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PARISH NOTICE

Jim Bolger has one omission from his list of big-race successes and will be hoping that **Parish Hall (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) can put it right by providing a belated first victory in today's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas at The Curragh. New Approach (Ire) appeared poised to bring the trophy home to Coolcullen four years ago only to be denied by Henrythenavigator, while Parish Hall's sire would have been a leading player had he the chance to flaunt his wares at three. Parish Hall has already posted the kind of top-level form required when beating the re-opposing **Power (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G1 Dewhurst S. when last seen at Newmarket in October, with another chief rival

Trumpet Major (Ire) (Arakan) back in fifth. That effort represented a marked improvement on past form, despite a solid second in the G2 Futurity S. here in August, and the ground has come right for him here. His owner, breeder and trainer is reflecting the pressure by keeping one eye on next Saturday's Derby. "I think he is good enough to win a Classic," he told *PA Sport*. "He will really come into his own when he gets 10 furlongs and a mile and a half. I shouldn't have huge

expectations, but he is already a Group 1 winner. I hope he can build on Saturday's run. I am very keen to get him to Epsom--if I thought the horse was well, I'd give it a go." **Cont. p3**

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SIX IN THE CITY

A small but select group of six has been assembled for Monday's GI Metropolitan H. at Belmont, with no fewer than four Grade I winners lining up in the Memorial Day feature. It's anyone's guess who will leave the gate as the favorite, but there's a good chance it will be last year's GI Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile hero **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini). In his 2012 return to the races, the Live Oak homebred soundly defeated Boys at Toscanova (Officer) in the one-mile GIII Westchester S. at Belmont Apr. 28. "He's had two good works [since] and seems to be looking pretty good," said his Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott. "It looks like it's a good race coming up. Nice horses here, without a doubt." That was a sentiment echoed by nearly all the horses' conditioners, including Dale Romans, who sends out last year's GI Preakness S. winner--and last-out GII Churchill Downs S. winner--**Shackleford** (Forestry). "[The Met Mile] has quality horses, and I'm proud to be part of it," he said. "I wouldn't be surprised if we see a champion come out of this race." To Honor and Serve drew the rail for the Met Mile, followed by Shackleford, **Caleb's Posse** (Posse), **Saginaw** (Peruvian), **Caixa Electronica** (Arromanches) and **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil). **Field p11**

Major Claims...

Richard Hannon has won this Classic three times, including with Canford Cliffs (Ire) (Tagula {Ire}) two years ago, and John Manley's Trumpet Major is certain to factor on his most recent form. After defying a three-pound penalty to win Newmarket's G3 Craven S. by five lengths Apr. 19, he was aggressively ridden before fading into fourth on an easy surface in the May 5 G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket. "We have always thought Trumpet Major was a good-ground horse," his conditioner commented. "He got away with soft ground in the Craven S., but Hughesie felt that similar conditions in the Guineas at Newmarket blunted his speed so in the circumstances he ran a stormer to finish fourth having looked the winner in the 'Dip.' He did a nice piece of work with Hughesie at Everleigh on Tuesday and, though it again looks very competitive, we have no Camelot to worry about. With the ground having dried up, he'll hopefully be right there again at the finish." Aidan O'Brien, who is bidding for a remarkable eighth renewal, saddles four headed by last year's G1 National S. and G2 Coventry S. hero Power.

The ☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆ was well-supported but ultimately beaten out of sight in Newmarket's G1 2000 Guineas three weeks ago, but jockey Joseph O'Brien expects major improvement. "There were a couple of things in Newmarket that didn't go 100% for him, but we've been happy with him at home since and hopefully he'll step up on that first run," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "On last year's form, he probably has some of the best form in the race. He's a Group 1 winner and was a bit unlucky behind Parish Hall in the Dewhurst, so hopefully he can run a big race." Michael Tabor is also represented by the Mar. 31 G2 UAE Derby scorer **Daddy Long Legs** (Scat Daddy), who was pulled up in the Kentucky Derby but who boasts an impressive record on turf or Tapeta, while Susan Magnier's **Wrote (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) drops back to a mile having looked a dubious stayer when third in the 10-furlong G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial at Leopardstown May 13. He was third from an unfavorably wide draw in the UAE Derby and there is a feeling that last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf hero has yet to show his best form.

Reply (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) makes up the quartet, and he is not far off the main players on his latest third in the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket in October. "I definitely wouldn't write off any of the horses," Joseph O'Brien warned. "We have four in it and I think they all have a big shout." One from under the radar is His Highness The Aga Khan's **Takar (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}), who booked his ticket with a win in the Listed Tetrarch S. over seven furlongs here May 7. Trainer John Oxx commented, "He's done little wrong and we need to know what his level is. The ground was heavy and not nice at all last time, but he quickened up very well despite not having the action of a soft-ground specialist. It wasn't a vintage Tetrarch S., but he'd had a setback in February and missed some time so I thought he did well to win that day. He travels well, has a good turn of foot and we think he'll be suited by fast ground. His dam got a mile and a quarter quite well, so I don't think there will be a problem with the trip."

SEVEN FACE THE QUEEN

Susan Magnier's runaway G1 1000 Guineas heroine **Homecoming Queen (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) faces only seven rivals as she bids to complete a Classic double in tomorrow's G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. Partnered by Ryan Moore at Newmarket, the nine-length Newmarket heroine now has Joseph O'Brien on board as she lines up in the smallest field since past Ballydoyle luminary Yesterday (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) upset Six Perfections (Fr) (Celtic Swing {GB}) in 2003. Moore switches to the May 13 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches fourth **After (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who along with Ann Marie O'Brien's May 7 G3 Athasi S. third **Ishvana (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) makes up a three-pronged attack on the Classic by the Rosegreen establishment. **Cont. p6**

Heading the opposition to the Ballydoyle machine is the quietly progressive **Yellow Rosebud (Ire)** (Jeremy), who hails from the Dermot Weld stable successful four times in total and twice since 2006. Highly tried at two, Dr. Ronan Lambe's representative came back to win Leopardstown's G3 Derrinstown Stud 1,000 Guineas Trial over a mile last time May 13. Jockey Pat Smullen is hoping for a bold show, despite the ominous presence of Homecoming Queen. "She's not done a lot wrong so far in her career and we can't ask for a lot more, so I think she'll run a huge race on Sunday," he said. "She goes there with a fighting chance, and I just hope the ground doesn't get too quick, as she appreciates a little ease." US-based interests are represented by Martin Schwartz's 2011 G1 Fillies' Mile runner-up **Samitar (GB)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) and Betty Maxwell Moran's **Princess Sinead (Ire)** (Jeremy). Both have to bounce back from unplaced efforts on their latest starts, with the Mick Channon-trained Samitar only ninth in the Poule d'Essai des Poulaches and the Jessica Harrington-trained Princess Sinead last of 10 behind Yellow Rosebud at Leopardstown.

CALL COLLECT

Admirably consistent and still progressing, Scuderia Effeve's **Cherry Collect (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}) already has a domestic Classic in the bag and she bids for another today when tackling the G2 Oaks d'Italia at the San Siro. While her stamina for this 11-furlong test has to be taken on trust, her strong finish at the end of the mile of the Capannelle's Apr. 29 G3 Premio Regina Elena bodes well. One who is more likely to relish this trip is Scuderia Blueberry's 2011 G1 Gran Criterium runner-up Rosa **Eglanteria (GB)** (Nayef), but she lacks a seasonal outing unlike the same connections' **Dan Loose Daughter (GB)** (Sakhee) who won by four lengths in the Listed Premio Baggio over 10 furlongs here last time May 6. Sunday's G2 Derby Italiano success of Feuerblitz (Ger) (Big Shuffle) showed the potency of the German challenge in these contests and Gestut Rottgen's **Wilddrossel (Ger)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) was one place behind that colt when third to Black Arrow (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) in Hanover's Listed Derby Trial over this trip last time Apr. 29.

MORE (HOPEFULLY FIRM) GROUND FOR ARUNA

Flaxman Holdings's **Aruna** (Mr. Greeley) will stretch out and hope the weather cooperates for Saturday's GII Sheepshead Bay S. at Belmont Park. Scratched from the May 5 GII Distaff Turf Mile S. when the Churchill Downs course came up less-than-firm, last term's GI Spinster S. winner was last seen finishing sixth in a paceless renewal of the 8 1/2-furlong GI Jenny Wiley S. at Keeneland Apr. 14 in her first start of 2012. "Her first race was paceless and where she finished wasn't a sign of how she was doing," offered trainer Graham Motion. "I'm not going to hold it against her. She was plenty fit, but she was taken out of her element." This will be Aruna's second try at the 1 3/8-mile distance--she finished a close-up fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf last November, closing well despite being a bit rank. "She handled the distance in the Breeders' Cup but had an unlucky trip, and [longer races] are the direction we're probably going to end up going," said Motion. The conditioner said he would consider scratching Aruna again if the turf course came up soft--Belmont was off the turf Friday, but not much precipitation was in the forecast Friday night into Saturday. Among Aruna's main competitors are **Hit It Rich** (Smart Strike) and **"TDN Rising Star"** **Aqsaam** (Dynaformer), who finished one-two, separated by a half-length, in the oddly run GIII Orchid S. at Gulfstream Mar. 31. Aqsaam opened as many as 12 lengths early on stalking Hit It Rich in that event, only to succumb late in a game effort. Juddmonte's **Principal Role** (Empire Maker) could also have a say in the outcome. Last year's G1 Nassau S. third-place finisher was a late-on-the-scene third in the local GIII Beaugay S. May 5 at 1 1/16 miles in her stateside debut for Bill Mott, but she did her best running in Europe last term for Sir Henry Cecil at 1 1/4 miles. "I ran her in the Beaugay because I had no other place to run with more distance," explained Mott. "She was ready at the end of April, and I couldn't find a race, so I used the Beaugay to get started. She's run quite a number of races at 10 furlongs, and she seemed to handle it OK. It could be the difference with her style."

MR. COMMONS FACES TEN IN AMERICAN

St George Farm Racing's **Mr. Commons** (Artie Schiller) looms an imposing and deserving favorite in Betfair Hollywood Park's GII American H. today, but the 122-pound highweight must navigate through a minefield of 10 other foes if he's to bounce back from a neck upset in Santa Anita's GI Kilroe Mile last time Mar. 3. The bay came into that last run off back-to-back scores in the Dec. 26 GIII Sir Beaufort S. and Feb. 4 GII Arcadia S. at this distance, but he was out-kicked by Arcadia runner-up Willconker (Ire) (Pyrus), and went down at 4-5. The presence of the likes of **Compari** (Redattore {Brz})--third in the Kilroe--as well as **Barney Rebel** (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) and **Liberian Freight** (Bertrando) should provide plenty of pace to set up the favorite's late kick. Should the chalk falter, **Venomous** (GB) (Red Ransom) could spring the upset if he returns to his best form. The bay kept top company in France last year before coming with a huge, but late, run to finish second in the GII Oak Tree Derby in October behind Ultimate Eagle (Mizzen Mast). He was fifth in both the GI Hollywood Derby and Sir Beaufort to finish off 2011, but worked a near-bullet in :59 3/5 over the all-weather here May 18 in preparation for his 4-year-old bow. **Cont. p9**

THE WAITING GAME

Today's G2 Temple S. at Haydock sees the return of Khalid Abdullah's **Bated Breath (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who has been runner-up in three Group 1 races so far in which he was beaten less than a length in total. Connections are hoping that an elusive win at that level will come this term, but first the homebred has to make the most of this opportunity on his first start since finishing eighth in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. Trainer Roger Charlton is hoping that last year's G1 July Cup, G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and G1 Nearctic S. second can open his Pattern-race account here. "The ground will be good and fast, so I can't make any excuses there," he told *PA Sport*. "He looks terrifically well and I think he's fit enough. Although he's never won over five furlongs, he's got plenty of speed." Among his rivals is last year's winner **Sole Power (GB)** (Kyllachy {GB}), who beat all bar the top Australian mare Ortensia (Aus) (Testa Rossa {Aus}) in the G1 Al Quoz Sprint over this trip at Meydan Mar. 31 and trainer Eddie Lynam is in bullish mood. "Everything's gone very well and he's taken everything in his stride," he told *PA Sport*. "His work has gone well since Dubai and he's trained on nicely." Sole Power was beaten a nose and a short neck when third behind **Tangerine Trees (GB)** (Mind Games {GB}) in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp on Arc day and that rival has to carry a four-pound penalty as a result, while the 3-year-old representation is headed by Robert Barnett's **Best Terms (GB)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}). Last year's G2 Queen Mary S. and G2 Lowther S. winner failed to stay seven furlongs when fifth in Newbury's G3 Fred Darling S. Apr. 21 and seventh on the Polytrack in Lingfield's G3 Chartwell Fillies' S. May 12 and reverts to the minimum trip. "Best Terms ran much better at Lingfield than she had done in the Fred Darling at Newbury, but it was clear that seven furlongs is beyond her so we are coming back sprinting," trainer Richard Hannon commented. "She has to take on the older horses, but there are no other options and we know that she has the speed for this." **Field p10**

Khalid Abdullah's **Emulous (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) was one of last year's most upwardly mobile distaffers and she returns in search of further laurels in today's G3 Ridgewood Pearl S. at The Curragh. Successful in this race and Fairyhouse's G3 Brownstown S. over seven furlongs in June, the homebred made light of a three-month break to deny Ballydoyle's top sophomores Together (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown. She has a penalty to defy as a result, but the owner-breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe is hoping she can set up a profitable campaign. "She was very impressive in the Matron and if she can reproduce that form, she's going to be something interesting this year," he told *PA Sport*. "She's entered in the [June 20] G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot and it's a possibility, but she is a mare who likes a bit of ease in the ground so the ground at Ascot would have to be suitable." His Highness The Aga Khan's **Alanza (Ire)** (Dubai Destination) was successful in the G3 Sceptre S. over seven furlongs at Doncaster in September before finishing sixth in the G1 Sun Chariot S. over a mile at Newmarket later that month. "She was a good filly last year and we've kept her in training to try and get a place or better in a Group 1 race at some stage," trainer John Oxx said. "The Sun Chariot was at the end of a year with plenty of racing. We've been waiting for drier ground and she has been going well. Emulous is a tough competitor and we are hoping to run her in the Windsor Forest after this."

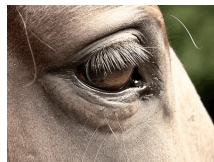

SPORTS BETTING COULD COME TO NJ TRACKS

New Jersey Governor Chris Christie said Thursday that he will defy a federal ban and begin allowing the state's 12 casinos and four racetracks to accept sports bets this fall.

"This is probably the best thing to happen to New Jersey racing since I can't remember when," said Tom Luchento, the president of the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey. "You have to be thankful to the governor. He always knew what he had to do. We in the horse racing industry are grateful to him for taking this initiative. Hopefully, it will all work out."

Christie made the announcement at a press conference in Atlantic City.

"We intend to go forward," Christie said. "If someone wants to stop us, then let them try to stop us. We want to work with the casinos and horse racing industry to get it implemented."

"Am I expecting there may be legal action taken against us to try to prevent it? Yes," the governor said. "But I have every confidence we're going to be successful."

A federal law that was passed in 1992 prohibited sports betting in all but four states--Nevada, Delaware, Oregon and Montana. Last fall, New Jersey voters voted to allow sports betting by a margin of nearly 2-1 in a non-binding referendum. Earlier this year, the legislature passed a sports betting law, which was signed by Christie. In addition, New Jersey State Senator Raymond Lesniak has attempted to sue the federal government to have the ban overturned.

"To those with a vested interest in the status quo--the professional sports organizations who take a hypocritical stance that wagering will 'ruin the purity of the game,' and the Nevada-based gaming conglomerates that have enjoyed that state's stranglehold on sports wagering for the last 20 years--I respectfully say, 'Bring it on,'" Lesniak said in a statement. "The sooner you make an issue of New Jersey's noncompliance with an unconstitutional federal ban, the sooner we can defeat that ban in the courts, and put New Jersey on the same competitive footing as the rest of the nation when it comes to sports wagering."

It still appears that the federal law supercedes the actions taken on the state level by Christie and others. New Jersey and Christie may yet have to face a challenge from the U.S. Justice Department.

"I love the idea of playing offense and having the federal government have to play defense against us," Tony Rodio, president of Tropicana Entertainment, which owns the Tropicana in Atlantic City, as well as casinos in several other states, told the *Associated Press*. "But I don't know who's going to want to be the first to open knowing they can shut you down. We'd need a lot more clarity before we invested lots of money in a sports book."

John Forbes, the head of the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Organization, which is also operating Monmouth Park, echoed the sentiments of Luchento. "It's good news," he said. "We're all for anything that helps racing and adds to purse revenues. This is something that can only be helpful. It's great news to us because we are hanging on by the skin of our teeth here in New Jersey."

According to Luchento, the amount that will go from the sports bets to racing and purses has yet to be determined.

WITH NEW WEAPON, REGULATORS SUSPEND TOP HARNESS TRAINER

Ever since harness trainer Lou Pena started winning races at an uncanny rate and vastly improving many horses in their first race under his care, rival horsemen and fans speculated that Pena must have an illegal edge. But during Pena's meteoric ascension to the top of the sport, which began in 2010, none of his horses has tested positive for an illegal drug.

That's still the case, yet Pena is facing what could turn out to be the most severe punishment in the history of either Thoroughbred or Standardbred racing. The New York State Racing and Wagering Board announced Thursday that Pena had been suspended indefinitely after its finding that horses under his care were administered illegal drugs on 1,715 occasions over a 27-month period. The Board's charges revolve around veterinary records which show the administration of drugs outside permitted time frames.

When asked how Pena could have had so many alleged violations yet no positive drug tests, a NYSRWB source replied: "Our investigation is ongoing, but it is suspected that Mr. Pena and his associates administered the drugs in amounts that could have potentially evaded detection or they were administered with other substances that made the drugs undetectable. This is why the investigation of vet records was critical in this case, and why the Board is considering additional rule changes regarding vet records." **Cont. p2**

It remains unclear how racing authorities were able to check Pena's vet records. He is stabled at a training center in New Jersey, but, because he has been banned at the Meadowlands, he races primarily in New York and Pennsylvania. The New Jersey Racing Commission got the records and turned them over to the New York Board.

It is widely suspected in both Thoroughbred and harness racing that some trainers are using drugs that are undetectable by existing tests. Using veterinary records to catch trainers could be a way to rely on something other than, and, perhaps better than, drug tests.

For that reason, the Pena case will likely be watched closely within both sports. At this point, it doesn't exactly seem certain that regulators can make the charges against Pena stick. He will have a hearing Wednesday at the NYSRWB offices in Schenectady.

"This stuff they got Pena on is a joke," said a harness trainer who asked that his name not be used. "I'm not saying he hasn't been juicing horses, but not with the stuff they are talking about now. If they looked at this way for every trainer then they'd all be banned. It's all standard pre-race stuff given by almost every vet to almost every trainer, almost every race. They couldn't figure out what he was doing so they came up with this."

Pena has called the latest suspension a "witch hunt" and adds that he is mystified about the fact that none of the horses involved tested positive.

"That bothers me," he said. "It's one of those things I don't understand."

Despite the lack of positive tests, the NYSRWB is clearly taking the Pena case very seriously. In its announcement Thursday, it said Pena could be fined \$25,000 for each of the 1,715 violations, which adds up to \$42.5 million. The Board also said it would take steps to reclaim some \$2.5 million won by the Pena-trained horses that were allegedly drugged.

"Obviously that concerns me," said Jay Hospodarek, a partner in Lightning Lane Stable, Pena's largest owner. "But I keep going back to the fact that these are only violations and that there were no drug positives. If Yonkers went back and pulled the vet records of every horse that ever raced there, that would be a different story. Me and my partner, we invested that money back into the business. If they did this to us we'd be homeless. There's no way we can pay that money back."

The usually loquacious trainer appeared shaken and had little to say when encountered at his barn yesterday morning. When asked what he would say at his hearing Wednesday, he replied: "I'm just going to say please stop [expletive] me and give me a little break, boys."

Pena was a moderately successful trainer and driver in California, which offers meager purses for harness racing, before moving to the Northeast in 2010. Upon his arrival in New Jersey, he started performing magical feats.

He has been the leading trainer at the Meadowlands, Yonkers and Chester and his winning percentage is normally about 30%. It is not unusual for a horse's times to improve by two or three seconds in their first starts for the trainer. This year, new Meadowlands owner Jeff Gural refused to allow Pena's entries.

"I feel very good seeing this news and commend regulators for finally catching Lou Pena," Gural told the New York *Daily News*. "I hope this sends a message to our industry to stay clear of these guys."

Pena said he plans to fight the suspension but has not yet contacted any attorneys or formulated his strategy.

HAATEF COLT TOPS GORESBRIDGE BREEZE-UP

Goresbridge's Breeze-Up Sale was highlighted by the sale of a son of Shadwell's freshman Haatef for €100,000 towards the end of yesterday's session. Consigned by Brendan Holland's Grove Stud, hip 170 was one of two high-profile purchases made by agent Stephen Hillen and is a half-brother to listed winner Ffestiniog (Ire) (Efisio {GB}). From the immediate family of pattern-race scorers Eisteddfod (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), Boston Lodge (GB) (Grand Lodge) and Border Patrol (GB) (Selkirk), his sale represented a pinhooking triumph as his tag had been a mere £5,000 at Doncaster last August. Hillen had earlier paid €70,000 for a son of Distorted Humor consigned by Willie Browne's Mocklershill Stables. Hip 63 is regally bred, being out of the Niarchos Family's high-class mare Shiva (Jpn) (Hector Protector), who was successful in the 1999 G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and also placed in that year's G1 Champion S. and the 2000 G1 Eclipse. Having fetched just \$7,000 at Keeneland in September, the chestnut achieved a handsome return and was purchased on behalf of owner Tengku Rahman to enter training with Kevin Ryan. Topping the fillies was another from the Mocklershill draft who sold to Anthony Stroud Bloodstock for €58,000. Hip 177 is by Curlin out of a stakes-placed half to the 2008 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity hero and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile runner-up Square Eddie (Smart Strike). That eclipsed the €52,000 earlier paid by agent Lars Kelp for hip 50, another of Grove Stud's offerings who is by Newsells Park's freshman Mount Nelson (GB) out of listed-placed Tia Mia (GB) (Dr Fong). At the close of play, the Co. Kilkenny-based company could boast a highly respectable 84% clearance rate at an auction which is now firmly entrenched in the calendar. The only downside was a slight drop in the average of €13,340 by 8% on 2011.
