

COIL AND BAFFERT RULE THE HASKELL

Coil (Point Given) proved he is a sophomore to be reckoned with in the second half of the season, outbattling GI Preakness S. winner **Shackleford** (Forestry) in deep stretch to earn a dramatic victory in Sunday's GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park. Off a step slowly, Coil was unhurried by Martin Garcia and soon trailed as longshot **Joe Vann** (Silver Deputy) took the field of eight through fractions of :23.38 and

:47.02. Favored Shackleford, always close to the pace, forged to the front at the quarter pole, but Coil was gearing up for his run from the middle of the track. The colt unleashed a furious rally to eyeball Shackleford in the final furlong. The favorite briefly battled back, but Coil was moving best of all late to give trainer Bob Baffert a fifth Haskell victory in the last 10 years. Coil's performance surprised even his conditioner. "He didn't break well and, at that point, I thought the race was over," Baffert admitted. "Down the backstretch, I thought he was going to have to be like his dad, Point Given, to win. In the stretch, when he was passing Shackleford it was almost like I couldn't believe what I was seeing." **Cont. p2**

ANOTHER GOLDEN DAY

Records are there to be shattered as far as **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) is concerned, and another went by the wayside at Deauville Sunday in the wake of the Wertheimers' all-time great, who racked up a fourth consecutive renewal of the G1 Prix Rothschild and a 14th Group 1 in total. No other horse has managed to win four consecutive French Group 1s since the start of the pattern-race program in the '70s and, predictably, it was the brilliant 6-year-old who achieved that feat in a much more impressive style than the winning margin of a neck to **Sahpresa** (Sahm) suggests. Tracking her trusty pacesetter **Flash Dance (Ire)** (Zamindar) until taking command with a quarter mile remaining, the 2-5 chalk had the race in safe keeping as Olivier Peslier--who was steering his 100th winner at the top level--eased off late to let the dual Group 1-winning runner-up close the margin, with the recent G1 Falmouth S. scorer **Timepiece (GB)** (Zamindar) adding further weight to the form two lengths adrift in third. "I am just over the moon--what can I add to what has already been said about her?" trainer Freddy Head said. "She is so good and so professional and is still at the top of her game at the age of six." **Cont. p2**

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Coil Battles to Haskell Victory (cont. from p1)

Jockey Martin Garcia admitted **Coil** (Point Given)'s bobble at the break changed his strategy for the race. "He was ready at the break, but just before the gates opened, he stepped back a bit, and that was that," Garcia explained. "I wasn't planning on being that far back, but once that happened, I didn't have a choice. I took him off the fence going up the backstretch, that didn't seem to be the best place today, it was kind of heavy. I was sitting on a ton of horse turning for home. When I got to Shackleford my horse kind of waited--he tends to do that when he makes the lead. I just kept getting into him. I knew I had Shackleford, but my horse made it interesting."

The lightly raced Coil was making just his sixth career start in the Haskell. A maiden winner in his second start at Hollywood Park last November, the chestnut opened his 2011 campaign with an optional claiming victory in Inglewood in May before earning a one-length triumph in the June 11 GIII Affirmed H. He missed by just a head when second in the July 9 GII Swaps S. last time out.

Coil, a son of Baffert's 2001 Haskell winner Point Given, gave owners Mike Pegram, Karl Watson and Paul Weitman a second straight victory in the race. No Excuses for Shackleford

There were no excuses from the runner-up's camp. Shackleford, making his first start since finishing fifth in the June 11 GI Belmont S., was a handful in the paddock, but looked to have a made-to-order trip. "We got a great trip," trainer Dale Romans said. "He took the lead turning for home, and dug in once Baffert's horse came up. It looked like he was digging in very gamely in deep stretch. I thought that he was going to come back and win it." Trainer Kelly Breen reported it was likely on to the Aug. 27 GI Travers S. for third-place finisher **Ruler on Ice** (Roman Ruler). The colt was closing late in his first start since winning the Belmont S. "They just kind of quickened going to the third quarter and it took him a while to get going," Breen reported.

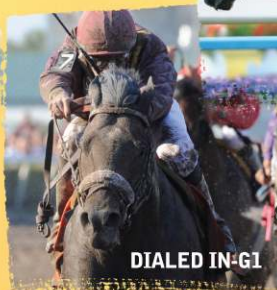
Since the upgrading of the European Pattern for fillies and mares early last decade, a new era has ushered in for the heavyweight distaffers, of which Goldikova takes the highest rank. Multiple Group 1 wins for the leading females has become commonplace, but it is probable that none will ever come close to equaling the tally of Goldikova, who was fittingly bringing up a 14th highest-level success in the centenary year of the Wertheimer racing operation. Watching her glide over the terrain of her favored Normandy circuit is like a replay of the previous occasion, with Flash Dance proving the perfect tow until two out when Peslier asks her to extend. That was the case again yesterday and there was never an anxious moment for her avid supporters, who had lost no faith after her eclipse at Royal Ascot at the hands of Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) in the June 14 G1 Queen Anne S. Only Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) has managed to get past her at this venue, when the ground turned against her in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois 12 months ago and Freddy Head is mindful that she should be spared another grueling test if the rains come again. "Of course, we are considering the [Aug. 15] Jacques le Marois now," Head said. "But if the going is soft, we could go to Ascot for the [Oct. 15] G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. I am guessing, but maybe I was too tender on her before Ascot, and she was not quite as fit as she should have been, but that is in the past now." **Cont. p4**

Jockey Tom Queally said of Timepiece, "She ran a great race, but Goldikova is Goldikova. She enjoyed herself on the track and traveled well, so I have no excuses."

Sahpresa's trainer Rodolphe Collet told the *Racing Post*, "Of course, I would have liked Sahpresa to have been first past the post, but I was happy to be beaten by Goldikova. The programme will be the same as last year. Sahpresa will not run again until she tries to land a hat trick in the [Sept. 24] G1 Sun Chariot S., and then she will be campaigned in Japan."

Ask the Moon, winless since taking an optional claimer in the Meadowlands slop way back in 2009, was claimed from Millicent Johnsen and trainer Ned Allard by Farnsworth Stables for \$75,000 out of a runner-up effort at Belmont June 15. She returned to run third for Gary Contessa in the July 1 Sky Beauty S. last time out. Making her first official start for trainer Marty Wolfson, the bay mare was sent off the longest shot on the board at 18-1. She jumped out to the early lead, setting fractions of :23.61, :46.92 and 1:10.83, and sailed clear uncontested for the upset victory. "It was a pretty decent pace, but the way she did it, on the lead, she was doing it so easily," said Javier Castellano, a replacement for Luis Saez. "She got a little tired at the end, but she gave me a good race and was strong." Castellano swept both stakes at Saratoga Saturday, taking the GII Jim Dandy aboard Stay Thirsty (Bernardini) and the GI Diana with Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune). "The weekend couldn't have been better," the rider added. Wolfson, speaking by phone from Monmouth Park, said, "She's a beautiful mare, that's why I claimed her. That, and the Malibu Moon. I loved that there was less speed in the race. I told Javier sometimes when you go to the lead, they'll back off and leave you alone. When they backed off on us, and left us alone, that was exactly what I wanted."

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Claim to Black-Type Fame...

Robert and Myron Miller's Farnsworth Farm is no stranger to success by way of the claim box. In fact, Farnsworth has perfected a strategy of targeting higher-priced claimers, most with good previous form, and turning them into stakes horses (if they weren't already). Its most notable success is the good sprint filly **Jessica Is Back** (Put It Back). Claimed for \$50,000 in 2009, the chestnut was moved to Marty Wolfson's barn and won her first stakes four starts later. Last July, she posted a career high in the GI Princess Rooney S. She was offered as a racing or broodmare prospect at the 2010 Fasig-Tipton November Sale and sold to Caroyn Vogel for \$475,000. She just missed by a nose when second in the Sunshine Millions F/M Sprint for Vogel, who kept her with Wolfson, before being retired to the breeding shed. And, while Jessica Is Back and Ask the Moon are Farnsworth's biggest scores, they aren't the operation's only astute claims. In April, Farnsworth reached in and claimed the 3-year-old filly **Oak Marsh** (First Samurai) out of a winning effort against \$50,000 maiden claimers at Gulfstream. She won a first-level allowance under Wolfson's care next out, and more recently was runner-up in the Desert Vixen S. at Monmouth. They claimed the 4-year-old filly **Bella Moneta** (Max's Pal) for \$32,000 in March.

She won an optional claimer in her next trip to the post, and was second in a pair of minor stakes at Calder in May and June. The 4-year-old filly **Bronx City Girl** (Yankee Gentleman) was taken for \$50,000 in May of 2010; she ran third in the GIII Azalea S. in her next, and has hit the board in her last three starts, all in stakes company. And **Amazing** (Greatness), who was already a SW & MGSP when she was claimed for \$75,000 at Saratoga last August, has proven her mettle with three additional stakes placings, including a second in the most recent renewal of the Sunshine Millions Distaff.

While Euroears failed to score in five starts last term, he did manage to hit the board in three of those outings, including a runner-up finish in the GIII Texas Mile and a third in the 8 1/2-panel GIII Lone Star Park H. A well-beaten 13th in his finale for trainer Bret Calhoun in last summer's GII Firecracker H. at Churchill Downs, the handsome chestnut was sidelined for the remainder of the year. An impressive 2 1/4-length winner in the GII Palos Verdes S. at Santa Anita Jan. 22, Euroears occupied the same position when shipped half way around the world for the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Meydan. The well-supported second choice in his first start since his return to America, Euroears enjoyed a clean break as favored Smiling Tiger was caught flat footed at the start and spotted the field a couple of lengths. While the 6-5 favorite tried to play catch up, Euroears reeled off opening fractions of :22.13, :44.26 and :55.91.

Holding a solid two-length advantage turning for home, the 7-year-old was given solid encouragement by jockey Rafael Bejarano in the dying strides, and had enough to hold off the late-closing Smiling Tiger at the wire. Euroears final time of 1:08.15 set a track record, eclipsing the 1:08.29 set by Cost of Freedom over this track Aug. 9, 2008. "That's his style [to show speed] and he ran a huge race today," said Mike Marlow, assistant to Bob Baffert. "Coming back from Dubai, he had time to recover and he runs well fresh. This track today wasn't favoring that kind of performance [track record]. But it didn't look like he was extended that much even at the wire." Joel Rosario, who was aboard the beaten favorite, said, "He broke just a little slow. I don't know if the post [No. 1] bothered him or not. I don't think so. He was just a little slow out of there. Then I didn't rush him. I just let him run his race. He ran well, but that winner had an easy lead and he was too much at the finish."

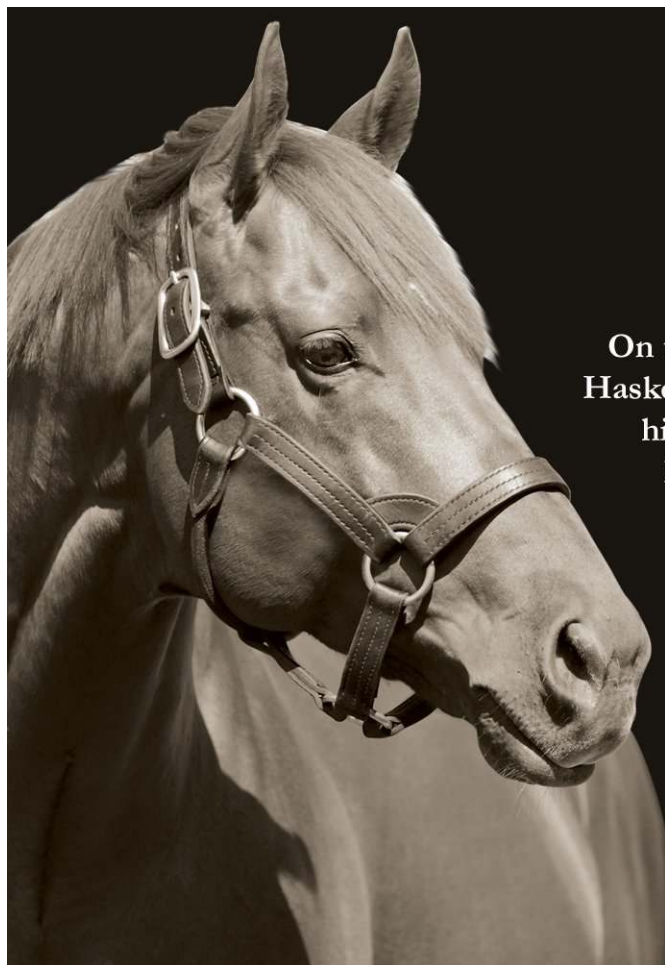

Durban Thunder was largely unconsidered here with the overseas challenger Famous Name and top domestic talent Elle Shadow in opposition, but the strong stayer had other plans as he took advantage of an enterprising ride from Terry Hellier. Sent straight to the lead from the outset, the chestnut kicked decisively at the top of the stretch and, despite Famous Name making some inroads late on, was not for catching. Durban Thunder had made significant progress at three when winning the Listed Grand Prix de la Region Alsace at Strasbourg in September and the G3 Engelbert Strauss Trophy at Baden-Baden the following month. Fourth behind Elle Shadow in the G3 Hessen-Pokal at Dortmund in November, he had returned to be third in the Listed Preis von Dahlwitz at Hoppegarten May 8 before filling that same position behind Night Magic (Ger) (Sholokhov {Ire}) in the 11-furlong G2 Grosser Preis der Badischen Unternehmen at Baden-Baden June 5. Only Lucas Cranach (Ger) (Mamool {Ire}) got in the way of a breakthrough success in the June 26 G2 Hansa-Preis over 12 furlongs at Hamburg, but there was no denying him this time as Famous Name missed out again at the top level. Trainer Torsten Mundry said, "Durban Thunder is at his best at the moment, and we left it up to Terry as to how he wanted to ride him. We are absolutely thrilled."

"As soon as I asked him, he responded and it worked out well for us," Velazquez continued. Elliott Walden, president and CEO of WinStar, added, "It's a little bit of a relief when you run a horse for the first time; obviously a big favorite. The pace scenario was a little unusual, especially for a horse that comes from California and wants to run in :22 and change, :45. I was a little apprehensive about him going that slowly, but he finished up nicely, which was exactly what we wanted." As for what is next for the versatile runner, trainer Todd Pletcher said, "We're going to consider the [Sept. 3 GI] Forego or the [Sept. 3 GI] Woodward, or turf. It's pretty rare that you have a horse that does everything as well as he does that's very, very good on three different surfaces."

He is Bright Generation's lone black-type horse. Dabirsim's dam Rumored was originally a \$325,000 KEESEP yearling. She failed to make it to the winner's circle in six career attempts, and later sold to Winning Bloodstock agency--with Dabirsim in utero--for \$60,000 at Keeneland November. Rumored had a Slickly (Fr) filly in 2010.
