The waters are decidedly deeper this afternoon when the sophomore takes on a seasoned field of veterans in the GI Cigar Mile H. at the Big A. Trainer Bill Mott isn't one to force the issue, so the fact that To Honor and Serve is back just three weeks after his decent seventh-place effort in

Owner/breeder Morton Fink and trainer Charlie Lopresti experienced the thrill of victory and the agony of defeat all within a few minutes' time in last year's GI Clark H., watching as Successful Dan (Successful

Appeal) crossed the line first, only to be demoted to third for causing interference. There was no such misfortune Friday afternoon, as **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry), the half-brother to Successful Dan, came calling for the lead in the final furlong and raced

away for a four-length victory over **Mission Impazible** (Unbridled's Song). Favored **Flat Out** (Flatter) could do no better than third. 'STARS' HELPS POWER TATTS FRIDAY

A 450,000gns filly from the first crop of champion Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) starred at Tattersalls last night when topping the penultimate session of the December Foal Sale in Newmarket. Offered from Harry McCalmont's Norelands Stud for a partnership, the filly is a half-sister to the Group 1-placed Surfrider (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) and was bought by Angus Gold as a long-term racing prospect for Sheikh Hamdan Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estate Company. The Feb. 5-foaled bay, catalogued as [hip 1012](#), is a

daughter of the Rahy mare Ecoutila. Few of yesterday's dearer lots are scheduled to see a sale ring again before they run, and several foresighted breeders were chasing fillies with eventual paddock potential. Though all manner of would-be buyers tried to get a bid in for the session topper, including John Clarke, racing manager to Sea the Stars' owner Christopher Tsui and his mother, Ling. Cathy Grassick, standing with Yvonne Jacques, Turkish-based owner Ibrahim Araci and underbidder Hugo Lascelles were others to make a play for the filly. **Tatts cont. p11**

Wise Dan won four of his six starts last term, including the GIII Phoenix S. on Keeneland's Polytrack, then was a close sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint before concluding the season with an allowance win going this track's one-turn mile exactly a year ago. It took him a few runs this season before he was ready to fire his best, but that he did when making his turf debut in the GII Firecracker H. on Independence Day. Close up, but four deep for the opening half-mile, he drew clear to score by 2 3/4 impressive lengths. Further amplifying his versatility, he took nicely to the Tapeta track at Presque Isle for a half-length success in the Presque Isle Mile Sept. 9, then found Grade I company just a bit too deep when fourth, beaten under two lengths, by Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in the Shadwell Turf Mile Oct. 8. He was on trial--in a certain sense--in the Oct. 29 GII Fayette S. at Keeneland, but strode clear to take it by four lengths. Lopresti wondered how he'd stay the nine panels; the gelding answered emphatically and earned a crack at a Grade I on dirt in the process.

Drawn 11 here, but with a long run to the first turn, Wise Dan was three wide and third under the wire for the first time and raced freely, as the stretch-out sprinter **Will's Wildcat** (Eurosilver) showed the way from

Mission Impazible. Flat Out secured an excellent spot in midfield and within shouting distance. Wise Dan was still pulling pretty hard against John Velazquez down the backside, but he was always traveling nicely and ranged up three deep to throw his name into the hat at the quarter pole. Mission Impazible had the first crack at the weakening Will's Wildcat in upper stretch, but Wise Dan switched his leads on cue, quickened up well and lengthened clear. Mission Impazible repeated his runner-up effort from this track's GI Stephen Foster H. in the spring, while Flat Out plugged home third.

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Summer Soiree set a searching pace in the GI Del Mar Oaks in August and was getting late in the final eighth of a mile, but was able to stave off a late rally from Star Billing. This time it was Summer Soiree who was on the short end of the stick, as Star Billing parlayed a perfect trip into a narrow victory over the East Coast invader. Star Billing won her first two trips to the post, including the GIII Seniorita S. over this course and distance May 7, before finishing a half-length second in the GII Honeymoon H. over a furlong further May 7.

She rallied from next to last to miss by a head when third in the GI American Oaks July 16 and nearly bridged a 5 1/2-length gap in the Del Mar Oaks, flashing home to be second by a half-length. The homebred, a 3/4-sister in blood to one of her owner's best previous runners in Starrer (Dynaformer), threw in a clunker in her latest, checking in a well-beaten sixth in Keeneland's GI QE II Challenge Cup Oct. 15, where Summer Soiree was fifth.

Settled off the pace of Summer Soiree while glued to the fence into the backstretch, Star Billing gained ground into midpack and inside of a three-wide Never Retreat passing the half-mile pole. While the favorite had some trouble negotiating the final turn, Star Billing was allowed an unimpeded run up the inside. Summer Soiree reached for the wire, but could not withstand the late kick of Star Billing, who was along in the final 20 yards. Team Block's Never Retreat was late in switching leads and worked home to snatch third on the wire. She is to be retired from the races and has a date in early 2012 with War Front.

Third in this event last season, Our Nautique was the upset winner of the GIII San Francisco Mile over this turf course Apr. 30 and was fifth to Uh Oh Bango (Top Hit) in the GIII Berkeley S. on the Tapeta May 30 before returning to the lawn to annex the Joseph T. Grace S. at Santa Rosa Aug. 7. Last of six behind Caracortado (Cat Dreams) in the GII Del Mar Mile H. Aug. 27, he defeated Bold Chieftain by 2 1/4 lengths in a grassy allowance Sept. 11, but was a no-excuses second to Dunmore East in an allowance prep for this on the Tapeta Nov. 4. Soon in front here beneath Kevin Krigger, Our Nautique had things all his own way up front. He cut the corner into the stretch and was able to withstand a late rally from Bold Chieftain, who was going well inside the final 100 yards, but found his best stride too late.

More Than Love, campaigned by Joe Broderic's Newtown Anner Stud, drew a tricky post 10 for her Sept. 16 debut at Belmont, sat a three-wide trip and stayed on well for a fourth-place effort. She had a softer journey last time out Oct. 9 and parlayed that into a one-length success and a plane ride to the left coast. A stalking second as the seemingly outclassed Starship Flare sailed along up front, More Than Love rolled up and looked like she might run up the score leaving the quarter pole. The pacesetter dug in and looked to have stolen the race, but the favorite knuckled down and was just up. The winner was purchased in utero by Hugo Lascelles Bloodstock for \$300,000 at the 2008 Keeneland November sale.

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Best Shot Needed...

In order to succeed this afternoon, To Honor and Serve will likely need to uncork a career-best effort, though his current form is hard to fault. He crushed a field of Saratoga allowance horses by over eight lengths Aug. 26 and showed further improvement to best GI Belmont S. hero Ruler On Ice (Roman Ruler) by 2 1/4 lengths in the GII Pennsylvania Derby Sept. 24. That set him up for his run in the Classic, where he was part of the first flight and was within a length of the lead at the stretch call before finishing 3 1/2 lengths adrift of his stablemate Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) at just under 10-1. Barring a total disaster, To Honor and Serve will break the \$1-million mark in career earnings this afternoon.

Recovery Mission for Haynesfield...

Haynesfield (Speightstown) did everything in last year's Cigar Mile except win, as he was run down on the money by Jersey Town (Speightstown) while registering a career-best 111 Beyer Speed Figure. The 5-year-old has had an abbreviated campaign this season, finishing fourth as the odds-on favorite in the GIII Westchester S. Apr. 30 and fifth in the GI Met Mile May 30 before returning recently to take down the Empire Classic Oct. 22. "It would mean a lot for him to return to that [Grade I] level," said Toby Sheets, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen. "We are very fortunate that his owner [Turtle Bird Stable's Harvey Weinstein] has been so patient and is willing to give him the time."

Pletcher Tag-Team...

Trainer Todd Pletcher scratched both **Caixa Electronica** (Southern Image) and **Calibrachoa** (Arromanches) from Thursday's GIII Fall Highweight H. in favor of this tougher spot. The latter is perfect in a pair of starts in Ozone Park, with a win in the GIII Toboggan H. over the inner dirt last winter and last-out score in GIII Bold Ruler H. Nov. 6. He had **Sangaree** (Awesome Again) and former \$40,000 claimer Caixa Electronica behind in second and third that afternoon.

Angus Gold said the initial signs are positive for Sea The Stars. "I've been impressed by everything I've seen by the stallion, like most people," said Gold. "We've got five of our own Sea The Stars foals at home, and I don't think I've ever seen a better lot of foals by a first-season sire in terms of quality."

Gold added, "We tend to buy five or six foals each year, and this filly has a great temperament and was a bit of a no-brainer for a racing operation like ours."

Sea the Stars' owners, who trade as Sunderland Holding, paid 340,000gns for a colt by their European Horse of the Year out of Ripples Maid (GB) (Dansili {GB}) sold by Tweenhills Stud on behalf of Qatar Bloodstock. John Clarke saw off the likes of Hugo Merry, Ibrahim Araci, Chris Wood and Willie Browne for the colt.

"Ling and Christopher Tsui want to help the horse, and felt that if breeders were using him at stud, they should show their appreciation by buying some of his foals. Their purchases will go to Giltown Stud," said Clarke, who added the early commercial success of the Tsuis' champion is to be expected. "Sea the Stars was one of the all-time greats, if not the greatest racehorse. He has a fantastic physique and a wonderful pedigree. If you add it all together, then it's not a surprise that there is such interest in him."

David Redvers of Tweenhills Stud, which consigned the 340,000gns colt as [hip 939](#), was delighted with the result. "He was slightly unusual among the Sea the Stars foals here because he is from a speed family, and while he could be a Royal Ascot 2-year-old, it was hard for buyers to know where to place him," said Redvers. "I believe he will be trained by John Oxx, and I'd be surprised if he is not his first 2-year-old winner in 2013."

More Sea, More Stars...

Sea the Stars' prominence extended further Friday. James Wigan of London Thoroughbred Services paid 280,000gns for one of the sire's best-bred fillies in the sale, a three-parts sister to G1 Irish 1000 Guineas winner Nighttime (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). But Wigan said the sire did not influence his purchase.

"Obviously I like Sea the Stars, but it almost counted against this filly for me because I don't like buying unproven sires," said Wigan. "It was the fact that she was a sibling to a Classic winner that appealed. She was a very nice filly with a great page and has been bought to race."

One Sea the Stars foal who didn't find a new home was a half-brother to Group 1 winners Youmzain (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}) and Creachadoir (Ire) (King's Best). The colt, offered by the Castlebridge Consignment, was led out unsold at 590,000gns.

The pick of the foals by Sea the Stars' half-brother Galileo (Ire) was a 375,000gns full-brother to G3 Lillie Langtry S. winner Gravitation (GB) sold from Plantation Stud to Demi O'Byrne.

Charlie Gordon-Watson was underbidder on the colt, for whom Ibrahim Araci and Ed Sackville also made a play. The colt is a son of Guaranda (GB) (Acatenango {Ger}) and sold as [hip 799](#).

"This was a grand colt, and I'd imagine he'll be kept to race. I don't need to tell anybody about Galileo," said O'Byrne, whose purchase will run for the usual triumvirate of Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Sue Magnier.

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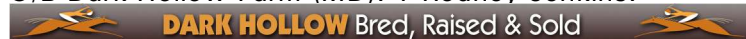

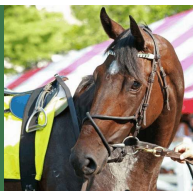

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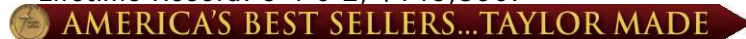
