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JUVENILE CHAMP OUT OF DERBY

There had been a swirl of rumors all week regarding the status of last year's juvenile champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie), and on Friday morning, trainer Todd Pletcher and owner Mike Repole confirmed what many had already guessed: the talented colt, unbeaten at two and pegged as the second choice in the morning line for the 137th

GI Kentucky Derby, would not participate in the race.

During a somber press conference held Friday morning at Churchill's auxiliary press box, Pletcher and Repole met with reporters to say Uncle Mo continues to show the ill effects from what initially was said to be a gastro-intestinal infection. A battery of recent tests, however, proved inconclusive, and with the vets still scratching their heads, they said that it wasn't in the best interest of the horse to compete in the 1 1/4-mile Classic.

"We're dealing with an internal issue, and we're not quite sure what it is," Pletcher said. "He definitely had a GI tract infection, but what we're trying to figure out if that was the primary issue, a secondary issue, or the function of something else."

Uncle Mo has had a number of specialists attending to him since suffering his first career defeat in the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 9, and on Thursday, no fewer than three top vets--Dr. Ken Reed, Dr. Doug Byars and Dr. Steve Allday--examined him.

"We have one specific enzyme that is elevated and they cannot identify why," said Pletcher. "Without getting too scientific, when this particular enzyme is elevated, there is something else in the blood work that would point to a liver or a kidney...or something else. But in this case, it has everyone baffled. The only thing I can tell you now is that nobody knows what it is."

Repole said his decision to scratch actually came late Thursday morning, after the vets had examined Uncle Mo, but before they weighed in on the results.

"After they left, Todd said 'I don't want to run this horse,'" explained Repole. "The vets didn't say the horse couldn't run; in fact, they said he could. But, when Todd said he didn't want to run, that was pretty much it for me. I know he treats these horses better than he treats his own health, and if he didn't want it, then that was that. It was an easy decision. I trust this man more than anybody." **Cont. p2**

PRETTY IS AS PRETTY DOES

When she first got off the van, I called her 'Plum Ugly,'" trainer Bob Baffert admitted as he headed to the winner's circle after the GI Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs yesterday. "But now she's beautiful." Peachtree Stable's **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) gave Baffert his second Oaks winner; his first was

Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) in 1999. A 6-1 chance, the bay tracked **Summer Soiree** (War Front) through fractions of :23.65, :46.99 and 1:11.25. She drove to the lead when they straightened into the lane and looked home free, but jockey Rosie Napravnik wheeled 16-1 **St. John's River** (Include) off the rail inside the eighth pole and the longshot came flying. It was close, but the wire came just in time for Plum Pretty to hold on by a neck. "Everybody talks about how long the stretch here is at Churchill Downs," Napravnik said after the race. "I wish it was just a nose longer today."

Mike Repole said he waited to announce the decision out of respect for the vets, explaining that he wanted to hear their diagnosis before notifying the press.

Pletcher said there are no immediate plans for Uncle Mo, but said he could be sent to a local clinic for further testing, and all but ruled out starts in the GI Preakness S. two weeks from now and GI Belmont S. three weeks after that. He mentioned mid-summer races like the GII Jim Dandy S. and GI Travers S. at Saratoga, but stressed that, until they found out what was wrong with the horse, they weren't even thinking about where he might turn up next.

Repole, who flew in some 100 friends and family for the Derby, still has another runner in the race in GIII Gotham S. winner **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini). In one of the lighter moments of the press conference, Repole removed his Uncle Mo ballcap and replaced it with a Stay Thirsty hat.

It's the second straight year that Pletcher has lost a Derby runner in the days leading up to the race. In 2010, the heavily favored Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway) was declared six days out with what would ultimately be a career-ending soft-tissue injury. Jockey John Velazquez had the call on both Eskendereya and Uncle Mo. Asked if Velazquez, Pletcher's go-to rider, could possibly be named on Stay Thirsty, Pletcher said no, and confirmed Ramon Dominguez will retain the mount. "We made a commitment to Ramon," said Pletcher. Later, Team Valor announced that Velazquez would replace the injured Robby Albarado on **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}).

Pletcher himself was visibly downcast--even more so than a year ago--and said he looked at the scratch as a 'personal failure.'

"I am very, very, very, very disappointed about this," Pletcher said. "I don't think I've ever had a horse as good as Uncle Mo. We've had every resource to try to get this horse right, but we're not there. I take this as a personal failure. We just don't know what's wrong with this horse, and it scares me. I feel very sorry for Mike. I feel very sorry for Johnny Velazquez. This is the third year in a row he's lost the Derby favorite."

Velazquez was also the regular rider of Quality Road (Elusive Quality), forced off the 2009 Derby trail with foot ailments.

If body language was anything to go by, the writing was on the wall several hours before yesterday's announcement was made. Pletcher sent Uncle Mo to the track around 6:15 a.m., and he watched quietly as the colt jogged an easy mile. Repole was not present, and Pletcher walked with his head down back to the barn as media types began to gather in expectation of an announcement. Churchill's John Asher finally announced at 8:15 a.m. that a press conference had been called on Churchill's front side, and Repole was joined there by a 15- or 20-strong entourage, many of whom wore Uncle Mo T-shirts or Repole Stable sweatshirts.

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Uncle Mo was a near-unanimous choice for an Eclipse Award as champion juvenile male. He made his 3-year-old debut in the Timely Writer S. at Gulfstream Mar. 12 and won easily, but lost his unbeaten record when a flat third as the 1-9 choice in the Wood Memorial. Subsequent X-rays and exams came back negative, but shortly after the race it was revealed that he was suffering from a gastro-intestinal issue. He was treated and reportedly regained his appetite and, in recent weeks, pleased connections with his progress. But Pletcher said that once he was taken off medication, his health declined once again.

"The biggest thing I see is depressed appetite and loss of weight, and his coat's not right," Pletcher explained. "When he was in the Breeders' Cup last year, he looked phenomenal--his coat, dapples, rich color, good appetite, good weight, good muscle tone. Unfortunately, he doesn't have those things, but we can't find why."

Because there is no also-eligible list for the Derby, horses who were on the bubble in terms of graded earnings--including **Ruler On Ice** (Roman Ruler) and **Sway Away** (Afleet Alex)--will still not be able to run. There were rumblings in the camp of the latter after Uncle Mo was entered Wednesday, thus ensuring the exclusion of Sway Away, but Pletcher was not apologetic during the press conference. "I think Uncle Mo deserved every last minute for us to make the decision," he said. **Derby field, p3; more coverage, p11-14**

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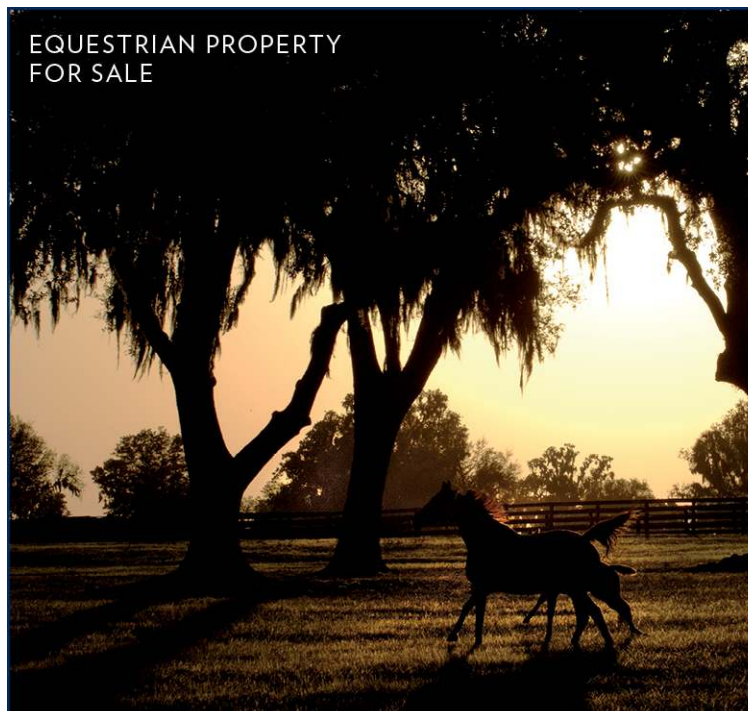

The bay came back to be third in the Jan. 15 GII Santa Ynez S. and she was 5 1/2 lengths behind winner Zazu when completing the triple in the Feb. 5 GI Las Virgenes S. Connections hit the road in search of a softer field, and boy, did they find one. The Pennsylvania-bred was bet down to 1-20 in the Mar. 27 Sunland Park Oaks and made those slim odds look right on the money as she romped home a 25-length winner over five grossly overmatched rivals. Looking to get back to the winner's circle for the first time since taking the GI Alabama S. last August, Blind Luck overcame a rough start to win what by what constitutes a handy margin for the late-running filly. The chestnut had run second in each of her last five

appearances, including a 3 1/4-length defeat by Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) in the GIII Azeri S. at Oaklawn last time out Mar. 19. But she was returning to the scene of one of her greatest victories, a nose triumph over Evening Jewel (Northern Afleet) in the GI Kentucky Oaks exactly a year ago. Blind Luck stumbled badly at the start and was

shuffled back to last, trailing the field around the first turn. She started to close the gap midway down the backstretch, and caught her first victim on the final bend. Fanned wide at the top of the lane, she was under steady left-handed encouragement as she closed on the leaders, finally collaring Unrivalled Belle in the final strides. "We had trouble in the beginning, she overcame it and I am very proud of her," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "We never lost confidence in her. I always thought it was circumstances that prevented her from getting another win." First Dude failed to score in 11 straight starts after breaking his maiden at Gulfstream Park in January of 2010, but he made it two in a row with this late run. The handsome bay did hit the board in five straight Grade I events last term, including a second in the Preakness S. and thirds in the Belmont S., Haskell Invitational S. and Travers S. A neck behind Morning Line (Tiznow) when runner-up in the GII Pennsylvania Derby last September, he threw in a clunker in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Classic, finishing eighth. Owner/breeder Donald Disney opted to send the colt west to trainer Bob Baffert after a fourth-place showing in the Jan. 29 Sunshine Millions Classic in Hallandale, and First Dude was a lackluster sixth in his first try under new management, the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 5. He dropped into an entry-level allowance off that effort, and got a confidence booster, winning by 2 1/2 lengths as the 4-5 favorite in Arcadia Apr. 9. Settled in fifth through six furlongs in 1:11.95, the 4-year-old was just behind the leaders when they hit the lane. Regal Ransom grabbed the advantage, with Caracortado (Cat Dreams) making a run at him from the inside. Victoria's Wildcat became the third graded winner from Bellamy Road's initial crop with this decisive score. The late-developing filly finished a neck back in second in a one-mile Churchill maiden last Halloween--her fourth career start--and connections brought her back in a six-furlong NW1X under the Twin Spires Nov. 27, which she annexed by two lengths. Freshened over the winter, she won an entry-level allowance on return at Gulfstream going 6 1/2 furlongs Mar. 19. Making her first attempt again stakes foes here, Victoria's Wildcat broke from the eight hole and was dead last in the early going as Home Sweet Aspen emerged with the lead and carved out :22.02 and :44.57 splits. The winner began to gear up behind those fast splits and set her sights on the leaders with 3/16ths to go. She pegged down both soon after and was going away at the wire. "This is what we always thought we had, and it has finally all come together," said trainer Bob Hess Jr. "She bruised her foot in January. We thought she hurt herself, but it was just a bruise and an abscess. She's going to be a neat filly the rest of the year and next year. She's very healthy. We'll sit down and talk about what's next--maybe something in New York or here." Arienza (Distorted Humor), the favorite coming off second to Joyful Victory (Tapit) in the GII Fantasy S. at Oaklawn Apr. 10, was in the mix, but faded to be eighth. "I just want to get back there and make sure she is OK," trainer Dan Peitz said. "[Jockey Ramon Dominguez] felt like she didn't handle the race track, but I don't know. That's kind of a lame excuse, I think. I'm to get back there and see how she is. I'll know more tomorrow probably about where we're at. St Nicholas Abbey powered through an unbeaten juvenile campaign, which included wins in the G2 Beresford S. at The Curragh and the G1 Racing Post Trophy, but endured a stifled campaign last year. Quoted as low as 6-1 to complete a sweep of Britain's Triple Crown races, he failed at the first hurdle when

It's been a real emotional roller coaster for everybody, particularly for the guys at Fair Hill, who put so much into Toby's Corner. That is the nature of the game, and it's what you grow used to. I certainly wouldn't have anticipated two months ago this horse running in the Derby, but I don't think that's a knock against him, because I think he's a really special horse. Regardless of what happens on Saturday, he's a really good horse."

MARAM HEADED TO BREEDING SHED Maram (Sahm--American Dreamer, by Quest for Fame {GB}), the winner of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita in 2008, has been retired and will be bred this year. Now five, the dark bay filly RNA'd for \$9,500 as a Keeneland November weanling. Breeders Karen Woods and Saud bin Khaled opted to race her, sending her to trainer Chad Brown. Maram was undefeated in three starts as at two, taking the GIII Miss Grillo S. by a neck and hitting the wire a nose in front on Breeders' Cup day, then was out of action for more than nine months. The homebred captured the John Hettinger S. at Saratoga in her return in August of 2009, but suffered her first loss when third by a neck in the Pebbles S. at Belmont that October. She ran a respectable sixth in the 2009 GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf the following month. In four starts last term, Maram captured the Miss Liberty S. and was runner-up in the GIII Eatontown S., both at Monmouth. She was preparing for her 2011 bow when she suffered a suspensory injury, and her connections decided to retire her. "Maram has more than proved her worth as a race filly, and certainly identified herself as a future keystone broodmare in my breeding program," Woods said. Maram compiled a record of 10-5-1-1 and bankrolled \$900,320. Mating plans have not yet been finalized.

NJ HORSEMEN, BAILEY REACH AGREEMENT

The *Asbury Park Press* has reported that the New Jersey Horsemen's Association and real estate developer Morris Bailey, who was awarded a five-year lease of Monmouth Park last month, have reached an agreement on purse distribution and race days for the Oceanport oval's upcoming 2011 meet. Monmouth Park is scheduled to open May 14, with a June 1 target date for Bailey to take over operations. The agreement stipulates a 71-day meet that will extend through the fall, with daily purse distribution of \$400,000. State legislation would have mandated a 141-day race meet if the deal had not been done. "We made significant progress with the horsemen and are continuing to make progress with the state, and we're getting closer to wrapping everything up," Bailey's attorney Ronald Riccio said. "It's very possible [that] it could all be done by opening day," he added.

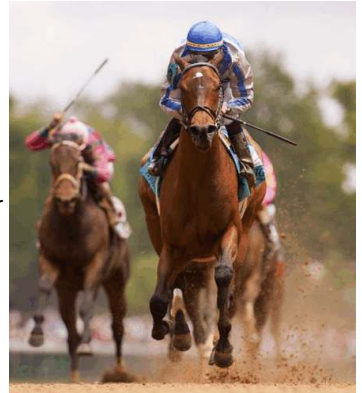
