



ALL POWER TO HIM

Those who witnessed the lifeless effort of **Power (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G1 2000 Guineas three weeks ago would have given Michael Tabor's colt little chance of providing Aidan O'Brien with an eighth renewal of the G1 Abu Dhabi Irish 2000 Guineas yesterday. Yet again, the new maestro of Ballydoyle produced some uncanny magic in the interim period to catapult the

forward from his Newmarket flop and onto Classic glory at The Curragh. "He was a very solid horse last year, and we thought the combination of very soft ground and it being his first run of the year were to blame at Newmarket," O'Brien said. "We were delighted with him since and Ryan [Moore] told Joseph to ride him, as he said he had felt great during the first half of the race before getting tired."

MAKE WAY

She may not have been an obvious leading lady a few weeks ago, but **Homecoming Queen (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) put herself firmly in the spotlight with a sensational victory at Newmarket and is poised to complete the double in today's G1 Etihad Airways Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh. Any suggestion she would play a hand in the 1000 Guineas early last season would have seemed fanciful at best, particularly after Susan Magnier's diminutive bay had been shelled out the back in a six-furlong Naas maiden in June. Since a rise in trip and switch to forcing tactics, she has left her initial ditherings behind her and came into her own under a never-say-die ride from Ryan Moore three weeks ago. That astonishing performance is backed up by impressive fractions and a repeat will see her become the third to complete the Newmarket-Curragh Guineas double since 2004. "It was a great performance in Newmarket and if she reproduces something like that she should be very, very hard to beat," commented jockey Joseph O'Brien. "There was no fluke about it. She went to the front and did it the hard way." **Cont. p14**

Admirably consistent at two, Power was winning the Listed Marble Hill S. on this card last year and went on to Royal Ascot to add the G2 Coventry S. to his tally the next month. He was second as the 7-4 favorite when returning from a break in the G1 Phoenix S. here in August, but Aidan O'Brien blamed himself for leaving him short on that occasion, and with the pressure

applied at home in the meantime returned to put matters right in the G1 National S. in September. Denied only by this race's most notable absentee Parish Hall (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}) in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket the following month, he

had attracted support for the 2000 Guineas but that proved wide of the mark as he faded to beat only one rival. Despite that negative hanging over him, it was only 12 months ago that Roderic O'Connor (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) had rebounded from an unplaced effort at Newmarket to win this race, and jockey bookings and market strength suggested that all the faith remained. Keen early anchored against the fence in sixth as the stable's G2 UAE Derby first and third Daddy Long Legs and Wrote (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) set off in isolation, Power tracked the British raider Foxtrot Romeo through as the two leaders started to send out distress signals with a quarter mile to race. Making ground up the rail, he was forced to angle around the tiring Wrote and as Daddy Long Legs veered left from the furlong marker was able to dash back to the rail. In front with 100 yards remaining, he surged away from the surprise package Foxtrot Romeo despite flashing his tail to lead home a one-three-four for the stable. "He traveled and quickened well off a solid pace today, and Ryan [Moore] felt he was a little bit unlucky in the Dewhurst last year--if he had gone a bit farther he would have got there--so he gets a mile well," said O'Brien. "Daddy Long Legs is a different horse on the grass and wouldn't mind stepping up to a mile and a quarter. I think Power is a horse for the G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 19], but it will be discussed and they all have lots of options open to them." In a remarkable turn of events for Highclere Stud, John Magnier revealed that Power had been raised alongside the leading Derby contenders Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) and Bonfire (GB) (Manduro {Ger}) at the Berkshire-based operation. 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Sea Change...

One of the race's intriguing players was **Born To Sea (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and, like Power, Christopher Tsui's three-parts brother to Sea the Stars (Ire) made major improvement from an unplaced effort in the 2000 Guineas. Sporting a hood for the first time, he stayed on late to be fifth. "I was very pleased with him," jockey Pat Smullen told *PA Sport*. "The number-one objective was to get him to settle, but once he did, I was too far behind. Hopefully he will progress, and I think he has the ability to be a nice horse once he starts doing things right." John Manley's **Trumpet Major (Ire)** (Arakan) was sent off the 9-4 favorite, but after trailing in last of the 10 runners was reported to be coughing.

Cherry Collect entered elite territory yesterday when completing the rare Classic double of the G3 Premio Regina Elena-G2 Oaks d'Italia in impressive fashion. Despite the jump in distance of three furlongs between the two races, recent precedents had been set by the dual Classic heroines Miss Gris (Hail the Pirates) in 1985 and Nicole Pharly (GB) (Pharly {Fr}) in 1997, and the pedigree and racing style of Cherry Collect suggested she had the right credentials to follow suit. One of her country's leading juvenile fillies, the bay suffered a sole defeat at the hands of Bugie d'Amore (GB) (Rail Link {GB}) in the G3 Premio Dormello over a mile here in October before giving Last Night Show (Ity) (Martino Alonso {Ire}) six pounds and a two-length beating in the Listed Criterium Femminile over 7 1/2 furlongs at the Capennelle in November. After returning to take a mile conditions event here Mar. 24, she also had that rival back in second in the Regina Elena which is classed as the Italian version of the 1000 Guineas when last seen Apr. 29. Placed in mid-division racing wide through the early stage, she moved up to challenge Rosa Eglanteria and Angegreen passing the furlong marker and was soon on top of that brief battle as Angegreen found extra to provided the stable with a 1-2.

Aruna inhaled free-running Aqsaam (Dynaformer)
with an eye-catching move approaching the stretch and
held sway late in an eventful renewal of the
Sheepshead Bay. Winner of the GII Mrs. Revere S. at
three, Aruna added last year's GIII All Along S. at
Colonial Downs ahead of a second to Zagora (Fr)
(Green Tune) in the GI Diana S. at Saratoga July 30. A
half-length winner of the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. on
the Keeneland Poly Oct. 9, the homebred was set for
the GI Breeders' Cup Filly/Mare Turf and gave an
excellent account of herself in fifth, beaten a length for
everything. Aruna resumed in the GI Jenny Wiley S. at
Keeneland Apr. 14, but caught a race completely
devoid of speed and trailed in sixth. Content to ride the
rails from fourth as Aqsaam raced along on a lonely
lead, Aruna was patiently handled into the final bend,
but got first run on Hit It Rich to attack approaching the
stretch. She shot right past the weakening pacesetter,
opened some daylight at the furlong marker and held
for the win. "There was a spot by the three-eighths pole
where I had to make a decision," winning jockey Ramon
Dominguez explained. "I had to really take a shot and
go through at that moment, which I did. I was a little
concerned it would compromise my filly, but she kept
on coming for me, so I was very happy with her."
Mystical Star (Ghostzapper) broke through the gates
just before they were opened and finished third, but
was disqualified to last for the false start. Magical Cat
(Ire) (Giant's Causeway) was held onto by the gate
crew in the stalls and was declared a non-starter.

Making his first start for the Jeff Mullins barn, Wilkinson turned in a razor sharp performance to light up the tote. Conditioned by Neil Howard for this owner through his sophomore season, the homebred was a very good third to Western Aristocrat (Mr. Greeley) and Brilliant Speed (Dynaformer) in the GI Jamaica H. at Belmont Oct. 8 and closed the season with a solid runner-up effort in the GIII Commonwealth Turf S. at Churchill in November. Wide on both turns when fifth in a Fair Grounds turf allowance Mar. 10, the dark bay was eighth, but not horribly beaten, in the GII Muniz Memorial H. in New Orleans Apr. 1 and was most recently sixth in the 12-furlong GII Elkhorn S. on the Keeneland turf Apr. 27. Cutting back in distance for this, Wilkinson took advantage of his low draw to sit just in behind the Cal-bred duo of Compari (Redattore {Brz}) and Liberian Freighter (Bertrando). Angled outside of those two rounding the turn, he came under heavy pressure from Martin Pedroza, but hit the front passing midstretch and was always holding Mr. Commons in the run to the wire. The latter, favored at odds-on, was able to get down to the two path and was midpack for the stretch run, but could not run down the eventual winner and settled for second.

Tried only once previously over five furlongs, Bated Breath showed that he possesses more than an average share of speed to finally score in pattern company and set a new course record in the process. A narrow runner-up in each of last year's G1 July Cup, G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and G1 Nearctic S. all over six panels, the homebred encountered ground easier than ideal when ninth in the G1 Nunthorpe S. over this trip at York in August and had little realistic chance when drawn in the 12 hole in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint. Despite that negative, the bay showed the kind of early pace at Sha Tin--where he was beaten just over three lengths in eighth--to suggest he would not be overawed by this speed test. After a wet spring held up his reappearance, the drying conditions due to the mini British heatwave played into his hands and it was evident from an early stage here that he was in his element. Taking a keen tug in the hands of George Baker just off the furious early pace set in part by last year's G1 Prix de l'Abbaye hero Tangerine Trees (GB) (Mind Games {GB}), he was allowed to stride to the front approaching the furlong pole and had first run on Sole Power. That proved decisive, as last year's winner pushed him all the way to the line and clear of the remainder to crack the track record. "If he had something to track, he would have made it a little easier on himself, but he's really stamped himself as belonging at the top now," the owner-breeder's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said. "We were doubtful last year whether this trip would see him at his best, but after seeing how he got to the turn in front of all those good sprinters in Hong Kong, we knew we would have the pace for this. He wouldn't want it too soft and loves this fast ground, so the G1 King's Stand S. [at Royal Ascot June 19] would loom a bit larger than the [June 23] G1 Diamond Jubilee S. at the moment. That might be an interesting option, as he needs Group 1 racing, and after Ascot we'll try and end up at the G1 Nunthorpe S. [at York Aug. 24] with the G1 July Cup [at Newmarket July 14] on the way. But I suppose there is a little bit of a shadow hanging over us from Australia."

Milan played host to Germany's multiple stakes-winning Alianthus (Ger) (Hernando {Fr}) here and the San Siro faithful even sent him off as the hot favorite, but it was a member of the domestic defence who prevailed as Vedelago struck for the Classic generation. Having beaten the subsequent G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere third Salure (GB) (Sakhee) in the G3 Premio Primi Passi over six furlongs here in June, Vedelago was best of his sex when third behind the smart fillies Nayarra (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and Rosa Eglanteria (GB) (Nayef) in the G1 Gran Criterium over this track and trip in October. Returning to the Capannelle to kick off his sophomore campaign with a pair of conditions wins over 7 1/2 furlongs and a mile Mar. 4 and Apr. 9, the bay was denied by a nose by Malossol (Rahy) in that circuit's main event, the Apr. 29 G3 Premio Parioli. Reserved off the pace early, he challenged Alianthus as that rival hit the front inside the final quarter and soon wrested the advantage from the visitor before drawing away in the last 100 yards.

Looking to remain perfect on the synthetic track, Hunters Bay drafted in fourth as Queen'splatekitten (Kitten's Joy), Mister Marti Gras and Hothersal punched the breeze ahead of him. The favorite advanced three wide approaching the far turn, challenged outside Mister Marti Gras upper stretch and quickened up nicely for the victory. "I got lucky, with three in front of me...just the perfect garden trip," said winning jockey Emma-Jayne Wilson. "When I asked him to go, he responded and responded well. You couldn't have asked for better. You couldn't have written it better. He's definitely a big boy," she continued. "He's a colt and gets a little fired up. But when he's got his game face on and you tell him to go, he's there. Just like any athlete, they like to let you know they're on the field or on the track, and he definitely has some presence."

Hunters Bay is the second foal to race out of six-time graded winner and Grade I-placed Smok'n Frolic. Frank Stronach paid \$1.25 million for the grey mare at Keeneland November in 2004. The mare's first foal for Adena Springs, A.P. Cardinal (A.P. Indy), topped the 2008 ADNMAR sale on a bid of \$380,000. Hunters Bay is her second foal, and she subsequently produced Grip Hands (Giant's Causeway) before being sold to Shadai Farm carrying a full sister to Hunters Bay for \$750,000 at Keeneland November in 2008.

Simnard, at the age of seven, was winning his first graded stakes back in February when he got his nose down over Newsdad (Arch) in the 1 3/8-mile GII Mac Diarmida S. at Gulfstream. It was a well-deserved victory considering his 2011 campaign included, among

other fine efforts, a runner-up performance in the GI Northern Dancer S. at Woodbine in September that saw him go down to defeat by only a neck. Simnard didn't immediately build off the breakout win, however. He finished third to Newsdad in the 1 1/2-mile GII Pan American S.

Mar. 24, then traveled to Keeneland to be third again--this time to Point of Entry (Dynaformer)--in the GII Elkhorn S. over the same trip Apr. 27. But he wouldn't have to wait too long for a second graded win, and was the second choice here against an evenly matched field of eight. Simnard used his tactical speed to his advantage and secured a good tracking spot as Depeche Chat (Wildcat Heir) cut out modest splits. He continued to stalk as Harrods Creek (Langfuhr) assumed command after three quarters in 1:14.74, but moved to engage that foe on the far turn. His connections might have been worried that he hit the front too soon after taking a narrow lead two furlongs out, but Simnard wasn't in the mood for a minor placing and ran on gamely to the wire while easily accounting for the late thrust of Joinem. The final time of the race, 2:27.16, was a new stakes record. "We broke a little slowly, but I had him placed forwardly," winning jockey Gabriel Saez said. "After we went a mile we started to pick it up a little bit. Every time I asked him he responded, and at the end we were ahead by a length. I got a perfect trip. It couldn't have gone any better than that." Suzy Lorimer, the assistant to trainer Roger Attfield traveled with the horse on a van ride from Toronto on Thursday morning, added, "He has really clicked this year, and Gabriel rode him perfectly. It was great. He'll ship back home [to Woodbine] tonight."

AMBITIOUS DRAGON SHOOT FOR CROWN

There is plenty at stake today for **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}) in today's Standard Chartered Champions & Chater Cup at Sha Tin. A win in his first try over 2400 meters would make him just the second horse in history to complete the Hong Kong Triple Crown of the Stewards Cup (1600 meters), the Hong Kong Gold Cup (2000 meters) and this staying test. River Verdon completed the sweep in 1984, when the Champions and Chater Cup was contested over 11 furlongs. It would also mean a bonus of HK\$5 million. If he is to make history, he will do it with the services of Umberto Rispoli, who landed last month's G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup. The reigning Horse of the Year, exiting a fourth in the G1 Champions Mile May 6, had previously been ridden by champion jockey Douglas Whyte, but he and trainer Tony Millard had a falling out following the Champions Mile and the change was affected. Whyte lands on **Dominant (Ire)** (Cacique {Ire}) for the ever-dangerous John Moore stable. Purchased off promising European form with the Hong Kong Derby in mind, the 4-year-old was only eighth on that occasion, but most recently scored a maiden local win in the Queen Mother Memorial Cup over this course and distance May 6.

AIGLES TO SOAR IN STELLAR D'ISPAHAN

Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) will be on familiar territory when facing seven rivals in a stellar renewal of today's G1 Prix d'Isphahan at Longchamp. Jean-Claude-Alain Dupouy and Xavier Niel's evergreen has already won eight times over the Bois de Boulogne strip--including April's G1 Prix Ganay--and conditioner Corine Barande-Barbe has selected this contest over next week's Coronation Cup at Epsom for the 6-year-old bay. "Longchamp is Cirrus des Aigles' back yard," Barande-Barbe told *Racing Post*. "The horse is very well and there wasn't much [to choose] between the two races. This way we avoid a long trip in the heat [for the June 2 G1 Diamond Jubilee Coronation Cup]."

Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) was transferred from Elie Lellouche's barn to the Newmarket base of Marco Botti, and hit the board first up for new connections in the Mar. 30 G1 Dubai World Cup at Meydan. Making his European comeback here, he has failed to score in four starts since defeating Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse to Bend {Ire}) and Cirrus des Aigles in last year's G1 Prix Ganay at this track.

Master conditioner Andre Fabre bids for a record-equalling eighth renewal and is represented by the returning dual Classic winner **Golden Lilac (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). Unbeaten through wins in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulches and G1 Prix de Diane, Gestut Ammerland's homebred distaffer comes back off a break and a third to Galikova (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}) in August's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano at Deauville.

The list of Classic winners in contention does not end there as **Reliable Man (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}), winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey Club at Chantilly, and **Tin Horse (Ire)** (Sakhee), last term's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains victor here, both throw their hat into the ring. Reliable Man could not cope with the swamp when third--10 lengths off Cirrus des Aigles--in the Ganay, and better will be expected on a much sounder surface here. Tin Horse has failed in three top-level events since registering his career high and makes his seasonal debut coming off a seventh, albeit ahead of Planteur, behind Excelebration (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) in September's G1 Prix du Moulin here.

Emerging from the Provinces to annex March's Listed Prix Rose de Mai at Saint-Cloud, ahead of Trois Lunes (Fr) (Manduro {Ger}) and the re-opposing **Crecy (GB)** (Refuse to Bend {Ire}), she had **Aigue Marine (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) in arrears when bagging win number five in last month's Listed Prix Caravelle at Toulouse.

His Highness The Aga Khan is the winningmost owner with five renewals and is represented this time around by Alain de Royer-Dupre trainee **Sagawara (GB)** (Shamardal). Successful in one of two juvenile starts, she was a neck short of Trois Lunes, and 2 1/2 lengths in front of **Prima Noa (Fr)** (Layman), in last month's G3 Prix Vanteaux at this track.

Pretty Please (Ire) (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) is an intriguing participant and flies the flag for the burgeoning Ecurie Wildenstein-Mikel Delzangles axis. She is a 3/4-sister to Planteur (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who contests the G1 Prix d'Ispahan 75 minutes further down the line, and steps straight into the fire off a once-out win, defeating **Hasna (Fr)** (American Post {GB}), at Chantilly last month.

POSITIVE THINKING

The Curragh's G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup is traditionally one of the easiest pickings among Europe's top-level races and today's renewal should represent an ideal opportunity for **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) to record a ninth win in this grade and a fourth in the Northern Hemisphere. Although excuses can be made for some of the Antipodean giant's recent eclipses, his reputation has taken some minor knocks and a confidence boost here could set him up for a return to Royal Ascot where he was turned over by Rewilding (GB) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) in the G1 Prince of Wales S. last term. Coming back from a break after his fourth in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup, the 6-year-old would not have to be at a peak to deal with apparently over-

matched rivals here. "He seems in good form and we just felt he didn't act on the surface in Dubai," Joseph O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "We've been happy with him at home, but he has had a little break and this is only his first run back. I'm sure he'll improve, but hopefully he can run a big race." Despite a plethora of admirable achievements in a lesser grade, Khalid Abdullah's **Famous Name (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) had his chance of landing that elusive top-level success in this race three years ago and came up short when favored against stable companion Casual Conquest (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}). Only third 12 months ago, the veteran has not shown anything in recent starts to suggest he has improved and will need So You Think to misfire to collect, provided he is allowed to start as connections monitor the ever-drying conditions. "He's been an amazing servant for us and is a great horse, but he's come up short on several occasions and is not getting any younger," jockey Pat Smullen said. "He won as well as he's ever done last time and is in great order." **Bible Belt (Ire)** (Big Bad Bob {Ire}) proved another modestly bred success story for Cristina Patino's Anamoine operation last term and rounded off her campaign with a career-best second to Dancing Rain (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the G2 British Champions Fillies and Mares S. at Ascot in October.

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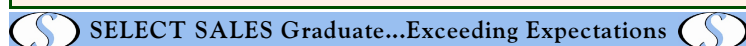

The homebred bay then slipped to sixth in the Apr. 23 G2 Prix Noailles at Longchamp last time, but rebounded in style under a penalty to claim a second black-type score here.

Restrained in rear for the most part, he was forced wide when closing into the straight and powered down the outside under a drive to prevail in the dying strides.

RICARDO SURPASSES BAZE FOR WORLD

RECORD South American riding legend Jorge Ricardo partnered the 11,596th winner of his illustrious career in Buenos Aires Friday to regain the lead as the world's leading active jockey. The 50-year-old Brazilian and former record holder, who has fought against lymphoma missing 219 days in 2009, has climbed back to the top of the rankings, surpassing Northern California-based Russell Baze to rank first as the world's all-time winningest jockey. Ricardo guided Stud Los Nelson's star 2-year-old Winning Prize (Pure Prize) to an eight-length victory in the ninth race and added a third victory on Friday's San Isidro card to gain a two-victory lead over Baze at the conclusion of Friday. Ricardo, who won 26 riding titles in Rio de Janeiro before moving permanently to Argentina in 2006, became the first jockey in the world to reach 10,000 wins in 2008. Baze, 53, became North America's winningest jockey when he passed Panamanian legend Laffit Pincay Jr's record of 9,530 winners in December 2006 and the first jockey in the world to reach the 11,000 landmark in August 2010.
