

GEMOLOGIST POLISHES OFF WOOD

WinStar Farm's **Gemologist** (Tiznow) held off **Alpha** (Bernardini) to maintain his perfect record in the \$1-million GI Resorts World Casino New York City Wood Memorial S. at Aqueduct yesterday afternoon. "That's a great win, he's a great horse," said Elliott Walden, president of WinStar. "This stamps him as a Derby prospect, which we're excited about. We needed

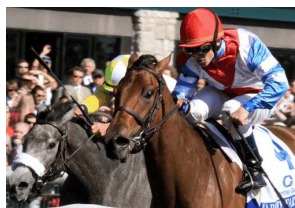

KARLOVY VARY SPRINGS ASHLAND UPSET

Two years ago, Alex G. Campbell Jr. watched as his homebred Dynaformer filly It's Tea Time just missed in the GI Ashland S. Fast forward to **Karlovy Vary** (Dynaformer), who made amends for Campbell by wiring yesterday's renewal of the \$500,000 event. "We had trained her on the Polytrack," said winning trainer Rusty Arnold. "She loved it, but never had the opportunity to run on it.

HOUSE SLIPPERS

It didn't take legendary trainer Gai Waterhouse too long following his debut win in the Listed Thoroughbred Breeders' Plate in October to anoint **Pierro** (Aus) (Lonhro {Aus}) as a leading chance to provide her a fourth winner in the G1 AAMI Golden Slipper S. "In the heat of the moment, you say things you probably shouldn't, but I knew that this was a special colt," Waterhouse told the assembled press after the attractive bay colt drove through underneath the pacesetting **Snitzerland** (Aus) (Snitzel {Aus}) inside the final half-furlong for a half-length victory. **Samaready** (Aus) (More Than Ready) was a bit slow to begin and finished well for third without threatening the top two. Winning rider Nash Rawiller, who was completing another Group 1 double on the card, was necessarily among the believers in Waterhouse's declaration, at least at first. "I shook my head and walked away. She's a genius," he told *AAP*. "He made his own luck today. He jumped well and it went through my mind early to lead, but there was a bit more pressure, so I was happy to sit off them. I knew if it came down to a dogfight, he was going to be too good. He's just such a talented colt." **Cont p7-8**

"So far, it would be hard to be unhappy with anything he's done so far his whole career," Pletcher added. "It was great to see. It looked like he had a little something left after the wire, so I think from a conditioning standpoint, with a good mile race and a good 1 1/8-mile race under our belt, hopefully we can have a good month of training leading up to it. When he came back, he wasn't blowing like an exhausted horse. I think his fitness level is pretty good. I think he can [get better]."

Runner-up Alpha also punched his ticket to Churchill.

"It was a good race and a good test, he did everything right except win," said trainer Kieran McLaughlin. "So, we'll make sure with [Godolphin Racing Manager] Simon Crisford that we're going on to May 5, but that's what we intend to do, and we've got the earnings now."

Gemologist's dam has a 2-year-old Bluegrass Cat filly named Catbird Seat. After producing a Colonel John colt last February, she was bred to Giant's Causeway.

I'll Have Another, second to Creative Cause in the GII
Best Pal S. at Del Mar, was put away following a sixth
in the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga. The
chestnut returned Feb. 4 in the GII Robert B. Lewis S.
at Santa Anita, and parlayed a stalking trip into a
winning effort worth a 96 Beyer Speed Figure. With
Holy Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) scratched in favor of
the Apr. 14 GI Toyota Blue Grass S., the Reddam
colorbearer broke alertly and settled in second as
longshot Blueskiesnrainbows set a fair pace up front.
Creative Cause came off the rail on the far turn and
took aim on the game frontrunner. They were three
abreast in midstretch, but I'll Have Another was going
just a bit better to edge the favorite in the shadow of
the wire. "This is so unbelievable," said winning rider
Mario Gutierrez. "He is such a good horse and he gave
me a big kick at the end." Creative Cause's trainer Mike
Harrington was pleased with his charge's effort. "I
thought the horse ran a helluva race," he said. "The
other horse beat us today, but will he beat us next
time? I don't know."

The winner's dam has a 2-year-old Tapit filly named
Gloria S, and was bred to Midnight Lute last spring.

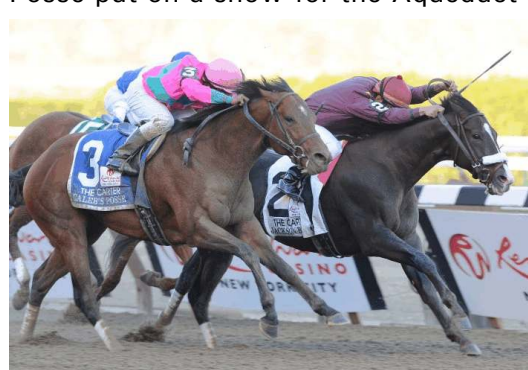

Florida-bred coming out on top. Third in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, Jackson Bend kicked off 2012 with a determined win in the GIII Hal's Hope S. at Gulfstream Jan. 14, and followed that

with a non-threatening third in the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 10. The Carter's complexion changed when Emcee (Unbridled's Song) broke awkwardly, then rushed up to challenge Shackleford. Jackson Bend, unhurried early, wound up his late run and wrested the lead from the GI Preakness S. hero. He was confronted by the rallying Caleb's Posse, but was saved by the wire. "When Caleb's Posse started coming at me...this horse has so much heart," said winning rider Corey Nakatani, who had four winners on the day. "It brings a tear to my eye. He's Mighty Mouse. He's so little, 15 hands, but he's got so much heart." Jackson Bend's next target will be the GI Met Mile at Belmont on Memorial Day. Aqueduct specialist Calibrachoa (Southern Image) was scratched Saturday morning due to a quarter crack.

Karlovy Vary, named for the spa town in the Czech Republic, was beaten less than a length in her career opener on the Saratoga sod last summer. After earning her diploma on the Keeneland infield Oct. 12, the bay was seventh in the GII Golden Rod S. on the dirt at Churchill Nov. 26, and closed out her juvenile campaign with troubled seventh in the Ginger Brew S. on the Gulfstream grass on Christmas Eve. She resurfaced with an optional-claiming success on that course Feb. 26 and posted a pair of good-looking breezes on this Polytrack ahead of her synthetic debut. Listed at 5-1 on the morning line, Karlovy Vary drifted up to 15-1 by the time the Ashland gates flew open, but showed the money was wrong this time. The sophomore set out in front and carved out splits of :48.97 and 1:13.78. Favored Stephanie's Kitten came under a ride and ranged up three wide turning for home, but Karlovy Vary shifted into gear, and dismissed a persistent bid from Hard Not to Like to gain her first black-type success. "She'll run in the Oaks if everything goes good," said winning trainer Rusty Arnold. "We still think she can run on the dirt. She had her one start on the dirt, had some things go wrong. We fixed those, and think we're ready now."

Karlovy Vary's dam The Right Pew broke her maiden for Alex Campbell after being purchased for \$230,000 at KEEJUL. She has a 2-year-old Medaglia d'Oro colt and a yearling Birdstone filly, and produced a Pleasantly Perfect filly Feb. 19.

Stephanie's Kitten is still on track for the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. "I thought she'd kick in but she didn't," said owner/breeder Ken Ramsey. "I'm a little disappointed. The goal is to go to Royal Ascot. We've been over there twice and run second both times, so I'd like to win one." Ramsey added, "We'll get another race in her at Churchill or Arlington or someplace, and if she goes forward, we're still going. But if I don't think I can run one-two-three, I would think about [not] going. We're not flying over to run second again."

Done Talking stamped himself as one to watch for 2012 after finishing fourth, beaten just a length, in the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct in his juvenile finale. The bay colt colicked afterwards, however, and wasn't quite ready for division heavyweights when he kicked off his season in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct Mar. 3. He never lifted the proverbial hoof and was 10th at every call, ultimately winding up 20 3/4 lengths behind champion Hansen (Tapit). With two sharp drills at his Laurel base in the interim, Done Talking made amends here. The Maryland shipper was content to race near the rear during the opening half, and patiently picked off rivals through the far turn. As favored Currency Swap (High Cotton) began to fade, second-choice Morgan's Guerilla looked like a winner when he surged to the front in midstretch, but Sheldon Russell got to work aboard Done Talking, and they flashed under the wire first. The \$300,000 winner's share of the purse will likely earn Done Talking a shot at the Run for the Roses. "You don't get a lot of chances to go to the Kentucky Derby," winning trainer Hamilton Smith told *Daily Racing Form*. Skeedattle is the nom de course of Robert White and Lou Rehak, both of whom reside in Clarksville, Maryland. They operate the Mid-Atlantic Door Group, an overhead door distribution company. Dixie Talking, the 2005 GIII Cicada S. winner, has a 2-year-old Midnight Lute filly and a yearling Old Fashioned colt. She was bred to Indian Charlie last spring.

With the withdrawal of Black Caviar's half-brother All Too Hard (Aus) (Casino Prince {Aus}), Pierro was firmly entrenched as the second favorite leading up to the Slipper and proved the value play. “I couldn't believe he wasn't favored,” Waterhouse admitted post-race.

Drawn on the fence, Pierro was away without incident and got a perfect position just behind the speed as Snitzerland, a last-out fourth to Samaready in the Mar. 24 G2 Reisling S., and Faustus (Aus) (More Than Ready) went at each other up front. The favorite had a bit of trouble at the start and drifted back to about midfield while forced to cover ground three wide. Snitzerland swatted away the pace pressure of Faustus and opened up a bit while drifting away a bit from the inside, allowing Pierro a clear shot at her. It looked like she may have had the race won with a furlong to the wire, but Pierro called on his class and determination and pegged her back in the final 70 meters. Samaready had no choice but to peel seven or eight paths wide into the stretch and finished willingly down the center, but could not bridge the gap late.

“I could see Jimmy [Cassidy aboard Faustus] coming across putting a bit more pressure on,” Rawiller explained. “I just wanted to sit there as long as I could and wait for it to happen. Corey [Brown, rider of runner-up Snitzerland] rolled off a few and it was just game over then. I was pretty confident a long way out. I was as confident as you would ever see me ride, I reckon.”

Darley bred Pierro from Miss Right Note (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}), a winner at Chantilly in France who continued her career in Australia with a Sydney handicap score from eight starts. Pierro was offered by his breeders at the 2010 Magic Millions National Weanling Sale, where he was sold for A\$115,000 as a pinhook prospect. Waterhouse signed the ticket at A\$230,000 on behalf of owners Greg and Donna Kolivos at last year's Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale. His dam produced a Lonhro filly Sept. 8.

Pierro descends from the Gerald Leigh family of Ghislaine (Icecapade), the dam of top miler Markofdistinction (GB) (Known Fact) and granddam of the good stayer Opinion Poll (Ire) (Halling).

Trinniberg is fast turning into an ace seven-furlong specialist. The dark bay colt came within 3/4 lengths over springing the 68-1 upset over Currency Swap (High Cotton) in the GI Hopeful S. at that distance last September at Saratoga before finishing second by the same margin in the 6 1/2-furlong GII Nashua S. at Belmont in early October. He was on the engine through a quarter in :20 4/5 in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint at Churchill Nov. 4, and understandably tired to seventh, but after a break bounced back with a wire-to-wire six-length score in the seven-furlong GIII Swale S. at Gulfstream Mar. 10. Taking advantage of his rail draw here, he was up to set comfortable :23.46, :47.41, and 1:11.50 splits and sailed home well clear as the slight favorite. "The performance was amazing," said winning owner Shivananda Parbhoo. "I knew he would go to the lead. He's the class of the race. [Jockey Willie Martinez] didn't even use him at all." Parbhoo has been plans for his emerging star. "The plans are the GI Preakness S., but let me see how good he comes out," he said. "There's a 15% chance for the GI Kentucky Derby. I want to go long. I wanted to do that [and run him in the Wood Memorial], but I don't think he was ready. I wanted to go to the New Orleans race [the GII Louisiana Derby], but I canceled 15 minutes before the race. Me and my pops [trainer Bisnath Parboo] are an amazing team." The father-and-son duo also campaign Grade I winner Giant Ryan (Freud).

She kept on finding more in the lane and was never seriously threatened by Welcome Guest. "I wanted to make a gradual stretch out, so we were pleased," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "[As for trying two turns], I don't know yet. We'll take her back to Palm Meadows tomorrow and see how she trains. She was kind enough today to step up to a mile. It's encouraging, but we'll just play it by ear and see. There are a lot of nice races like the GI Acorn [Belmont May 28], the GI Prioress [Saratoga Aug. 4], [and] the GI Test [Saratoga Aug. 25], so we have to think about it a little bit."

As Trevor Denman might say, Lady of Shamrock appeared to jump into the GIII Providencia S. at the quarter pole and unleashed a devastating turn of foot to take Mike Smith to within one win of 5,000. Fifth to Saturday's GI Ashland S. victress Karlovky Vary (Dynaformer) in a Oct. 12 maiden at Keeneland, the dark bay graduated by a head at Churchill Nov. 12 before being acquired privately by these connections. The Triple Crown nominee came from as many as 15 lengths back to take the Dec. 30 Blue Norther S., but was only third in her lone try on the main track in the GIII Santa Ysabel S. Jan. 28. Back to her preferred surface for her latest, she came from near the tail of the field to add the Mar. 10 China Doll S. and was odds-on here. Lady of Shamrock left from the one hole and ducked in a bit towards the gap past the temporary rail, but then switched off in last as Charm the Maker (Empire Maker) came to quicken them under the wire for the first time. Ms. Pianist (More Than Ready) charged up to pressure the pacesetter for the run up the backstretch, but Charm the Maker accelerated away approaching the quarter pole and set sail for the wire. She put a couple of lengths on the field, but Lady of Shamrock spied a gap one off the inside and burst through for a very impressive score. "This filly is really fun to ride because she has quite a turn of foot," said winning rider Mike Smith. "She's kind of a tall lanky filly, but she gets over the grass unbelievably." Winning trainer John Sadler added, "We thought we were running the best horse. She's obviously good on this course. What we'll try to do is have a nice campaign with her this summer and be back in the fall."

In the absence of Atlantic Jewel (Aus)--also a daughter of the increasingly popular and successful Fastnet Rock--Mosheen has become the leading middle-distance filly of here generation and did little to tarnish her reputation here at long odds-on. The reigning G1 Crown Oaks winner was upset in the G3 Vanity S. Feb. 18, but atoned for that loss in a big way by beating the colts in the G1 Australian Guineas at Flemington Mar. 3 and the G1 Randwick Guineas Mar. 17. Danny Nikolic sent Mosheen to the front and opened a bit of daylight down the far side of the course. She looked on her way to the easiest kind of victory, but gave her backers a scare as Nikolic allowed Streama to cut the winning margin down to a half-length. "I made her begin out of the barriers because I'd been pretty conservative the last couple of runs, dragging her back," Nikolic told AAP. "They sat off me for quite a while and just at the 600 [metres] I started to pick up the tempo like a track gallop. She got a little bit wayward up the straight." While the jockey is touting a run in next Saturday's G1 Australian Derby or the G1 AJC Oaks Apr. 21, trainer Robert Smerdon suggested he is more inclined to give the filly a break.

"I'm just sick over it. You wait your whole life for a horse like this and something like this happens. I thought he was the best sprinter in the country. We'll consider stem cell therapy, give him a year off, and see where he is then."

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Triple Threats

Hansen Breezes for Blue Grass

Champion **Hansen** (Tapit), winner of the GIII Gotham S. last out, breezed five-eighths in 1:00 at Churchill's Trackside Training Center yesterday ahead of his engagement in next week's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. The grey colt was joined in the stretch by stablemate La Gran Bailadora (Afleet Alex), and the two finished up together. "I don't want to hook him up with another horse early in his work to keep him from getting rank, so I just have a workmate jump in with him to start their work where he's finishing to get him to finish well," said trainer Mike Maker. "Before the Gotham, that's kind of how we were working him. So we're hoping to have a replay for the Blue Grass." Maker added, "I just hope we draw well at Keeneland. It looks like there's going to be a big field." Owners Dr. Kendall Hansen, Harvey Diamond and Jim Shircliff were on hand to watch the colt's drill. "I can hardly work," Hansen said. "It started two days ago when it was the fifth and it [the Derby] was exactly 30 days out. Something happened to my body. My nurses were telling me, 'Doc, your hands are shaking.' My hands never shake, but I've got a tremor now, and I think it's from adrenaline. So I'm staying away from Mountain Dew."

Three other Blue Grass candidates worked at Keeneland yesterday. Team Valor's **Howe Great** (Hat Trick {Jpn}) went five-eighths in 1:01.60 in company with stablemate Under Control (Brz). "It was a good work and went as well as it could have," said trainer Graham Motion. **Adirondack King** (Lawyer Ron) covered the same distance in :59.80, while **Politicallycorrect** (Kitten's Joy) earned a bullet for his breeze in :59 ([video](#)).

Reveron Dreaming of Derby Spot

Stipa Racing Stable's **Reveron** (Songandaprayer), second at 31-1 in the GI Florida Derby last weekend, will continue to target the GI Kentucky Derby May 5, although his connections concede that his current \$220,000 in graded earnings may not save him a spot in the starting gate. "We're going to work him three times leading up to the Derby, that's what we're preparing him for," trainer Agustin Bezara said through an interpreter. "But if he doesn't get in, then we'll work him again and go right to the Preakness. But we're getting him ready to run in the Derby; that's the goal. And he'll do all his prep work here at Calder."

"I can't worry about things I can not control," Bezara added. "Of course, I would love to run this horse in the Derby, but it's out of my hands now. And there is no way we would run him again looking for more [graded] money. So we'll prepare him for the Derby, and see what path destiny has chosen for us."

Top Pleases With Gallop...

Trainer Roger Charlton expressed his satisfaction with the racecourse gallop of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Top Offer (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) at Newbury this week. Khalid Abdullah's colt returned to the scene of his maiden score as he gears toward the May 5 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket and his conditioner said, "Top Offer went to Newbury and had a nice easy gallop with two lead horses down the back straight in the wrong direction and it was a good to get him away from home, having not run since August. We still have two weeks before the G3 Greenham S. [at Newbury Apr. 21], and he is progressing."

Flying Fish a 'Secret' No More...

Flying Fish principal Art Fisher has been breaking and training horses in the Ocala area for over two decades now--notably, he was employed by Loblolly Stable back 1990s--but it wasn't until four or five years ago that he started selling at the juvenile-in-training sales. Though Fisher's operation still flies a bit under the radar, that may change soon, especially if Flying Fish continues to turn out horses like ☆ **"TDN Rising Star" ☆ Secret Circle** (Eddington), the likely favorite for next Saturday's GI Arkansas Derby after wins in the GII Rebel S. and GIII Southwest S. this year in Hot Springs.

Flying Fish sold Secret Circle to Mike Pegram, Karl Watson, and Paul Weitman for \$165,000 at last year's OBS March Sale, and watched as the colt developed into a star under the care of trainer Bob Baffert. Secret Circle won his first two starts, including last October's Jack Goodman S. at Santa Anita, by a combined 12 1/2 lengths, then lived up to 2-5 favoritism with a victory in the inaugural running of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint S. Secret Circle lost his unbeaten record with a game half-length second to Out of Bounds (Discreet Cat) in the one-mile GIII Sham S. at Santa Anita Jan. 7--his route debut--but showed two turns was indeed in his wheelhouse with his wins in the one-mile Southwest Feb. 20 and 1 1/16-mile Rebel Mar. 17.

"It's been a lot of fun watching him," said the 52-year-old Fisher, a straight-talking horseman who's quick with a quip. "We enjoy watching them after we send them out. We work hard, and take a lot of pride in them."

The "we" is Fisher's family--wife Martha "Marty" Fisher, and sons Zack, 26, and Sam, 13. The Fishers are based in Belleview, Florida, not far from Ocala, and run a big 120-horse stable throughout the winter. The bulk of the horses there are broken for outside clients and sent directly to the track. Clients include My Meadowview Stable's Len Riggio, as well as Peter Willmott. It was Willmott who, in the fall of 2002, sent Fisher a strapping chestnut colt by Unbridled named Eddington. Trained by Mark Hennig, Eddington went on to bank over \$1.2 million, with his record including a win in the GI Pimlico Special and placings in the GI Preakness S. and GI Travers S.

"He was a big, beautiful horse," remembered Fisher. As it turns out, Fisher broke a diminutive Dixieland Band mare name Ragtime Hope a year later for Willmott and his brother Thomas. The filly was a stakes winner of over \$125,000 on the track, and when she was retired to Willmott's broodmare band, was sent to Eddington. The result was Secret Circle.

"The mare was this big"--Fisher holds his hand a few feet off the ground--"she's very small," he said. "Secret Circle himself is an average-sized horse, but he is a perfectly made horse."

Willmott initially offered Secret Circle at the 2010 Keeneland September Sale, but fell just shy of getting him sold, said Fisher.

"They had live money at \$15,000, and he bought him back for \$17,000 and sent him to me," reported Fisher. "He just got better, and better, and better as we trained him. When we started breezing him, I think he gained 50 pounds."

Willmott decided to take advantage of Fisher's new juvenile consignment--launched at the behest of several of Fisher's clients--

and at last year's OBS March Sale, Secret Circle breezed an eighth in :10 1/5. The work caught the eye of bloodstock agent Donato Lanni, who tipped off Baffert that Fisher's draft might have a hidden gem.

"Baffert came and looked at him five times," said Zack Fisher. His father added, "Before the sale, Baffert asked me what I thought he'd bring. I said the reserve's going to be \$50,000, but that I was going to bid \$100,000 on him myself. But we got run out, me and another [partner], and Baffert got him for \$165,000." Secret Circle has now won nearly \$820,000 and, with a win in the Arkansas Derby, would be one of the favorites heading into the GI Kentucky Derby May 5.

The big question all spring has been how far the Juvenile Sprint winner wants to go, despite a pedigree with plenty of stamina influences. "He always looked like a sprinter to me," Fisher said of Secret Circle. "He just worked so fast, and any time you worked him, he'd sleep for a day [after]--he'd give you his life in his works."

That said, Fisher said he isn't surprised Secret Circle has been able to stretch his speed. "His pedigree says long," Fisher said. "Plus, I was glad to see him rate last time [in the Rebel, when he rallied from fourth]. It looks like he turned himself off, then came back on in the final sixteenth."

Should Secret Circle go onto success on the Classic trail, he won't be the first horse hailing from Fisher's training center to do so. Nor will he be the first who used Oaklawn's preps as a springboard. Back in the early 1990s, Fisher broke the Danzig colt Pine Bluff for John Ed and Mary Lynn Anthony's Loblolly Stable. Winner of the GII Remsen S. at two, Pine Bluff came back to win the GIII Rebel S. and GII Arkansas Derby in before taking the GI Preakness S. in 1992.

Fisher also broke Pine Bluff's brilliant but unsound year-younger full-sister Angel Fever, who broke her maiden by 11 lengths on debut as a juvenile at Churchill before being retired after making just one more start. Angel Fever made up for the abbreviated race record, going on to acclaim as the dam of GI Kentucky Derby hero Fusaichi Pegasus (Mr. Prospector).

"She was a stone freak," said Fisher.

Fisher, who also has broken the likes of GISW Teaks North (Northern Fleet), hopes he has something of her ilk in its 2012 April draft, which numbers three after scratches. They include [hip 76](#), a New York-bred Harlan's Holiday filly who was produced by a half to MGSW Incurable Optimist (Cure The Blues); [hip 112](#), a Big Brown half-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up Beautician (Dehere); and [hip 136](#), a Mineshaft filly from the family of Flawlessly and Halo.

The Big Brown filly, who breezed an eighth in :10 1/5 despite jumping off leads repeatedly, could be the star of the group.

"We love her," said Zack Fisher. "She worked outstanding. She's got a big, long stride on her, and came back like she never did anything. I think she's a racehorse, and we've got high expectations for her."

Looking forward, Fisher insists he aims to cut down on the number of horses he breaks each year, a claim that prompts a collective groan from his family.

"Last month, he said he was going to cut back to 20 horses [next year]," said Sam Fisher. "Then it was 50, and now he's saying 70. Next month..."

Next month, of course, could change Fisher's life dramatically. But first thing's first: for the Fisher family, all eyes will be on Oaklawn next Saturday. -LM

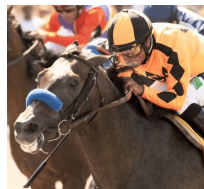
