STRONACH PURCHASES FIRE ON ICE

Fire On Ice (Unbridled's Song--Lost in the Storm, by Storm Cat), an eye-catching 10 3/4-length debut winner on the GI Travers S. undercard at Saratoga Aug. 27 ([video](#)), has been purchased privately by Frank Stronach. The \$160,000 FTKJUL graduate, out of an unraced half-sister to champion sprinter Squirtle Squirt (Marquetry), was co-owned by trainer John Kimmel and Eli Gindi. He will remain under the care of Kimmel and be pointed toward the Oct. 8 GI Champagne S. "Fire On Ice is an exciting racehorse with great talent," Stronach said. "He has the potential to become a champion racehorse and, with that, earn the right to join the stallion roster at Adena Springs." Fire On Ice was tabbed a **"TDN Rising Star"** following his unveiling, which received an 88 Beyer Speed Figure. He stopped the clock for six furlongs in 1:09.67. Adena Springs Racing Manager Mike Rogers added, "The purchase of this colt, along with the select yearlings purchased at Saratoga and Keeneland, underscore Mr. Stronach's commitment to the industry as well as his desire to maintain and develop his world class stallion roster. We are very optimistic about the future of our program and these additions will complement our exciting group of homebreds already in training."

Winter Memories shrugged off her loss in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf last November to capture her first three starts this term in the Apr. 21 GIII Appalachian S. at Keeneland, May 30 GII Sands

Point S. at Belmont and July 27 GII Lake George S. at the Spa. Off at 2-5 in the Aug. 21 GII Lake Placid S., she was caught inside until they hit the lane, then failed to accelerate on the rain-soaked course and spun her

wheels in a fourth-place effort. There was no such disappointment in the Garden City. Hard held as More Than Real loafed her way through fractions of :26.40, :51.60 and 1:16.12, she was once again behind an equine wall when they hit the lane, but this time had the traction she needed to sweep to the front in the shadow of the wire. "At the eighth pole I thought there was no way--a horse could not pull that off," said owner John Phillips. "It's not like they were blistering up front, so for her to have that brilliant turn of foot...it was breathtaking." 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AN END TO THE EURO DROUGHT?

Since its inaugural running back in 1988, every winner of the GI Woodbine Mile has been saddled by a North American-based trainer. Neil Drysdale leads the charge with four wins in the race, and Bobby Frankel had three, including stakes-record holder Ventura (Chester House). But Andrew Balding hopes to end the losing streak for Team Euro with **Side Glance (GB)** this afternoon. The 4-year-old gelding has won three of his five starts this term, including the G3 Sovereign S. at Salisbury Aug. 11. Favored in the G2 Summer Mile S. July 9 at Ascot, he ran into traffic trouble and ended up third. Leanne Masterson, assistant to Balding, remarked, "He had no luck running at all. He got stuck in the pocket, got out late and flew up on the outside." But the signs are positive for his chances today. "He travelled well and he's drunk plenty," Masterson said Thursday. "He ate up last night. He was bucking and kicking coming off the track this morning, so the travel hasn't seemed to affect him at all." Also shipping across the Atlantic for the race are **Dance And Dance (Ire)**, who was beaten a neck when second in the Sovereign S., and **Forte Dei Marmi (GB)**, third in a conditions race at Epsom Aug. 29 in his latest effort, and winless since taking a handicap at Newbury exactly one year ago.

Finale picked up checks in his first two starts--both on the dirt at Belmont's spring/summer meet--but he has been unbeatable since switching to the turf. The dark bay broke his maiden by 5 3/4 lengths on the Belmont lawn July 15 and romped by 10 1/2 lengths in the Continental Mile S. on the Monmouth sod Aug. 20. He was odds-on to make it three-for-three. Up to press the pace from third for six furlongs, he put a head in front at the eighth pole and outfinished Excaper for a narrow victory. But the trip was not all smooth sailing. "He didn't leave the gate very good," jockey John Velazquez explained. "I actually hit the door and the iron went all the way to my foot. I had to break and get a position where I wanted to be and place my feet back where they were supposed to be." The winner also struggled a bit in the final drive. "I thought he was going to finish a little better than what he did," Velazquez added. "I think he was having a hard time with the grass. It was a little bit on the soft side, and he was running at [Excaper], but he didn't have that quick spurt out of him."

Northern Passion was a debut winner in a 5 1/2-furlong sprint on the Woodbine Poly July 9. She just missed when stretched out an additional furlong for the Aug. 13 Ontario Debutante S., running second by a half length, and was trying a mile and the sod for the first time here. After breaking well to find herself just off the leaders as they raced away from the gate, the chestnut was downshifted and went backwards through the field to trail down the backstretch. Northern Passion was still last as they entered the far turn, but found an open path inside and started to pick off rivals as they swept around the bend. Jockey Luis Contreras did have to guide her around one tiring horse at the eighth pole, then sent her sailing past Dayatthespa in the closing yards. Northern Passion's full-sister sold for \$75,000 to Windhaven at Keeneland September yesterday as [hip 1289](#). Her dam, A Touch of Glory, is a half-sister to Ginger Gold (Golden Gear), who won the Natalma 10 years ago en route to the Sovereign Award as Canada's top juvenile filly for breeder Mel Lawson's Jim Dandy Stable. Lawson acquired second dam Gleaming Glory, with Ginger Gold in utero, for \$40,000 at Keeneland November 1998. The Canadian Hall of Famer worked for six decades at the family-owned Lawson Lumber and was involved in racing as an owner/breeder for 50 years. He passed away in July.

Always prominent, Marketing Mix took command at the top of the lane and was kept to the task as she drew off late. "They were expecting a big race out of her, and she didn't disappoint," jockey Junior Alvarado said. "I just wanted to make her relax and be comfortable. She broke well and relaxed right away behind the speed. At the quarter pole, I asked her and she responded. The rest was kind of easy." 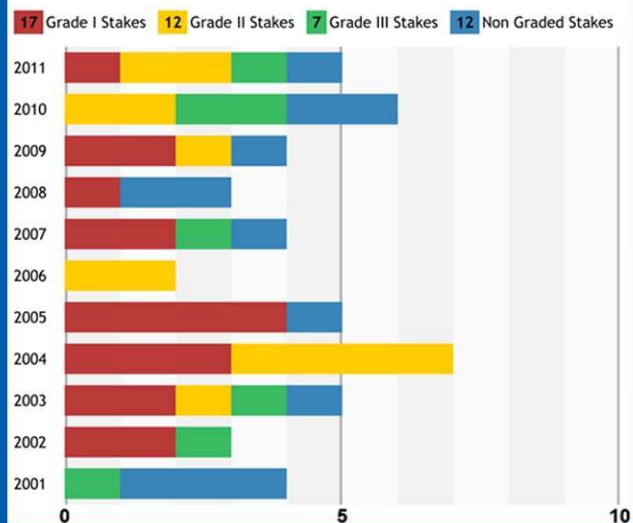

Caspar Netscher, who was fourth in the Listed Woodcote S. at Epsom on stakes bow June 4, hit the board in the Listed Windsor Castle S. at Royal Ascot 10 days later, and improved one spot in the July 15 Listed Rose Bowl S. at this track. On the board again in the July 29 G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood, he earned a



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personal best in the Aug. 19 G2 Gimcrack S. at York last time, and matched that achievement to become the first to register the Gimcrack-Mill Reef double. Caspar Netscher was under heavy restraint in rear early. Quickening smartly to go by his rivals in an instant inside the quarter-mile marker, he

ran on strongly, despite drifting right when in front, to easily double his pattern-race tally. "I think I got there too soon and he idled when he got to the front, but he's got some engine," enthused rider Kieren Fallon. "I wanted to creep up there and get to the others nicely, but he hit the front within two strides. I rode him in his work the other day, but he doesn't do much at home. When he gets to the racetrack, he comes alive."

Conditioner Alan McCabe added, "Caspar Netscher thrives on his racing, and that was just like an exercise gallop. He's not blowing that hard, and he is a very good horse. We'll keep an eye on the [G1] Middle Park [S. at Newmarket Oct. 8], but the long-term plan is the Breeders' Cup."

Green Destiny, who opened this campaign with an Apr. 30 handicap score at Newmarket, slipped to seventh in the June 17 Listed Wolferton H. at Royal Ascot, but regained winning ways in the July 9 John Smith's Cup H. at York. Off the board in a July 29 Goodwood handicap, he bagged a first pattern-race success in the Aug. 19 G3 Strensall S. back at York last time, and doubled that tally with a late swoop here. The eventual winner was restrained in rear from the outset. Lyric of Light Supplemented for Fillies' Mile...

Godolphin's unbeaten **Lyric of Light (GB)** (Street Cry {Ire}) was added yesterday to Friday's G1 Shadwell Fillies' Mile, for which 15 remained at the six-day stage. Successful in a Newmarket maiden and the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster Sept. 9, she could be in line for a match with Michael Tabor, Susan Magnier and Derrick Smith's similarly unbeaten **Maybe (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the Newmarket feature. Lyric of Light's trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni has also entered **Kunooz (Ire)** (Hard Spun) . "Lyric of Light is in good form," said Al Zarooni. "She came on a lot for her first start at Newmarket and I hope that she has learned a lot from the May Hill S., because she was still very green. She has improved with every start this season, so I am hopeful that she can continue her upward curve. We have entered Kunooz in several races including the Shadwell Fillies' Mile and the G3 Sakhee Oh So Sharp S., while she could also head to Italy for a race out there. She is a nice filly but she needs juice in the ground and the further, the better, for her." Also on the list is Normandie Stud's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Fallen For You (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who was runner-up in the May Hill and the June 17 G3 Albany S. scorer **Samitar (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}), who was third in the May Hill.

Discourse Suffers Setback...

Godolphin's unbeaten ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Discourse** (Street Cry {Ire}) has met with a minor setback, connections revealed yesterday. Left out of the six-day entries for Newmarket's G1 Shadwell Fillies' Mile, the Mahmood Al Zarooni-trained Aug. 6 G3 Sweet Solera S. winner may miss the rest of the year. Simon Crisford told the *Racing Post*, "We'll look for another race for her, but if we're not completely happy or can't find another race, then we'll put her away."

‘QUALITY’ COLT TOPS KEESEP SATURDAY

An Elusive Quality half-brother to Canadian standout Southdale (Street Cry [Ire]), selling late in Saturday's Book 3 opener at Keeneland September, brought a

session-topping \$425,000 from Stonestreet Stables LLC. Bloodstock agent John Moynihan signed for the eye-catching bay, who was offered by Anderson Farms on behalf of breeder Rod Ferguson. “He was a beautiful, beautiful horse,” said Moynihan. “I thought he was probably the prettiest colt who went through today--he's big, strong and looks like he'll be fast. Just a nice horse, and the good ones are bringing that kind of money. He was certainly prettier than a lot of horses

who sold earlier in the week for more money. We're happy to have him.”

Stonestreet, begun by the late Jess Jackson and now carried on by his wife Barbara Banke, has been busy at September, buying five other yearlings, including two in partnership with George Bolton. The most expensive of the group is [hip 195](#), a filly by Bernardini--Miss Audrey who went for \$500,000 Monday evening. Bolton co-signed for that one. Yesterday, Stonestreet and Bolton teamed to buy [hip 1394](#), a colt by Macho Uno--Forty Moves for \$225,000, while Stonestreet alone was on the docket for [hip 1188](#), a colt by Tiz Wonderful--Silver Lullaby, for \$140,000.

Yesterday's topper was produced by the 10-year-old Pinafores Pride (Saint Ballado), a daughter of SW & MGSP Pinafore Park (Ascot Knight). Pinafores Pride never made it to the races, but her first foal, Southdale, has been a good performer at Woodbine, with wins including the GIII Eclipse S. and GIII Durham Cup S. The 5-year-old, who races for Ferguson, has earned just shy of \$400,000. Last year, a Street Sense daughter of Pinafores Pride realized a bid of \$130,000 from Jim and Susan Hill.

Consignor David Anderson said expectations were high for the Elusive Quality colt. “Going in, we knew we had a nice horse, and he's just done everything right from the beginning,” said Anderson. “He was an unbelievably good-looking foal, in my opinion. I think this has just been a great horse sale. The stars were aligned, and we were able to get him in on this day, and we had a lot of lookers. I think some people maybe got shut out in Book 2, and that money overflowed here. We just couldn't be more thrilled for the Fergusons. They've been in the game a long time, and this is a real beauty.”

Anderson assumed the mantle of his father's Ontario-based operation after his dad, Bob Anderson, died of a heart attack last November at the age of 64. The elder Anderson had bred such horses as Alydeed and Ascot Knight. The latter is the sire of the Elusive Quality colt's second dam. Rod Ferguson is a commercial farmer, also based in Ontario who has done business with Anderson Farm for over two decades. Sale officials said it was a sentimental result for many.

“We're delighted for David Anderson,” said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. “Anderson Farm has been a great supporter of Keeneland for many years, and it's great to see David continuing on. To have a session topper less than a year after his father passed is really special.”

It was another strong day of selling at September. The session average of \$73,620 was up 25.6%, while the median of \$51,000 was up 2%. The cumulative average now stands at \$160,532, up 24%. The cumulative median of \$110,000 represents an outstanding 37.5% gain.

“I think it was a very good Book 3 [opener],” said Russell. “It's what we designed Book 3 to be. We've told consignors over the years that they have to put physical horses in Book 3. They have to have good horses, or [buyers] are going to walk right by you. Also, with some of the smaller consignors, it's their first time selling--they don't have a Book 1 or Book 2 horse--and so it's their best horses. But part one of Book 3 has accomplished our goals.” -L Marquardt

'Pass' Plays Well at Book 3 Opener...

Just after signing the ticket for [hip 1290](#), an attractive dark bay daughter of War Pass (Cherokee Run) who sold around the 1 o'clock hour for \$400,000, trainer Bob Baffert was asked for a quote on the filly. Baffert

said, "She was expensive." The Hall of Famer wasn't wrong. She was, in fact, the second-most expensive horse to sell Saturday, having touched off a bidding duel between Baffert and bloodstock agent David Ingordo. Baffert won the war for longtime client Mike Pegram, who will campaign the filly with Karl Watson and Paul Weitman. The same connections have owned, among others, last year's champion 3-year-old Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike).

From the first crop of her late sire, the Jan. 30-foaled filly was produced by Avenging Tomisue (Belong to Me) and is a half-sister to SW Striking Tomisue (Smart Strike). Lane's End consigned her on behalf of her breeders, Tomisue Thoroughbreds and Menard Thoroughbreds.

Baffert stood in a center doorway of the pavilion with Hill 'n' Dale's Donato Lanni--part of Baffert's buying team--and one of his owners, Bernie Schiappa, as Ingordo set up shop in the doorway just under the press box. Both men were on their cell phones, and it was Ingordo who ultimately relented, backing into the hallway with a smile on his face after Baffert immediately countered his \$390,000 offer.

War Pass enjoyed a brilliant 2-year-old season in 2007, winning the GI Champagne S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile for owner Robert LaPenta and trainer Nick Zito. He was awarded a huge 113 Beyer for the latter win. Named champion juvenile male, War Pass was injured in April of his sophomore year after finishing second in the GI Wood Memorial S. and retired to Lane's End. War Pass covered 90 mares in his first season at stud and 83 mares in his second. He shuttled to Widden Stud in Australia to stand the Southern Hemisphere season in 2010, but shortly after returning in December, died in his paddock. Necropsy results were inconclusive.

Success Tied to Lane's End...

Yesterday's War Pass--Avenging Tomisue yearling has ties to Lane's End that go well beyond being a member of Will Farish's September draft. Her first two dams are by Lane's End sires, and her breeders have done business with the farm for over 15 years. Hilbert

Thoroughbreds is the nom de course of Steven Hilbert and his wife Tomisue, who jumped into the game in a big way back in 1995, when they went after and secured several yearlings from the first crop of Lane's End's new sire A.P. Indy. The very first yearling the Hilberts purchased at public auction

was Tomisue's Delight, a Lane's End-bred and -consigned daughter of Prospectors Delight (Mr. Prospector) who went for \$575,000 at Keeneland July. Tomisue's Delight won the GI Ruffian H. as a 3-year-old of 1997 and finished second in the GI Kentucky Oaks. A year later, she added the GI Personal Ensign H. She banked over \$1.2 million and, along with her full-brother, Horse of the Year Mineshaft, ensured her dam would be named Broodmare of the Year in 2003.

Tomisue's Delight was as good in the breeding shed as she was on the track for the Hilberts. Her first foal was the Belong to Me filly Possession, who brought a bid of \$2 million from John Ferguson at the 2002 Keeneland July Sale. Three years later, Circle E Racing paid \$3.9 million for her son Mr. Sidney (Storm Cat), who won the GI Maker's Mark Mile S. here at Keeneland and now stands in France. Another son, the pinhooked Brock (Distorted Humor), later made \$2.3 million at the 2010 FTFEB sale.

Tomisue's Delight wasn't the only A.P. Indy filly the Hilberts purchased at the July Sale in 1995. They also nabbed the \$530,000 grad Tomisue's Indy, who, while less of a racemare than Tomisue's Delight, still was a stakes winner of nearly \$200,000. Tomisue's Indy only produced two foals, but one was Avenging Tomisue, the dam of yesterday's topper.

"She was a really nice filly--when you have Ingordo and Baffert hooking up on a horse, those are two pretty good judges," said Lane's End's Bill Farish, who admitted the filly nonetheless exceeded expectations. Farish added of War Pass, "It's very sad we lost the sire, but we have two good crops from him here and another in Australia."

At the 1997 Keeneland July Sale, the Hilberts enjoyed even more success with Lane's End and A.P. Indy. There, they landed the Lane's End-bred Stephen Got Even for \$325,000, and campaigned him to a career-best win in the GI Donn H. in 2000. Stephen Got Even has stood at Lane's End since his retirement and is the sire of champion Stevie Wonderboy and Grade I winners I Want Revenge and First Dude.

The Hilberts also raced Parade Ground (Kingmambo) with W.S. Farish; the son of blue hen Battle Creek Girl won four graded stakes and earned nearly \$800,000.

A few years ago, the Hilberts brought on John Menard Jr., founder and owner of Menards, the major Midwestern hardware/home improvement store chain. But the Hilberts and Menard, who is also heavily involved in NASCAR, are exiting the racing and breeding business. In November, they will sell the majority of their bloodstock holdings, including Avenging Tomisue. -L Marquardt

Team Repole Takes the Pulpit...

Mike Repole's dream team of advisors secured a colt by Pulpit for the New Yorker yesterday at Keeneland, going to \$320,000 to add [hip 1381](#) to Repole Stable. "We thought he had a pedigree to be a stallion," reported Jim Crupi, who bid from the center of the pavilion while seated with racing manager Jim Martin and bloodstock advisor Eddie Rosen. "He had a lot of leg on him. He was a little immature, but we think he'll grow into himself. And, if we're right, we'll have a very nice horse." Crupi admitted the final price tag was a little over what he expected to pay for the youngster. "We thought we were going to have to be between \$200,000 and \$250,000." It was the ninth yearling purchase of the sale for Repole Stable. Repole also purchased a colt by Dixie Union ([hip 450](#)) for \$380,000, a son of Distorted Humor ([hip 692](#)) for \$375,000 and a colt by Bernardini ([hip 848](#)) for \$350,000. Asked if it was hard to get the horses he was after, Crupi admitted, "Not really. Not when you are buying for Mike Repole." He added, "A good horse sells good, like in any other market."

The Pulpit colt, bred and consigned by Claiborne Farm, is out of Exploding Star (Exploit) and is a half-brother to graded stakes placed Eden Star (Eddington). Claiborne purchased Exploding Star, in foal to Smoke Glacken, for \$85,000 out of the 2007 Keeneland January sale. The mare was part of the dispersal of the late Eugene Dixon. After yesterday's sale, Claiborne's Dell Hancock commented, "I said to our farm manager Bradley Purcell, 'Mr. Dixon is looking down and smiling.' We bought the mare out of Mr. Dixon's dispersal and we were so crazy about him. So I am glad that something good has come from it." Of the yearling, Hancock added, "He's a leggy colt. He's got his father's eye a little. He's a good mover and there is nothing wrong with him. So they should have a lot of fun with him. I sure hope so." -J Martini

Sales Success for Stonehaven Steadings...

Jeff and Chiquita Reddoch's Stonehaven Steadings enjoyed its biggest sales success in its relatively short history yesterday at Keeneland. The couple, from Lafayette, Louisiana, sold a colt by Candy Ride (Arg) for \$200,000 to the bid of Bernard Schiappa. The yearling ([hip 1357](#)) was out of the stakes-placed Double Flyight (Flying Continental), who Stonehaven Steadings had acquired for \$15,000 out of the 2008 Keeneland November sale. In foal to Closing Argument at that sale, the dam had already produced stakes winner Round Trip Flight (Monarchos).

"She'd had a stakes winner and we just bought a modestly priced mare," explained Stonehaven Steadings manager Colby Marks. "I wasn't really surprised by the price; that's when things started to tail off a bit [in the market]."

Double Flyight's Closing Argument colt brought \$10,000 at last year's September sale, but her Candy Ride colt proved popular yesterday.

Of the yearling, Marks said, "He was a lovely horse and had been all along. He was a May colt, but had plenty of size. He had a nice long walk and was relatively correct."

The Reddachs, who are in the oil and gas pipeline construction business, decided to get into racing after their daughter Leah started college in Kentucky, and purchased a farm in Versailles in 2004. They have a broodmare band of 12 head, and are focused on breeding commercially.

"We try to sell them, but if we don't get what we want we'll race them," Marks explained.

In addition to the Candy Ride colt, Stonehaven Steadings also sold a Stormy Atlantic colt ([hip 972](#)) for \$170,000; a Grand Slam filly ([hip 372](#)) for \$110,000; and a Harlan's Holiday colt ([hip 346](#)) for \$105,000. Among Stonehaven Steadings four horses currently in training is Second Street City (Consolidator), a recent allowance winner at Indiana Downs for trainer Tom Amoss. The farm bred stakes-placed Honey Bunch (Cherokee Run), a \$130,000 Keeneland September yearling of 2008. -J Martini

Indygo Colt, Kin Shine for Summer Wind...

Frank and Jane Lyon's Summer Wind Farm stayed in on the smartly bred Indygo Shiner (A.P. Indy--Navarra, by El Gran Senor) when they sold the graded stakes-winning homebred to South American interests for stud duty. And, after the chestnut hit big in his first crop in Argentina, they were in a position to bring him back to stand at John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Farm.

Now, Indygo Shiner's first Northern Hemisphere foals are yearlings, and a number of them have stood out at public auction--thanks, in part, to the support Summer Wind threw behind the 13-year-old. The evidence includes [hip 1211](#), the fourth foal from GSW Susan's Angel (Cape Town) who sold yesterday to Jim Karp/F. Brothers, agent for \$160,000; and [hip 900](#), the first foal from the MGISP Jade Queen (Giant's Causeway), who went to Bluegrass Hall for \$150,000. Both horses were bred by Summer Wind and consigned by Lane's End.

"He's showing that if you bring a nice one in here out of a nice mare, they can do okay," said Summer Wind Farm Manager Mark Moloney.

That sentiment was bolstered in August when, at Fasig-Tipton's Preferred Sale, a New York-bred colt by Indygo Shiner--Free As Tristan brought the second-highest price of the sale when purchased by John Fort for \$185,000. A month earlier, at Fasig's July Sale, WinStar connections landed a colt by Indygo Shiner--Ruth's Proof for \$85,000.

Produced by a graded stakes-winning full-sister to the brilliant producer Toussaud--dam of Empire Maker, Chester House, et al--Indygo Shiner won the GIII Jefferson Cup S. in 2001 before joining Haras La Quebrada's roster in Argentina in 2003. He has sired no fewer than 16 stakes winners, including Miss Match (Arg), a Group 1 winner in Argentina who also won this year's GI Santa Margarita Invitational S. at Santa Anita. He has three other Group 1 winners in Argentina, which earned him a trip to Sikura's nursery, where he currently stands for \$7,500.

"John's just done a great job with the horse," said Moloney. "Indygo Shiner's bred over 100 mares each year he's been here, including 150 mares in his first year. We bred six of our own mares the first year, and four or five in the last few years."

That included the aforementioned Susan's Angel, whom Summer Wind bought for \$290,000 at the 2009 Keeneland January Sale; and Jade Queen, a \$450,000 buy at the same auction.

"For a \$7,500 sire to have the results he's already had, it's phenomenal," said Moloney. "We're looking forward to them hitting the racetrack, because that's where it really happens."

Horses from The Edge...

Peter O'Callaghan's Woods Edge Farm enjoyed a strong day of selling at Keeneland Saturday, with a son of Leroidesanimaux (Brz) leading the way when selling to Jerry and Ann Moss for \$250,000. It was [hip 1197's](#) second trip through the Keeneland sales ring. Peter's father, Gay O'Callaghan, purchased the colt as a weanling for \$52,000 out of last year's Keeneland November sale with the intention of taking the youngster home to Ireland, but the exploits of GI Kentucky Derby winner **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) had the yearling rerouted back to Kentucky.

"We had bought him with it in mind to bring him home to Ireland," confirmed Peter O'Callaghan. "Leroidesanimaux had a good horse there last year in [MG1SP] Glor Na Mara (Ire). We actually did take him to Ireland, so he is a well-travelled horse. He went home in November, and he came back about two months ago."

Asked what prompted the change, O'Callaghan explained, "Leroidesanimaux had such a good year here, with Animal Kingdom and all his other performers. He seems to have runners in many of the Saturday afternoon races, particularly in California on the synthetic and on the turf. It made good sense to have him here. He was a nice one, and he was worth putting that kind of expense into him."

In addition to the Derby winner, Leroidesanimaux has been represented this year by graded-stakes winners Always a Princess and Sarah's Secret, as well as graded-stakes-placed Crimson Knight and La Reine Lionne.

Woods Edge also enjoyed success at Keeneland yesterday with a colt by the farm's freshman sire Latent Heat (Maria's Mon). O'Callaghan purchased the dam Shirazeri (Jade Hunter) for \$10,000 out of the 2009 Keeneland January sale.

Covered by GI Malibu S. winner Latent Heat that spring, the mare's resulting foal ([hip 1184](#)) brought \$105,000 yesterday. "We bought the mare to cover with the stallion," O'Callaghan said. "She was quite a nice mare. Jade Hunter mares look to be very useful, and he was a really excellent first foal."

Latent Heat has already been represented by stakes winner Softly Lit and by True Feelings, runner-up in the GIII Schuylerville S.

"Latent Heat has made a nice start, he has had some nice winners early and a couple of stakes horses," O'Callaghan said. "He's had a lot of runners in the last couple weeks running second. If we could turn a couple of those into winners, he'll be doing well."

The Mosses were patronizing Woods Edge again a short time later, buying a son of Hard Spun ([hip 1333](#)) for \$230,000. The colt, out of Cookin Vickie (Far Out East), was a \$90,000 FTKNOV weanling. Another Woods Edge pinhook, a son of Divine Park ([hip 1319](#)), was bought for \$67,000 at this year's Keeneland January sale and resold yesterday to John Fort for \$180,000. Capping a strong day for the Kentucky farm, a daughter of Malibu Moon ([hip 1540](#)), purchased for \$85,000 last November, brought a final bid of \$160,000 from Fox Hill Farm late in the session.

Despite Woods Edge's success, O'Callaghan said it was a hit-or-miss market. "It's definitely spotty," the Irishman said. "There is money there, people are still willing to pay you for the really nice horse that vets out clean, by the nice sires and with the nice pedigrees. There is definitely enthusiasm and appetite for the really good horse, but there is not a lot of depth of trade. There are a lot of useful horses really struggling to get sold. That is disappointing. I thought maybe in Book 3 and Book 4 there would be a little bit deeper bench of buyers, but there doesn't seem to be so far." -Jessica Martini

Cardoza Working to Make a Difference...

Fifth-term congressman Dennis Cardoza, who represents California's 18th District and who recently joined the board of directors of the Thoroughbred Owners of California, made an appearance at Keeneland September yesterday afternoon. The unassuming Cardoza spent time flipping through a catalogue and watching the action at the back of the pavilion, chatted with Keeneland President Nick Nicholson, and was warmly greeted by Hall of Fame trainer Bob Baffert.

"I love coming to the sales and seeing what's going on," said Cardoza.

Cardoza has been a friend to the industry in recent years. He was instrumental in the formulation and passing of the 2007 Farm Bill that temporarily boosted first-year depreciation on yearlings to 100%. Last December, that legislation was renewed, and industry observers have credited the advantageous tax break in helping boost results at this year's yearling sales.

"I worked on the House side, and [Senate Republican] Mitch McConnell, in the other party in the other house, did a great job working behind the scenes to get it passed," recalled Cardoza. "It was a tough bill. It was able to overcome a presidential veto--President Bush vetoed it, but we got two-thirds majority to override it."

Cardoza's involvement with racing runs much deeper than the Farm Bill, however. A lifelong fan, he was introduced to the sport by his mother, who took him to the races at the Fresno Fair growing up. Cardoza finally made the jump into ownership in 2009, and last year began breeding horses, too. He has horses in training with Ron Ellis and Rene Amescua in California, and with Tim Tullock and Tim Keefe in Maryland. As a breeder, Cardoza currently has weanlings on the ground by Fairbanks and Petionville, among others.

Cardoza, a moderate Blue Dog Democrat, is the ranking member of the House Agriculture Committee's Subcommittee on Livestock, Dairy and Poultry, and brings heady credentials to the TOC. He said he's seeing policies enacted at the state and national level having positive effects on the industry.

"This sale's been fantastic so far, and there are two big reasons, I think," he said. "One is that California and New York have significantly raised--or will be raising--their purse structure, and people are optimistic based on that. The other is the accelerated depreciation Congress passed is really working. We've lowered the taxes on these kinds of investments, and people are feeling more comfortable risking their capital. Having owned and bred and been a fan of the sport, I know how long it takes to get a horse from conception to the track, and accelerated depreciation helps that process."

Cardoza might not be a passive observer at the sale, either. "I might try to buy one or two," he said. "But maybe not--my wife might kill me." -L Marquardt

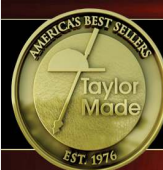

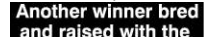

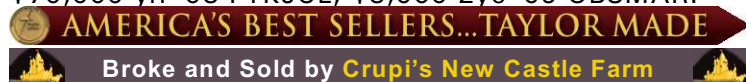
