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COILED AND READY TO STRIKE IN HASKELL

Trainer Bob Baffert has a remarkable record in Monmouth Park's GI Haskell Invitational S. Since 1997, Baffert has sent seven colts to contest the nine-panel

test. The first, Anet (Clever Trick), ran second at 5-1. He was followed by Forestry (Storm Cat), third as the 8-5 second choice in 1999, and Captain Steve (Fly So Free), beaten just 3/4 of a length when second to Dixie Union (Dixieland Band) as the 8-5 chalk in 2000. That was the last time a Baffert trainee was beaten in the Jersey Shore's signature race. Point Given (Thunder Gulch), bet down to 3-10,

gave the snow-capped conditioner his first Haskell win in 2001; he was followed by 3-10 War Emblem (Our Emblem) in 2002, even-money Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus) in 2005 and 6-5 Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike) in 2010. Suffice it to say, Baffert doesn't head to the Shore just to get another hot dog at Max's. This year, he brings in the lightly raced **Coil** (Point Given), who makes his sixth start as he bids to follow in the hoofsteps of his sire. The chestnut capped a three-race winning streak with a one-length tally in the GIII Affirmed H. at Hollywood June 11. He battled bravely in his latest, the July 9 GII Swaps S., but got caught late and ran second by a head. Comparing the colt to his quartet of Haskell heroes, Baffert said, "They were farther along--they were already proven really good horses. I'm just hoping that Coil is this good. We're going to find out a lot about him. He's trained really well, I think he's going to run a big race." The colt makes his conventional dirt debut. **Cont. p6**

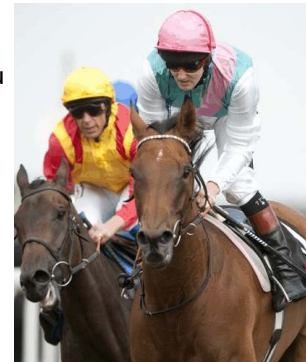

THREE-PEAT FOR MIDDAY

Sent off the 6-4 favorite in the absence of her chief opponent Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), Khalid Abdullah's **Midday** (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) justified that confidence to bring up a third consecutive renewal of Glorious Goodwood's G1 Nassau S. yesterday. Connections were left befuddled by her dramatic eclipse in the G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh last time June 25, but the old air of authority was back here as she dealt with **Snow Fairy** (Ire) (Intikhab) with the minimum of fuss. Settled in behind the steady early pace by Tom Queally, the bay took over with a quarter mile remaining and despite veering in front, as she had 12 months ago, was in no danger en route to a two-length score. In doing so, she was registering a record eighth win in this contest for her trainer Sir Henry Cecil, and also became the most successful horse to represent Warren Place at Group 1 level, having now racked up a total of six in that category. "She's a marvelous mare and has been a bit unlucky not to have won two or three more Group 1s," Cecil said. "What happened last time in Ireland, I'll never know, but she was beaten by a very good filly there." **Cont. p2**

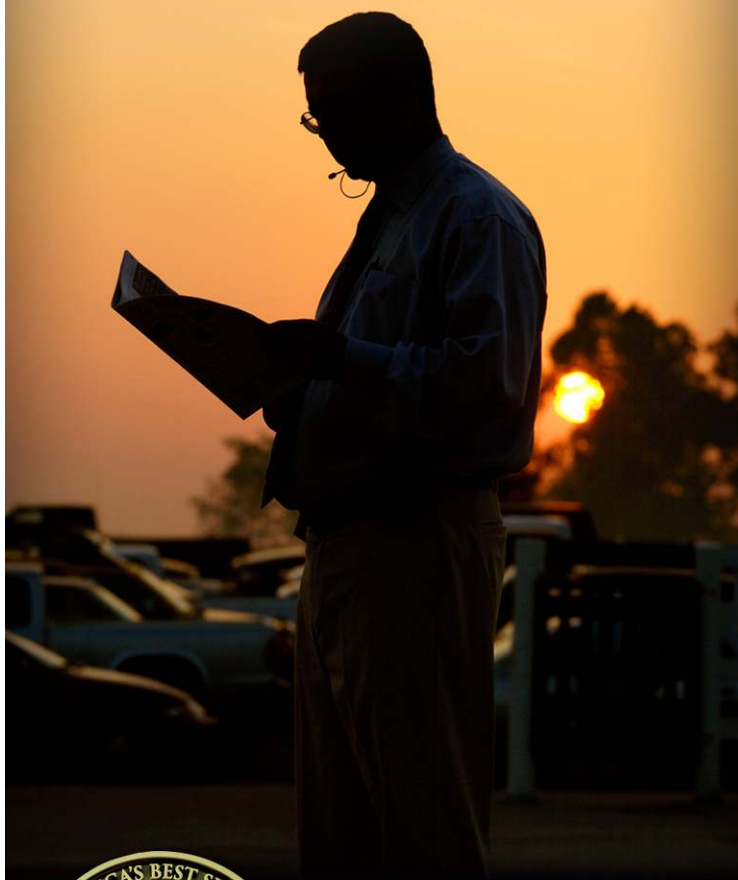

Highly reliable over the past three seasons, Midday had been out of the exacta on only two of her last 15 starts and when beaten always made sure that her opponent had been in a fight. This term, she started out with a comfortable win in York's G2 Middleton S. over this trip May 12 before going under by a length to St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in Epsom's June 3 G1 Coronation Cup. Widely considered to have gone for home too soon in that contest, the homebred was hammered into 1-3 for the Pretty Polly, but never got a look-in as Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) quickened away from her on rain-softened ground. That six-length defeat cast a cloud over her entering this renewal, but when Ballydoyle announced that her chief rival was not shipping in, the portents were strong for Midday's record bid. Always traveling comfortably in behind a steady pace set, she moved to the fore with ease at the top of the stretch and had only the following Snow Fairy to worry about from the quarter pole. Running around in the clear, as she had done when toying with Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) here 12 months ago, she was mainly hand ridden to safely hold the runner-up. "She's the queen of Goodwood--she loves it here," Tom Queally commented. "When I asked her to quicken, I was conscious that Frankie [Dettori] was there or thereabouts [on Snow Fairy] stalking me, so I gave her a smack to make her mind up. She's very special and an absolute sweetheart." Henry Cecil has a tilt at a second G1 Yorkshire Oaks in mind now. "All going well, she'll go for the [Aug. 18] Yorkshire Oaks and, after that, we'll just leave it completely open," he said. "We'll feel our way and let her tell us--I'm not going to tell her what to do."

Twice a Group 3 winner in France last year, Zagora ended her European stint with a close-up third in the G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville last August. The chestnut opened her U.S. account with a second in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland last October before going from Jean-Claude Rouget to Chad Brown. A neck runner-up in the GIII Hillsborough S. Mar. 12 at Tampa in her first start for Brown, she was third over a yielding Keeneland sod in the Apr. 16 GII Jenny Wiley S. The 4-year-old just missed in her latest, closing with purpose despite glacial fractions in the 10-furlong GII New York S. at Belmont June 25. Her late kick carried her to the wire first this time.

Zagora settled in fifth under stout restraint as previously undefeated favorite Unbridled Humor (Distorted Humor) cut out fractions of :25.20 and :50.31. The pacesetter was starting to feel the heat as they clicked off six panels in 1:14.02, but jockey Javier Castellano still had Zagora on hold in midpack. He finally gave the diminutive filly her head when they straightened for home, and she pinned her ears and drove past her

rivals, drawing off late to win handily. "My mentor, Bobby Frankel, taught me everything I know, especially about European horses," winning trainer Chad Brown said. "And this was one of his very favorite races. He loved the Diana, and we won it a couple of times when I worked for him." Brown added, "She had been knocking on the door and she had been a little unlucky, but one thing Bobby told me was, 'Go back to the European form and see who they were running with. It's a good measure of how much ability they have.' She was running with very good horses in Europe, so it was just a matter of time for her to fully acclimate over here, maybe get lucky with a trip, [and] find the ground she liked. Everything came together today." Unbridled Humor faded to seventh.

When he is good, he is very, very good, and Stay Thirsty was on top of his game yesterday. Second in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. over this track at two, the dark bay opened 2011 with a decisive win in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 5. He failed to factor in the Apr. 3 GI Florida Derby or the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, but turned it around with a game second in the June 11 GI Belmont S. The second choice here, Stay Thirsty was eased back to sit just off the leaders going into the first turn. Comfortably in fourth as they reeled off a half in :47.66, he was shifted into high gear approaching the stretch, put Dominus away at the eighth pole and pulled clear. It was the fourth win of the afternoon for trainer Todd Pletcher, and the second for owner Mike Repole. "I've been telling most of you guys that this is going to be a second-half 3-year-old, and he'll be better at four than he is at three," Repole said. "And I think that's what you saw today--a horse that's just getting better and better and better." The Aug. 27 GI Travers S. will be next for the winner.

Tres Borrachos had not visited the winner's circle since taking an optional claimer on the Hollywood Cushion in May of 2009. [Jones] said just find a spot and get comfortable. When I finally asked him to run, he just went."

Springing a surprise here, Dalarua finally justified the belief of connections who had pitched her into the G1 Prix Saint-Alary on only her third start. Only eighth in that 10-furlong Longchamp contest May 22, she was not disgraced when beaten under four lengths before finishing just over two lengths behind Beatrice Aurore (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) when an unlucky fifth in the G3 Prix Chloe over nine furlongs at Chantilly last time July 3. Bourbon Bay, four-for-five last term, went to the shelf after the GII San Juan Capistrano H. at Santa Anita in April. Third in the GI Clement L. Hirsch S. at Hollywood in October, he opened the new year with a win in the Jan. 17 GII San Marcos S. The gelding prepped for the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic with a nose second in the GII San Luis Obispo S. Feb. 17, but was a well-beaten 11th at Meydan Mar. 26. Freshened after his overseas trek, he was an even third in the June 11 GI Charles Whittingham H. at Hollywood, and entered this off a late-running fourth in the July 2 GI United Nations S. at Monmouth Park. The bay was making only his second synthetic start. Bourbon Bay rated in fourth as the three leaders opened up on the field in the early going. Still seven lengths adrift of the pacesetting trio after six panels in 1:13.21, he quickly bridged the gap as they approached the far turn. Dahoud put away his fellow frontrunners and set sail for home, but the chase was on. Bourbon Bay collared him at midstretch and drew clear under a vigorous Joe Talamo hand ride.

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Change of Pace?

Coil, prominent in each of his career starts, will have blinkers off for the Haskell, and his trainer has not made any concrete plans for tactics today. "You know what, I'm just going to leave it up to [jockey Martin Garcia]," Bob Baffert said. "Now that he has the rail, we'll just let him do his own thing. That's the best thing with Martin--I just let him do his own thing. Every time I give instructions, I mess him up." There is plenty of speed in the field, but the horse guaranteed to be on the front end early is GI Preakness S. hero **Shackleford**. The eye-catching chestnut cut out the fractions in the GI Kentucky Derby before weakening to fourth, and he was just a half-length off the lead in the opening exchanges of the Preakness. Jockey Jesus Castanon tried to slow it down as he set the pace in the GI Belmont S., but Shackleford didn't see out the mile and a half and finished fifth. As for Sunday's plan of action, trainer Dale Romans said, "Well, we're not going to take him back, we're just going to let him break running and see how the race sets up. If somebody wants to set an unrealistic pace, then he has no problem setting off of them, just like in the Preakness--having the target in front of him maybe even did him some good. If he goes to the lead, fine, and if somebody wants to gun, we'll just sit right off of them."

THE LATEST DIRT ON THE RUFFIAN

She didn't make her first start on conventional dirt until this June, but **Distorted Legacy** is now perfect in two tries on the surface. The Bruce Lunsford homebred shoots to the top floor in quest of her third in a row. Second for a \$50,000 tag on the turf at Gulfstream in January, Distorted Legacy was a troubled sixth in allowance company the following month. The chestnut came flying late after a tardy break to complete the exacta in a starter allowance in Hallandale Apr. 8, then headed north. Trainer Angel Penna Jr. was impressed by the way the 4-year-old was training over the Belmont main track, and decided to make a surface switch. "She could not handle the dirt at Palm Meadows at all," Penna said. "But when we came back to New York, she started gliding on the dirt. She changed completely. She loved it." The filly annexed an allowance at Belmont June 2 and added a win in the Sky Beauty S. July 1, with **Ask the Moon** back in third. She takes a major class hike this afternoon. "It's a big jump, but she loves the distance and has taken to this track very well," Penna said. "The allowance races will always be there, the Grade Is come and go, so why not take a shot?" **Payton d'Oro**, the morning-line chalk, came back after an 11-month layoff to be third in an optional claimer at Oaklawn in March. Second to **Super Espresso** in the May 21 GIII Allaire DuPont Distaff S., she was most recently runner-up in the June 18 GI Ogden Phipps H., with Super Espresso third that afternoon.

STARS ALIGN IN FOURSTARDAVE

Sidney's Candy, purchased privately from breeder Craig Family Trust after running second in the May 28 GII American H. at Hollywood, makes his first for owners WinStar Farm and Rubio B Stable this afternoon. The winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby on the all-weather, the chestnut, tried turf for the first time in the GII La Jolla H. at Del Mar last summer and scored by 5 1/2 lengths. He faded to sixth after setting the pace in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile in November, but bounced back with a 7 1/4-length triumph in the off-the-turf GIII Sir Beaufort S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26. The 4-year-old was runner-up in the GII Mervyn Leroy H. at Hollywood in his 2011 opener May 7. He rambled through five furlongs in :57.60 over the Oklahoma turf course July 24 in preparation for this test. Trainer Todd Pletcher, who took over from John Sadler when the colt changed hands, expects to see similar speed in the GII Fourstardave H. "I think he's a free-running horse, from what we've seen in his races in California," Pletcher said. "Speed seems to have done pretty well at the meet so far on the turf course. We're not looking to be cute and change his style. We'll let him run his race."

The 4-year-old took the Feb. 19 GII San Carlos H. by a head, and rallied for a 2 1/2-length tally in the Apr. 14 GIII Count Fleet H. at Oaklawn. Caught in traffic in the May 7 GII Churchill Downs S., he ended up a troubled sixth, but changed tactics to lead gate to wire in the July 2 GI Triple Bend H. back at Hollywood. He faces a tougher field in this year's edition of the Bing Crosby, but trainer Jeff Bonde is not particularly worried. "He's one of the few horses that I really don't worry about who he's racing with," Bonde said. "I just hope he comes with his best performance, because he's a true competitor and, if you beat him, you're going to have to run one whale of a race usually." The conditioner also feels his horse has improved with age. "He's just a more mature horse, he's gotten better with age and he's kind of filled out and no longer a teenager," he remarked.

FOURTEEN FOR GOLDIKOVA?

Now that Midday (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) has won three Nassaus, it is up to **Goldikova** to do the upstaging as she bids for a 14th victory at the Group 1 level, and a fourth consecutive renewal of the G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville, formerly known as the Prix d'Astarte. There is no evidence that the Wertheimers' queen is diminished in any way in 2011, but all defeats cast doubts and, despite the merit of her second to Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) in the June 14 G1 Queen Anne S., the fact remains that she comes here off a rare reversal. Freddy Head has not been dwelling on Royal Ascot as he prepares her for the return to the historic Normandy venue at which she has won four out of five. "She's very well, and I've been very happy with her since Ascot," Head told *PA Sport*. "Her training has been good, and I still feel she's as good as ever. We've got the pacemaker [**Flash Dance**], and she does her job well. Up against her own sex for the last few years, she has been very hard to beat." He added, "If everything goes well, she'll go for the [Aug. 15] G1 Prix Jacques le Marois next." Rodolphe Collet is in the rare position of having two live chances in a Group 1 race here and, in **Sahpresa** and **Nova Hawk**, he has two worthy contenders. Sahpresa, who has taken the last two runnings of the G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket, was 1 1/4 lengths second to **Timepiece** in the G1 Falmouth S. on Newmarket's July Course 23 days ago, while Nova Hawk was in the same spot behind Immortal Verse (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}) in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot when last seen June 17. "Sahpresa was unlucky at Newmarket, in that the pace of the race was slow," Collet told *PA Sport*. "She came from far back, and the tactic of the winner was a good one. Sahpresa has come out of the race well and, with pace in the race and good ground, I think she will run pretty well. If I beat Goldikova, I will be happy, and if I am second behind her, I will be pleased for that champion filly." Sir Henry Cecil could cap a week to end them all if

Famous Name looks for a well-deserved first success at this level, having missed out by a head in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly three years ago and finished runner-up in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and G1 Prix du Moulin the following year. His exploits in his native Ireland are well-documented, with a remarkable 13 black-type successes there including impressive recent efforts in the G3 International S. at The Curragh June 24 and G3 Meld S. at Leopardstown July 21. Chief among his opponents is the filly **Elle Shadow**, who returned from a lay-off to capture the G3 Grosser Preis der Wirtschaft in impressive style over 10 furlongs at Dortmund last time June 23. She is still relatively unexposed and there is a chance that she could begin to emulate her champion dam Elle Danzig (Ger) (Roi Danzig) with time still on her side. Of the remainder, last year's G1 Deutsches Derby third **Russian Tango** has the best form on offer but after a latest seventh in the June 26 G2 Hansa-Preis at Hamburg it would be a surprise if he is good enough to trouble the main protagonists.

Eightyfiveinafifty Nearing Return...

Four-year-old **Eightyfiveinafifty** (Forest Camp), sidelined since finishing fifth in the GII Woody Stephens S. at Belmont more than 13 months ago, may be close to a comeback. The bay worked five furlongs in a rapid :59.76 on the Saratoga main track Wednesday, but trainer Gary Contessa is not quite ready to drop the entry slip. "He got a little tired towards the end of the work this week, so we're still not there yet," Contessa said. "For the last year, that horse has been one step forward, two steps back, so hopefully we'll take one step forward and keep going forward for a change. I was at Aqueduct saying, 'Oh, yeah, he's a few weeks away from running,' and then I was saying that at Belmont and now we're at Saratoga thinking he's a few weeks away from running, so we'll see what happens. He'll probably work one day towards the middle of next week--with him, it's one day at a time, and you've got to pick your spots." Eightyfiveinafifty got everyone talking with a 17 1/4-length maiden victory at Aqueduct in January of 2010, then was again the topic of the day after bolting on the first turn in the Whirlaway S. and crashing through the outside fence. Undaunted, he returned to take the GIII Bay Shore S. that April, but was off the board in the GIII Derby Trial and in the Woody Stephens. His record stands at 6-2-0-1, with earnings of \$168,514.

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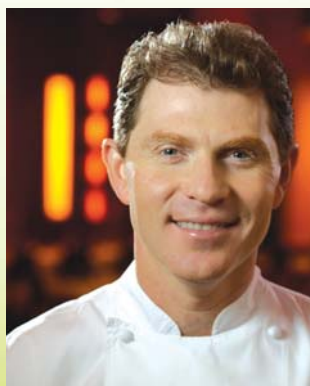

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Spa Jockey Title to Be Named in Honor of Cordero:
(Edited press release) The jockey title at Saratoga Race Course will be named in honor of Hall of Famer Angel Cordero Jr., a 14-time leading rider at the Spa. "For most of the 1970s and all of the 1980s, Angel Cordero Jr. and Saratoga were synonymous," said NYRA President and CEO Charles Hayward. "We are extremely pleased to honor Angel by naming racing's most prestigious jockey title after him." Cordero, known as the "King of Saratoga," won his first riding title at the Spa in 1967, riding 36 winners at the age of 25. Nine years later he came back to take his second title, with 29 winners in 1976, thus beginning a string of 11 straight years he remained atop the jockey standings. In 1987, Cordero's streak was snapped by Jose Santos, but he returned to win again in 1988 and 1989. Cordero, who was born in Santurce, Puerto Rico, on May 8, 1942, retired in 1992 with 7,057 career victories. 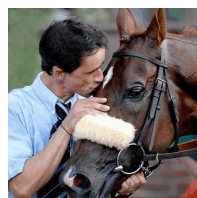

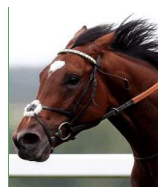
