



KEENELAND SPURS HOPES OF RECOVERY

The Keeneland September Yearling Sale drew to a quiet close yesterday in Lexington, but the final session belied what was generally regarded as two weeks of vibrant trade at the world's biggest yearling auction. At the end of session eight, the sale had already surpassed last year's gross receipts, and when all was said and done, there were solid gains in average while the overall median was level with the 2010 figure. The sale average of \$76,511 was up 11%, and the median held steady at \$30,000. Importantly, buy backs were down. The RNA rate was 20.7% compared to last year's 26.5%.

PRAISE HER

Thought by trainer Rodolphe Collet to be better than ever at six, Teruya Yoshida's **Sahpresa** (Sahm) made odds of 13-8 look distinctly generous when sauntering to an unprecedented third success in yesterday's G1 Kingdom of Bahrain Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket. Her latest third in the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville backed up her trainer's claim and she was always traveling much the best just off the undemanding early pace set by **Strawberrydaiquiri** (GB) (Dansili {GB}). Not fully extended to take over from that rival with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining, the bay had a cozy length margin to spare over **Chachamaidee** (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) at the line. "It was very easy," jockey Christophe Lemaire said. "She took the lead very easily and we were in front a little bit too soon. She's a strong finisher and I wanted cover in the early part of the race. She relaxed well even though the pace was slow." **Cont. p2**

Sahpresa's Sun Chariot Hat Trick a Real Treat...

Sahpresa came to this race in 2009 without too many convincing credentials, but she had shown more than a spark of ability when fourth in that year's G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville. Her defeat of the 1000 Guineas heroine Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway) at 16-1 caused some ripples among the Rowley Mile faithful, but she was no longer the Collet stable's best-kept secret 12 months later despite a light campaign that included a warm-up success in Longchamp's seven-furlong G3 Prix du Pin. Dealing with **Strawberrydaiquiri** with a degree of comfort in her second Sun Chariot, she just missed out in a four-way go for Kyoto's G1 Mile Championship in which she had also been third in 2009.

Third in the G1 Hong Kong Mile in December, she returned to Europe with a vengeance with an impressive defeat of subsequent G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest scorer Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the seven-furlong G3 Prix du Palais-Royal at

Longchamp June 4, but fell prey to a slow pace and finished runner-up to **Timepiece** (GB) (Zamindar) in the G1 Falmouth S. over a mile on the July Course here July 8. Sahpresa was pitched against Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) on two starts during Deauville's August meet, where she

was second-best to her in the latest renewal of the Prix Rothschild July 31 and third behind Immortal Verse (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}) and the Wertheimers' queen in the Jacques le Marois. She was bridging the gap to France's greatest distaffer and would have passed her in another stride on the latter occasion. **Cont. p3**

Ridden closer to the pace here than she had been in the Falmouth, the outcome was never in doubt as soon as Christophe Lemaire gave her the freedom to slingshot down and out of Newmarket's famous "dip," which suits her so well. Chachamaidee was the only other to emerge from the pack and mount any kind of threat, while Strawberrydaiquiri was excelling in this race in which she was fourth and second in the past two renewals. "She was a little bit nervous before the race, but when she is like that it is good news," Rodolphe Collet said of the mare who has now passed the £1million mark. "Today, we changed the strategy as we thought the pace would be slow and we didn't want to have the same outcome as the Falmouth. She had no experience of the July Course when she went there in the summer, but she was always going too easily back here. Maybe I have the third-best filly in Europe at the moment and we got close to Goldikova this year, so she is getting better and better. She will now run in the [Nov. 20] G1 Mile Championship in Japan again and the quarantine is tough and the journey is long, so we have to prepare for that. I have no idea whether she stays in training at seven, but I don't think so." Collet added, "This means more because Douglas McIntyre died a few days ago." Lemaire wore a black armband in memory of the mare's former owner-breeder, who had been 92 at the time of his death earlier in the week.

QUICK AS LIGHTENING

Supplemented for yesterday's G1 Cheveley Park S. after a five-length success in The Curragh's G3 Round Tower S. Aug. 28, Pearl Bloodstock's **Lightening Pearl (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) justified that decision with a display of raw speed on Newmarket's Rowley Mile. Quickly away against the far rail under Johnny Murtagh and enjoying a lead from the eventually injury-stricken Shadwell representative **Sajwah (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), the 3-1 second choice took control with a quarter mile remaining. Despite drifting left, the bay had done enough to ensure victory as **Sunday Times (GB)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) delivered a late flourish and the daughter of the recently deceased Derrinstown success story had a half length to spare over that rival at the line. "From day one she was always good," Murtagh said. "The more racing she has got, the faster she has become and she was very professional today and had the race won from a long way out."

It's in our blood

One of Sheikh Fahad's newly formed Pearl Bloodstock flagbearers this term, Lightening Pearl was two lengths second to Experience (Ire) (Excellent Art {GB}) in a six-furlong maiden at Navan on debut June 15. Upped a panel to score at Roscommon July 4 and finish third to the all-conquering Maybe (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Aug. 7 G2 Debutante S. at The Curragh, she showed how quickly she was progressing back at six when comprehensively reversing Navan form with Experience in a tour de force in the Round Tower. As Ger Lyons had said this week, it would have been the wrong thing to do not to supplement for this prize, which appeared to be dominated on the form book by the unbeaten **Best Terms (GB)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) and it soon became evident that Lightening Pearl was traveling more kindly than that over-zealous 11-8 market-leader. As the eventual fifth-place Best Terms began to pay for over-racing, Lightening Pearl was subduing Sajwah and was left in the clear when that long-time leader broke down with a quarter mile remaining. Continuing her drift left as the closers made their moves, she was beyond the reach of the green Sunday Times who belied her 33-1 odds with a storming rally up the rising ground. "We thought this horse could be special," Lyons commented. "It was a no-brainer to supplement her and the 1000 Guineas is be the plan--at the moment I'd say it's likely she'll now go into winter quarters." Cont. p5

Sad End for Sajwah...

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Listed Dick Poole Fillies' S. winner Sajwah (Exceed and Excel {Aus}--Tahrir {Ire}, by Linamix {Fr}) had to be euthanized after sustaining a broken pelvis during the race. Trainer Charlie Hills told *PA Sport*, "Unfortunately, Sajwah has had to be put down after she was found to have broken her pelvis and couldn't be saved." As for Sunday Times, she justified trainer Peter Chapple-Hyam's regard for her. "I've always thought she was pretty good," he noted. "She's not had many races and could come back here for the [Oct. 28] Listed Bosra Sham S. Her half-sister Question Times (GB) (Shamardal) finished second in that last year, so we'll try and go one better with her." Richard Hughes said of the disappointing favorite Best Terms, "She ran flat and I was beaten at halfway."

Dick Turpin has proved a mainstay of the Richard Hannon stable since his 2-year-old days, when successful in the G2 Richmond S. at Goodwood and valuable Tattersalls Ireland Sale S. at Fairyhouse. He upset Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) in the G3 Greenham S. last April, but was second to that stable companion in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot two months later after similar placings in the English and French 2000 Guineas. His confidence was restored with an easy win on his favored testing ground in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly in July, but the bay had only come close to that level of form on two occasions subsequently. They came when third behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in Longchamp's G1 Prix de la Foret over seven furlongs on Arc day and when beating yesterday's re-opposer Fanunalter (GB) (Falbrav {Ire}) under a penalty in Ascot's G2 Summer Mile July 9. Only seventh in the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville when last seen, he rebounded on this lively surface to demonstrate his versatility and deny fellow British raider Cityscape in the dying strides. Held up in fifth early by Christophe Soumillon, he looked booked for a place as Cityscape cut loose inside the final quarter but kept grinding away to reel in that rival in the shade of the post.

GII WinStar KY Cup (TP) **Future Prospect** (Freud) causes the upset.

To Honor and Serve endured a dull patch earlier this season and was sidelined a short time thereafter with a soft-tissue injury, but showed yesterday that he is past those issues with a stalk-and-pounce success in the Pennsylvania Derby. After debuting with a runner-up effort to the high-class Astrology (A.P. Indy) sprinting at Saratoga last September, the bay colt took an off-turf route by better than eight lengths then ran the table with front-running scores in the GII Nashua S. and GII Remsen S. in November. Those efforts earned him a spot alongside Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) and Boys at Toscanova (Officer) on the Eclipse ballot.

Though many were willing to excuse his third-place effort to Soldat (War Front) on his return to action in the Feb. 26 GII Fountain of Youth S., there were fewer alibis when he weakened to the bottom of the triple in the GI Florida Derby Apr. 3 and he was soon sent to the sidelines. He was certain to need the race over an inadequate seven furlongs in the GII Amsterdam S. Aug. 1, and ran just that way, forcing the pace before steadily drifting back to sixth. Trainer Bill Mott elected to try his charge against older rivals going nine panels at the Spa Aug. 26, and the decision paid off, as To Honor and Serve served notice that he was back with an authoritative 8 1/4-length victory. John Velazquez rode that afternoon, but opted here for GI Travers S. runner-up Rattlesnake Bridge, and it was Jose Lezcano taking over for the first time since teaming with the colt to score in the Nashua.

As advertised by trainer Tony Dutrow, Rush Now (Tiznow) made the lead and towed them along on a reasonable pace as To Honor and Serve tracked intently from second, with Rattlesnake Bridge a bit further back in midfield. Sent after the front-runner under the mildest of urging by Lezcano, To Honor and Serve overhauled that one, opened a clear advantage past the midstretch marker and held sway late as GI Belmont S. hero Ruler On Ice finished willingly for the place. Rattlesnake Bridge attempted to follow the eventual winner exiting the turn, but flattened a bit and settled for third. With the win, To Honor and Serve likely earned a start in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

"The timing would be right--the horse seems like he's doing well. I'll discuss that with Ms. Weber and the Live Oak team and we'll come to a decision on it, but I'm sure we'd all like to give that a chance if the horse is up to it," Mott told *Daily Racing Form*.

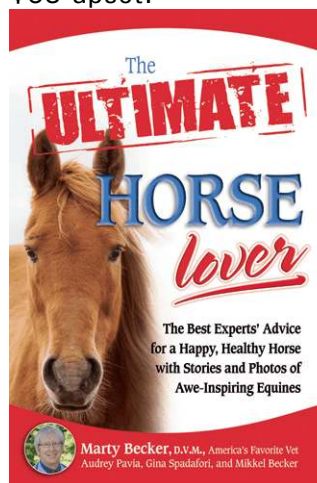

Closest to pacesetting Moontune Missy (Forest Wildcat) for the opening half-mile, Pomeroy's Pistol was coaxed to the front approaching the stretch. She had Tamarind Hall trying to launch a simultaneous bid to her outside, but quickened up better than that one and easily outsprinted her to the wire. "I thought she was absolutely awesome," said Tarrant. "It was the best result we could possibly expect: it wasn't by a nose, it wasn't by a head. She pretty much dominated, I think, in the race. We're very excited about it, and now she is going to go home for a nice rest and we're going to be looking towards the Breeders' Cup for her. We'll be staying at Monmouth and shipping out to Kentucky on [Oct. 31]."

He vanned over to Parx to finish second in an allowance Aug. 1, and came into this contest off a solid third to Wilburn (Bernardini) in the Smarty Jones S. at the Bensalem oval on Labor Day. With many of the glamour names scratched when this race came off the turf, I'm Steppin It Up assumed his usual spot on the front end, and was unchallenged through six furlongs in 1:13.18. That left him plenty of gas in the tank, and despite favored King Congie trying his best to cut into the margin, the local boy made good. It was the 1,000th career win for trainer Anthony Pecoraro.

TIME FOR THE EARL

Honors are nearly even between the 3-year-olds and older horses in the last 20 runnings of the G1 Preis von Europa, with the Classic generation just holding sway with 11 wins to nine. With only two taking on the sophomores this time, this renewal looks likely to fall to the youngsters and **Earl of Tinsdal** is primed to provide trainer Andreas Wohler with a fourth renewal. He has already beaten his main opponent **Saltas** on three occasions this term, most recently when capturing the G1 Rheinland-Pokal over this track and trip Aug. 14. Four lengths separated the duo on that occasion, with the gap between them widening each time they have met. Just a half-length separated them when first and second in Frankfurt's G3 Albert von Metzler-Rennen May 1, which grew to two lengths when they were second and third, respectively, behind Waldpark (Ger) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 3. Fellow 3-year-old **Ibicenco** has been performing with credit in France on either side of an eighth-place finish in that Classic, finishing runner-up to Kreem (GB) (Hurricane Run {Ire}) in the G3 Prix du Lys at Chantilly June 12 and third in Longchamp's G3 Prix de Lutece when last seen Sept. 4. **Campanologist**, who won the G1 Rheinland-Pokal and G1 Deutschland Preis in this country last term, has been second in the May 22 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh and G2 Bosphorus Cup at Veliefendi Sept. 4 on either side of three off-the-board efforts in 2011. Trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented, "I was pleased with Campanologist's run in Turkey, and he came out of that race very well. This is the right trip for him and he returns to Germany in good order. I am hopeful that he can run another nice race."

"The comments from the buyers I spoke to said it was very difficult to buy a good horse in the first week. There was very competitive bidding, and guys like Ben Glass [advisor to Gary and Mary West] didn't leave until [Wednesday, Sept. 22]. It took him that long to fill his orders for the Mr. West. That's one of the great things about the September Sale. If you don't get it on Monday, you'll get it on Tuesday. Or Wednesday. There's always an abundance of quality. The first week created great momentum, which carried over to the second week. And the second week was very good."

KEESEP Wrap-Up cont.

There was, if not a changing of the guard of top-level buyers, at least much more variety to them. Coolmore, the international powerhouse, has reduced its spending at September in recent years. In fact, it's been five years since John Magnier's conglomerate was a top-five buyer by money spent. This year, Coolmore ranked seventh by expenditures, and in the three years prior ranked 20th, 9th and 11th, respectively. Likewise, Sheikh Mohammed's Darley operation has radically altered its buying strategy. Darley rep John Ferguson signed for 36 yearlings this September, and every one of them was by a Darley sire. (Similarly, Ferguson bought 13 at Fasig-Tipton's Saratoga sale. But except for yearlings by Exchange Rate and Tiznow, they were all by Darley sires.) Which isn't to say, of course, that Sheikh Mohammed isn't still the game's preeminent buyer--he led all shoppers this year with \$8.87 million in purchases. Taken together, that has left some air at the top of the market for other players to exist, and those players, at September at least, we're primarily based in North America. To wit, the top seven yearlings--including the A.P. Indy--Malka colt--were bought by domestic connections.

The biggest player, and the biggest new player, was Benjamin Leon Jr.'s Besilu Stable. The Cuban born, Florida-based Leon was actually the sale's second-leading buyer a year ago, landing three yearlings for \$5.06 million. But a large chunk of that was the \$4.2 million Mr. Besilu (A.P. Indy--Balance). This year, Leon again was second on the buyer's list, but his involvement was much more comprehensive. He landed many more prospects--13 yearlings in total--and spent more Monday: \$8,175,000. The average price of his 2011 yearling? \$628,846.

"We're delighted by Mr. Leon's participation," said Russell. "Last year, he made a very big splash very early, purchasing hip 14, who was the sale topper. This year, it looks like he's trying to build up a racing stable and needs numbers, and also needs broodmares as well. His goal, from what I've been told and what I read, is that he's here for the long term, and he wants to build up a quality racing and breeding operation. He's certainly started off the right way."

The yearlings that comprised September this year were conceived in the spring of 2009, the first breeding season following the world economic collapse. Reduced production costs, generally in the form of less expensive stud fees that year, meant breeders stood a better chance of making a profit in 2011. It also helped put them in a buying mood.

"Horses were blowing by their reserves," said Russell. "The production costs they have in these horses was lower, which means their returns are better, so breeders and consignors weren't putting huge reserves on them. That helped create confidence in the market. I think John Ferguson was quoted saying that reserves are now being set with the goal of selling the horse, not hitting a home run. I think that's exactly what happened, and it's reflected in the clearance rate."

Boosted by the successful dispersal of the late Edward Evans's stock, topped by an Elusive Quality--Kobla full-brother to Quality Road who went to Fox Hill Farm for \$650,000, Lane's End was September's leading consignor. In all, Will Farish and company's draft sold 335 horses for \$27,437,000. But interestingly, the love was spread around to many different consignors at September. Of the top 15-priced horses, only Hill 'n' Dale and Gainesway had more than one representative. And there were new faces at the top. Greenwood Lodge Farm and Catherine Parke's Valkyre Stud, both small operations that came to Keeneland with a limited number of yearlings, came through with seven-figure yearlings.

Along with unexpected consumer confidence, September's strong results could be attributed to a smaller number of mares bred in 2009, another effect of the economic recession. At September, that meant fewer yearlings out of less-accomplished producers.

"The credit there obviously needs to go to the consignors and breeders," said Russell. "The horses that are not being offered are the noncommercial horses. That's a good thing."

In the end, Russell uttered the 'R' word everybody was hoping to hear after the sale.

"Our goal last year was to create stability in the yearling sale market," he said. "We successfully did that, and other sales have built off that. Now, we've built off the stability and pushed it forward. We seeing the start, we hope, of a recovery." -LM

BETTER TALK NOW BATTLING INTESTINAL PROBLEM

Retired multi-millionaire **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) had to be taken from trainer Graham Motion's Herringswell Stables in Lewisville, Pennsylvania, to New Bolton Center in Kennett Square last Tuesday. Outlining the 12-year-old's condition on the Herringswell website, New Bolton's Dr. Fernando Castro explained Friday, "Better Talk Now has a gastrointestinal problem that does not allow normal function of his esophagus and small intestine. This problem has led to a continuous amount of gastric fluid build up over the last 48 hours and severe reflux, which in turn has led to pneumonia from inhalation of the reflux. The cause of this problem is still unknown, although botulism is suspected. He has been undergoing supportive therapy at NBC since Tuesday and, for the first time since then, is regaining some of his normal GI function. His reflux has finally stopped and his attitude has greatly improved. He is still in critical condition, but it appears that as of today, he has taken an important first step towards recovery. We are cautiously optimistic." An update on the website Saturday morning provided an upbeat bulletin. Herringswell's Office Manager Sue Kenny reported of the farm favorite known as Blackie, "Dr. [Santiago] Garcia called, and he continues to be pleased with Blackie's progress. He has not refluxed in a while and they are starting to increase his feed to see how he tolerates it. They are doing more blood work today to make sure that is still balanced. He spoke also of release maybe next week? It makes me breathless to think about it as we all want him back so much--especially [fellow retiree] Gala Spinaway (Star Choice)! He is lost without his buddy." Kenny visited the gelding Saturday afternoon, and was able to take him outside for 20 minutes of walking and grazing. The winner of the 2004 GI Breeders' Cup Turf, Better Talk Now won 10 stakes races, including five Grade I events, and earned \$4,356,664. His last start was a second-place finish in the 2009 GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga.

AQUEDUCT PURSE INCREASES ANNOUNCED

(Edited Press Release) The New York Racing Association has announced that total purses for the 2012 winter/spring meet at Aqueduct Racetrack are expected to increase by approximately \$8.6 million, or 36%, over the 2011 meet. The new purse structure, which will go into effect Jan. 1, 2012, is possible due to the expected fall opening of Genting's Resorts World New York Casino at Aqueduct. During the first year of the casino's operations, 6.5% of revenue from the Video Lottery Terminals must go to NYRA's purses. "The 2012 Aqueduct winter/spring meet marks a new era for our purse structures," said NYRA President and CEO Charles Hayward. "The opening of Genting's Resorts World New York Casino is a highly anticipated event that will benefit all of the stakeholders at Aqueduct, Belmont Park, and Saratoga Race Course. Increased purses will help bring more top owners, trainers, and horses to our tracks, create larger fields for our customers to wager on and generate higher handle for our races." The daily average purse structure for the 2012 Aqueduct winter/spring meet will increase to approximately \$375,000 per day--\$100,000 more than the approximately \$275,000 that was distributed per day during this year's meet. "Aqueduct's winter/spring meet is very important for all of our year-round owners and trainers," said NYRA Vice President and Director of Racing P. J. Campo. "We are hopeful that the substantial purse increases will result in increased participation from horsemen during the meet." While every race category will see purse increases, there will be different increases depending on the distance, with route races having larger purses. Under the new purse structure, the highest overnight purses will be overnight stakes, which will have a purse of \$80,000 for routes and \$75,000 for sprints, up from \$60,000 during this year's Aqueduct winter/spring meet.

CHRB Approves Santa Anita Fall Meet:

In a letter to the Stronach Group sent out Wednesday, the California Horse Racing Board gave its approval for the application for a fall meet at Santa Anita. The Stronach Group, which operates the Arcadia, California, oval, as the Pacific Racing Association, had presented a signal distribution plan at a meeting Aug. 25 that did not meet the requirements of the CHRB, as the live signal distributed over the internet would have only been available to PC users, excluding Mac users, as well as all mobile devices. A new plan was devised that will make the signal available to all computers and mobile devices, and included a marketing campaign utilizing social media and print ads to promote the distribution. According to a CHRB press release, however, the letter also stated, "The approval of the live racing signal program instituted by the Pacific Racing Association for the fall meet at Santa Anita is only applicable for the 2011 racing season." The press release added, "The Board will expect future meets of the Stronach Group and other racing associations and fairs in California to provide the widest distribution possible of the live racing signal on all telecommunications platforms. Expanding the distribution of the live racing signal will increase the public's participation in horse racing." The Santa Anita meet starts Sept. 30.

MELBOURNE CARNIVAL HOPEFULS ARRIVE IN OZ

A number of European runners due to compete at this year's Melbourne Carnival successfully landed in Australia Saturday morning on a flight organised by International Racehorse Transport. The arrival of the flight, which left from London's Heathrow Airport, was timed so that the horses could satisfy the necessary quarantine conditions and regulations ahead of the Carnival. "The pre-export quarantine arrangements in the UK were exceptionally strict this year, and negotiations with ministries, both here and in Australia, to allow the runners to compete in the Cup Carnival have taken many months to complete," Jim Paltridge of IRT said. "The fall-out from the 2007 Equine Influenza outbreak has seen increasingly stringent pre-export isolation requirements, both for the staff and their horses, in their stables and when exercising on Newmarket's famous Heath. But, in the end, things were agreed for the horses to work at 4 p.m. each day with an army of inspectors in attendance to insure no contact was made with non-quarantine horses. The trainers and their staff have been very patient and obliging when complying with the new stricter rules." The runners on the flight include last year's G1 Melbourne Cup winner **Americain** (Dynaformer); fellow French-trained **Dunaden** (Fr) (Nicobar {GB}); the Luca Cumani-trained quartet of **Bauer** (Ire) (Halling), **Drunken Sailor** (Ire) (Tendulkar), **Manighar** (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) and **Sahara Sun** (Ire) (Desert Sun {GB}); and the Brian Ellison duo of **Moyenne Corniche** (GB) (Selkirk) and **Saptapadi** (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}). A spokesman for IRT said that the journey to Australia went smoothly and that the horses will now spend a two-week period at the Werribee racetrack import quarantine yard. Paltridge said, "It's a terrific new quarantine facility, with it's own track for the exclusive use of the quarantine horses, and its quiet environment allows the horses generally to relax and exercise well." A number of the IRT shipment have one or more entries at the Carnival, including Americain, who has [Oct. 15 G1] Caulfield Cup and [Oct. 22 G1] Cox Plate entries lined up before he attempts to win the Melbourne Cup for the second year in succession. Three of Luca Cumani's runners, Drunken Sailor, Manighar and Sahara Sun, all hold entries in the Caulfield Cup. IRT has a second wave of runners due to leave England Oct. 13. That shipment will start pre-export quarantine this Thursday and is likely to include Red Cadeaux (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) and Jukebox Jury (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}). Five-times Cup winner Lee Freedman, who was here overseeing his Cup contender Lucas Cranach (Ger) (Mamool {Ire}), was heard to quip, "There are so many foreigners this year trying to lift our big prize, we should have run the Melbourne Cup in Newmarket!"
