UNRIVALED BELLE RETIRED

Unrivaled Belle (m, 5, Unbridled's Song--Queenie Belle, by Bertrando), the winner of the 2010 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic, flipped in the paddock prior to Saturday's GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont Park, and fractured the bone in her withers. She will be retired. "She didn't come down with a big thud, it was more of a soft landing, but when she got up I knew immediately she had broken her withers," trainer Bill Mott said. "I've had horses come back and win stakes after they break their withers, but she'll be retired and go on to be a broodmare." Bred and raced by Gary Seidler and Peter Vegso, the grey mare had a stellar season last year, running first or second in six of her seven starts. She captured the GIII Rampart S. at Gulfstream and GII La Troienne S. at Churchill, then was runner-up in three Grade Is in a row--the Phipps, the Ruffian and the Beldame. Off at 7-1 in the BC Ladies' Classic, she closed from fifth to take the lead early and held on late to best champion Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) by 1 3/4 lengths. The mare had been out twice this season, finishing third behind Awesome Maria (Maria's Mon) in the Rampart and second to Blind Luck in the La Troienne. Overall, she compiled a record of 14-6-6-1 and bankrolled \$1,854,706.

The first race meeting ever held at Ascot took place on Saturday Aug. 11, 1711. Her Majesty's Plate, worth 100 guineas and open to any horse, mare or gelding over the age of six, was the inaugural event.

Rock On...

Society Rock broke through at Nottingham in his second go in August 2009 before landing a massive pot in the £250,000 Tattersalls Timeform Millions Sprint at his local Newmarket track the following month. Disadvantaged by an unfavorable draw in the even-more-valuable Tattersalls Timeform Million back at headquarters, he was far from disgraced when seventh in that juvenile season closer. He hit the ground running last term when opening his sophomore campaign with a win in April's Listed Pavilion S. over this course and distance, but slipped one spot contesting the Listed Carnarvon S. at Newbury in May. The bay backed that up with a bang, but was no match for Starspangledbanner (Aus) (Choirir {Aus}) in this event last year, and that effort left its trace as he could manage only seventh when re-opposing that superstar in the G1 July Cup back at Newmarket once more July 9. This semester's report card read "could do better" following a 10th in the Apr. 14 Listed Abernant S. back on the Rowley Mile in his 2011 curtain raiser and he was a last-out second, to the re-opposing Bated Breath (GB) (Dansili {GB}), in a six-furlong Haydock conditions heat May 7.

Society Rock settled off the pace after jockey Pat Cosgrave became agitated in the plate soon after leaving the stalls. Coaxed into contention as Star Witness set sail for home approaching the final furlong, he reached top gear just as that rival's runner-up effort in Tuesday's G1 King's Stand S. and the cloying mud combined to take its toll. The Australian invader's stride shortened as he began to paddle inside the closing panel, and Society Rock, along with Monsieur Chevalier, swept by inside the final 150 yards, but the latter was unable to find enough to oust his fellow outsider nearing the line. "We see Sir Henry Cecil on Newmarket Heath every morning and, if we're having a bad time, he reassures us to keep plugging away so we've done that with Society Rock. You never know if they'll like this type of ground and he's never raced on it before, but he obviously likes it. It's a fantastic result for his owner Simon Gibson, who is sadly not here today because he had a fall down some stairs and banged his head. He's recovering at the moment, and this will make him feel better. It's also great for Pat [Cosgrave], who has been with us for a year, and he rode a fantastic race there." Cosgrave, who picked up his first Royal meet winner, added, "I think a lot of people doubted this horse after his first two runs this year, but this was the target all along. In the last three weeks, he's been showing all the old Society Rock, and he showed just how good he is today. I jumped too well and it was a bit tight for the first furlong, but I got the splits at the right time and he picked up good. All Group 1s are nice, but it's nice to get a first Royal Ascot winner on the board, and I hope there are many more."

Star of Wonder...

Star Witness (Aus) (Starcraft {NZ}) may not have left his hoofprints in the winner's circle, but he has certainly added to his legion of antipodean fans with two commendable performances this week. The fan club may yet swell further if the chestnut gets the nod for next month's G1 July Cup at Newmarket. Trainer Danny O'Brien was full of praise for his stable star. "A winner would have been great, but racing doesn't reward you out of turn," said O'Brien. "The horse has run very well today, but he's just found the ground a little testing. He hit the front full of running, but certainly tired inside the final furlong. He has got a really good burst, and if it was good going today he would have really let go. I'll be guided by how he comes out of this run, but we did come over here with the intention of running in three races if his form justified it. On his two runs this week, I'd say he has and I'd love to win one. He's got three weeks until Newmarket, and he's thrived since he's been here, so if he keeps going along that plane he'll be there on July Cup day [July 9]. Royal Ascot have been fantastic in the way they've looked after myself and the owners, and we'd love to come back here and win a race."

Having drifted alarmingly in the betting for her debut at Naas last month, Maybe nonetheless burst onto the scene with a 4 1/2-length success--which earned her ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status--and she confirmed that initial promise with a dominating score in this opening bout on the final day of this year's Royal Ascot meet. Taking a walk in the betting again, from an overnight even-money to a generous 5-2, the powerful bay broke best to settle in a prominent third through the early fractions. Tanking to the front in smooth fashion soon after halfway, jockey Ryan Moore was forced lower in the saddle to give encouragement when pressed at the two pole, and Maybe readily lengthened clear inside the closing panel to win decisively. "When the ground changed the way it did, we had to be a little worried and didn't know how things would pan out," admitted Aidan O'Brien. "We've always thought she was very smart, and she is a classy filly at home." Reacting to quotes as low as 7-1 favorite for next May's G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket, the Ballydoyle maestro added, "She was very impressive first time out when she won her maiden over six [furlongs], and we thought she'd stay much farther than that with time. She seemed to get the seven [furlongs] very well today, so you'd imagine she's have no problem getting a mile."

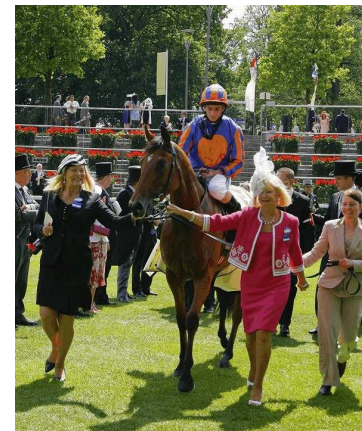


PEDIGREE NOTES - MAYBE

It took the significant bid of \$500,000 for Denis Brosnan's Epona Stud Management to secure listed winner Sumora when the daughter of Danehill was sold as part of the Swettenham Stud dispersal at the 2007 Keeneland November Sale, yet that already appears money well spent. Earlier this month, Sumora's 3/4-sister, Dancing Rain (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), made all to land the Oaks, thereby emulating her close relative Dr Devious (Ire) (Ahonoora {GB}) in recording an Epsom Classic victory. Epona Stud Management, which operates under the guidance of Paul McCartan at Croom House Stud in County Limerick, bred 2004 G2 Queen Mary S. heroine Damson (Ire) (Entrepreneur {GB}) and came close to further Royal Ascot success earlier this week when graduate Zoffany (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) was a fast-finishing second in the G1 St. James's Palace S. At €340,000, Maybe was the dearest Galileo filly sold in the ring at last year's Arqana August Sale when knocked down to Demi O'Byrne. She is yet another high-class prospect bred on the famed Galileo--Danehill cross. Maybe is the first winner from three foals out of Sumora, who has a yearling brother to the winner that is likely to be offered at this autumn's yearling sales. He'd been double-digit odds his last three starts without a win, but Pool Play got it done at his biggest price of the year to pull off the shocker here. The 6-year-old won his last two starts of 2010, taking a Woodbine allowance in November and the Valedictory S. in December, both on Poly. Stepping up to the graded ranks to kick off the new year, he switched to the turf to run a close-up fourth in the GII MacDiarmida S. at Gulfstream Park Feb. 19. The dark bay was fifth going 12 panels on the lawn in the Mar. 26 GII Pan American S. in Hallandale, and improved to be second at the same route in the Apr. 29 GIII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland. He was completely ignored making the very first dirt start of his career in his Grade I bow.

The longest shot on the board, Pool Play looked like he was right where he belonged early, trailing the field as Regal Ransom (Distorted Humor) and Mission Impazible led the pack through six panels in 1:13.37. But he got into gear three furlongs from home, and swung to the far outside at the top of the lane. The Canadian-bred was pickin' 'em up and layin' 'em down, eating into the advantage Mission Impazible built after Regal Ransom tossed in the towel. He dropped in several paths 70 yards from the wire, but avoided any significant interference, and caught the leader in the very last jump. Explaining the surface change, trainer Mark Casse said, "It all started when he was at Palm Meadows, and [son] Norman [Casse] would call me and say, 'Dad, this horse loves the dirt!' We didn't get to run him on the dirt [at Gulfstream], but we brought him here and started thinking about it again. He was working really well and I called [owner Bill Farish Jr.] and told him that we could go the grass route, but it'd be nice to see if he can run over the dirt, because there is a little race they'll run here in the fall for \$5 million."

The winner of the GII Matron S. and second in the GI Frizette S. at two, Awesome Maria made just four starts last season, taking the Riskaverse S. on the turf at the Spa. She capped the campaign with a runner-up effort in the GI Gazelle S. on the dirt at Aqueduct Nov. 27. Freshened after that test, the grey opened 2011 with a solid 4 3/4-length score in the GIII Sabin S. at Gulfstream Park Feb. 19, and made it two in a row with an eight-length leg-stretcher in the GIII Rampart S. Apr. 2. The Robsham homebred had to fight for it in the May 2 GII Shuvee H. at Belmont, beating Absinthe Minded (Quiet American) by a head while giving up seven pounds, and was giving her four rivals seven or eight pounds apiece this time. Off a half-step slowly after tossing her head at the break, Awesome Maria came on to press the pace from between Absinthe Minded and an over-eager Life At Ten. She put a head in front as they neared the stretch, then was joined by Life At Ten on the outside. Those two raced as a team for a half-dozen strides, but Awesome Maria swiftly asserted authority and drew clear. "She didn't break as well as I would have liked to, but once I got her into gear she was going comfortably the whole way around--really, really nice," jockey John Velazquez said. "Even though we were going a quick pace, she was doing it easy. Coming to the quarter pole, I got after her and made her switch leads and, down by the three-sixteenths pole, she got another gear." The winner will be pointed for the GI Ruffian S. at Saratoga July 31.

He brought me to the Kentucky Derby, which, hopefully, won't be a once in a lifetime experience. He's just a very special horse." Winning trainer Kelly Breen said that the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth July 31 was a "definite possibility."

Locally based Scotus wore down the dueling pacesetters--and race favorites--Joe Vann and Wilburn (Bernardini), and held the closing Infrattini safe to earn his first black-type badge in just his second career win. The 3-year-old colt got somewhat of a late start, debuting at Gulfstream in March, but looked like a horse with some talent when drawing off to a 2 1/4-length tally in a \$50,000 maiden claimer. Stepped up to a first-level allowance and stretched to two turns over Keeneland's Polytrack Apr. 16, he ran a game third, beaten 3/4 lengths. Third again, this time by 3 1/4 lengths, to Wilburn and Infrattini in an optional claimer under the Twin Spires May 15, he snuck in another race prior to this--a close-up second-place finish over course and distance June 5--while that pair headed straight to the Matt Winn. Maybe that experience and/or conditioning paid off, as the dark bay tucked in behind in third while the 5-2 Joe Vann raced up to press the 9-5 Wilburn, racing very wide, through :24.47, :48.27 and 1:12.45 splits. Joe Vann finally was able to inch past the chalk two furlongs out, but was tackled by a rallying Scotus a sixteenth from home. Scotus scooted clear as the wire approached, and was never seriously threatened by the running-on Infrattini, who nonetheless ran a nice race coming from well out of it. Scotus gave trainer Ken McPeck the first half of a graded stakes double, following the success of Bizzy Caroline in the GIII Regret S. a race later. McPeck admitted it almost didn't happen, though. "I came very close to scratching him," he said. "I debated all morning long whether this was the right spot for him or not. We were thinking that we were going to scratch if Joe Vann stayed in, and we would run in the starter allowance tomorrow. Finally, I called [owner] Pete Callahan and said, 'These are the races we like winning and these are the kind of races we need to run in. Let's just go with it.'"

Homebred Street Game got his head handed to him when facing state-bred maidens on the dirt at Saratoga last September, then disappeared. Shipped south for the winter and switched to the turf, the chestnut ran respectably in two open maiden races at Gulfstream, finishing second Mar. 13 and third Apr. 9. He was bet down to 3-5 with the return to the New York-bred ranks at Belmont May 7 and romped to a 10 3/4-length win. Street Game was looking to make it three in a row after taking a restricted allowance on a yielding local sod May 21. Breaking alertly, he took apprentice Ryan Curatolo right to the front and cut out out splits of :24.56 and :48.92. Curatolo sat chilly to the top of the lane, then went to work. Street Game opened up after a couple of left-handed taps and, after three quick looks over his right shoulder, his rider put the stick away and enjoyed the ride to the wire. Carl Lizza, owner of Landmark Builders, races under the name Flying Zee Stables and owns Highcliff Farm in Delanson, New York. He had success early with Wayward Lass (Hail the Pirates), who earned the Eclipse as the top 3-year-old filly of 1981. Two years later, in foal to another Flying Zee star in Noble Nashua (Nashua), the mare sold for \$2.35 million at Keeneland November. Lizza has had the family of the Hill Prince hero for some time. Third dam Marathon Girl (Fleet Nasrullah), purchased as a yearling for \$41,000, was third in the '79 GI Spinaway S. She produced MSP Anthenian Girl (Noble Nashua), dam of four black-type horses for Flying Zee. The quartet was topped by Thunder Achiever, winner of the GI First Flight H. in 1996. Street Game is her first stakes winner, though she is the second dam of New York SWs Thunderestimate (Western Expression) and Lady Vi (Tale of the Cat).

For the public, it was the right trainer, wrong horse. Kathmanblu was sent postward as the 9-5 choice to get back on track for conditioner Ken McPeek after a sixth-place finish in the GI Kentucky Oaks, but it was another McPeek-trained runner, the progressive Bizzy Caroline, who proved best in this contentious event. Bizzy Caroline looked pretty ordinary in her first few races. She was sixth in her turf and route debut at Saratoga last August, then, after a seven-month absence, ran an improved third in a grassy Gulfstream maiden in mid-March. But the light came on in her next, and she ran off to a daylight victory in a 1 3/16-mile event at Keeneland Apr. 28. That was followed by an even more impressive win in a first-level allowance here May 27, when she aired by seven lengths. And while the Churchill faithful backed Kathmanblu as the favorite, they gave Bizzy Caroline respect, too, as the 4-1 third choice. Under Manoel Cruz, Bizzy Caroline was never far back in fifth while Bouquet Booth, making her turf debut, cut out sensible :24.61 and :49.19 fractions. The pressing Excited forged to a narrow lead in upper stretch, but once Bizzy Caroline extracted herself, the race was essentially over, as she kicked away for another powerful win. "She ran a great race," said McPeek. "I think she is a filly that just needed to mature. When she was younger, she looked like a horse that was headed in the right direction, but would need some time. The Clays are a great family and had no problem with us taking our time to develop her." McPeek said he would probably send Kathmanblu on holiday. "I think she is probably due a rest," he said. "She's been running hard since January, and it might be time to just give her a little R&R and go from there."

The field was scratched down to four, and Banned had an easy time of it en route to his second straight graded score. The bay broke his maiden at Belmont in his turf bow last September, and followed up with a five-length allowance tally at Keeneland Oct. 17. He loomed a danger at midstretch in the Nov. 6 GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, but weakened late to be fifth, and was given the winter off. Third, but beaten just a neck, in a Keeneland allowance in his seasonal debut Apr. 17, he came from well back to beat 11 rivals in the May 6 GII American Turf S. at Churchill, and was the heavy chalk to make it two in a row. Changing tactics in this abbreviated field, Banned was under stout restraint as he sat second off easy early fractions. He powered his way to the front as they approached the stretch, and it took no more than a vigorous hand ride to see him pull away to a handy victory, with Jose Lezcano posing as they hit the line. "I felt like a winner the whole time," Lezcano said. Dam Cardinalli, who RNA'd for \$425,000 as a FTSAUG yearling in 2002, raced for breeders Albert Finney and Karen and Mickey Taylor, winning two of her 13 starts. She was purchased by Ken and Sarah Ramsey for \$125,000 as a 4-year-old broodmare prospect at FTKNOV 2005. Her first foal, a colt by Kitten's Joy, died as a yearling in 2008. 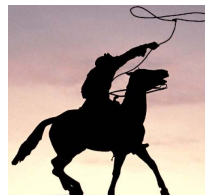

Mike Repole's champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) is set to begin galloping at WinStar Farm Monday. The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner has been boarding at that state-of-the-art facility in Versailles, Kentucky, since May 9--three days after he was scratched from the GI Kentucky Derby. Uncle Mo was diagnosed with cholangiohepatitis, an inflammation of the bile system and liver, June 3. Repole told *Newsday* that his colt, who is reportedly "going in the right direction" and has gained 100 pounds since he first arrived at WinStar, will go through a jogging routine for 10-14 days with the hopes of returning him to Todd Pletcher's barn in about a month. "Hopefully, if we can get him back, he can prove he's the best 3-year-old in the country in the second half of the season," Repole told *Newsday*. "But if he takes a step backward or the stress of racing is too much for him, he'll be retired. It's my responsibility to do the right thing."

Godolphin's **Delegator** (GB) (Dansili {GB}), scratched from yesterday's G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, is set for a run in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket. 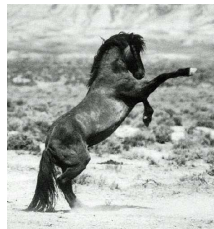

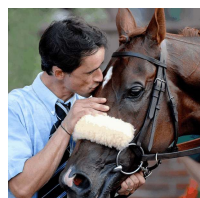
