STABILITY EXPECTED AT KEENELAND

Entering last year's Keeneland September Sale, there were hopes the market would halt a dramatic slide sparked by the economic crisis of 2008. The market did stabilize--the average at September enjoyed a 6.4% bump to \$64,811, and the median was up 13.6%, to \$25,000. Now, with a handful of domestic and European yearling sales in the books, there's more confidence that the market will again find solid footing in 2011. The 13-session September sale kicks off tonight at 7 p.m. "I think we're going to be all right," consignor Headley Bell of Mill Ridge Sales said yesterday afternoon. "We've seen quite a lot of traffic and, you know, there's a pretty good feeling back here. There are a few new faces, too." Mill Ridge consigned last year's topper, the \$4.2-million A.P. Indy--Balance colt who went to Benjamin Leon Jr.'s Besilu Stables. The 2011 renewal of September will closely resemble last year's revamped format. A smaller, more select Book 1 will be held tonight and tomorrow night. Book 2, reduced from four days to three, runs from Tuesday through Thursday, with sessions beginning at 11 a.m. And after a dark day Friday, the remaining eight uninterrupted sessions start at 10 a.m. each day. **Cont. p15**

Very few Ballydoyle Group 1 winners are bargain buys, but Power has made a mockery of his 50,000 guineas price tag this term. Purchased privately by Demi O'Byrne at Tattersalls last year after failing to meet his reserve, the bay paid instant dividends for that foresight by earning ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status when beating the subsequent G3 Tyros S. winner Remember Alexander (GB) (Teofilo {Ire}) on debut over six furlongs here May 2. Aggressively ridden back at five panels to garner the May 21 Listed Marble Hill S. here, he again proved generous to his rider's urgings when adding the June 14 G2 Coventry S. to his tally at Royal Ascot.

He lost his unbeaten tag when caught close home by La Collina (Ire) (Strategic Prince {GB}) in the G1 Phoenix S. back at this venue last time Aug. 7, and that may be the last time he is seen over shorter sprint trips if this strong-staying effort is any guide. Receiving a more patient ride from Seamie Heffernan, Power was amenable to restraint in fourth as stable companion David Livingston

set a solid tempo under Pat Smullen. Angled out for his effort inside the final quarter, he dragged Dragon Pulse and Fran Berry along in his slipstream as the long-time leader refused to buckle, and only started to get on top in the final 100 yards. At the line, Power had made his strength count from the

G2 Futurity S. winner, who was the only one to stand in the way of a Ballydoyle sweep as Furner's Green (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) made up significant ground to be fourth. "I was always happy I was going to pick up the leader," Heffernan commented. "I wasn't sure about Dragon Pulse going into the race, but I was sure Fran [Berry] was going to be tracking me. In my opinion, there is a chance he might be better again at a mile. He's tough and genuine and is a big, strong colt." Aidan O'Brien is still some way off Dr. Vincent O'Brien's record of 15 wins in this race, but Power was recording an eighth for the current Rosegreen incumbent.

Dragon Pulse's trainer Jessica Harrington told *Racing Post*, "Fran said he was still a little bit green, because he came there almost travelling better than the winner, but he was just a little bit more battle-hardened than our fellow. That to me proves he's a good horse. He'll obviously stay a mile. Whether he's done enough for this season, I don't know."

Masked Marvel, fifth to Genius Beast (Kingmambo) in Sandown's G3 Classic Trial in his sophomore bow Apr. 24, took in the May 18 Listed Cocked Hat S., but was no match when eighth in the G1 Epsom Derby June 4. He regained the winning thread with a narrow verdict over Census (Ire) (Cacique {Ire}) in the July 7 Listed Bahrain Trophy at Newmarket last time, and took a giant leap forward here. The bay was reserved off the pace as stablemate Buthlezi (Dynaformer) cut out solid fractions on the front end. Making ominous headway in the long straight, he seized control just inside the two pole and was urged clear from there to claim a career high. "Masked Marvel won well at Goodwood, but was confused by Epsom, and then he came back really well at the [Newmarket] July meeting," explained Gosden. "[Owner] Mr. [Bjorn] Nielsen allowed me to back off him and give him a nice freshener to come here, so we've got a lovely horse for the autumn. To win the oldest Classic with this horse is what we'd planned for about two years, so sometimes it works. He's got a high cruising speed and I told William to settle where he was comfortable and happy, and don't attack too soon, as there is a hell of strong headwind [in the straight]. He's been working quite beautifully at home, and I'd have been shocked if he hadn't finished in the [first] three."

With 8-13 favorite Fame and Glory (Montjeu {Ire}) completely bombing, it was left to the British raiders to fill the first three spots, and Duncan and Jukebox Jury proving inseparable at the line. Duncan, winner of the G2 Yorkshire Cup in May, was coming off a runner-up finish in the G2 Lonsdale Cup at York Aug. 20. Jukebox Jury entered this contest off a front-running score in the G2 Prix Kergorlay at Deauville Aug. 21. Taken to the front early by Johnny Murtagh, Jukebox Jury raced with enthusiasm, tracked all the time by Duncan and Fame and Glory. The favorite started to send out distress signals before the final turn, and the front pair had it between them, with the long-time leader looking to have the advantage as they began their war of attrition. But Duncan refused to give in to his rival and, with Eddie Ahern using hands and heels for the final furlong, managed to craft a share of the spoils.

Trumpet Major broke through at Goodwood in his second go May 21, but was out with the washing behind yesterday's G1 National S. hero Power (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) when pitched straight into the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot. Narrowly beaten by Talwar (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) in the July 23 Listed Winkfield S. back at the Berkshire venue next time, he gained a confidence-boosting conditions score at Newmarket Aug. 11, but was undone by rain-softened turf behind Talwar again nine days later in the G3 Solario S. at Sandown last time. Trumpet Major was sharpest from the gate, but was reined back to race third under cover as Entifaadha led the field into a headwind. Stoked up and angled into the clear for his bid at the two pole, he quickened to the fore passing the furlong marker and ran on strongly from there to easily assert superiority from the strong-finishing G2 Superlative S. victor Red Duke, who found a three-pound impost for that victory too much to bear. "We didn't go that fast because the headwind was slowing us down," explained rider Richard Hughes. "I was lucky to get a bit of cover and, when I whipped him out, he took off." Red Duke pleased trainer John Quinn, who revealed lofty plans for the runner-up. "Red Duke has run a very good race and I'm very pleased with him, but the ground may not have been quick enough," said Quinn. "Next stop is the [G1] Breeders' Cup Juvenile [at Churchill Nov. 5]. That will be tailor made for him, because he needs a mile run at a frenetic pace."

French Navy was the comfortable winner of the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp in September when trained by Andre Fabre and went on to finish fifth in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud at the end of October. Sidelined by a stress fracture until returning for his new conditioner with a workmanlike win in a 10-furlong Newmarket conditions race Aug. 13, the bay was restrained from the stalls to race at the tail of the field this time. Coming around his rivals to challenge up the stand's rail outside the quarter pole, the homebred hit the front soon after and was ridden out to win with a little in hand. Diana Cooper, Godolphin's representative, said, "He had his issues earlier in the season, but just needed time. Last year, he showed us enough promise for us to give him all the time that he needed. He didn't like the very soft ground in the backend of last year in France. This year he's done well physically and loved his reintroduction at Newmarket. He's won with similar ease today, and we'll see where Sheikh Mohammed would like to race him next and take it one step at a time. The pace looked strong, which allowed him to settle, and Ahmed gave him a lovely ride bringing him up this stand's side."

start, but the dark bay is worth considerably more these days. Second to Comma to the Top (Bwana Charlie) in the Real Quiet S. at Hollywood in his 2010 finale, he resumed May 29 with an allowance win in Inglewood, and it's been nothing but Derbies since. The Zayat colorbearer annexed the GIII Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows June 25 and added Mountaineer's GII West Virginia Derby for good measure

Aug. 6. With no early opposition, rider Rafael Bejarano sent his mount up to take the lead, and Prayer for Relief got away with murder: a half in :50.31 and six panels in 1:15.49. Awesome Bet and Populist Politics came wide with eye-catching runs, but the favorite had plenty left in the tank, and was going away again late. I thought [second-choice Meistersinger {Yes It's True}] would be on the lead, but, after the break, you never know," Bejarano told *Daily Racing Form*. "I was supposed to be the second speed. He did it easily."

After an unsuccessful spell in Dubai, he returned to annex the G2 Prix du Muguet at Saint-Cloud May 1 before finishing third behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan. His subsequent fourth behind Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Sussex S. July 27 was no disgrace despite the fact that he was never able to get out of last place.

"I hope she can run well and I hope she can win, but it is a good race," trainer **Freddy Head** told *PA Sport*. "It was a very good performance from her in Deauville, and her preparation has gone very well since. Everything is fine." While **Sarafina** is not here, **Alain de Royer-Dupre** has a smart deputy in the progressive **Shareta** as he bids to add another renewal to the six he has already garnered since 1983.

PREPPING IN PARIS

An unlucky third in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe last term, **Sarafina** takes her final step towards a second tilt at the main feature back here in three weeks' time. So far in 2010, her campaign has gone smoothly, outclassing the subsequent G1 Prix Jean Romanet heroine **Announce** (GB) (Selkirk) in the G2 Prix Corrida at Saint-Cloud May 23 and treating the multiple group-winning **Cirrus des Aigles** (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) with utter contempt in the June 26 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. Trainer **Alain de Royer-Dupre** is not expecting fireworks from the  **"TDN Rising Star"** here. "She is okay, but this is only preparation for the big race, and she is not at her peak fitness," he told *PA Sport*. "I have been very happy with her this season, and she has had a nice break since her last run at Saint-Cloud. She is in good form, but she always needs her first run after a break, so I would expect her to improve." Jockey **Christophe-Patrice Lemaire** paid tribute to the 4-year-old, who was also successful in last year's G1 Prix Saint-Alary and G1 Prix de Diane. "Her run in the Arc last year was special, as she was very unlucky in the 'false straight' and still managed to finish up impressively," Lemaire said. "Without that interference, she maybe would have won, and this year she has shown that she is still very good. What she did in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud was very impressive, and she has the ability to win the Arc." **Cont. p12**

Last year's Arc runner-up **Nakayama Festa** and compatriot **Hiruno d'Amour** are fascinating runners here, with the former bidding to improve on his second to Duncan (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) 12 months ago. Last year's G1 Takarazuka Kinen hero has been off since finishing unplaced in the G1 Japan Cup in November, while Hiruno d'Amour captured the G1 Tenno Sho at Kyoto May 1. Both have been camped in France for several weeks, and the Japan Racing Association's Shingo Soma provided a bulletin on the duo this week. "Both horses had their final preparations for the trial in Chantilly and their trainers are very happy," Soma told *PA Sport*. "Mitsugu Kon says Hiruno d'Amour is in very good condition, and he worked with his training partner last Wednesday. Everything went very well, and his connections are expecting a big run. Nakayama Festa was due to work last Wednesday also, but his trainer Yoshitaka Ninomiya said the horse got a little excited so he went somewhere else to work on his own. But Mr. Ninomiya says he is very happy with the horse's preparation, so, hopefully, he will run well." **St Nicholas Abbey** completes a high-class quartet of Arc trialists, and he is certain to strip fitter for this back from a break after his latest third in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 23.

TAPPING ON THE DOOR OF NUMBER ELEVEN

Andre Fabre has garnered a record 10 renewals of the G2 Prix Niel, a sophomore prep for the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe named in honor of Gaston Niel. Five of those winners--Tremolino, Carnegie (Ire), Sagamix (Fr), Hurricane Run (Ire) and Rail Link (GB)--went on to capture the main event in the same season. Fabre is doubly represented this time with Listed Prix Frederic de Legrange victor **King of Arnor (GB)** acting as back up to stable number one **Meandre (Fr)**. The latter took seven goes to graduate, but capped a rapid rise through the ranks by posting an impressive win in July's G1 Grand Prix de Paris, and he comes back for his first start since that Bastille Day success. **Reliable Man (GB)**, hero of June's G1 Prix du Jockey-Club at Chantilly in his penultimate go, encountered a first career defeat in that course-and-distance event, and will bid to emulate his sire, who claimed victory eight years ago, in this return mission. The Alain de Royer-Dupre trainee is joined by stablemate **Vadamar (Fr)**, who makes his first start since running seventh in June's G1 Epsom Derby. "Reliable Man is very well and I hope he can run a good race," commented de Royer-Dupre, adding, "Vadamar is coming back from a break. The ground was too firm for him when he ran in the Epsom Derby, and I hope there is more rain for him." Japanese raider **Nakayama Knight (Jpn)**, winner of February's G3 Hai S. in Tokyo, reappears for the first time since finishing just off the board in the G1 Tokyo Yushun at the end of May.

BANIMPIRE TO REIGN AGAIN?

Jim Bolger's sole triumph in the G2 Blandford S. came courtesy of Topanoora (GB) (Ahonoora {GB}) 20 years ago. The durable **Banimpire (Ire)** bids to end the Coolcullen conditioner's barren spell in her 11th start of a busy sophomore campaign. Chinned on the line by Blue Bunting (Dynaformer) in July's G1 Irish Oaks here, she gained compensation in the G2 Royal Whip S. over this course and distance last month, but slipped off the board for only the second time this term when making a swift reappearance--behind Blue Bunting again--in the G1 Yorkshire Oaks. She is unbeaten at this 10-furlong trip, and Bolger feels there were legitimate excuses for her Knavesmire eclipse last month. "I think there were a couple of things against her at York," he explained. "The ground was very tacky and she didn't handle it, and she was also due in season. It's possible that might have been against her, too, and [jockey] Kevin [Manning] said she was very quiet in herself. We want to keep her going until the end of the season and then see what we are going to do next year." Sir Michael Stoute registered back-to-back scores with Red Bloom (GB) in 2005 and 2006, and saddles last year's heroine **Eleanora Duse (Ire)** in a bid to emulate that former incumbent's feat and take the Newmarket trainer's tally to five in the contest. She failed to hit the board in four subsequent starts, but gave hint of her old sparkle when a close sixth to Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) in July's G2 York S. last time, and merits the utmost respect back among her own gender. **Bible Belt (Ire)** bagged a Leopardstown handicap in her belated seasonal bow in July, and has gone from strength to strength in an unbeaten three-race campaign. She trounced the opposition by five lengths and more in last month's Listed Hurry Harriet S. at Gowran Park, and registered a career high when comfortably lifting the G3 Dance Design S. going nine panels here two weeks ago. Very much on the upgrade, it will come as a surprise if she is not in the mix at the business end.

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September Tweaked, But Not Much...

The major overhaul of last year's September Sale was well-received by buyers and sellers alike, and Keeneland officials believe this year's format, which includes a only a few small tweaks, will prove even more popular.

"We thought last year was a good starting point," said Keeneland's Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "Last year, on going to four days for Book 2, our goal was to put as many horses in front of buyers before the break as possible. But we might have overdone ourselves there. Looking back, we felt if we reduced it by a day, it would be beneficial to the whole experience." Russell added that the slightly delayed start time of the Book 2 sessions--11 a.m. daily--gives buyers more time to shop, and consignors more time to do things like register reserves

with the sales company.

When action resumes Saturday after the dark day, buyers can expect a Book 3 filled with top physicals, said Russell, explaining that Keeneland and consignors have renewed efforts to fill next weekend's sessions with athletic, correct horses who might be somewhat lacking when it comes to pedigree power. "Obviously last year, with the big Book 2, we had to take horses from Book 3," he said. "But we've worked hard with our consignors looking for very good physical horses, rather than pedigree horses, in Book 3. With the pedigree horses, if they had good conformation, obviously they'd sell earlier in the sale, and if they don't have good conformation, they shouldn't be in that book, they should be in latter books."

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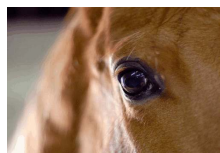

The expectations are for a stable market at September, but Russell said there are a few reasons to be optimistic of an upturn. "I think one factor that will come in is the reduced number of horses," he said, referring to the first foal crop--produced in 2010 and much smaller than in previous years--that was bred after the economic downturn. "We'll just have to gauge supply and demand. Supply has shrunk, and if the demand stays the same as last year, we'll be in good shape."

Russell also said current tax laws should benefit the sale. As part of the economic stimulus passed by Congress last December, through 100% bonus depreciation, the cost of yearlings purchased in 2011 will be able to be written off completely. Bonus depreciation drops to 50% in 2012.

This is the 10th anniversary of the Sept. 11, 2001 terrorist attacks. Keeneland will observe the anniversary with words from Nick Nicholson at 9 a.m. The remarks will be broadcast throughout the sale pavilion and barn area.

'Rags' to Riches: Brothers Steps it Up...

In some ways, Chris Brothers lived a dual life growing up. Raised in New York City, he attended private school at Xavier High in Chelsea, and spent much of his time on the golf course, where he was good enough to earn college scholarship. But as the son of Jack Brothers, the popular bloodstock agent who spent years with Adena Springs and is now a partner in Hidden Brook Farm, Chris had strong ties to the Bluegrass and to horseracing, too. In the end, Brothers chose the rolling hills of Kentucky over Manhattan's macadam, and today at 27 years of age is one of the industry's top young professionals.

In 2010, Brothers launched Xavier International Bloodstock, which advises, among others, Mandy Pope's Whisper Hill Farm. Xavier also assists IEAH Stable with its buying and selling. For the latter, Brothers helped broker the recent sale of IEAH's Court Vision (Gulch) to Spendthrift Farm as a stallion prospect.

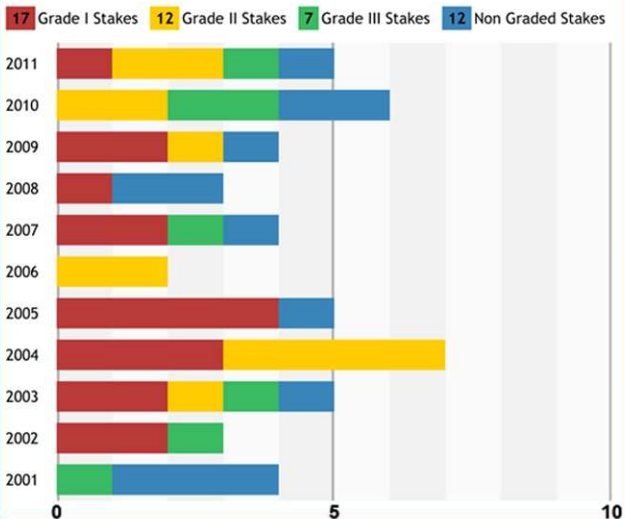
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Xavier--the name, of course, is a tip of the hat to his alma matter--has enjoyed a few other high-profile successes that have helped it on its way. The run began last year with the Tapit filly Tell a Kelly. Brothers purchased the now 3-year-old privately as a weanling off the farm back in 2008 and sold her a year later, through Hidden Brook, for \$45,000 at KEESEP. Running for Ike and Dawn Thrash and trained by John Sadler, Tell a Kelly won the GI Del Mar Debutante S. in her third career start last September.

For IEAH, Brothers selected Fantasy of Flight (Tiznow), a \$725,000 FTSAUG grad in 2009 who broke her maiden impressively at first asking at Churchill on Oaks day in May. In her next start, she ran second in the GIII Dogwood S. under the Twin Spires June 4. John Terranova trains the 3-year-old filly. And, in June, Brothers co-brokered the deal that sent GIII Eight Belles S. winner Victoria's Wildcat (Bellamy Road) to Andrew Rosen's stable.

But the horse that could really put the spotlight on Brothers is another he helped purchase for IEAH, the 2-year-old colt Union Rags (Dixie Union). A first-out winner for trainer Michael Matz and owner Phyllis Wyeth's Chadds Ford Stable at Delaware in July, Union Rags then shipped up to Saratoga and promptly romped by over seven lengths in a sloppy edition of the GII Saratoga Special S. Aug. 15.

With the defection of Overdriven (Tale of the Cat), Union Rags might be the pro-tem divisional leader on the East Coast, and his connections are optimistic the colt could be a star.

Brothers selected Union Rags at the 2010 FTSAUG sale, and IEAH purchased him from his breeder, Phyllis Wyeth, for \$145,000. "I buy yearlings for IEAH, and

every year we buy some for the select [juvenile] sales," said Brothers. "I think he was the cheapest out of all of them. I just kept looking at him, and I knew he wasn't getting a whole lot of attention at the sale, and I kept second guessing myself. 'Is there something obvious I'm

missing?' He was a big, gangly horse. For a Dixie Union, you don't see that a lot. You usually get shorter and punchier. But he was very athletic and well put-together, too, and he was very flashy. I think we were just a tick over the reserve when we got him."

Five months later, Wyeth was so impressed with his improvement that she bought the horse back for \$390,000 out of Eddie Woods's draft at FTFEB.

All that's a pretty strong resume for someone who's only been actively involved in the business for nine years. That's how long it's been since Brothers made the move from New York to Kentucky and began working at Hidden Brook.

"At the time, I wanted to learn about the horses more and see if I was really into it," he said. "I had been going to school to be an architect--not that I really wanted to be an architect, but it shows you the direction I was in. I started out on the maintenance crew of the farm, and started stepping up a little, bit by bit, until I realized this is what I want to be doing full time for the rest of my life."

Despite a pedigree for the business and spending time on the backside of New York's tracks with his father, Brothers admits the learning curve was steep.

"I was very green," he said. "I didn't understand how complex the business can be, and how many areas there are. You think someone's in the horse business, you think everyone does the same thing. I didn't realize how many roles it takes to get a baby from before it is foaled, then to the races, then to be either a stallion or broodmare."

Brothers worked his way up to be assistant manager at Hidden Brook, but in 2010 decided to strike out on his own. He credits the farm's team--which in addition to his father includes farm manager Sergio de Sousa, trainer and partner Danny Vella, and partners Dan Hall and Mark Roberts--with providing his foundation in the sport.

"In this business, leaving Hidden Brook was like graduating from Harvard, I think," he said. "I had the best farm manager teaching me, the best bloodstock guy, the best trainer. It was a little bit of everything."

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Brothers is now a major part of Mandy Pope's team, and he said he's lucky to have joined up with the Citra,

Florida-based horsewoman. "Mandy's great," he said. "She's by far one of the best people I know. For her, the horse comes first, no matter what. She has the biggest heart for these horses...and for people."

Pope has purchased well-pedigreed

broodmares in recent years, and last year expanded her operation to include yearling-to-juvenile pinhooking. She also is becoming more involved in racing, and last November bought the horse-in-training Funny Sunny, a 2-year-old filly from Sharp Humor's first crop, at Keeneland November for \$380,000. In her second start for Pope at Gulfstream this spring, Funny Sunny won off by 10 3/4 lengths in a NW1X.

Sidelined with a splint injury, Funny Sunny returned in a five-furlong overnight stakes on the grass at Saratoga Aug. 11, and handled her first turf foray with aplomb, swerving to avoid a fallen rival and just missing by a head to be second. "People say we were unlucky [not to win], but we were lucky that she didn't go over that horse," said Brothers. In her latest, Funny Sunny ran fifth, beaten 5 1/2 lengths, in the GIII Victory Ride S. at the Spa Aug. 27.

"She really never took to the track," said Brothers. "Kent [Desormeaux] did a really good job of just guiding her around there and not finishing her, like some of these guys can do. He realized she wasn't handling the track. But she came out of it okay, and she's a very talented filly. We'll get a few works into her and then decide what's next for her."

Brothers will add another dimension to Xavier in November when he begins a weanling-to-yearling pinhooking venture aimed at engaging friends and business associates in racing.

"I have a couple of clients, but also a lot of friends back home and in Kentucky who wanted to invest a little money in the business," Brothers explained. "They don't want to be in it for the long haul with racing, so I put together a partnership, and the shares are real small."

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"We're not going to be buying these obvious \$200,000 weanlings," Brothers added. "We're going for the \$30,000 weanlings, and play with the numbers a little bit. We'll have eight or nine horses, and hope a couple hit and the rest do okay. Most of these people are new to the game, and I think it's a good way for them to get a taste of it. Some of them could be very big in the game if they wanted to."

Meanwhile, November will mark another big milestone for Brothers. He and his wife Emily, who works at Shadwell, are expecting their first child, a daughter, Nov. 13. Brothers said the prospect of becoming a father has altered his perspective when it comes to his business.

"I have a little different agenda now that I'm having a kid," he said. "Obviously, we'd all like more clients, and I'm pretty content where I am right now. But I'd like to see it grow for her." -Photos/editorial by L Marquardt

"These mares were bred after Midshipman won the Breeders' Cup Juvenile; Unbridled's Song was really just flooded with applications the next year," commented Taylor Made's Mark Taylor. "The result was just a phenomenal book of mares. You look through that Book 1 and it's just one after another. Unbridled's Song has already had 13 Grade I winners, he's had multiple Breeders' Cup winners, he's just one of the top stallions in the world, and I think you're going to see him going even to another level with this crop that he's got that will be 2-year-olds in 2012." Among the mares with yearlings by Unbridled's Song in Book 1 are champions Folklore (Tiznow) and Maryfield (Elusive Quality), as well as Grade I winners Take Charge Lady (Dehere) and Madcap Escapade (Hennessy). There are also half-siblings to champions Stardom Bound (Tapit) and Proud Spell (Proud Citizen) and a full to MGISP Dunkirk.

"He's not a typical Dynaformer, and I mean that in a good way," said Three Chimneys's Case Clay. "The Dynaformers can be a little coarse, but this colt is more refined. For many years, Dynaformer has produced many coarse horses that won graded stakes races, and buyers finally caught on. This horse is just a gorgeous animal. He is kind of your 'wow' horse. From the first time we went out to the farm to see him, we knew he was something special." This colt's full-sister, Bluegrass Princess, was offered at this sale in 2007, but found no takers, RNA'ing for \$340,000. The filly went on to place in a pair of graded stakes, including the GII Sands Point S. "He is very much like his sister in that he is a very nice Dynaformer and a very athletic mover," said Clay.

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING ...AT THE SALES

Tom Van Meter, Van Meter Sales

"The nice thing about September is that there is a wealth of bidders and buyers that are going to drive this market. I think we are going to be pleasantly surprised with the outcome of this sale. I think people are hungry to buy horses. I think it will be good, and we can start on the road to recovery."

Reiley McDonald, Eaton Sales (140 yearlings this year)

"We had about 260 last year, and I tried to have about half as many this year, and that's about where I am. This year, we are stacked more on the front end and have lost more from the back of the book. That is really the whole concept behind the number of yearlings I brought here this year. It's not where I want to be, but it's a good first step."

Case Clay, Three Chimeys Sales

"I think this sale will be similar to last September. I think it's going to be more of a 'real world' sale. Maybe the first couple of sales that have gone well haven't been the greatest of indicators as to what is going to happen in September. I'm not trying to be doom and gloom, but I think it will be similar to last year. I just hope breeders will do a little better, since they paid lower stud fees with this crop. The only variable might be, given the yen is strong, I don't know if the Japanese farms will be coming to shop. But, if they do, they will have the advantage of a strong currency."

In addition to hip 31, Three Chimneys offers the Dynaformer colts [hip 42](#) (out of Bohemian Lady, by Carson City) and [hip 155](#) (out of Charges d'Affaires, by Vice Regent). Clay addressed the issue of bringing multiple yearlings by a single sire to the same sale

"We always judge a horse based on its own merit. We ask ourselves, 'are they Book 1 worthy or not?' And each one of these were. All of them have good families and physically they are a little different, but if they weren't outstanding physicals, they wouldn't be in Book 1. 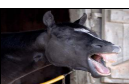
