditioner, who was greeting his 25th British Classic winner and the widest-margin winner of the Guineas since Tudor Minstrel (GB) in 1947. "He had won his race and was wondering where everything else was, but we thought there was something left in the tank. Whether he'll get a mile and a half is another matter." Cecil continued, "It is a relief it's gone right. He's a very, very good

horse and, while it's difficult to compare with other generations and champions, he must be up there with them. I've got ideas, and we'll sit and think and try and work it out, but he's in the G2 Dante S. [at York May 12] and we'll see how he comes out of this. We'll leave all options open and if he's very well, he could go there and I could easily bring him back to a mile afterwards for the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 14], but I'll discuss it with the Prince."

### *From the Eye of the Storm...*

Frankel's performance had Britain's handicappers in a spin, and the longstanding Halifax-based *Timeform* reacted by giving the Juddmonte star a provisional rating of 142 pounds, which is ahead of the likes of Mill Reef, Dancing Brave and Sea the Stars (Ire) and makes him the co-fourth-highest-rated horse on their books.

Fellow trainers and jockeys were similarly blown away. Dubawi Gold's trainer Richard Hannon commented, "It was a good race, but I don't particularly want to run against Frankel again. I don't see any reason why we wouldn't go for the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at

The Curragh May 21] now. The other fella might not go for that, and I don't want to go where he goes. There's also the [June 15] G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot." Ed Dunlop, trainer of Native Khan, said, "It is a shame he has come along in the year of Frankel--he ran a great race to be third. We will step up in trip for either the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [French Derby at Chantilly June 5] or [June 4] G1 Epsom Derby."

Ryan Moore, who finished 11th on **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), told *PA Sport*, "I have never seen anything like that. It was the best performance I've ever seen, and Tom [Queally] was very brave to ride him like that. The horse that tried to stay closest to Frankel finished the furthest back, and I think that says it all. It's good for the sport to have a horse like that." Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said of the unplaced pair **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal) and **Saamidd (GB)** (Street Cry {Ire}), "I think we've got to put a line through today, as the brilliant winner had them all hard at it from a long way out, and we know Casamento is a lot better than his finishing position. Hopefully, today hasn't taken too much from him, and Epsom is still very much in our minds. I think Frankel prompted us to chase him earlier than we wanted to, and nothing would have beaten him today. We were very disappointed with Saamidd, who seemed reluctant to race as he had in the Dewhurst last year."

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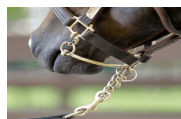
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## English 1000 Guineas cont.

### Three Cheers?

Cheveley Park Stud are regular players in these events, and they are responsible for the premier form choice in **Hooray (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}). She set the benchmark with successes in the G2 Lowther S. at York in August, G3 Sirenia S. at Kempton in September and G1 Cheveley Park S. here in October. On the latter occasion, she dispensed with recent G3 Fred Darling S. winner Rimth (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) and G2 Queen Mary S. heroine **Maqaasid (GB)** (Green Desert) by 4 1/2 lengths and 1 1/4 lengths, respectively. Were it not for the pessimism of her trainer Sir Mark Prescott, the homebred would probably be sitting higher in the betting, but the master of Heath House has grounds for concern. "She's not very big and there is not very much of her," he said. "She is just the same as she was and is a funny little thing. She is very impatient and runs like a frightened deer. She is complex, but has got better with racing. Her history is not good for training on at three, as her half-brother Hypnotic (GB) (Lomitas {GB}) wasn't nearly as good at three."

### Down Memory Lane...

Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's **Memory (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) was one of the leading ante-post prospects for this after her impressive shows when swooping late to win Royal Ascot's G3 Albany S. over six furlongs in June and the G2 Cherry Hinton S. on the July Course here the following month. Things unraveled with a disappointing sixth in The Curragh's G1 Moyglare Stud S. in August, but connections are upholding the faith. "Memory is arguably our best chance yet of winning the first fillies' Classic," conditioner Richard Hannon commented. "She will be coming from the back, so we will have to hope that she does not encounter traffic problems. Hughesie [jockey Richard Hughes] was absolutely delighted with that seven-furlong gallop she did at Newbury last week, and she really seemed to appreciate being back on grass" Fellow Royal Ascot scorer Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Maqaasid is another with stamina questions to answer, but jockey Richard Hills is hoping she can build on a promising return when third under a penalty in this venue's G3 Nell Gwyn S. over a furlong shorter. "She ran a very good race at Newmarket and that was just a trial," Hills said. "It's early, and we obviously haven't tried her over a mile at home, but we breed these horses to have a crack--there is nothing else for her at this time of year."

Having beaten the subsequent G1 Epsom Derby third and G1 Dubai Sheema Classic winner Rewilding (GB) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Noailles here 12 months ago, it looked as if Classic glory could be on the cards for Planteur, but he met his match when runner-up to Lope de Vega (Ire) (Shamardal) in the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly in June. Second again to Behkabad (Fr) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in both the G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G2 Prix Niel over 12 furlongs here in July and September, the homebred was already beaten when causing interference which led to his disqualification in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in October. Beaten less than two lengths when fifth behind Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin in December, he gave notice on his return with an impressive win in the Apr. 10 G2 Prix d'Harcourt over this track and trip that he had turned over a new leaf. Traveling with consummate ease in fifth early as Cape Blanco (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) took over duties on the front end from Planteur's pacemaker Pouvoir Absolu (GB) (Sadler's Wells), he was temporarily short of room against the fence when hitting top gear in early straight. Switched out to carve his way between Cape Blanco and Cirrus des Aigles approaching the final furlong, the homebred was beyond recall as Sarafina stayed on to fill the runner's-up spot.

Machen unleashed a barnstorming stretch rally similar to the one he produced when earning **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** honors this past January, only this time there were a whole lot more marbles on the line. The first foal out of his MGSW & GISP dam, which was purchased by Don Adam for \$750,000 at Fasig-Tipton November in 2006, Machen turned in a highly promising debut effort sprinting six furlongs at the Fair Grounds Jan. 2, rolling home by 5 1/2 lengths, good for a 94 Beyer. That effort left him the 1-20 favorite trying two turns for the first time four weeks later, and the colt was off slowly and was blocked for a run in the stretch, but punched through once the daylight came and strolled home by five lengths. With that foundation, connections pressed on to the Feb. 19 GII Risen Star S., but the 2-1 chance raced deep on both turns and couldn't quite finish off his race, checking in fourth behind Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno). He was double the price for the GII Louisiana Derby Mar. 26, but was equally luckless in the running. Forced to cover ground on the final turn, he drew to within a couple of lengths at the eighth peg, but was outfinished and came home fifth. Trainer Neil Howard, in his typically conservative and thoughtful way, pulled the plug on Kentucky Derby aspirations, and that decisions paid dividends on opening day of the spring/summer meet. Last but not one as the field hooked up with the track proper, Machen bided his time beneath Edgar Prado as Dominus alternated up front with favored Travelin Man (Trippi), last-out winner of the GII Swale S. Still in the latter third of the field as they reached the stretch, Machen was bumped from between horses and had no choice but to race wide when they straightened. Dominus had put away Travelin Man and looked on his way to an on-pace victory, but Machen came with relentless strides down the center of the track to take the photo. "It's easy to say it now, but we felt that shortening up in distance might benefit this colt," winning trainer Neil Howard told *Daily Racing Form*. "And it seems so far we're right. He ran well." Connections seems to be inclined to remain off the Triple Crown trail. "We'll probably keep him middle distances, one turn," Howard told the *Form*.

Team Valor International's **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) hinted that he could be a force to reckon with in Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby, drilling six furlongs in a very sharp 1:13 yesterday. The move was in stark contrast to his last, when the colt worked much slower than planned at Keeneland. With Robby Albarado in the irons for Saturday's pre-Derby breeze, Animal Kingdom, the Gili Vinery Spiral S. hero, went his opening furlong in :12.40 and threw in a similar fraction to reach the first quarter in :24.80. His middle two furlongs were covered in :24.40, while his final quarter mile was clocked in :23.80 and he pulled readily clear from his company with good-looking and push-button acceleration. His gallop-out time for seven furlongs was a strong 1:26.40. "As disappointed as I was with how things turned out last week, I couldn't have been happier this week," trainer Graham Motion said. "Last week, everything did not go perfectly. Today, everything went perfectly--just cut and dried, really." Motion also worked Team Valor's GI Kentucky Oaks candidate **Summer Soiree** (War Front) a half-mile in :48.80, then high-tailed it back to his Fair Hill base, where GI Wood Memorial hero **Toby's Corner** (Bellamy Road) is scheduled to have his final Derby work this morning. Owned and bred by Diane Cotter, Toby's Corner will ship to Louisville Tuesday instead of Monday, Motion reported. "I don't see any need for him to get in here on Monday. I'm just going to wait, let him work tomorrow, give him an easy day on Monday and ship him on Tuesday," he explained.

### ***Bonde Pair Go Six Panels...***

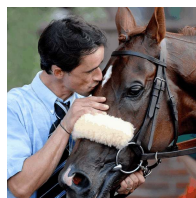
With three-time Kentucky Derby-winning jockey Calvin Borel in the saddle, GIII Sunland Park Derby winner **Twice the Appeal** (Successful Appeal) went three-quarters of a mile in an even 1:15.60 just prior to sun-up at the Downs Saturday. The Jeff Bonde-trainee went his opening quarter in a leisurely :26 before picking it up a bit to a half in :50.40. He galloped out an extra furlong in 1:29.20. "He felt good," Borel said afterward back at Barn 42. "He clipped right along, and I liked the way he finished up." Borel said there are few similarities between Twice the Appeal and Derby upsetter Mine That Bird (Birdstone). "The other horse [Mine That Bird] was more of a plodder," Borel explained. "He'd just go along there and then finish strong. This horse moved along the whole while better. And he galloped right out for me."

About a half-hour later, stablemate **Sway Away** (Afleet Alex) was out for a six-furlong breeze of his own, covering the trip in 1:14 with jockey Brian Hernandez aboard. Clockers caught him in :26 for the quarter and :50.80 for the half. He had a very strong gallop-out time of 1:27.60. "He finished up strong," Bonde said. "I liked that a lot. I sure hope I get a chance to run. This colt belongs in there." Bonde has secured the services of Martin Garcia for the Derby, but currently Sway Away sits on 24th position on graded-stakes earnings, and will need a lot of help to get in the race.



### ***Kathmanblu Works on Her Own...***

**Kathmanblu** (Bluegrass Cat) turned in one of the more visually impressive victories by a 2-year-old filly last season, when she waltzed home an easy winner of the GII Golden Rod S. on closing weekend of the fall meet. With the likes of **R Heat Lightning** (Trippi) and **Joyful Victory** (Tapit) grabbing the bulk of the headlines this winter and early spring, the bay is something of the forgotten one heading into Friday's GI Kentucky Oaks. Kathmanblu turned in her final workout yesterday morning at Churchill, going five furlongs in 1:01.80 with big-race rider Julien Leparoux up. "It was a nice and steady work," trainer Ken McPeck said. "I got her last quarter in :24, which is all we wanted."

2-year-olds blowing out down the lane right along the rail. The work shaped fast early and slower late, with an opening two furlongs in :23 flat. He five-furlong gallop out was 1:01.80. Trainer Todd Pletcher was not unduly concerned about the un-evenness of the move. "Some might say she's headstrong," he said. "But I just think she's very enthusiastic about her work. She'll go on a light schedule from here on out up to the race on Friday."

### ***California Hope Builds Stamina in Final Work...***

Jerome and Ann Moss's **Zazu** (Tapit) was sent out for a seven-furlong breeze Saturday morning at Hollywood Park, covering the distance in 1:24 2/5. "She went really well; we're very pleased," said trainer John Sadler from his Hollywood barn. "Joel Rosario was aboard for the move and he'll ride her Friday." Winner of the GI Las Virgenes S. in February, Zazu ships to Kentucky on Tuesday.

### ***Delightful Mary Out of Oaks Consideration...***

Connections have pulled the plug on a Kentucky Oaks run for **Delightful Mary** (Limehouse) following a work deemed subpar Friday. The John Oxley-owned filly, third in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, went five furlongs in 1:01.60. "It was a good work yesterday, but we wanted a tremendous work and we did not get that," said Norman Casse, son of and assistant to trainer Mark Casse. "I think she is going to go back to Woodbine and regroup. There are no definite plans for her next race. We will let her tell us when she is ready."

### ***Flashpoint Preakness Bound...***

The *Daily Racing Form* reports that **Flashpoint** (Pomeroy), a distant fourth in the GI Florida Derby Apr. 3, has been moved to the barn of trainer Wesley Ward and will target the May 21 GI Preakness S. While under the care of Rick Dutrow Jr., the grey romped by 6 1/4 lengths in his career opener at Gulfstream in January and came back to take the Feb. 26 GII Hutcheson S. by 7 1/4 lengths. Flashpoint worked a bullet five furlongs in :59 flat at Keeneland Thursday. "This horse is training as well, if not better, than he has ever trained in his life," Fort told *DRF*. "I'm not sure why he had an off-day in the Florida Derby. We're pointing to the Preakness and, if he keeps going around there like he has been, we're going to head to the Preakness with a lot of enthusiasm."

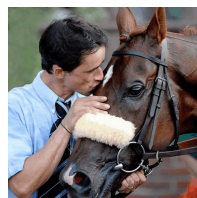
