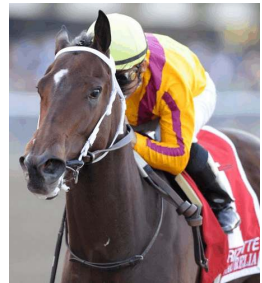

Champion **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) was favored to get back on track in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile, and duly obliged to take his bankroll past the \$6-million mark. "Winning this race means so much to me because we had so many seconds and close calls, and he's such a great horse," said winning rider Ramon Dominguez. Union Rags, a rallying winner at Delaware in his July 12 unveiling, caught a lot of attention when he skipped over the slop to secure the GII Saratoga Special S. by 7 1/4 lengths Aug. 15. He earned a 95 Beyer Speed Figure that day, and was expected to build on that effort here. Content to race in midpack as longshots Power World (Distorted Humor) and Right to Vote showed the way, the favorite was forced to take up a bit, but resumed his ominous advance through the turn. Though jockey Javier Castellano was sitting on a ton of horse, he put off the decision as to whether to go inside or outside until the last possible moment. Opting for outside, Castellano gave Union Rags several taps and the flashy bay responded, moving by Right to Vote and opening up in style.

"Anytime you can win going five-eighths with me, you know they're nice horses," quipped winning trainer Michael Matz.

Castellano was full of praise for his mount. "He's an amazing horse-- nothing bothers him," said the reinsman. "He got dirt in the face, he was blocked all the way on the trip. He's a big horse with a huge stride. He lost all the momentum, but I decided it was my best opportunity, and he did it. When he saw daylight, he took off."

Godolphin's Alpha, coming off a six-length maiden win at the Spa Sept. 3, rallied up the center of the track to get second, and punched his ticket to Churchill Downs.

"I was happy with the way he ran in only his second start," said trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "He finished second to a very nice horse. We'll go on to the Breeders' Cup with him."

Union Rags's second dam Terpsichorist was bred and campaigned by the Mills family's Hickory Tree Farm. The daughter of Nijinsky II captured the GIII Long Island H. at three in 1978 and the GII Sheepshead Bay H. the following season; she earned \$426,986 while winning 11 of 28 career starts.

Wyeth bred the colt and sold him as a yearling at FTSAUG, only to buy him back this past spring at FTTFEB.

"We always had hopes for him, but it's really an honor, because my mother bred all the mares," Wyeth added. "It's what they all lived to produce. It really is an honor."

She looked a solid prospect when breaking her maiden in her July 22 debut at Saratoga, and added a neck score as the 1-2 chalk in the Aug. 14 GII Adirondack S., but My Miss Aurelia took it to another level in her Grade I bow. The bay brushed with Stopshoppingmaria soon after the start, then eased up the rail to vie for the early lead. Still in hand as they clicked off fractions of :22.64 and :46.02, she was put to the test when they hit the top of the lane, and aced it, drawing off under a vigorous hand ride and a couple of waves of the whip to win as much the best. "She actually would have gone faster if I let her," said rider Corey Nakatani. "You're basically just harnessing her energy and her power until the stretch, then you let her level out and do what she's got to do to win the race." Dam My Miss Storm Cat, a \$70,000 KEESEP yearling acquisition for Ed and Natalie Friendly, won five of her seven career starts, including the 2006 Desert Stormer H. Stonestreet Stables purchased the mare, in foal to Unbridled's Song, for \$925,000 at Keeneland November in 2007. Her first foal was the stakes-placed 3-year-old Albergatti (Unbridled's Song). She has a yearling colt by Mr. Greeley and a weanling colt by Distorted Humor, but is barren for 2012.

Gio Ponti hadn't visited the winner's circle since last year's victory in this event, and some racing fans were wondering whether the gallant bay had slowed a step at age six. All four of his starts this year had come at 10 furlongs or further, but a return to a mile was just what the doctor ordered. The Castleton Lyons colorbearer settled in fourth along the inside as Sidney's Candy towed them along. With the gaps coming at the right time in the stretch, Gio Ponti angled out and earned his way back to the Breeders' Cup. "I didn't think he was going to get there at the quarter pole," admitted winning trainer Christophe Clement. "Yet again he proved me wrong, and he got there." Second to Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita in 2009, Gio filled the same spot behind Goldikova (Ire) in the GI BC Mile at Churchill last year. Clement said that the 6-year-old would likely face off with Goldikova once more in the Mile, but that owner Shane Ryan would make the final decision. "You know he's a top-class horse, and I really mean this," Clement added. "He was a bit unlucky this year. I've been running him on softer ground. There's nothing I can do; the program is made that way, and I cannot control the weather."

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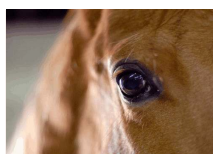

Never Retreat, in the midst of her best season yet, recorded a career high with this sharp performance. The nearly black mare notched her first graded win in the GIII Honey Fox H. at Gulfstream Mar. 5, and followed up with a victory over this course and distance in the GII Jenny Wiley S. Apr. 16. Sixth as the favorite in the GII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill May 7, she was runner-up in the GII Nassau S. at Woodbine June 4, and got back on top in the GII Dance Smartly S. over the same course July 10. Never Retreat faded to seventh over yielding ground in the GI Beverly D. S. Aug. 13, but rebounded with another Woodbine win in the GII Canadian S. Sept. 18. Forced to take the overland route after breaking from post 12, the 6-year-old raced in fourth as Wasted Tears (Najran) took up her expected position on the front end. Never Retreat revved her engine entering the stretch, hit the front inside the eighth pole and was confidently handled by jockey Julien Leparoux. "We were on the outside, so we were hoping to drop her in a little bit on the first turn," said Leparoux. "She put me in the race good, just nice and easy, and she finished good." Daveron waited for room and rallied up the fence, but was nipped at the wire by fellow closer Together.

Dullahan, who had run with credit in each of his previous starts, finally earned his diploma with a big payday. A distant third in his career debut at Churchill June 9, the half-brother to 2009 GI Kentucky Derby hero Mine That Bird ran fifth in a similar test July 3, but came up just a half-length short when stretched out on the Saratoga turf Aug. 13. He finished a close third last out in the GI With Anticipation S. Sept. 1--with Optimizer second--and didn't garner much attention in this all-weather bow. Forced to steady early, the blaze-faced chestnut had a five-wide journey. He set his sights on Majestic City turning for home and forged to the lead late. "The race went exactly opposite of what we had planned," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "I almost fell around the first turn. He had to get his legs back underneath him and he did do that quickly, but I had to make a five-eighths of a mile run down to the wire." Trainer Dale Romans added, "This is a special horse, and we've known it all along. We felt like he was a Grade I-caliber racehorse, and he showed it today."

On the board in all seven prior starts this term, Amazombie made it rain in April, taking the GII Potrero Grande S. at Santa Anita and the Tiznow S. at Hollywood. It looked as if he'd added the GIII Los Angeles H. to his resume May 30, but the bay was DQ'd and placed third for a bumping incident as he forced his way through a narrow gap at the eighth pole. He was looking for his first Grade I rosette after finishing third in the July 2 GI Triple Bend H. at Hollywood and July 31 GI Bing Crosby H. at Del Mar. Jockey Mike Smith opted to take back as odds-on The Factor (War Front) was harried by outsider Sirocco Strike (Forestry) through a salty opening half in :43 4/5. That early pace took its toll, and The Factor was swallowed up when they hit the lane. Amazombie forged to the front from the outside and made it tight when Irrefutable made his bid from the fence, repelling that late challenge to prevail. Trainer Bill Spawr discovered Amazombie when he was turned out at a farm in Riverside County, California, in early 2009. Out to check his own lay-ups, he was offered the chance to buy a couple of Gregg Anderson-bred 3-year-old maidens by Northern Afleet. Smokenomore was thought the better of the two, and Spawr made a modest offer that was accepted. But when that colt was sent to Spawr's barn at Santa Anita, he was accompanied by Amazombie, who'd been thrown in for free. He blossomed after being gelded in January of 2010, and is now a Grade I winner. Smokenomore is still racing as well, but in the claiming ranks, and has earned \$38,560. Asked if he would take a swing at the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Churchill Nov. 5, Spawr said, "We'll see how he comes out. We hope to, if he comes out fine. If he doesn't, he'll run in the Cal Cup [Sprint Oct. 29]." The Factor, who faded to fourth, will head to Kentucky. "As long as he comes out of it all right, this will set him up for [the Sprint]," Bob Baffert said. "The next race will be the most important one."

Jim Bolger conquered the G1 Dubai Dewhurst S. with Teofilo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) five years ago, and it was fitting that yesterday's renewal should be won by a member of that Darley sire's first crop. Parish Hall was introduced in the same Leopardstown maiden won by the stable's luminary Finsceal Beo (Ire) (Mr. Greeley) in 2006, becoming his sire's first runner and first winner in that Apr. 10 contest. It was a statement of intent that he was sent back there for the seven-furlong G3 Tyros S., used as a stepping stone for the eventual Dewhurst heroes Teofilo and New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), but he finished second. Eighth over six in The Curragh's G1 Phoenix S. Aug. 7, he was runner-up to Dragon Pulse (Ire) (Kyllachy {GB}) in that track's G2 Futurity S. over this trip last time Aug. 20. Racing close to the pace early, Parish Hall was committed by Kevin Manning approaching the quarter pole and battled gamely against the fence to see off the eventual third Most Improved, as Power struggled for daylight in behind. He held on grimly in the final yards as his half-length margin diminished with every stride, but his head was in front of that strong-finishing 15-8 favorite where it mattered. Whether Parish Hall will shape up to be a New Approach remains to be seen, but Bolger is hopeful the 2012 Classics will not elude him. "He's up there with my three previous winners of this race," Bolger said, adding, "That will be it for the year. Sent over the Irish Sea to make his debut in York's Convivial Maiden S. Aug. 19, Crusade faded late into eighth in that seven-furlong contest. Crusade's dam, La Traviata, was purchased by Coolmore for \$1.1 million as a FTFEB juvenile, and won three of her four career starts, including the GIII Victory Ride S. at Saratoga. This is her first foal.

Expectations were high for Strong Suit following a juvenile campaign highlighted by a win in Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. and a second in the G1 Middle Park S. He disappointed when last of six to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury on sophomore bow Apr. 16, but a breathing operation saw him return to form with a ready win in the June 15 G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot. Third in a tight finish for the July 3 G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly, the chestnut was acquired by Sheikh Fahad bin Faisal Al Thani's Qatar Bloodstock after a comfortable win in the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood last time July 26. He stalked the strong early pace set by Across the Rhine (Cuvee) in second here. Moving smoothly to the front inside the two-furlong pole, Strong Suit quickened clear under a hand ride when challenged by Maqaasid a furlong out. Chachamaidee finished fast to snatch second place on the line. The winner will now head Stateside for the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill, an assignment that jockey Richard Hughes thinks likely to suit. "I would say it's made for him," Hughes said. "Rock-hard ground and he can go left under pressure, so he'd be going the right way." Confirming Churchill Downs is indeed Strong Suit's desitination, trainer's son Richard Hannon Jr. added, "After what he showed today, I'd say all roads lead to Louisville for the Breeders' Cup. [Owner's bloodstock manager] David Redvers bought the horse especially for the Mile, so we gave him a break after Goodwood and, hopefully, this will have put him spot on. To make him an internationally recognized stallion, he's got to run out there and run very well. He will go around that very tight mile track and he will enjoy it."

On a day when Ballydoyle was responsible for the first and third in the G1 Middle Park S., and a possibly unlucky runner-up in the Dewhurst, Wading carried out her part of the success story with aplomb when dominating this strong-looking renewal. "She had a lovely run the first time and Joseph [O'Brien] said she was very smart when he rode her at Dundalk. She traveled very sweetly over seven there, which she did the last twice she ran. She's very classy--she is an easy traveler and is a fine, big good-walking filly. She is a beauty. She'll hopefully be trained with a Classic campaign in mind." Wading is a granddaughter of Arc heroine Urban Sea, who went on to produce the likes of leading sire Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and champion Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}). Cherry Hinton produced a full-brother to the Rockfel winner in 2010, a full-sister this past January and was bred back to Giant's Causeway.

Jeranimo broke on top before conceding the early advantage to Monterey Jazz (Thunderello). He pounced on that foe turning for home and, though Mr. Commons rallied belatedly, was in no danger late. "I'm not going to get involved in that conversation [about running in the Breeders' Cup]," said winning trainer Mike Pender. "We'll let the horse tell us what to do. We got a little bit ahead of ourselves sometimes with this horse in the past. We ran him in the Santa Anita H. [in 2010] when he was a little bit under 100% and we don't want to make that same mistake twice, so we're just going to watch this horse. This horse is kind of tricky. Sometimes he'll lay an egg on you if you're not watching him close. Other times he'll give you a race like today."

Bubble Chic added international spice in this Future Champions Day card closer and the Italian raider easily prevailed at generous odds to add weight to an already impressive portfolio. Second in last term's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, the bay bagged a sixth straight silver medal in the June 5 G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly, but slipped to fifth in the July 14 G1 Grand Prix de Paris at Longchamp. He returned to finish a close-up fourth in the Sept. 17 G3 Prix du Prince d'Orange at the Bois de Boulogne track last time, and registered a belated first black-type score in murky conditions here. 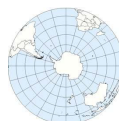

On paper, the G2 Schillaci S. was a soft return spot for reigning Australian Horse of the Year Black Caviar, but with the supermare visiting the races for the first time since May, there was a bit of trepidation from the Peter Moody barn. Any fears there may have been were dispelled following an authoritative 56-second display in front of the Caulfield faithful. Black Caviar was recording the sixth win of her career when landing this event in 2010, an effort she used as a springboard to five subsequent scores at the highest level, including the T. J. Smith S. in Sydney in April and the BTC Cup in Brisbane the following month. Instead of heading overseas, the mare was spelled, trialled successfully in late September and was sent off as the lowest favorite in an Australian group race in 50 years here. Black Caviar wasn't especially quick from the stalls, traveling in midfield early before looming upside the pacesetter on the bend. She cantered to the front at the head of the stretch and was asked for a bit of an effort before stretching well clear. "It's great to see her back doing what she enjoys," Moody said after the win. "She is an unbelievable athlete and it is just great to see her back in that shape. We feel an obligation to showcase our sport and this is our opportunity in the spring and this horse is our banner horse. It is just great to see her back and putting on a great show for the crowd." The conditioner told Australian television that this could be the year he sends the mare overseas, but first are engagements in the G2 Schweppes S. Oct. 22 and the G1 Patinack Farm Classic Nov. 5, both won by Black Caviar last season.

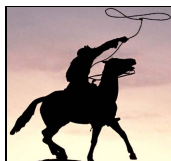

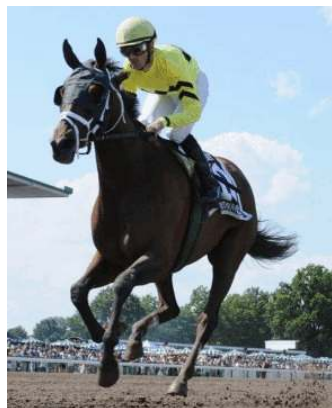

**October 12, 1966...****Damascus**, owned by Edith Bancroft, broke his maiden at Aqueduct Racetrack, winning by eight lengths.

**October 12, 1990...****Great Normand** paid \$354.80 for a \$2 win wager when he upset the GI Meadowlands Cup.

**October 13, 1927...****Arlington Park** opened. The track, built by H. D. Brown, had a steeplechase course and a polo field and was adjacent to tennis courts, a golf course and a one-mile training track.
