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CAPE BLANCO LOOKS LIKE A MILLION

It was a great day for the Irish yesterday at Arlington Park, particularly if you were an Aidan O'Brien-trained Irish Derby-winning son of Galileo (Ire). First 2011 Derby winner **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) won the GI Secretariat S. and then, an hour or so later, 2010 Classic winner **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) swept to a 2 1/2-length victory in the GI Arlington Million S. Cape Blanco, favored at 2-1, settled in a stalking fourth as **Mission Approved** (With Approval) took the field along through

pedestrian fractions over the rain-soaked Arlington turf course. The Irish raider was asked for run turning for home, made a bold move to put his head in front in upper stretch and surged clear. **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) closed late for second, matching his finish in last year's Million. "He's a good tough horse and he's brilliantly trained," jockey Jamie Spencer said of the winner. "All I did was do the steering. Aidan gave me my instructions and I rode accordingly."

BEACH BATTLES TO SECRETARIAT WIN

Treasure Beach (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) outbattled **Ziyarid (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}) to give the Europeans a one-two finish in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Park Saturday. The Aga Khan's Ziyarid set a moderate pace with Treasure Beach a stalking second over a yielding turf course. The G1 Irish Derby winner pulled Colm O'Donoghue into closer order after a half in :50.09 and three-quarters in 1:14.64. He engaged the pacesetter late on the final bend and the pair battled determinedly with Treasure Beach moving best in the dying strides to win by the length of his neck, completing the 1 1/4 miles in 2:03 4/5. **Cont. p3**

Cape Blanco, a two-time group winner during his undefeated juvenile campaign, parlayed a win in last year's G1 Irish Derby into a strong runner-up effort

behind Harbinger in the G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. before storming home by 5 1/2 lengths in the G1 Irish Champion S. This term, the chestnut colt took to the synthetics for a fourth-place effort in the

G1 Dubai World Cup in March and was fourth again in the G1 Prix Ganay at Longchamp in April. He set sail for America after a sixth-place effort in the June 14 G1 Queen Anne S. and made a quick impact on these shores, defeating Gio Ponti by 2 1/4 lengths in the July 9 G1 Man o'War S. at Belmont Park. "I'm very pleased just to be able to ride the horse," Spencer continued. "There are very few horses that have the will to win like he has. The more you ask from him, the more you get from him. He had loads left in the end."

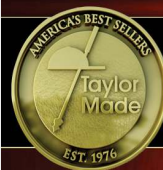

Cape Blanco won the Irish Derby and Irish Champion S. last term for owners Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor. Dubai socialite Fitri Hay joined the ownership group in March when she purchased a significant interest in the colt. Hay and her husband own the UAE-based holding company JMH Group.

Second Again for Gio Ponti...

Champion **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat), who won the 2009 GI Arlington Million, was bested in last year's renewal by Debussy (Ire) (Diesis {GB}). His campaign so far this term has been a case of close calls. He was fifth, beaten just 1 3/4 lengths, in the G1 Dubai World Cup and was third in the June 11 GI Manhattan H. before failing to catch Cape Blanco by 2 1/4 lengths in the July 9 GI Man o'War last time out. "The winner had first run on us and you have to give him credit, we were second best today," said jockey Ramon Dominguez. "If you put him in striking range too soon, he is going to go too early and it takes him out of his game. He isn't three any more, but he runs so good every time he's out there. We are all so used to his consistency."

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Treasure Beach Battles to Secretariat Win

Jockey Colm O'Donoghue was confident that **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) would be able to catch pacesetter **Ziyarid (Ire)** (Desert Style {Ire}). "He wasn't doing much," O'Donoghue said. "He was finding it quite easy in the homestretch. He just kept plugging on for me. He's very adaptable and can go on any ground."

Coolmore's Charlie O'Connor added, "Colm O'Donoghue gave him a great ride. Colm and [trainer] Aidan O'Brien were pretty confident coming over, so when the

two of them are confident, you have to be pretty happy."

Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Treasure Beach** ended his juvenile campaign with a third-place effort behind **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the G2 Royal Lodge S. and began 2011 with a narrow victory in the G3 Chester Vase S. in May. After just missing by a head when second in the June 4 G1 Epsom Derby, the dark bay rebounded with a 3/4-length win in the G1 Irish Derby. He was making his U.S. debut off a subpar fourth in the July 14 G1 Grand Prix de Paris.

Treasure Beach was bred by Brian and Jane Hammond's East Devon-based Ashley House Stud. Ashley House purchased the colt's dam, **Honorine (Ire)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), for 50,000gns as a 4-year-old out of the 2004 Tattersalls December sale. **Treasure Beach**, her third foal, was purchased for 180,000gns at that same sale as a weanling in 2008. **Honorine** has an unraced 2-year-old colt by **Singspiel (Ire)** and a yearling by **Cape Cross (Ire)** who brought 120,000gns at Tattersalls last December.

Happy with a Second...

Trainer Alain de Royer Dupre was content with **Ziyarid's** runner-up effort. "He had a perfect race," de Royer-Dupre said of the Secretariat pacesetter, who was coming off a win in the G3 Prix Daphnis. "He was beaten by a true Group 1 horse. I'm delighted we came. I think the horse proved himself." Jockey Christophe Lemaire added, "He was beaten by a Derby winner and that's not too bad, is it? He gave a great performance."

Traffic for Banned...

Glen Hill Farm's **Banned** (Kitten's Joy) was rank behind the slow pace and was forced to wait for running room before checking in third. "I had a real good trip going into the first turn, but the pace was just slow enough that he wasn't liking it and felt pressure from the other horses," Garrett Gomez explained. "He got rank with me and, turning for home, it cost him a little bit. If he had settled in a little bit more, I think he may have been able to outrun those horses. He was handling the course real well."

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Stacelita Sails to Beverly D. Win (cont. from p1)

Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}), making her first start for trainer Chad Brown, broke from the inside post and was content to let pacesetter **Dubawi Heights (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) take the early lead as she settled into a rail-skimming stalking trip. She took closer order on the final bend and snuck through along the rail inside of the pacesetter in upper stretch and burst free to a 1 1/4-length victory.

"I had an absolutely wonderful trip," admitted winning rider Ramon Dominguez. "I was able to sit right off the leader. Nice and relaxed--comfortable fractions. Turning for home, once I found a seam on the rail--I had to go for it and she reached for it great."

The talented Stacelita won the G1 Prix Saint-Alary and G1 French Oaks in 2009 and earned the win via disqualification in that

year's G1 Prix Vermeille. Her first loss came with a seventh-place effort behind Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the 2009 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. She was victorious in last year's G1 Prix Jean Romanet and ended the 2010 season with a close-up eighth-place effort in the G1 Hong Kong Cup. She began 2011 with a third-place finish in the G3 La Coupe and, in her stateside debut, was third against the boys in the G1 United Nations S. in her final start for trainer Jean-Claude Rouget.

Stacelita gave owner Martin Schwartz a record third win in the Beverly D. The 66-year-old stock broker won the race in 2006 with Gorella and in 2005 with Angara. Schwartz purchased Stacelita privately from breeder Jean Pierre Joseph Dubois, just prior to her French Oaks victory. "Stacelita and Chad Brown are both fantastic," Schwartz said yesterday. "Stacelita has been a magnificent animal since I first saw her, and Chad has been a magnificent animal since I first saw him."

Jockey Joel Rosario was happy with Dubawi Heights's second-place effort. "She ran great," he said. "I tried to slow it down as much as I possibly could and let her go turning for home. She responded well, but the winner is just so good that our best wasn't good enough today."

The classy Winchester, who almost exactly three years ago took the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Park, added a pair of Grade I events down at Belmont Park last season, and with a bullish late run in this, added a fourth top-level score to his resume. The Firestone homebred enjoyed a strong 2010 season, winning three of nine, including the GI Manhattan H. and GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational. A respectable fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf in November, he then failed to fire in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase, coming home 11th. Off from December to July, he returned in the off-the-turf GIII Stars and Stripes H. at Arlington July 23, and while he made up some ground to be second that day, it was obvious he lacked his usual kick. That kick was in full force yesterday. The 6-year-old was last of seven as Rahy's Attorney ensured honest fractions of :24 1/5, :48 3/5 and 1:13 2/5. Winchester and jockey Cornelio Velasquez edged closer heading into the far turn, moved widest coming into the lane and chased down the very game pacesetter. Al Khali, squeezed a bit late, ran on for third. "My horse had a very good trip," said Velasquez. "He was ready for this race. He always runs a big race, and today he ran another one. I rode with confidence, but I had a lot of horse." Winning trainer Christophe Clement added, "I knew that [the Stars and Stripes] would set him up perfectly for this race. He was unlucky: the race was switched from the turf to the Polytrack. He ran well anyway, and the race set him up, as you can see, perfectly for today." Rahy's Attorney was vanned off after pulling up lame, but Dr. Larry Bramlage, the veterinarian on call, said there was "nothing outwardly wrong" with the 7-year-old gelding.

It was a tale of two trips in the La Jolla as favored Midnight Interlude (War Chant), winner of the GI Santa Anita Derby earlier in the year, was blocked abruptly in the stretch, while the hard-knocking Burns was the beneficiary of a heads-up, rail-skimming Pat Valenzuela ride. Burns, making his 11th start of the year, won by a nose in a Hollywood Park optional claimer June 25, then finished a good second to the highly regarded Mr. Commons (Artie Schiller) in the restricted Oceanside S. July 20. Immediately angle toward the rail by Valenzuela, Burns tracked in fourth as longshot Thirtyfirststreet and Surrey Star (Dubawi {Ire}) led the way. It was those two into the stretch, and as Midnight Interlude was stymied trying to split the pair, Burns slipped up the inside and just outfinished the fast-closing Lil Bit O'Fun. "I was down there inside saving and waiting," said Valenzuela. "The horse in front of me [Thirtyfirststreet] was trying to get out on both turns, and I knew the rail was going to open up. I just had to be patient and hope it happened at the right time. At the eighth pole I made it through and he fired. He ran huge. And he'll run farther. I have no doubt about that." It was an emotional win for trainer Barry Abrams, who is recovering from throat cancer and currently speaks through a voice-enhancing device. It was the barn's first win of the Del Mar meet.

Third behind Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) when last seen in the June 14 G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, Excelebration showed the benefit of his subsequent vacation to annihilate a competitive line-up here. Always close to the pace set by the stable's Ceremonial Jade (UAE) (Jade Robbery), the well-backed chalk took over passing the quarter pole and, despite veering right under Adam Kirby, was extending his advantage over the chasing pack as he maintained his powerful surge. Excelebration, who was also second to Frankel in the Apr. 16 G3 Greenham S. over this track and trip before annexing the G2 Mehl Mulhens-Rennen May 22, is set for a rematch in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Oct. 15. "I think there will be improvement to come from him, and he will come on from it, so I was delighted with the way he won," trainer Marco Botti said. "Adam said he got him relaxed behind the pacemaker and, when he asked him, he quickened straightaway. For me, he is a stronger horse than he was at Royal Ascot. There is a big gap between now and the QEII, so he might go to France for the [Sept. 11] G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, but it all depends how he comes out of this. Everybody dreams about giving Frankel a race, but he is not just a normal good horse--he is a freak--so to think we can beat him is a bit unrealistic at this stage, but who knows. All I can say is our horse is tough, and he was relaxed beforehand and didn't sweat today, so that's a sign that he is enjoying what he does. If he keeps on improving, maybe one day. Gitano Hernando (GB) (Hernando {Fr}) gave us good days, but this horse's turn of foot makes him probably the best I've had."

Slowest to break here, he was soon rushed up to race close to the early tempo and, after being asked to stride to the front with three furlongs remaining, was always holding his arch-rival in the run to the line. "He was well-beaten by Brown Panther before and he beat him well today, so he's obviously a horse massively on the upgrade, and he'll be our first runner in the St Leger," the trainer's son and assistant Richard Hannon Jr. explained. "He's a very talented horse and is improving, which is the main thing at this time of year--he was lightly raced last year and has been relatively lightly raced this year, too, so he's probably the perfect horse to take into that race. He was a little bit inexperienced at Newmarket and was green and ran around a bit, but today he had a rail and showed he is mentally tough enough for the Leger." Jockey Richard Hughes added, "He was very good there and is a horse that could win a Leger now. He's a big, raw horse who is only getting better and better, and they stopped in front of me, so I had to get rolling early, and he doesn't do a stroke in front."

Stewards took a look at Savvy Supreme's trajectory in the stretch, but let the result stand. "She just got here this morning," said Anthony Sciametta Jr., assistant to trainer Todd Pletcher. "Coming out of sprints, we thought she'd be in front, but those two other horses went really fast early. We were able to sit in third just off the speed. Everything worked out perfectly for us. I'm not sure where she'll go next. I would imagine she'll ship back to Saratoga in a couple of days."

Arguably the top California-based turf filly of her generation last season, Pam and Marty Wygod's **Harmonious** looms the one to beat as she continues on a path connections hope will end in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf in November. Only 10th in that event last season, the homebred had no pace to run at and missed by a nose in the GII Robert J. Frankel S. Jan. 1 at Santa Anita. She took on fellow 4-year-old fillies in the Feb. 13 GII La Canada S., but dirt was not her calling, and she finished a well-beaten third of four. Rested off that effort, she resurfaced in the GII Royal Heroine Mile July 4 at Hollywood. The distance of that race was always going to be uncomfortably short, and the dark bay was doing her best work late, finishing second. She gets an extra furlong to work with this afternoon and should prove tough. Defending champ **Wasted Tears** is more distance-limited than Harmonious and enters this off a fifth in the GIII Modesty H. at Arlington July 9. Despite getting things her own way up front, she could not see out the 9 1/2-furlong trip and retreated to finish fifth. This cutback to a mile and an eighth will be to her liking. **Celtic Princess** just missed in the GI Gamely S. going this distance May 30, but atoned for that defeat in the Royal Heroine. "It's between Harmonious and Celtic Princess," said the Royal Heroine winner's trainer A.C. Avila. "I do believe we have to beat Harmonious. Celtic Princess has trained super, like she always does and it's good that we're against femals. It's good that she has drawn outside. She'll be clear to go her own and she has good tactical speed for Rafael [Bejarano] to decide what to do."

GI Belmont S. winner **Ruler On Ice** (Roman Ruler) turned in a five-furlong drill at Monmouth Park Saturday in a bullet :58.80 under jockey Jose Valdivia, Jr. "Tremendous," trainer Kelly Breen said of the move. "He started out five lengths behind a couple of his stablemates and he finished four in front. He worked as good as a horse could work. It was visually very impressive." The gelding enters the Aug. 27 GI Travers S. off a third-place effort in the GI Haskell Invitational.

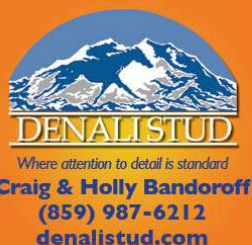

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DIXIE UNION COLT TOPS FTNAUG DAY 1

With the prospect of slots-infused purses and on the heels of a successful select sale, the first session of Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga New York-Bred Preferred Yearlings Sale last night realized huge gains in average and gross, a healthy boost in median, and reason for optimism for local breeders. A total of 11 horses eclipsed the six-figure mark, compared to just a single horse during last year's corresponding session. Leading the way was hip 300, a colt by the late Dixie Union who went to Cheyenne Stables LLC for \$250,000.

Don Robinson's Winter Quarter Farm consigned the youngster, a Jan. 16-foaled bay son of the 11-year-old GSP Dash For Money (General Meeting). The colt was bred by Waterville Lake Stables, a longtime client of Robinson's. Known to some as the man who raised Zenyatta, Robinson signed for Dash For Money for \$230,000 at the 2007 Keeneland November Sale. The foal she was carrying at the time, the Waterville Lake-bred Prado Dash (El Prado {Ire}), sold to Jim Tafel for \$160,000 at KEESEP 2009. Now three, Prado Dash broke his maiden in a Churchill special weight in June, added an allowance there July 3, and was most recently unplaced in a restricted stakes at Saratoga Aug. 8. Waterville Lake's homebred Miss Valentine (Afleet Alex) ran second as the favorite in the GIII Monmouth Oaks yesterday.

Cheyenne Stables, whose lone purchase on the night was the session topper, is the nom de course of Everett Dobson, who recently became a minority partner in Three Chimneys Stallions. Owner of the NBA team Oklahoma City Thunder, Dobson won the GII Amsterdam S. with Caleb's Posse (Posse) two weeks ago at the Spa.

The second-highest price on the night was the \$150,000 Walter Sorace, agent, paid for hip 271, a colt by Orientate out of Back Bay Lady (A. P. Jet). The colt's winning dam is a half to GSW Inherit the Gold (Gold Token). Vinery Sales, agent, consigned the Empire-bred.

In all, 59 horses sold for \$3,067,500. Compare that to last year, when 55 sold for \$1,908,000. The average of \$51,992 was up a whopping 49.9%, while the median of \$33,000 was up 22.2%. The lone black mark on the evening was the RNA rate: a high 35.9%. Last year, it was 25.7%. 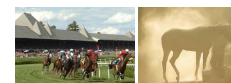

ROSY OUTLOOK FOR NY RACING As was observed by a member of the audience, "Everybody gets along when there's plenty of money to go around," and so it was with the harmonious panel of five assembled for the New New York Forum: The Latest on Breeding and Racing in the New VLT Era, held Saturday morning at the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs. The quintet consisted of New York Thoroughbred Breeders Inc. Executive Director Jeff Cannizzo, Fasig-Tipton Director of Marketing Terence Collier, New York Racing Association CEO Charlie Hayward, Genting New York President Michael Speller and trainer Rick Violette Jr., president of the New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association. Reflecting the mood of the majority of those at the well-attended event, Cannizzo said during his opening remarks, "[The VLT era] is something we have all been waiting on for a very long time. I'm very excited about this, everyone at this table is very excited about this and, I'm sure, everyone in the room is very excited about this. There is going to be significant change in the racing and breeding industry in New York, and it very well could affect racing and breeding nationally." After a decade-long delay, the Resorts World Casino is set to open in October. "We are going to get this done in record time," Speller said. Genting, the largest gaming company in the world with market capital of \$45 billion and some 58,000 employees world-wide, has made an \$830-million investment in the Aqueduct facility--its first foray into the American gaming industry. The two-million square foot casino is expected to produce more than 3,000 jobs. The first of the 4,525 VLTs to be installed are scheduled to arrive Tuesday. According to Speller, revenue from the VLTs is projected to produce \$55 million a year for purses; \$10 million annually for breeders' awards; and more than \$50 million each year for capital and operating expenses for NYRA. The state is predicted to garner \$550 million a year, including \$350 million for education. "There is \$2-3 billion a year [in gaming revenue] that goes across state lines," Speller said. "Our role is to keep that money in [New York]." And, unlike racing jurisdictions with VLTs, such as Indiana and Pennsylvania, who have seen their share of the VLT revenue cut due to legislative changes that give the states a larger share, the situation for the industry in New York appears more secure. "The splits to the racing industry are done by statute in other states, and anything done by statute today can be undone by statute tomorrow," Hayward said. "But, in February of 2008, when we were awarded our 25-year franchise, the franchise agreement contained the splits to NYRA, to purses and to breeders. We also have a settlement agreement that stipulates these amounts, so we have the statute, the franchise agreement and the settlement agreement. It would be tough to change the splits in New York, and I think we'd have a strong legal case if the state tried to do so."

There were concerns raised that, with the boost in purses, the competition for stalls in the state would grow as well, and local trainers might get shut out. But the concern did not fall on sympathetic ears. "The racing is going to get tougher," Violette said. "But if you are not in this business trying to achieve excellence, you are going to fail. New York is going to have the best racing in the country, if not the world, and it is the job of the racing secretary and NYRA to put the best horses in the stalls here. It's a real business, not a charity. If [NYRA Racing Secretary] P.J. Campo doesn't do that, if the quality of racing slips, it's his butt on the line."

Mangalee Nearing Finish of Mongol Derby:

Edited Press Release

It's 512 miles down, approximately 120 more to go for Monmouth Park marketing manager Sophia Mangalee as she competes in the Mongol Derby, the world's longest horse race. The 28-year-old Eatontown, NJ, resident is currently one of approximately two-dozen riders from around the world riding in Mongolia's historic race. The 1,000-kilometer (630-mile) course is based on the legendary postal system of Ghengis Khan, using a series of horse-changing stations every 40 kilometers. With the eighth day of riding in the books, and with just two days remaining to complete the race, Mangalee has only two horse stations between her and the finish line. While the first of the Mongol Derby participants crossed the finish line Friday night, Mangalee remains in a group of about four riders with a little over 100 miles remaining. According to www.mongolderby.com, Mangalee's adventure was delayed on Thursday when her horse ran off as she jumped off to tighten the girth. With her mount on the loose, Mangalee was reportedly forced to walk seven kilometers back to the nearest horse station. Once back on the course, Mangalee made up good ground to stay in range of the main pack of riders. Aboard native, semi-wild horses, Mangalee and the rest of the field are negotiating the Outer Mongolian Steppe with only 11 pounds of gear and nothing more than the stars and a GPS to guide them.

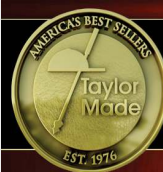

(Danzig--Foreign Courier, by Sir Ivor) has been pensioned after failing to get any of his mares in foal this season, the *Racing Post* reported yesterday. Having stood at Shadwell since his retirement from racing 25 years ago, first at Melton Paddocks and then, from 1990, at Nunnery Stud, the 28-year-old Gainsborough-bred will spend his retirement at the Norfolk establishment. One of the leading sires of the last three decades, his legacy as a sire of sires was secured by his highly influential sons Cape Cross (Ire), Oasis Dream (GB) and Invincible Spirit (Ire). Sam Bullard, director of stallions at Darley, told the *Post* Friday, "He has proven to be an outstanding sire of sires, and we are fortunate enough to stand his very best son, Cape Cross, and leading freshman of 2008, Kheleyf." Trained by Sir Michael Stoute for the late Maktoom bin Rashid Al Maktoom, the bay won five of his 14 starts, including the 1986 G1 July Cup and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup, and was runner-up to Dancing Brave in that year's G1 2000 Guineas and G1 St James's Palace S. As well as the aforementioned trio of heavyweights sired during his spell at Sheikh Hamdan's establishment, Green Desert was also responsible for a host of top-class runners, including Oriental Express (Ire), Sheikh Albadou (GB), Shinko Forest (Ire), Desert Prince (Ire), Desert Style (Ire), White Heart (GB), Markab (GB), Desert Lord (GB), Owington (GB), Diamond Green (Fr), Tamarisk (Ire), Desert Sun (GB) and Byron (GB) and also the high-class distaffers Heat Haze (GB), Maqaasid (GB), Rose Gypsy (GB) and Bint Allayl (GB). In total, he has sired 24 Group 1/Grade I winners, four champion sprinters and 40 group- and graded-stakes winners.

A maiden winner at Tipperary last season, Master of Hounds was third in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at two and second by a nose in the G2 UAE Derby at Meydan in his 3-year-old bow. Overall, he has compiled a record of 9-1-3-1 and earnings of \$520,878.
