A PERFECT TEN

Noises from the Southern Hemisphere have recently questioned whether **Frankel** (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) is indeed the world's best, but the Juddmonte juggernaut's reply came across loud and clear yesterday as he went 10-for-10 in his own incredible fashion in Newbury's G1 Lockinge S. Despite a well-documented setback in training last month and a race-hardened **Excelebration** (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) lining up to expose any resulting flaw, Khalid Abdullah's legend-in-the-making simply continued where he left off with another monstrous performance. Sent off the 2-7 favorite, the unbeaten star followed his 3/4-brother **Bullet Train** (GB) (Sadler's Wells) as he would on the Newmarket slopes and, when asked to go on with a quarter mile remaining, stretched out in customary style to wallop his old adversary Excelebration once again by five lengths. "He belongs to racing at the moment," jockey Tom Queally. "He's filled out and is the real deal now."

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Precociousness...

Despite a long-winded pedigree, top and bottom, I'll Have Another led past every pole to register a 3/4-length debut victory at Hollywood last July 3, then had the misfortune of running into the big-figure maiden winner Creative Cause in the GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar Aug. 7 and dropped a 1 3/4-length decision while finishing runner-up. Attempting to strike while the iron was hot, connections sent the chestnut colt cross-country for the GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga Sept. 5, but little went right, as he caught a sloppy and sealed track, was off the track entering the final half-mile and struggled home a distant sixth in what would mark a frustrating end to a season that began with such promise.

Plan B Works Just Fine...

Owner Paul Reddam and trainer Doug O'Neill were eyeballing a down-the-hill allowance for I'll Have Another's seasonal return, but the colt was reportedly doing so well that the decision was made to try him in the Feb. 4 GII Robert B. Lewis S. instead. Dismissed at 43-1 in that seasonal return, and ridden for the first time by Mario Gutierrez, he stormed by to score by 2 3/4 lengths and was pointed for a start in the GI Santa Anita Derby. A 4-1 chance to favored Creative Cause, I'll Have Another fought his way to a nose victory and a trip to Churchill Downs. Drawn in the parking lot and let go at 15-1 given all he had to overcome, he was able to save ground into the clubhouse turn, came out in upper stretch and outfinished Bodemeister, who was forced to set a wicked pace, for the upset.

Another Flawless Performance...

Bodemeister, favored in the rematch at 17-10, won the break and made the lead passing the stands for the first time, while--somewhat surprisingly--Creative Cause emerged as the nearest pace presence. I'll Have Another jumped fairly and was handy enough while racing in about the three path, but was nudged out a bit wider by **Went the Day Well** (Proud Citizen) approaching the clubhouse turn. The Team Valor runner backed off a bit, and that allowed Gutierrez to tuck into a three-wide spot around the turn and into the backstretch. Back on the front end, Bodemeister and Mike Smith were coasting along through an opening half-mile in :47.68, not taxing on paper, but perhaps an above-par pace over a dull strip. Creative Cause was in good striking position from second, while I'll Have Another was three wide, but covered up behind his grey fellow Californian.

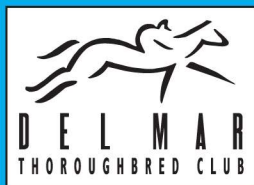
Bodemeister was still going smartly on the engine at the three-eighths marker, and Gutierrez seemed to have a few seconds of hesitation as he tried

to decide whether to go inside or outside of Creative Cause. He remained off that one's heels to the quarter pole, was switched out thereafter and was a bit clumsy in switching his leads. It looked for a few strides as if I'll Have Another might have work to do to catch the free-wheeling Bodemeister, but he continued to plug away with dour determination, took aim on the Baffert runner entering the final half-furlong and pegged him back in the final two strides. Creative Cause finished third, though nearly nine lengths off the top two. The winning rider admitted to expecting a dogfight in the waning stages. "I knew it was going to be a little bit of a tough race," he said. "But I'll Have Another had a tremendous kick in the end. So I could feel my horse racing ground and everything was definitely the way. So it's a great feeling when you're riding a horse that's giving you a hundred percent. He's an amazing horse."

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O'Neill Living In the Moment...

For every trainer who has not excelled under the Triple Crown spotlight, there is a Doug O'Neill. His lead-up to yesterday's Preakness included throwing out the first pitch prior to the Orioles-Yankees game at nearby Camden Yards and various public appearances. In fact, O'Neill took time out on national television in the winner's enclosure, to call out the first names of at least a dozen people, most likely young people, whose acquaintance he had made during his time in the city. Much maligned, O'Neill is clearly cut from a different mold and has flourished in the aftermath of the Derby. He was very much at ease after finally making his way to the post-Preakness press gathering.

Q: Your wife is known for being allergic to horses. Is she allergic to I'll Have Another?

A: It's amazing. The large checks seem to keep her from itching and coughing.

And what about the next three weeks. Certainly the intensity and pressure will be on the rise. Are you looking forward to it?

"I am. I'm excited," he said. "I'm surrounded by so many fun people. Just having fun with them. That is kind of doing our thing around the barn. We work hard and take good care of the horses. When injuries come up, we just regroup, take care of them, and we just have a really good atmosphere in the barn. That helps us have time to keep everything very loose for me and the horses and the staff."

So, look out NYC. Team O'Neill is on their way.

No Disgrace in Defeat for Bodemeister...

The camera caught trainer Bob Baffert a few seconds after Bodemeister had gotten run down in the final strides of the Preakness. "He ran his race," one could read on his lips. So, with newfound appreciation for

life, the silver-haired conditioner was more or less philosophical about his runner-up effort. "I felt really good about where he was," Baffert explained. "He looked like he was traveling nicely down the backside and coming to the three-eighths pole, he just sat on him. The fractions were more reasonable today, so turning for

home I really thought he was going to do it. He just got a little late there at the end. The winner's a good horse. It was a good horse race. I really can't complain. We didn't win it, but my horse ran his race. "The winner's a good horse. He'll get the respect now that he deserves. The California horses are really tough. They ran 1-2-3. I'm proud that as a trainer my horse showed up and he ran his race. He just got beat."



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Preakness 2012 By the Numbers...

Saturday's Preakness was witnessed by a record Pimlico crowd of 121,309, slightly better than the 121,263 that passed through the gates for the 2005 renewal. That attendance number included InfieldFest partygoers who were treated to music from a half-dozen bands, including Wiz Khalifa and Maroon 5. There was also a National Volleyball League tournament. The 13-race program generated all-sources handle of \$80,463,005. "The numbers say it all. We had a tremendous event," Maryland Jockey Club president Tom Chuckas said. "We knew in 2009 when we changed the landscape of the infield it would take three or four years to get to where we needed to get, and we are back. The crowd out there now is in the 21-35 group. They're here to have a good time, not to cause mayhem. First-rate entertainment and world class racing is a winning combination."

Newbury was the venue at which Frankel's 3-year-old career was launched, and the little-known Excelebration got his first taste of chasing him in vain during the G3 Greenham S. The pair met on two further occasions and, although the latter got closer to him in the G1 St James's Palace S., the order was always the same. That Royal Ascot contest seemed to expose a weakness in Khalid Abdullah's colt, as he appeared to tread water late on there, but any doubts were dispelled by commanding performances in Goodwood's G1 Sussex S. in July and the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. on Ascot's Champions' Day. Not long after he had caused untold stress to connections when striking into himself on the gallops, Frankel was giving all a reminder of his prowess in a public exercise on 2000 Guineas day, and had reportedly done even better when taken back to Newmarket's circuit last Saturday.

Tom Queally was full of confidence entering this high-profile return and, although he had a bullseye on his back with Joseph O'Brien settling Excelebration on his heels, the most-envied jockey in the Northern Hemisphere was only watching Bullet Train ahead. Moving into pole position with a quarter mile remaining, the combination were soon extending the margin between them and Ballydoyle's challenger without any recourse to the whip. "It's a great relief he's come back and great to be on board," Queally said. "He showed that burst of acceleration and is not like anything I've ever sat on or ever will do. He has grown up from last year and is thicker-set. He's a great horse." Frankel's next options are the June 19 G1 Queen Anne S. over a mile or a first try at 10 furlongs in the following day's G1 Prince of Wales's S. and, while no decision has been made at this point, his trainer strongly suggested that the former will be his target at the Royal meeting. "It hasn't been straightforward with 10 days off, but the team have got him through it and done exactly what I wanted them to do, so I want to thank them," a typically emotional and humble Sir Henry Cecil said.

"He's always taken a hold, but he quickens so well and his first race is never his best. He always improves for a race and has had a very good blow afterwards. He's done everything right and in every sport a champion is needed, so it's good for racing. We'll take it step-by-step and he's in the two races at Ascot, so we'll feel our way. The Prince is amazing and leaves it to me. I don't want him to run over a mile and a quarter until he's ready for it, and so the mile is more likely at Ascot. If we stick to a mile there, he may be ready to step up in August or September. Time will tell."

Hudson Steele had logged just six starts over the course of his 3- and 4-year-old seasons, finishing second--via disqualification--in the Oliver S. at Indiana Downs ahead of a victory in the Jersey Derby. He faced the starter but twice in 2011, for a good-looking score over some stakes-tested rivals in a third-level allowance over the Gulfstream turf in April, and was shelved off a neck defeat at the hands of Straight Story (Giant's Causeway) in Belmont's GIII Fort Marcy S. the next month. Gone nine days short of a full year off that effort, Hudson Steele returned to action in this track's Henry S. Clark S. Apr. 28, rallying from third to score as the 2-1 favorite, with Humble and Hungry back in fourth in his seasonal debut. Tucked away in about fourth position as Straight Story doled out reasonable splits up front, Hudson Steele bided his time around the turn and waited for that pacesetter to come back to him. He did just that entering the stretch, and Javier Castellano took full advantage, collaring him at the three-sixteenths pole before going on to a clear-cut victory. Humble and Hungry followed the move of the eventual winner while saving ground for most of the opening seven furlongs and stayed on well into second.

Roxy Gap, winner of the six-furlong GIII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream in early 2011, added the restricted Fury S. over seven panels on the main at Woodbine before an off-the-board effort when trying nine furlongs in Woodbine Oaks against fellow Ontario-breds in June. She ended her sophomore campaign with a runner-up finish in the restricted Ontario Damsel S. over the Woodbine sod July 9 and resurfaced with a third in a \$62,500 optional claimer going five furlongs over the Gulfstream turf course Mar. 14, but got up in time to eke out a narrow score in the GIII Whimsical S. Apr. 22. Settled in a stalking third through a half mile in :46.06, Roxy Gap poked her head in front midstretch and drew clear to post the easy victory. "She was relaxed," said winning rider Patrick Husbands. "Last time, when I was on the outside, she was aggressive. This time, on the inside, she was the boss today."

"[The connections] told me the race today was kind of far him, so the key was to get perfect timing," said winning rider Florent Geroux. "He broke pretty sharp and we stayed just behind the first flight. I didn't want to go five wide the whole way, so I took him inside on the turn to try to save ground. I had enough horse in the turn, but I didn't want to make the lead too soon. The mile is about as far as he can go. I tried to have good timing to get there."

Coach [Lukas] wanted me to be just off them like we were. It enabled him to run his best race. He ran a tremendous race." Hamazing Destiny's score marked the first graded stakes victory for the trainer since Dublin (Afleet Alex) took the GI Hopeful S. in 2009. "He was favorite and he ran like it," said Lukas. "The horse liked the track"

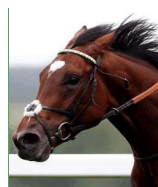

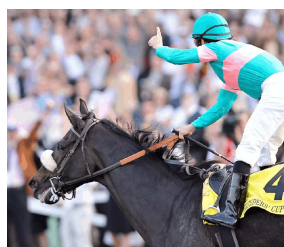
