Palides Investments NV's **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) tracked the pace of GI Kentucky Oaks winner **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) from fourth down the backstretch, came wide into the drive and outstayed Godolphin's **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft) to cap what is likely to be a championship season in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic under the lights at Churchill Downs. NO ONE GETS NEAR MISS IN JUVENILE FILLIES

George Bolton and Stonestreet Stables' **My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike) stalked the pace from second, edged to the front at the head of the lane and outpaced **Grace Hall** (Empire Maker) to take her record to a perfect four for four in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. STAR-STUDED SATURDAY AT THE DOWNS

Breeders' Cup Saturday will feature a who's who in the world of Thoroughbred racing, headed by a mouth-watering matchup between **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam). The latter will try to become the second of her sex in the last three years to take down the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. **Goldikova** (Anabaa) makes the final start of her illustrious career against a field in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile that is about on par with those she has handled in each of the last three years. **Big Drama** (Montbrook) is back to defend his title in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, but has some questions to answer while making just the third start of the season this afternoon. In the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, **Union Rags** (Dixie Union) will try to cement his status as the nation's top 2-year-old when he faces top California rival **Creative Cause** (Giant's Causeway) in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. The GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile is perhaps the deepest and most competitive race of the afternoon, with **Trappe Shot** (Tapit) taking on a couple of fleet sophomores in the form of **The Factor** (War Front) and GI Preakness S. hero **Shackleford** (Forestry).

Ajina (Strawberry Road {Aus}) and Escena (Strawberry Road {Aus}) in 1997 and 1998, respectively, and bagged a third renewal of the event 12 months ago with Unrivaled Belle (Unbridled's Song). This year it would be Royal Delta (Empire Maker) to represent the barn, and she came well-

credentialed, with tallies this season in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. in May and, more importantly, a win over divisional heavies **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft) and **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI TVG Alabama S. The season would boil down to a final head-to-head-to-head clash in this event, and Royal Delta left little doubt as to who was best.

From Rising Star to Breeders' Cup Champ...

Accorded ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status off a monster maiden win at first asking last October, Royal Delta rebounded from a dull sophomore debut to register a Keeneland allowance win Apr. 15, followed by a 2 1/2-length success in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. May 20. Forced to miss the GI Mother Goose S. in June, Royal Delta resurfaced against It's Tricky and Plum Pretty in the GI CCA Oaks at Saratoga July 23, and she did not turn in her best effort, racing evenly while finishing third to her two rivals, beaten 7 1/4 lengths. She gained a measure of revenge and rewarded those that did not lose faith in her when she returned a square 11-2 in besting It's Tricky by a comprehensive 5 1/2 lengths in the GI TVG Alabama S. at the Spa Aug. 20. She faced the unenviable task of taking on Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) in the GI Beldame Invitational S. at Belmont Oct. 1, and was in a different area code that afternoon while finishing a clear runner-up.

Championship Form...

With her two rivals in the gate alongside her Friday evening, it was something of a winner-take-all affair, and Royal Delta was forwardly placed beneath Jose Lezcano as Plum Pretty led in advance of Ask the Moon (Malibu Moon) through a moderate opening half-mile that went in :49 flat. It's Tricky rode the rails in third, while Royal Delta was posted wide in fourth. Plum Pretty arrived at the midway point of the turn after six panels in a leisurely 1:13.72, and connections must have felt confident in a repeat of her GI Kentucky Oaks win over the course and distance in May. Royal Delta, still four wide at the quarter pole, seemed a bit one-paced

when the real running began, but she methodically reeled in Plum Pretty and was doing her best work at the finish. It's Tricky held for second, while Pachattack finished up well for third. "I got a very good trip," said Lezcano, winning his second Breeders' Cup race (Maram, Juvenile Fillies Turf, 2008). "She broke real good and she was very comfortable and relaxed. When I asked her, she gave me a very good kick. When we hit the quarter [pole], I felt very comfortable that we would win the race. She's a fantastic filly. She handled the track very good." SHIRLEY YOU JEST

For the second year in a row, a North American-based longshot upended a fancied European in the GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. Charles Fipke's homebred **Perfect Shirl** (Perfect Soul {Ire}), still looking for her first win of the year, came with a sustained bid to edge previously unbeaten **Nahrain** (GB) (Selkirk) in the final strides.

"She was aggressive early, but, when we went by the wire the first time, she settled right down," said winning rider John Velazquez. "From there on out I had a perfect trip. [Trainer] Roger [Attfield]...said he just wanted me to save her for the end. It worked out just like we'd hoped."

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Emirates Airline BC F/M Turf cont.

Perfect Shirl seemed to be on her way to the big time last summer when she captured the GII Lake George S. at Saratoga in July and finished a close third in the GI Del Mar Oaks the following month. But she finished 2010 with an eighth in the GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, and got off to a slow start this season. She finally showed some of her old form when a rallying third in the GIII Taylor Made Matchmaker S. on the Monmouth sod July 31, then filled the same spot in the Belle Mahone S. on the Polytrack at Woodbine Aug. 20. In her most recent effort, the bay filly had a troubled trip, but came within a half-length of the streaking Never Retreat (Smart Strike) in the GII Canadian S. on the Woodbine weeds Sept. 18.

Announce (GB) (Selkirk) figured prominently in the wagering until she acted up in the post parade and wound up hitting the rail; a laceration to her right hind leg dicated that she be scratched. When the gates opened, Misty for Me stumbled and nearly did a face plant from her outside post, but the others broke cleanly. Though Dubawi Heights (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) faced some early pressure from Dynaslew (Dynaformer), the California-based bay wound up settling through splits of :25.44 and :51.07, while Perfect Shirl picked up her usual spot near the back. Velazquez guided her into a five-wide rally as the field fanned out turning for home, and the 4-year-old had the goods. Nahrain, unbeaten in four starts overseas, struck the front and looked like the winner until Perfect Shirl ranged up just to her outside and hit the wire first. "I'm ecstatic," said winning trainer Roger Attfield. "I had my doubts about running her. I was very concerned because she's never been able to handle a soft course. Once I saw how she was moving down the backside, I could see she was moving beautifully, and I became very excited."

Favored Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) looked to be in a perfect spot on the hedge and waiting for room when the real running began, but it took a while for a hole to open up, and the mare--equipped with a protective bubble over her eye--never punched it in. "Around the 3/8-pole I was very happy because she was still taking it in," said rider Ramon Dominguez. "Turning for home, she just didn't have the response I was looking for. I can't say it was the course."

She's a Lady...

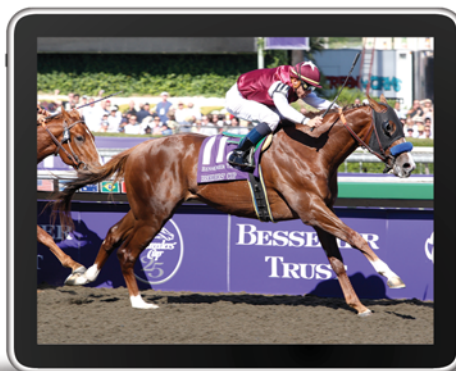
Lady Shirl defied her obscure Illinois origins to bank over \$950,000 while winning 18 of her 41 starts, including the 1991 GI Flower Bowl H. She failed to sell her first few times through the auction ring, and wound up going to Triple J. for \$90,000 in 2000 at KEENOV while in foal to Theatrical (Ire). That foal turned out to be the brilliant Shakespeare, and the late Jack Werk signed a \$485,000 ticket on the mare on Charles Fipke's behalf when she was carrying a full sibling to that multiple Grade I winner. Lady Shirl has a 2-year-old full-sister to the F/M Turf winner and was bred back to Perfect Soul this year.

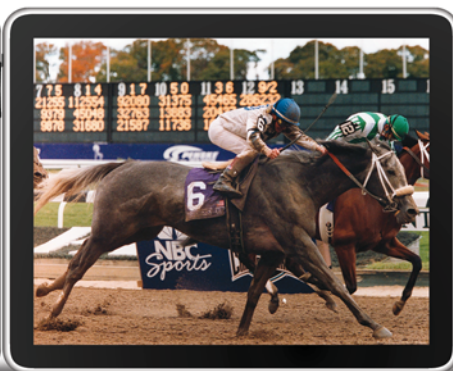

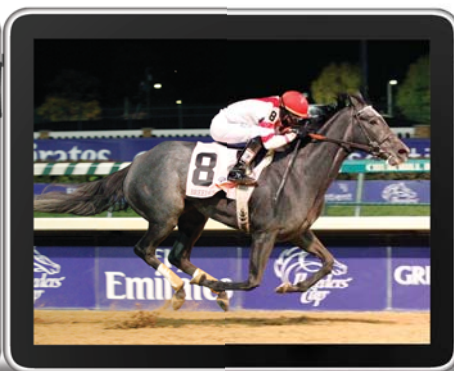
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AURELIA STAYS PERFECT IN JUVENILE FILLIES

The team of George Bolton and Barbara Banke's Stonestreet Stables had tasted Breeders' Cup success with an offspring of Lane's End's Smart Strike, namely Curlin, who clinched a Horse of the Year title with a smashing score in the 2007 GI Classic at Monmouth Park. Going Back to the Well...

The collective braintrust from Stonestreet found themselves at Keeneland a handful of days following Curlin's Classic score and went to \$925,000 to acquire My Miss Storm Cat in foal to Unbridled's Song at the Keeneland November sale. The mare foaled a colt by the Taylor Made stallion and was sent to Smart Strike for the following breeding season. The result was My Miss Aurelia, and she got her career off on a high note, defeating a field including Stopshoppingmaria (More Than Ready) at Saratoga July 22 and followed with a neck score in the GII Adirondack S. at the Spa Aug. 14. Corey Nakatani replaced Julien Leparoux at the controls for the GI Frizette S. going Belmont's one-turn mile Oct. 8, and while the pilot was different, the result was the same, as the attractive bay filly set a good pace after a bit of a slow start and ran away in the stretch to best Stopshoppingmaria by 5 1/2 convincing lengths.

A Rating Gear...

Blessed with good early speed, My Miss Aurelia had the opportunity to take a sit off a rival in the Juvenile Fillies, as California's **Candrea** (Trippi) won the break and took the field into and around the first turn with the race favorite in close attendance from second. The race's other chief protagonists, Grace Hall and **Weemissfrankie** (Sunriver), were further back in the field. While Nakatani

allowed My Miss Aurelia slide up a bit closer to the pacesetter midway on the turn, Grace Hall was making her move and split horses to loom a challenge from third. But My Miss Aurelia spurted away in upper stretch and, though Grace Hall was finishing willingly, she was never a threat to the winner through the final 100 yards. "She broke really well," Nakatani commented. "My main concern was getting her in a good spot so I had options to go outside, or inside, or to the lead. Actually, she put herself in just the right spot. It's great to be connected with [trainer] Steve [Asmussen] and [assistant trainer] Scott [Blasi]. They give you a lot of confidence when you ride."

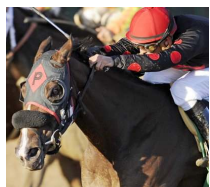

PAYING FOR 'ROMANCE'

Adam Lazarus of Pinnacle Racing Stable and co-owner/trainer Bill Kaplan called a last-minute audible and decided to supplement GII Presque Isle Downs Masters S. heroine **Musical Romance** to the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint for \$130,000. Money well spent, gentlemen. Overlooked by the Churchill faithful at odds of 20-1, the hard-knocking filly drifted in sharply into **Champagne d'Oro** (Medaglia d'Oro) at the start, and was quickly straightened to race in hand while pressing the early pace from the inside. Shuffled back a bit entering the far turn, Musical Romance found a seam along the inside in the stretch, shot through with authority to gain command and held the rallying duo of **Switch** and **Her Smile** safe. "This filly's done everything I've asked of her and more," Kaplan commented. "She's just awesome. I don't care if she runs 13 or 14 times a year, she gets better with every shot. I was confident she'd run good, but I didn't know she would beat these horses." Kaplan added, "This is it--this is the pinnacle." According to on-call veterinarian Dr. C. 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A Finely Tuned Instrument...

Musical Romance has really stepped up her game during her 14-race, 4-year-old campaign. The dark bay put them back-to-back at Calder in the Ema Bovary S. May 22 and the U Can Do It H. June 11, then was a heart-breaking second to the imposing Sassy Image (Broken Vow) in the GI Princess Rooney H. July 9. She splashed her way home to a narrow victory in the Barb's Dancer S. Aug. 7, but could do no better than third as the 6-5 favorite in the grassy Connie Ann S. Aug. 28. Muscial Romance eked out a win in the aforementioned Masters, and earned her way to Louisville with a close second in Keeneland's GI Thoroughbred Club of America S. Oct. 8. "It was not a good financial decision," Kaplan admitted of supplementing his charge to the big dance. "Well, it is now, but at the time it cost us \$130,000 just to get her in the race. That means we had to run second to break even." He continued, "So we had a lot of confidence that she'd do good, and we also knew this is the one shot for this filly to be a champion and everyone involved to be a champion. It just worked out great. I'll tell you, I couldn't be happier." South-Florida based Jockey Juan Leyva, 27, handled himself like a pro in the irons during his first Breeders' Cup mount. "I didn't really want to be a jockey," the native of Mexico revealed. "I wanted to be a football player, but I was too small for that. So I settled for being a jockey. I love what I do."

Nightmare Trip...

Turbulent Descent (Congrats), favored at 7-5 following a stylish win in the GI Test S. at Saratoga Aug. 6, reported home fifth after enduring a rough trip. She was bumped hard at the start, ran into some traffic and was checked hard by David Flores shortly thereafter, gained a short lead in the stretch, but flattened out late to finish fifth. "She got slammed leaving the gate," trainer Mike Puype said. "She got slammed leaving the backside. Then it made her eager and she pulled her way right up to the leader, moved too early and then she flattened out after all that. She couldn't sustain a good run. She just didn't have a good trip at all. It's her first bad race. [This is] the wrong day to have it, but it happens and we've just got to move on." Flores added, "She was aggressive; she really wanted to get in the bit. I tried to get her back because there was so much bumping going on. Trouble followed us all the way to the turn and she was trying to get out of it. She knew she had to get out of there, but there was too much trouble. She was okay, but she was tired at the end."

Stephanie's Kitten was third when unveiled by conditioner Wayne Catalano over the Arlington Polytrack July 9, and took to that Chicago oval's yielding sod Aug. 5 to earn her diploma. Shipped north of the border for Woodbine's GIII Natalma S., the homebred was a late-running third with an extremely wide trip. According to Trakus data, she traveled 50 feet (equal to 6 1/4 lengths) more than winner and GI Juvenile Fillies contestant Northern Passion (First Samurai), who finished 3 1/4 lengths ahead of Stephanie's Kitten. The bay returned to Polytrack at Keeneland to annex the GI Darley Alcibiades S. Oct. 7, earning a "Win and You're In" bid to the Juvenile Fillies, but her connections opted to return her to the grass and were handsomely rewarded. In between horses in the perfect position in fifth behind splits of :24.57, :50.55 and 1:15.71, Stephanie's Kitten was forced to wait for running room at the head of the lane as Stopshoppingmaria continued to travel well on the lead. The rail opened up for the Alcibiades victoress in mid-stretch, and she powered through before tipping out into the two path to pull clear from the leader late. Sweet Cat, who tracked her stablemate early from second, narrowly held off Irish invader Up (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) for the show dough.

"First of all, I have to thank the owners who give me the opportunity to work with these fillies," said Catalano, who conditioned 2006 champion 2-year-old filly Dreaming of Anna (Rahy) and 2008 champ She Be Wild (Offlee Wild), when asked about his knack with young runners of the fairer sex. "Having the opportunity that these great people gave me to train these horses and the staff behind me, it was like old school. We had it done before, and it's been working. We stayed with it and I hope they continue to send me great fillies." Ramsey, who won the 2009 GI Breeders' Cup Mile with Furthest Land (Smart Strike), added, "[Rider John Velazquez] said he had absolute confidence in the filly. She landed about fifth or sixth down the backstretch, and all I wanted was her to get through. She got through. I thought she'd have the kick. It was a belated birthday present. Yesterday was my 76th birthday. Didn't win yesterday, but today makes up for it." Stephanie's Kitten is named for the Ramsey's granddaughter.

The wagering for inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint was dominated by Pegram, Watson and Weitman's **Secret Circle** (Eddington), who was sent off at prohibitive odds of 2-5, and while the margin of

victory did not exactly correlate to that long odds-on quote, the California raider staved off a late bid from the slow-starting, but fast-finishing **Shumoos** (Distorted Humor). **Holdin Bullets** (Ghostzapper), unraced since breaking his maiden in his lone previous appearance at

Keeneland Apr. 21, was in touch throughout and stayed on for third. Trinniberg (Teuflesberg), the GII Nashua S. runner-up, and Secret Circle broke alertly and engaged in a lively opening quarter mile in :20.96 here, but Shumoos, drawn just inside the chalk, exchanged bumps with that rival and dropped well back early on. With Rafael Bejarano riding confidently throughout, Secret Circle eased by Trinniberg and went for home, while Shumoos was just getting underway one from the rear. The Bob Baffert runner began to show signs of fatigue entering the final furlong, and the European filly was now in high gear, having been guided down to the fence at about the three-sixteenths marker. It appeared for a few strides as though she might be able to sustain her momentum and motor past, but Secret Circle had enough left in the tank for the victory. "After I saw those fractions, I thought, 'Oh boy,' but he was doing it easy," commented Baffert, winning his eighth Breeders' Cup race and first since 2008. "He's just a very gifted horse; he has unbelievable speed. I feel good about it because he came off the plane and won here. I was a little worried about him coming down the lane, he kind of lost focus, but he's just young." Secret Circle, a

Repole Stable's **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) returns to the scene of his GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile tour-de-force for this afternoon's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, for which he has been installed the 5-2 favorite on Mike Battaglia's morning line. After suffering his first career defeat in the GI Wood Memorial in April, he was removed from GI Kentucky Derby consideration for a potentially career-threatening liver problem. That he made it back to the races is no small miracle, forgetting altogether that he's turned in two powerful efforts—a runner-up effort in the Aug. 27 GI King's Bishop S. and a front-running victory in the GII Kelso H. Oct. 1.

"Since July 11 when he came back, everything went according to plan," trainer Todd Pletcher explained. "I think we've gotten as much foundation as we could get. The only decision we wrestled with a little bit was possibly going to the [GII] Pennsylvania Derby and getting a mile-and-an-eighth race under his belt." Instead, Uncle Mo stayed home for the Kelso. "We just felt like staying at home at Belmont and eliminating the X-factor in Philadelphia," Pletcher continued. "I don't think we'd ever gone into the spring with a horse who seemed like he was as qualified for the Derby as we felt Uncle Mo was. We're pretty fortunate to be where we are." Despite the tough beat at

Saratoga, Pletcher never lost faith. "He got beat going seven [furlongs] in the King's Bishop," Pletcher said. "I didn't think that could happen, but it did. But the way this horse has trained, if you watch him gallop, he gets into a rhythm. He's got a tremendous stride, great rhythm. I think if he can fall into that rhythm and get comfortable, I think he stays a mile and a quarter. There's only one way to find out." **Cont. p12**

Fox Hill Farm's **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam) will look to follow in the footsteps of her sire, who used victory in the 2005 Classic as a springboard to his own Horse of the Year title. The 4-year-old filly won the GI Apple Blossom H. early in the season and defeated **Flat Out** (Flatter) three starts later in the GI Woodward S. at Saratoga to enter the HOY discussion. Connections dropped her back to her own gender and she dominated Royal Delta (Empire Maker) by a decisive 8 1/4 lengths Oct. 1. In a slight departure from this week's norm, Havre de Grace was out just after 6 a.m. "We wanted to get out there when we thought the track would be the best and to also give her experience under the lights," said trainer Larry Jones. "She handled things just fine. We're ready."

In a way similar to how Blame (Arch) remained in the shadow of Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}) in the lead-up to last year's Classic--and returned a handsome mutuel to his believers--Flat Out represents an extraordinary opportunity, pari-mutelly speaking. With **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) likely to romance more than a few bettors, the Scooter Dickey trainee could be the fourth choice in the wagering. That would be colossal value on a horse whose lowest Beyer (106) in his last four starts came when he was a runner-up to the now-retired Tizway (Tiznow) in the GI Whitney H. at Saratoga. He exits a convincing victory over **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) and GI Travers S. hero **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 1.

Betting the Breeders' Cup

Saturday, Nov. 5:

CLASSIC - While Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) is the most talented horse in this race, he's a terrible bet here. He's simply had too much go wrong in 2011, and now must stretch out two furlongs to a distance he's never gone before. Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) is also a guaranteed underlay, in part because she's the type of horse that the public latches on to, and also because she's probably best at nine furlongs. Add to the mix a likely over-the-top, unproven on dirt So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}), who in my estimation will be about a third the price he should be, and the value on a major contender continues to balloon.

Flat Out (Flatter) is by far the most reliable runner in this race, and he's an absolute must-bet. While Havre de Grace beat him in the 1 1/8-mile Woodward, she got the jump on him after being closer to a below-average pace. Flat Out was gaining on her late (his final eighth came in :12.75 to her :12.87), and also passed her during the gallop-out. He had no trouble getting this distance last out in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, and figures to get plenty of pace to run at. Game On Dude (Awesome Again) will be gunned to the lead because his connections have decided that he has to be ridden that way, and To Honor and Serve (Bernardini) and the Repole pair shouldn't be far behind. Flat Out doesn't capture the public's imagination the way others in this field do, but he's undoubtedly the most likely winner of the Classic and sure to be a huge overlay.

TURF - He's not exactly a secret, but I had a hard time getting past **Sea Moon (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}) here. The Europeans clearly have this race locked up, and Sea Moon offers by far the most upside with just five starts under his belt. His eight-length romp in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in August over a weak field earned a field's best 126 *Racing Post* rating, and came at this distance. He was clearly best in the G1 St. Leger last time, as he was trapped down inside of horses for almost the entire stretch run. That he finished third with the trip he had was a testament to his very serious ability, and note that Sir Michael Stoute used the St. Leger as a springboard to Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire})'s first of two BC Turf wins. St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) is the under-the-radar Euro, and is probably the race's 2d most likely winner.

DIRT MILE - The obvious players in here are no secret and will be on my tickets somewhere, but how about **Tres Borrachos** (Ecton Park) to spice things up a bit? In a race where two of the favorites are stretch-outs, the 6-year-old veteran turns back off a fifth-place finish in the GI Goodwood S. in which battled through an opening half that was 13 points above par on the Moss Pace Figure scale. He was third in June going seven panels with a 98 Beyer, and took a weak renewal of the 1 1/16-mile GII San Diego H. with a 97--those figures probably aren't quite good enough to win this, but he did run consecutive 106s in 2009. His dam was a sprinter/miler, and he has always given the impression that he too would be best at 7-8 furlongs, but, surprisingly, he's only gone a flat mile once in his career. Tres Borrachos probably isn't as talented as some of these at their respective bests, but he could show up with something close to a career top, which would put him in the mix.

TURF SPRINT - Havelock (Great Notion) is the most reliable runner in this race--he's won the last four turf sprints he's contested, and has the versatility to travel in mid-pack or towards the back. It seemed like he was left with way too much to do last time in the Gill Woodford S., but he flew home late to get up and clear (granted, the early pace was hot). He should get just enough pace to set up his late rally again, and even though his style isn't optimal for five furlongs, he sports a 6-4-0-1 record at the distance. A crazy longshot to include might be **Grand Adventure** (Grand Slam), who has run races in the past that would win this for fun. He's been a disappointment so far in 2011, but he's had just enough of an excuse in most of his races that perhaps he can turn it around--especially on firm turf and at a shorter distance--at astronomical odds.

JUVENILE TURF - Like the filly version of this event, this is clearly a spread race. With so many places to go, it seems like a good idea to start with the Euros. I want no part of exposed sprinter Caspar Netscher (GB) (Dutch Art {GB}) and, while he's got a shot and is certainly one to use, Farraaj (Ire) (Dubai Destination) seems to be a wise guy horse from what I've read and heard. **Wrote (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) is very interesting--or at least as interesting as a horse can be in an inscrutable race that anyone can win. I loved his performance to be third last time in the G2 Royal Lodge S. over Newmarket's Rowley Mile behind stablemate and Juvenile contender Daddy Long Legs (Scat Daddy). He was last early behind what seemed to be a slow pace set by his Ballydoyle buddy and, when producing his run, was inexplicably guided towards a blocked rail before being taken back outside by Jamie Spencer. He loomed ominously before tailing off a bit late, but the final furlong of that course is uphill (the previous furlong is downhill), so going from a mile there to a mile at Churchill Downs could almost be considered a turn back. He gives the impression of a horse that will love a good-to-firm American turf course, and trainer Aidan O'Brien is having a huge year Stateside after suffering from an extended rough patch previously. I'm expecting a breakout performance from Wrote, and doubt any American horse can hang with him if he runs that sort of race. For more Breeders' Cup Saturday analysis, visit the [TDN Blog](#).

who were shut out from turf training Thursday, led by Sea Moon (GB) (Beat Hollow {GB}), who once again looked good as he breezes the easiest of three furlongs in :41.20 for trainer Sir Michael Stoute.

Later in the early afternoon, across town, racegoers prepared to trek to Churchill at the area hotels. A handsome couple standing outside the Marriott duly perused their

TDN while awaiting their ride. Over at the historic Brown Hotel, a large French contingent, headed by Goldikova (Ire)'s owners Alain and Gerard Wertheimer, packed into a black cargo van that utterly belied the brothers' Chanel ties.

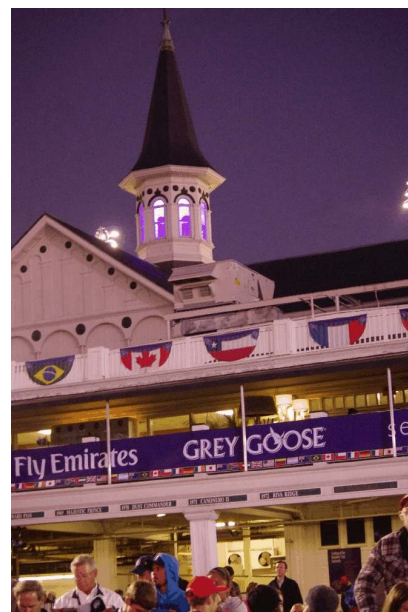
The first few races were contested under those stubbornly grey skies, but the sun finally emerged mid-afternoon, and from there on, conditions were ideal. In the day's second Breeders' Cup race, the GI Juvenile Fillies Turf, Repole Stable's Mike Repole directed traffic in and amongst his significant entourage in the paddock area, while Ken Ramsey, whose filly Stephanie's Kitten (Kitten's Joy) would win the race, took questions from a TV crew. Ramona Bass, near trainer Michael Matz as part of the Somali Lemonade (Lemon Drop Kid) crew, sporting a flashy fur stole, chatted with Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell as the rest of the Keeneland crew--Tom Thornbury, Chauncey Morris and Mark Maronde--talked with the various horsemen and owners.

Consignor Archie St. George, who helped purchase GI Filly & Mare Turf contender Cambina (Ire) (Hawk Wing), warmed up the betting windows by hitting the cold exacta in the Juvenile Fillies Turf--Stephanie's Kitten over Stopshoppingmaria (More Than Ready)--which paid \$106.20 on a \$2 wager.

Lady Gaga's "Bad Romance" blared as the field for the GI Filly & Mare Sprint filed into the saddling area. Starlight Partners' Jack Wolf, whose outstanding filly Hilda's Passion (Canadian Frontier) would have been the likely favorite for the race but for injury, was casually dressed in cords and a sweater and talked with consignor Reiley McDonald. Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning Jr., who offers Hilda's Passion Sunday, chided a sneaker-clad friend's choice of footwear.

Bluewater's Meg Levy soaked up the action prior to the GI Juvenile Fillies with her son Sam, as did 2-year-old consignor Dave Scanlon. "Just enjoying the day," said Scanlon. "Got two in tomorrow--Stay Thirsty [Bernardini] and Ice Box [Pulpit]." Scanlon Training Center broke both of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic contenders.

By the time the GI Ladies' Classic rolled around, the skies over Churchill Downs matched the purple of the Breeders' Cup banners adorning the track's facade. John Fort, dapper in a stylish tan suit and fedora, stood well over the crowd as his GI Kentucky Oaks heroine Plum Pretty (Medaglia d'Oro) strutted her stuff. Reno, Nevada-based Nels Erickson, owner of Ultra Blend (Richly Blended), and his crew excitedly watched the filly get saddled. At the call of jockey's up, the horses began to circle the gathered crowd, and Keeneland's Tom Thornbury nudged a reporter and said, "Look at her--that's something else," as Royal Delta (Empire Maker) strode past.

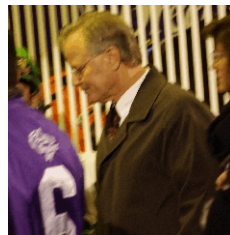

"I was a little concerned about the track because he's never run over a surface like this [muddy], but he's handled every track he's been on. I was also worried about the slow fractions and didn't know if he'd be able to close into that." The winner is possible for the GI Clark H. Nov. 25, a race won (via disqualification) by Giant Oak in 2010.

Arena Elvira had never been off the board in 10 previous efforts, and was looking to string together her third-straight victory here. The dark bay annexed the Aug. 5 Madame Jumel S. and Sept. 4 Sightseek S.--both at the Spa and both at this distance--in her last two runs, and was made the second-favorite behind GI Personal Ensign S. runner-up Tiz Miz Sue (Tiznow). In second early through comfortable splits of :25.17, :50.71 and 1:16.21, Arena Elvira challenged Banker's Buy (Distorted Humor) for the lead midway around the bend, and was soon joined by a three-wide Check Point. She disposed of that foe around the eighth pole, and cruised home easily to keep her streak alive. Tiz Miz Sue was forced to check early, but had no run late. "[Rider Junior Alvarado] rode her perfectly," said Leana Willaford, assistant to winning trainer Bill Mott. "The one horse we thought might show a little speed did. [Arena Elvira] was in a perfect stalking position and everything went smooth. Nice job on Junior's part."

HORSE FOR THE COURSE IN THE CHILUKKI

Buckleupbuttecup looks to run her record over the local strip to a perfect four out of four in this afternoon's GII Chilukki S. at Churchill. Victorious in last year's GIII Eight Belles S. going 7 1/2 sloppy furlongs beneath the Twin Spires, the grey has won two of her four trips to the post, including a third-level allowance success over **Ailalea** at Saratoga Aug. 24. She never lifted a hoof when last of six to Pomeroy's Pistol (Pomeroy) in the GII Gallant Bloom H. Sept. 24, but stretches out off that effort in her return to Louisville. **May Day Rose** has proven effective at seven-eighths to a mile, with wins in Oaklawn's Instant Racing S. going eight panels Apr. 16 and the GIII Railbird S. over seven furlongs of the Hollywood Cushion Track May 21. Eventually he will be sent to Goldmark Farm in Florida, and as he recovers, we'll decide with Vinery whether or not to try to bring him back to race again." 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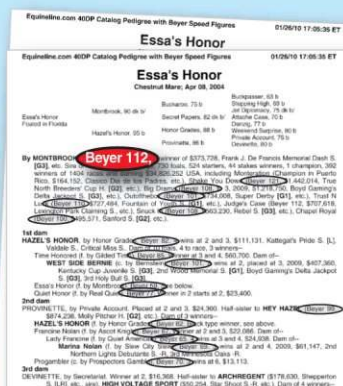

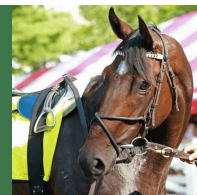

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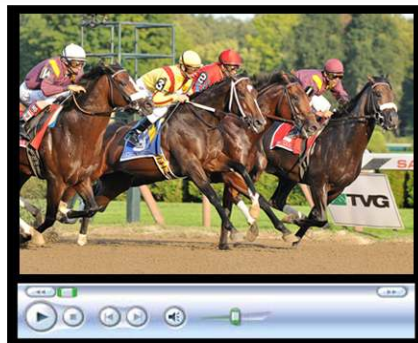
