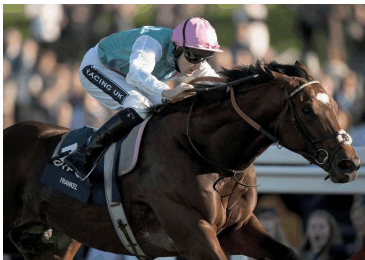




FRANKEL ON CLOUD NINE

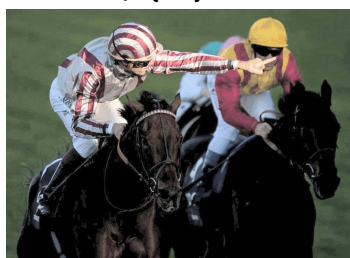
★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Frankel (Galileo {Ire})'s already lofty reputation was enhanced in July's G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood, and Juddmonte's World Champion-elect justified odds-on favoritism with yet another stunning performance in yesterday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. (Qipco British Champions Mile) at Ascot. Keen early as stablemate **Bullet Train (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) went clear on the front end, the 4-11 lock went in smooth pursuit from halfway and burst clear once set alight approaching the final eighth to easily best G1 Prix du Moulin hero and old foe **Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) by four lengths. "He's the real deal, not that he was never before, but he most certainly was today," enthused rider Tom Queally. "That was as good as ever, and he's getting more professional with each run. He's a horse in a lifetime for the public, let alone for the jockey lucky enough to be on him, and it's a privilege to be associated with him." **Cont. p2**

YOU CANNOT BE CIRRUS

Having knocked on the door six times at the highest level without reply, French raider **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) came back off a second in Longchamp's G2 Prix Dollar at the beginning of this month and picked an opportune moment to register a first Group 1 success in yesterday's Qipco Champion S. at Ascot. His victory added an international winner to the day's roster and set the perfect seal on the inaugural British Champions Day. Under restraint until easing into contention on the home turn, the 12-1 chance hooked up with **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) entering the final eighth and was more than a match for that rival in the drive to assert in track-record time. **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) ran on strongly in the latter stages to claim third, with a further six Group 1 winners left in their wake. "Winning means so much to me because I always believed Cirrus des Aigles was a very good horse, and he has now got the Group 1 win he deserves," enthused conditioner Corine Barande-Barbe. **Cont. p4**

A REGAL DOUBLE

They were on opposite sides of the Atlantic--one, an undefeated superstar colt billed as maybe the best to ever rule the turf; the other, a filly that hadn't hit the line first since taking a Group 3 event 15 months ago and riding an 0-for-12 streak. But both are 3-year-olds by the great Galileo (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), and they pulled off an impressive double yesterday, with son Frankel (Ire) taking the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Newmarket and, seven hours later, daughter **Together (Ire)** capturing the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. It was the third start in 22 days for Team Coolmore's Together, who was seventh in the Sept. 24 G1 Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket and second just a week ago in the GI First Lady S. over this course. **Cont. p8**

British racing's initiative of staging an inaugural Champions Day demanded a stamp of approval, and Juddmonte's superstar Frankel duly delivered to embellish his already perfect record. Returning to the scene of his first pattern-race triumph--in last term's G2 Royal Lodge S. going one mile on the round course here--the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ added to top-level victories in the G1 Dewhurst S., G1 2000 Guineas, G1 St James's Palace S. and G1 Sussex S. with another commanding performance in this straight mile test. Frankel was unhurried through the early strides and was off the pace under restraint as stablemate Bullet Train (GB) (Sadler's Wells) soon established a lead which was largely ignored by the remainder. Allowed into full flow before halfway, he towed the field into contention entering the final quarter mile and was let loose approaching the eighth pole, bursting clear to once again leave an indelible mark. **Cont. p3**

Living Up to the Hype...

"There was hype and pressure beforehand, but I like to think I handled it and enjoyed getting a kick out of it," admitted Tom Queally. "[Jockey] Ian [Mongan] went a good tempo [aboard Bullet Train] and did a good job. I lost my early cover, but Frankel was grown up enough to know not to tear off and waited until I said go. When he did it was electric, and he was flawless again."

Trainer Sir Henry Cecil continued, "It has been a long year and he's done everything we have asked of him. He was lovely and relaxed today, and I'm delighted. I'm really looking forward to having a winter over him next year, and I'm sure he'll get a mile and a quarter." In a rare public moment, winning owner Khalid Abdullah added, "He is the best horse I have ever owned. Many people think he is the best they have seen, and I am glad to have him. I hope he will do the same next year."

Cirrus des Aigles has done the hard yards venturing the globe in pursuit of glory, but came up short in Sha Tin's 2009 G1 Hong Kong Vase at the end of a 17-race sophomore season. Lightly raced by comparison last term, his seven-start campaign concluded with off-the-board efforts in the G1 Japan Cup and G1 Hong Kong Cup. He has remained exclusively in Europe this semester and franked his third in the Apr. 30 G1 Prix Ganay Apr. 30 at Longchamp by hustling Goldikova (Ire) when runner-up back there in the May 22 G1 Prix d'Ispahan. Cirrus des Aigles regained winning ways in the June 13 G3 La Coupe and gave Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse to Bend {Ire}) a scare when second in the June 26 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. He registered a trio of wins in the July 20 G3 Grand Prix de Vichy, the Aug. 14 G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron and the Aug. 28 G2 Grand Prix de Deauville, and was a last-out second in the Oct. 1 G2 Prix Dollar at Longchamp once again. The winner broke sharply from his inside gate and raced under restraint in fourth as Ransom Note (GB) (Red Ransom) and Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) pestered each other for the lead.

Making smooth progress into contention until coming under pressure at the two pole, he hooked up with So You Think entering the final eighth and dug deep to deny that game rival. "When they came to the final furlong, I could see that Cirrus des Aigles still had gas, and only then did I think he could do it," revealed Corine Barande-Barbe. "I am very pleased for the owners and the whole team back at the yard, but especially for my friend Cirrus. We are in paradise and so grateful to everyone for having us here. This is a great Group 1."

Connections Pleased With Placers...

So You Think's chances were scuppered by an unfavorable draw in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at the beginning of the month, but he bounced back here and gave way grudgingly to Cirrus des Aigles in the dying embers. "So You Think ran a stormer and he's a big horse with a big heart," trainer Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "The boys will have to speak about his future and make a decision." Snow Fairy was unable to confirm Longchamp with So You Think, but nonetheless ran her usual game race in defeat. "Everyone has told me she got boxed in and was a bit unlucky, but I haven't had a chance to look at the replay," added trainer Ed Dunlop. "She has run a great race. She was third in the Arc and third here, and hopefully we will go on to [the Nov. 27 G1] Japan [Cup] now."

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**British Champions Sprint S. cont.**

Deacon Blues started to deliver what he was capable of when lifting the prestigious Wokingham H. over course and distance at the Royal meeting June 18, before making the transition to stakes company look easy when winning the July 16 G3 Shadwell S. at Newbury. An impressive seven-length victor in the Aug. 7 G3 Phoenix Sprint S. at The Curragh, he showed that five furlongs held no fears under Frankie Dettori in the G3 Dubai International World Trophy at Newbury last time Sept. 17. Deacon Blues tracked Hooray (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) as that rival set the pace along the stands' side rail. Easing to the front with 1 1/2 furlongs to go, he was sent clear with a couple of backhanders by Johnny Murtagh before keeping on well to record a personal best. "I thought Deacon Blues was a nice 3-year-old, but he kept getting beat," revealed trainer James Fanshawe. "He ran 10 times and won [just] once, but this term he's won five out of six. He's the most amazing horse, he's improved since the Wokingham and is wonderful to have in the yard. The owners bred this horse and [G1 July Cup winner] Frizzante, which is a pretty amazing achievement." Murtagh added, "I've had a great bit of luck with James over the years. He's a great trainer, but doesn't know how good he really is. When he gets them here for the big day they usually win. He's a lovely man with a great family, and he looks after me very well. I'm very grateful to him for putting me back on the horse. From the day I won on him at The Curragh, I thought that he was a true Group 1 horse. He won by seven lengths [there], but was never out of second gear. I knew that there was a lot more to give. James said that he came out of the race really well and that's a great sign. James said Hooray would go to the fence, so I followed her until the two marker. His momentum was up and he won easily."

Wizz Kid on Scouting Mission?

Maeve Mahony's Wizz Kid failed to add to her win in June's G2 Prix du Gros-Chêne, but came back from a pair of fifths in the G1 Nunthorpe S. and G1 Prix de l'Abbaye to lay down a marker for next year. "We wanted to come here to see if Wizz Kid got six furlongs and handled Ascot, and she did," commented Ballylinch Stud's John O'Connor, perhaps hinting at next year's G1 Golden Jubilee S. over course and distance at the Royal meet. "She is quite lightly raced, and it is highly likely that she will stay in training next season. [Jockey] Gerald [Mosse] thinks she will be even better when she is more mature."

Fame and Glory enjoyed the perfect start to the season, taking listed prizes in the Apr. 17 Vintage Crop S. at Navan and the May 29 Saval Beg S. at Leopardstown. Marking his fifth Group 1 success with a commanding win over Opinion Poll in the June 16 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot, he was rested until posting a rather lackluster second in the Listed St Leger Trial S. at The Curragh Aug. 20. Despite that reverse, the bay was still sent off as the 8-13 chalk for the Sept. 20 G1 Irish St Leger, but a stop-start pace was blamed for his well-beaten fourth-place showing. Fame and Glory sat second as Chiberta King (GB) (King's Best) dawdled through the first half mile here, and was sent to the front soon after. He still traveled best in front on the home turn and, kicking on once facing the stretch, was under a sympathetic drive to hold his closing rivals in the final quarter. "His big day this year was the Ascot Gold Cup and he was trained hard for that, but we had to let him down and be kind to him afterwards," said trainer Aidan O'Brien. "We chased him hard for the Gold Cup and you don't want to do that twice in a year. He had his break and two nice comeback runs, and we chased him a little bit for today. We've been lucky to have him this year, and wouldn't it be great [to go for a second Gold Cup next June], but that's everyone else's decision."

Excelebration in the Bridesmaid Role Again...

Like Sham was to Secretariat, G1 Prix du Moulin victor **Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) has been blighted by fate to find a superstar in the midst of his generation. Nevertheless, he once again lost no caste in defeat and was clear of a high-class bunch facing his mighty rival Frankel (Ire) for a third time in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. "We have tried to take Frankel on three times, and there is no disgrace in losing to him once again," reflected trainer Marco Botti. "Excelebration finished three [and-a-half] lengths clear of the rest, so you have to be pleased with him. I will have to talk to the owners about what we do next--the only race left for him would be in [the Dec. 11 G1] Hong Kong [Mile], so we'll have to wait and see."

Immortal Verse to Sidestep BC; Stays in Training...

Immortal Verse (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}) had an interrupted preparation, and found an interrupted passage during the QEII itself, running on strongly once finding a clear route to be third. However, the G1 Coronation S. and G1 Prix Jaques Le Marois heroine will resist the temptation offered by Churchill Downs' Breeders' Cup meet and will instead be saved for another campaign next year. "She missed a bit of work, so maybe she was a little bit short," admitted Robert Collet. "To be honest, even if I was 100% happy with her, we would have been delighted to have finished second to Frankel. She won't go to the Breeders' Cup, but will definitely stay in training."

Bible Belt to Carry On, Gertrude Bell Retired...

Bible Belt (Ire) (Big Bad Bob {Ire}) rebounded from her first defeat of the year in last month's G2 Blandford S., to emerge best of the rest in the G2 British Champions Fillies' & Mares' S., and will carry on next term, according to trainer Jessica Harrington. "I'm thrilled with that performance, and it was probably a career best. Bible Belt has come back to the form of before her last run. She found the ground too soft [at The Curragh] last time, and even today, [jockey] Fran [Berry] thought the ground was still a little slow for her. She definitely stays in training next year, but we haven't discussed a plan." Rachel Hood's **Gertrude Bell (GB)** (Sinndar {Ire}), who followed a fourth in last year's G1 Epsom Oaks with success in July's G2 Lancashire Oaks, will not continue on the track. She has been retired to the breeding shed after a gallant third Saturday. "It was a great run--the winner has come back to her Oaks form and the second is very useful too," said John Gosden. "Gertrude Bell is my wife's first homebred and she will now be retired and sent to Oasis Dream."

Soumillon Seething at Ban...

The victory of **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) in the G1 Champion S. was somewhat tempered for jockey Christophe Soumillon, who was adjudged to have fallen foul of the new British whip rules. Soumillon struck his mount six times inside the final furlong, one over the five allowed, and was given a five-day ban for the indiscretion. The new regulations also determined he should forfeit his winning percentage and riding fee. "I'm very embarrassed for English racing today," the rider told *PA Sport*. "You have a lot of problems, but the whip is not one of them. Jockeys are not here to whip horses, they are here to make the horses do their best, and that is what I tried to do. We now have padded whips, they are very soft and I hit my horse to make him do his best in the last furlong. Unfortunately, maybe I should have hit him before the final marker, but the rules have only been in one week. I just gave six, I didn't give eight, nine or 10, and for a little mistake they give me a five-day suspension. I'm fighting for the [jockeys'] title in France, so it is important for my career, and they take away all my prize money, around £50,000. Never can a fine like this have been handed out in sport. I never saw [soccer player] Zinedine Zidane get a fine like this, nor Michael Schumacher in Formula One. I was just beside So You Think, who everybody knows is a very tall horse, but couldn't see the furlong marker. There are publicity banners everywhere on the track, so how can I see the marker? The marker is small, yet for this small mistake I get a big ban. I think the English jockeys have to get together to sort it out, because it is impossible to work this way. I will get a good lawyer and see what I can do."

"QIPCO has made it possible and they have been behind the event all the way. It makes an enormous difference working with a sponsor that is so involved and supportive."

Trainer Mike Pender was one who was not surprised by the outcome. "This was our Kentucky Derby horse before he got colic as a 2-year-old," Pender explained. "It's a miracle he's even here. The conditioner saddled his wife's Choc Ice (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) to victory in this race 10 years ago, and sent out Richard Strauss's Truly a Dream (Ire) (Darshaan {GB}) to win in 1994.

Another sophomore, Ecurie Wildenstein's **Adventure Seeker (Fr)**, steps up off her victory in the Listed Prix de Liancourt going 10 panels at Longchamp Sept. 25. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre looks to make it two in a row after taking last year's edition with Reggane (GB) (Red Ransom). "She has been running well most of the year on firm ground, and maybe she is better on a softer surface," de Royer-Dupre told *Racing Post*. "We will see, and I am led to believe that she remains in North America after the race." The conditioner also took this event with Khariyda (Fr) (Shakapour {Ire}) in 1987.

The Head homebred encountered traffic trouble in the Sept. 18 GI Woodbine Mile and was only just beaten, finishing third by a neck. The homegrown contingent is headed by Vinery's **Regally Ready**. The chestnut gelding won four in a row, including the Apr. 16 GIII San Simeon S. at Santa Anita and May 7 GII Twin Spires Turf Sprint at Churchill, before taking a three-month vacation. Juvenile at Churchill Downs Nov. 5, will miss the race after being diagnosed with an ankle chip, according to trainer Terri Pompay. "He has a small P-1 flake in his left front ankle," Pompay said. "He worked last weekend

and came back a little grouchy. My exercise rider could feel something wasn't right, so we X-rayed it and found the flake." A six-length maiden winner at Saratoga Aug. 6, the Florida-bred followed up that effort with a 3/4-length victory in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at the Spa Sept. 5. "We felt like we could have continued on to the Breeders' Cup, but after talking to the owners, we decided this was the best thing to do," Pompay added. "We'll take the flake out and point to the [GI] Fountain of Youth and [GI] Florida Derby. This was an agonizing decision, but we felt it was the best thing to do for the horse." The bay will van to Ocala Monday and, after undergoing surgery, will get 60 days off before preparing for the Triple Crown trail in Florida over the winter. "It's disappointing, because I truly believe that this is a special horse," Pompay said. "There's no doubt in my mind that, if he was 100%, he could win the Juvenile. He won the Hopeful, he's undefeated--he did his job for this year. We'll give him the time he needs and come back with a really neat horse for next year."

Big Drama Works Between Races at Calder...

Champion **Big Drama** (Montbrook) worked between races at Calder yesterday as he prepares for his title defense in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Timed by *Daily Racing Form* correspondent and clocker Mike Welsch, the 5-year-old went six furlongs in 1:13.87, with splits of :13.10, :25.16, :37.16, :49.09 and 1:01.49. He galloped out seven-eighths in 1:27 under jockey Daniel Centeno. "That was excellent,"

JOCKEYS STRIKE AVERTED Planned strike action by Britain's jockeys at Windsor and Pontefract tomorrow has been averted after officials of the British Horseracing Authority (BHA) agreed to meet representatives of the Professional Jockeys' Association (PJA) instead. The PJA has now recommended its members go ahead and take bookings for rides at both of Monday's meets. "We are pleased that the BHA board will meet the representatives of jockeys so that together we can resolve the current issues concerning the whip rules," PJA chief executive Kevin Darley told *Racing Post*. "It is imperative for the sport that these matters are settled as soon as possible. What jockeys do have concerns about are the new penalties for what they perceive to be relatively minor infringements of the rules. The PJA believes very strongly that this aspect needs to be reconsidered." Speaking at Ascot's inaugural Champions Day meet, BHA Chairman Paul Roy added, "I made it very clear that we've put a new set of rules in place. They have been commended by everybody in the sport after a thorough consultation process that took place over weeks and months. It resulted in a very long document and it was endorsed by everybody in the sport, including the PJA. Everybody agreed that it was necessary to make some amendment to the whip rule, so that is what we did. We have a regulatory board meeting on Monday morning, I've invited Kevin Darley and some of his team, which will probably include people like [jockeys] Tony McCoy and Ryan Moore. We will sit down to talk about the practicalities and pragmatism of what is going on at the moment. We're a week on and we've got some serious quirks, but we are going to sort it out. We maybe need an adjustment here and there. I take responsibility for bringing in the rules in on Monday, and if I felt differently I would have said so. These things are very difficult and hindsight is a great thing." Reflecting on jockey Christophe Soumillon's angry reaction to incurring a ban for his ride aboard Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) in the flagship G1 Qipco Champion S., Roy continued. "At the end of the day, Christophe [Soumillon] walked into that weighing room today and he knew the rules. He knew he could only hit the horse five times inside the final furlong."

The win gave jockey Craig Williams his third major, following victories in the G1 Cox Plate with Fields of Omagh (Aus) (Rubiton {Aus}) and G1 Golden Slipper with Miss Finland (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}). Southern Speed was coming off a solid fourth place finish in the Oct. 2 G1 Turnbull S. to December Draw (Ire) (Medecis {GB}), who went favored in the Caulfield Cup. He finished dead last in the 18-horse field, however, and trainer Mark Kavanagh told the *Herald Sun* it was case of Murphy's Law--everything that could go wrong did. He thought the 5-year-old gelding had been struck high above a hock, had an elevated heart rate after the race and might have swallowed a clod dirt. Needless to say, Kavanagh ruled out a tilt in the Melbourne Cup. "There very well may be some other problems that surface in the morning," Kavanagh told the publication. "Whatever, he will go for a spell."

I cannot wait until the Derby to have my revenge." Suggestive Boy is now the solid favorite for the G1 Gran Premio Carlos Pellegrini in December, but a rematch with Chuck Berry in the G1 Argentine Derby in mid-November looks likely.
