complete runaway, powering home to a 9 1/2-length tour de force over fellow 'Rising Star' Secret Circle. **Sabercat** (Bluegrass Cat) was a neck back in third and a head in front of **Cozzetti** (Cozzene). "It was extremely impressive," said winning pilot Mike Smith. "You could see it as well as I could feel it...That [last] was eighth was something." **Cont. p4**

STRETCH 'DULL'

Donegal Racing's **Dullahan** (Even the Score) was moving like an express train in the Keeneland stretch to mow down front-running champion **Hansen** (Tapit) and stamp his ticket to the GI Kentucky Derby in

yesterday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Relaxed while saving ground early as the grey favorite opened up a clear lead through solid splits, last year's GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity hero looked like he would come up with too little, too late at the head of the lane when Hansen began to shake free from his rivals. But the hulking chestnut was just getting started, and he sliced through horses and found his best stride with the help of some furious right-handed urging from Kent Desormeaux to win by an

ultimately comfortable 1 1/4-length margin at 3-1. Longshot **Gung Ho** (Kitten's Joy) was third. "He did everything that a good horse has to do to win," said trainer Dale Romans of the victor. "When it's time to accelerate, [jockey Kent Desormeaux] had enough horse to split through. He gets the job done. He's just a special horse." The rider added, "He switched leads, and he just exploded. As soon as he straightened (turning for home), there was a hole. He ran through that and then he said, 'Now what I do?' And I asked him to keep going. He was very strong all the way to the wire." **Cont. p3**

Dullahan always seemed like he was capable of more early on in his career, finishing third as a maiden in Saratoga's grassy GII With Anticipation S. last September. That encouraging effort prompted his connections to try the Breeders' Futurity going a sixteenth shorter here in October, and the 17-1 chance earned his diploma the hard way with a rally from far back. Aggressively spotted in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile under the Twin Spires Nov. 5, Dullahan was far from disgraced as he showed late interest to be fourth, beaten six lengths by Hansen and Union Rags (Dixie Union). The chestnut was coming off a second-place effort behind **Howe Great** (Hat Trick {Jpn}) in Gulfstream's GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 11, and the lack of early pace he had in front of him that day had many pundits on his bandwagon to upset last year's 2-year-old champ here. **Cont. p4**

Saving ground early in 11th of 13 as Hansen posted six furlongs in a quick-but-willing 1:11.32, Dullahan encountered little traffic trouble when making his move, and got his final eighth in :11.80 seconds. As expected, Dullahan, a half-brother to 2009 Derby winner Mine That Bird (Birdstone), will head to Churchill for the May 5 Classic. Romans and Donegal have used the Blue Grass-to-Derby move with some success before--Paddy O'Prado (El Prado {Ire}) was second in the 2010 renewal of this event before finishing third in that year's Derby.

Owner Dr. Kendall Hansen said of his namesake and runner-up, "I know he broke really well, [but] I was kinda hoping he'd tuck in. He went about three or four lengths faster than he should have... But what's great is the last furlong he went about :12 2/5, and he finished strong. Dullahan was just sharp today. I heard Dale Romans loved him all week, so I wasn't surprised. We have another chance in three weeks."

Second behind subsequent GII San Vicente S. runner-up American Act (Quiet American) in his 5 1/2-furlong unveiling at Santa Anita Feb. 19, Bodemeister turned heads when he went to the lead and flew home to graduate by 9 1/2 lengths with a 101 Beyer Speed Figure going a mile in Arcadia Feb. 11. The Zayat colorbearer paired up that gaudy figure when giving GISW and GI Santa Anita Derby second-place finisher Creative Cause (Giant's Causeway) a run for his money in the Mar. 10 GII San Felipe S. and was shedding the blinkers here for the first time in his brief career.

Breaking out a bit from the widest stall, Bodemeister quickly recovered to grab a narrow lead over Stat (Unbridled's Song) while traveling in the two path around the first turn. He made things a bit tight for his pursuer as he angled in approaching the backstretch, and posted splits of :23.02, :46.55 and 1:11.36 while traveling sweetly. Bodemeister spurted away a bit nearing the top of the lane, and gave the packed house quite a show, seeming to pick up even more steam approaching the wire despite his early exertions. Stablemate Secret Circle, winner of a division of the GIII Southwest S. as well as the GII Rebel S. here, was a bit erratic in the lane, but righted the ship to complete the Baffert exacta.

"It's exciting to see a young horse develop like this," Baffert, who finished the Oaklawn meet with six wins from nine tries and 100% in the money, said of the winner. "Secret Circle ran a great race too. He's shipped in there three times and ran hard each time. That's pretty impressive." He added, "I told both riders that I didn't care what they did as long as they ran one-two. I let them each run their own race. Bodemeister really ran huge. It's a great feeling to run one-two in a million dollar race." Noting that Oaklawn is a forgiving surface, Baffert said he would wait to see how his runners exited their efforts before committing to the Kentucky Derby. **Cont. p5**

Bodemeister is the second foal from Untouched Talent, who captured the GIII Sorrento S. at Del Mar in 2006. She also finished second in both the GI Del Mar Debutante S. and GII Darley Alcibiades S. that season before selling for \$850,000 at FTKNOV. Bred to Unbridled's Song, the mare wound up going for \$1.2 million to Audley Farm at KEENOV in 2007. She has a Smart Strike yearling filly, and produced a

Tiznow filly Jan. 9. Untouched Talent was bred back to Unbridled's Song. Audley Farm, which was once the home of Triple Crown winner Sir Barton, was acquired in 1978 by German breeder Hubertus Liebrecht. It is still owned by his family.

Daisy Devine faced little resistance early and little resistance late as she increased her turf record to four-for-four and became a Grade I winner here. The \$5,500 KEESEP yearling, who took the GII Fair Grounds Oaks last March over eventual GI Kentucky Oaks runner-up St. John's River (Include), was seventh in the Oaks before a similarly disappointing effort when fifth at 1-2 in the GIII Iowa Oaks in June. After a well-beaten third-place run in the GII Indiana Oaks Oct. 1, conditioner Andrew McKeever switched his charge to the turf, and she promptly blew up the tote at 43-1 over this course and distance in the GIII Valley View S. Oct. 21. She was successful again in Fair Grounds's Pago Hop S. Nov. 26, and was coming off a 2 1/2-length success in the Mardi Gras H. Feb. 21 back in New Orleans.

Unmolested from the gate as none of her other five rivals seemed concerned with early position, Daisy Devine loped to the front and got over to the rail before hitting the first turn. She doled out glacial splits of :25.12, :50.78 and 1:15.35 and was still traveling sweetly as she entered the stretch with Bay to Bay in closest pursuit. It was as if the race had just commenced at the quarter pole, and positions remained largely unchanged in the run to the wire. Most notably were the off-the-board finishes of Grade I winners Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune) and Aruna (Mr. Greeley)--both tried to make up ground from the back of the pack, but their tactical disadvantages proved too much to overcome.

"I was reasonably confident, but I respected the competition," offered McKeever.

"She's just a good horse. Good horses do everything for you." Pilot James Graham added, "She's just a bigger, stronger filly this year. She does anything you want her to do." When asked how he confident he felt turning for home after setting such comfortable fractions, the Irish expat said, "I had no doubt whatsoever."

Unsurprisingly, the connections of the favorites cited the lack of pace as their respective undoings. "Too far back. That's all I'm going to say," said Chad Brown, Zagora's conditioner. Aruna's trainer Graham Motion elaborated on the same notion: "The lack of pace really hurt her race. I think she ran her race, but for those kind of fillies to go that pace--they're much better than that. They weren't going to come back to her. She prefers to [come from behind]. It was just a paceless race, which was kind of what I was afraid of."

Caixa Eletronica has proven quite the astute claim since these connections grabbed him for \$62,500 out of a winning effort at Gulfstream last March. He resurfaced at Belmont the following month to romp in the GIII Westchester S. and finished third in the GI Metropolitan H. back at Big Sandy in May. The chestnut had added three more wins and one more Grade I placing since then, but was looking to bounce back from a sixth-place finish in Laurel's GII General George H. Feb. 20. Trying this distance for just the second time in his lengthy career--the first resulted in a starter allowance tally at Saratoga in August--Caixa Eletronica took up a stalking spot in between horses as the diverse group traveled through fairly lively splits. Rider Javier Castellano began getting into the 7-year-old in earnest on the final turn as defending champion Duke of Mischief tried to duplicate last year's running with a wide, early move. That foe opened up at the head of the lane, but Caixa Eletronica wasn't far behind and he quickly kicked to the front and clear. Mister Marti Gras ran on late to be third after being left with too much to do. "I really liked the horse today," said Castellano. "The question mark was the mile and an eighth, but I don't think it's a question mark anymore. He responded so well and I'm very satisfied with the way he did it."

"That was very exciting and it's always encouraging to see these fillies when they come back from their 3-year-old year into their 4-year-old year," Darley USA President Jimmy Bell commented. "She's blossomed, she's grown up, she's given us the indication of being a little more professional each and every time over there. There are some pretty quick fillies in this race and that certainly was a racehorse time from start to finish. It's just great to seeing her happy, healthy and really interested in doing what she does best. This is another good step forward." It's Tricky will return to the routing game in Belmont's GI Ogden Phipps at Belmont Park May 28. "We're going to want to run her longer next time, for sure," assistant trainer Art Magnuson confirmed. "I think she couldn't keep up at the three-eighths pole and he wanted her not to fall behind. When he did hit her, you're wondering all that kind of stuff, but in the end it doesn't matter anymore. It was a good run, good run."

He angled out widest of all at the top of the lane, and nobody could hold off his powerful late kick. "I think the seven-eighths [of a mile distance] probably suits him more than the five-eighths," said trainer Mike Maker. "Last time he got hung out pretty wide and still ran a credible race." Rider Joel Rosario added, "I thought they were going a little quick early. This horse likes to make one move. When I asked him, he just takes off, so that was great."

Outta Tune was haltered by current connections for just \$5,000 at Prairie Meadows last July and was running in \$7,500 claimers just seven months ago, but continued his upward trajectory here with a career-best score. "We went through a lot to get where we are today," said Richard. "We knew he was a nice horse at three and four. He deserves all the credit today."

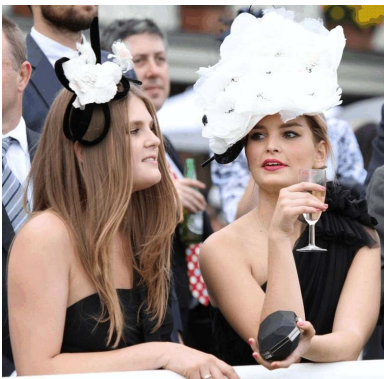

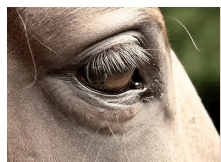

Following an announcement on *BBC Racing* that the brilliant 4-year-old would not race again, Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe stepped in to quash the hearsay. "He certainly hasn't been retired," he said. "I spoke to Henry [Cecil] today and no decision will be taken after this scan which will be done next week. It is incorrect to think that he has been retired and it's too early to talk about that. None of these things are straightforward, but I'm led to believe the scan will be definitive and if there isn't a problem, I would be very hopeful he will resume training. At this stage I'd like to remain positive and hopeful."

NEPTUNE WINS NATIONAL THRILLER

Yesterday's Grand National was won by John Hales's 11-year-old **Neptune Collonges (Fr)** (Dom Alco {Fr}), who nosed out **Sunnyhillboy (Ire)** (Old Vic {GB}) in a pulsating finish to the world's most famous steeplechase. In a renewal of the Aintree marathon marred by the deaths of the recent Cheltenham Gold Cup winner Synchronised (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and also to According To Pete (GB) (Accordion {Ire}), the grey provided trainer Paul Nicholls' with a first edition of the race at 33-1. Making ground steadily from rear during the first circuit, the stable companion of the famed Kauto Star (Ire) and Big Buck's (Fr) kept finding for jockey Daryl Jacob after the last fence to wrest the contest from J P McManus's Sunnyhillboy on the line. **Seabass (Ire)** (Turtle Island {Ire}), who was sent off the 8-1 joint favorite, was five lengths back in third under Katie Walsh, who had looked for a period off the home turn as if she was to make history as the first female jockey to win the race. "He's probably the best horse we've run in the race," Nicholls said of the winner, who recorded the shortest winning margin in the history of the contest and whose retirement was immediately announced. "He's got great form--he's been placed in Gold Cups, he stays, he's genuine and Daryl gave him a fantastic ride. Any good race would do, but this is the race we wanted." The death of such a high-profile chaser as the J P McManus-owned Synchronised, who was euthanized after breaking a hind leg, is certain to attract even greater scrutiny to the race which also saw two equine fatalities 12 months ago. Representing the British Horseracing Authority, Tim Morris said, "We are very sad about the fatal injuries suffered by Synchronised and According To Pete in the Grand National. In both cases, the horse incurred a fracture to the leg and the humane option was to put the injured horses down." Aintree's Managing Director Julian Thick added, "Safety is the first priority for the organisers of the Grand National and we make every effort to ensure that everyone involved in the event is able to participate in safety. After today, we will, as always, be looking at all aspects of this year's race to see how we can improve safety further."

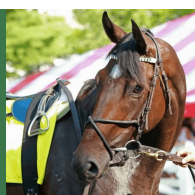

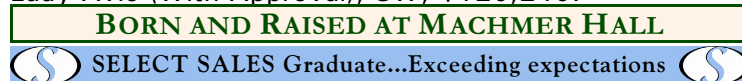
