Fort Larned came away well from his outside post and settled into a perfect spot third as longshot Endorsement (Distorted Humor) cut out fair fractions of :23.42 and :46.97 while tracked by Trickmeister (Proud Citizen). Favorites Ron the Greek and Hymn Book (Arch) were well behind at that point. Fort Larned's rider Brian Hernandez Jr., sitting on a ton of horse, pushed the button on the far turn and the 4-year-old responded readily, quickly putting daylight between himself and his rivals.

Stablemates Ron the Greek and Flat Out rallied in tandem down the center of the track, with Hymn Book to their inside, but the Whitham homebred had built enough of an advantage to secure victory.

"Brian did a tremendous job; first time over this track," trainer Ian Wilkes added. "He rode a perfect race and moved him at the right time. He put some open lengths between him and the closers. You couldn't let the closers get to you."

Fort Larned, fourth to 2011 GI Preakness S. hero Shackleford in his debut at two at Churchill, graduated in his second try at Gulfstream, but spent much of his sophomore campaign in allowance company. He annexed Tampa's Challenger S. Mar. 3 and promptly added the GIII Skip Away S. at Gulfstream Mar. 31. Second to Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) in a track-record-setting performance in the GIII Alysheba S. under the Twin Spires May 4, the bay backed out of it when eighth in Ron the Greek's GI Stephen Foster H. triumph. However, he responded by wiring Successful Dan, et al in the GIII Cornhusker H. at Prairie Meadows June 30, which was the third time this season he recorded a 108 Beyer Speed Figure.

"This is a free-running horse," Wilkes added. "He can do a lot of things. I always thought he belonged [up there] in the division. You question yourself coming off a race like the Stephen Foster; you got beat, you got your head handed to you there. So you question yourself. But this horse keeps rattling off those 108 Beyer Speed Figures. He stays consistent."

Include Me Out withstood a stern challenge from Star Billing to notch her second career Grade I victory, and secured a spot in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 2 by virtue of this contest being part of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge. The dark bay launched her ascent with the GII La Canada S. at Santa Anita Jan. 22, added the GI Santa Margarita Invitational on St. Patrick's Day, and completed a hat trick with a hard-fought success in the GII Marjorie L. Everett H. at Betfair Hollywood May 19.

However, her waiting ways and a seven-pound swing saw her blow a three-length lead in the GI Vanity H. June 16 at the Inglewood oval. Switch (Quiet American) surprisingly had the lead in time to register a :46.55 opening half, with Include Me Out utilizing her rail post to secure a fence-skimming spot in fifth. She shifted to Switch's outside in the stretch and, after making the lead, was confronted by Star Billing. The wire came in time for Include Me Out. Amani, making her first start on these shores, came from way out of it to round out the trifecta.

"I thought the race went perfect," said trainer Ron Ellis. "Then she drew out by a couple lengths and you know she pulls herself up when she gets on the lead. I guess [jockey] Joe [Talamo] likes to work hard trying to carry her home. I think she tolerates the synthetic tracks, but she's a much better filly on dirt. She doesn't seem to want to pull herself up as much."

Owner Jay Em Ess Stable will get a \$10,000 travel stipend to get Include Me Out to Santa Anita for the Breeders' Cup, but likely won't need to shell out that amount to van her over from her Betfair Hollywood base.

"I've been thinking about that since she won at Santa Anita [earlier in 2012]," Ellis added. "We're really excited she's in good form right now, and she'll have a couple months before she has to run again at Santa Anita. We're very excited about that."

Include Me Out is the third Jay Em Ess runner to win a Breeders' Cup Challenge race this year, following Redeemed (Include) getting a Marathon spot and Rail Trip (Jump Start) earning a berth in the Dirt Mile.

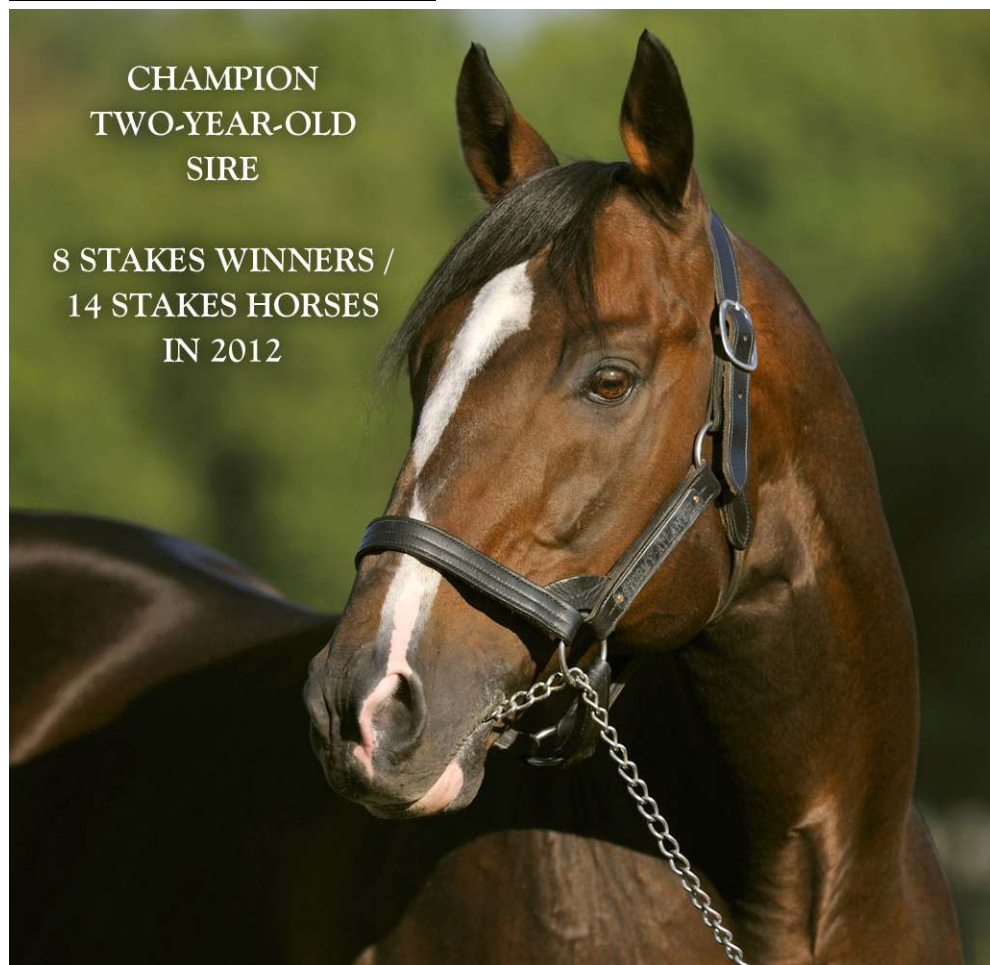
Emma's Encore took her time putting it all together, and finally earned her diploma in a Florida-bred maiden at Gulfstream Feb. 24.

She promptly added a six-furlong starter optional claimer Mar. 14, but she failed to menace in the nine-furlong GII Gulfstream Oaks Mar. 31. The dark bay made her New

York bow with a runner-up effort in a Belmont optional claimer May 16, which preceded her rousing upset in the GIII Victory Ride S. July 7. Emma's Encore broke from the rail, but immediately dropped out of it as favored Agave Kiss assumed her usual spot on the front end. Jockey Junior Alvarado had Emma's Encore take the overland route on the turn, and Agave Kiss began to tire after a :44.64. Judy the Beauty got first jump and looked like a winner, but Emma's Encore kept on coming and got her nose down on the line. "It all counts," Jerkens added. "Everything has to go well. The horse has to run good, the horse has to be good, has to be fit enough. She really had to run today. Nothing was in her favor today, looking at the scratch [of Jamaican Smoke]. It looked like speed was holding on pretty good."

There was much buzz about The Fugue during the spring, and it was clear that she had made significant progress from her taking debut win over seven furlongs at Newmarket in late October. Sent to the Rowley Mile for a gallop, the dark bay showed enough sparkle to book a ticket to the G1 1000 Guineas back there May 6, but was struck into early on in the Classic dominated by Homecoming Queen (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}). Even allowing for that incident and the unfavorably soft ground, she showed all the ability her connections were used to seeing at home when finishing strongly to be fourth and was back just 10 days later to turn York's G3 Musidora S. into a procession. Again unlucky when hampered early on in the G1 Epsom Oaks, she was widely considered to be the best filly in that June 1 Classic after making up considerable ground in the straight to be only 3/4 of a length behind Was in third. Her stamina at a mile and a half may have been stretched to the limit when encountering testing ground once more in the Ribblesdale, but she still put in her customary game effort to be second there.

William Buick may have had to side with Izzi Top (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) based on the pair's win record of late, but he had made it clear that his decision was a tough one.

Timepiece was given another perfectly judged ride from the front by Tom Queally, and by the time the field was approaching the furlong marker, she had all bar The Fugue in trouble in behind. Richard Hughes was always confident, and as soon as he pressed the button his mount swooped from rear to first in less than a furlong in a commanding display of class. "The more I eased her back, the better she was going, and she was loving it--she was like an elastic band ready to quicken," Hughes explained. "She is very well-balanced, and she's a beautiful filly with a lovely rhythm who floats across the ground. Not many move that well and have a change of gear, and a good, strong gallop will suit better, as they went a bit slow today. She couldn't have done it any easier, and I didn't want her to have a hard race, as she's had a few of them." John Gosden is looking at two main targets for the winner. "Our main aim is the [Aug. 23] G1 Yorkshire Oaks, and then the [Nov. 2] G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf," he said. "Santa Anita's fast ground will suit, and I think Lord Lloyd-Webber would like to see her run, as he has businesses and friends there." Izzi Top was sent off the 7-4 favorite, but was only sixth after failing to pick up in her usual style. "We were all worried there was no pace on, and Izzi Top got stacked three wide and was pulling all the way," Gosden added. "She ran with the choke out, but in small fields this can happen. William [Buick] has done nothing wrong--he has chosen a Group 1 winner, which he had to, but he's been torn apart." SALOMINA LAYS PERFECT RECORD ON LINE

Peter Schiergen registered one win as a rider in Dusseldorf's G1 Preis der Diana (German Oaks), but has outstripped that tally with two victories in his second career as a trainer. He is doubly represented in this year's 154th renewal with **Nymphaea (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) and the hitherto unbeaten **Salomina (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}), and it is the latter who will go postward with the hefty burden of expectation. Unraced as a juvenile, she added to wins at Cologne and at this track with a cozy, albeit tight, verdict in the July 5 G3 Grosser Preis von Lotto Hamburg last time. She will be the only distaffer to line up with a perfect record. Stall Grafenberg's **Sworn Sold (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}), who shares the same sire as runaway G1 Deutsches Derby hero Pastorius (Ger), is another lacking juvenile experience. Bettering a debut third at Cologne, she bagged Baden-Baden's May 19 Listed Iffezheimer Diana-Trial by two lengths and defeated a number of today's re-opposing rivals, including third-placed Nymphaea, with a tidy score in the June 16 Listed BMW Preis Dusseldorf at this track last time. Gestut Schlenderhan's **Imagery (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) was 1 1/4 lengths adrift of Sworn Sold in that event, but rebounded with an easy three-length defeat of **Waldtraut (Ger)** (Oasis Dream {GB}), and others, in the July 15 Listed Grosser Preis der Eilert Bauunternehmung at Hannover in her latest start.

Monami (Ger) (Sholokhov {Ire}) ended 2011 in Germany's top echelon of juvenile distaffers and backed up her victory in the G3 Preis der Winterkonigin at Baden-Baden with a win in the May 27 G2 Diana Trial at Hoppegarten, where Nymphaea ran third, on seasonal return. Nonetheless, her tiara has slipped in the build up and she finished fourth to Salomina--and one place behind **Wilddrossel (Ger)** (Dalakhani {Ire})--in the Grosser Preis von Lotto Hamburg last time.

Stem-Cell Therapy for Successful Dan

Morton Fink's GII Alysheba S. hero **Successful Dan** (Successful Appeal) is scheduled to undergo stem-cell therapy on a strained distal sesamoidean ligament in his foreleg. The 6-year-old gelding sustained a similar injury in 2009. "Both injuries are to the suspensory apparatus that supports the fetlock," Dr. Larry Bramlage told *Daily Racing Form*. "He had a couple of episodes before two years ago where we used stem cells on him. It seems to have helped, because the suspensory ligament has gotten better and better and better." The therapy will begin in a few weeks followed by, depending upon his progress, about two months of turnout and four months of active rehabilitation. "If everything went perfectly, we'd like to have him going by mid-year, next year," Bramlage added. Successful Dan last ran second to Fort Larned (E Dubai) in the GIII Cornhusker H. at Prairie Meadows June 16.

IN PRAISE OF THE GOOD MARE

"Fame is the sum total of all the misunderstandings that can gather around one name" - Rilke

What an insight from a century ago, especially of the Thoroughbred world and its stars, the stallions--and the fame we force upon them, deserved or not. Ignoring Rilke's wisdom we light the flame, convinced that this or that new sire will make Frankel's and Black Caviar's from slow mares--and mend our broken hearts.

We want to believe the hyperbole, follow fashion despite the facts that a stallion's record is infinitely measurable. Yet somehow sane men and women create an image around a stallion that is just blue sky. The majority don't measure up. Most fail, all fail ultimately.

Stallions must rise and fall to reinvigorate the breed. Look at one of the greatest, Ribot, undefeated in all of Europe, a light on the hill. Now the great instrument of Tesio is a flicker away from extinguishment, barely mentioned on the pedigree page.

Likewise, the towering figure of Star Kingdom, our greatest influence post war and pre Danehill, now a mere memory.

But the decline of giants doesn't stop the stallion cult, the need for us to talk all the new boys up, and just as it may stimulate the precocity of the breed, I reckon it makes us feel better, too. The resulting chimera is part PR, part perception and part imagination. And in this the breeder plays a part, we can talk ourselves into a horse, after all they are magnificent with a mystique all their own!

But how does this help us find a sire that can get runners--and if you're a seller, yearlings that fetch a champions price? There are no rules, no parachute, no guidelines except what you can afford. Only gut feel and the stats can help, opinions can sway, but the decision is yours. You make that call knowing a false step now will have you in the non-sellers bin come auction day two years down the track.

And in Australia this week, as the horse floats rumble across the wide, brown land, taking mares to stud, now is the time, a new beginning of the breeding cycle, a time for optimists, a reminder that racing is seasonal and inextricably close to nature.

All bets are off as we enter the genetic lottery.

Northern Dancer rules our herd, ubiquitous and dominant. His sire line got more than 60% of our Group 1 winners in 2011/12, ending Aug. 1. Eight of the 10 top sires trace back to him, five directly to Danehill.

It would seem self evident, a classic joining of the best to the best, that a cross of Danehill over Danehill, or linebreeding to the great horse, would be the way to go?

Not on your life, says breeding guru Peter Jenkins, who ironically is attached to the farm that brought Danehill to light, Arrowfield Stud.

Jenkin's research on duplicating Danehill shows plainly--on the available evidence to date--it's not the way to go. Of 573 named foals, there are only five stakes winners, and no Group 1 or Group 2 winners. And in the break up of the sexes, there is not one stakes winner amongst the 295 colts. Sadler's Wells, the dominant force in Europe, isn't much better if doubled up.

Danehill duplicated runs at 0.87 stakes horses to named foals, and Sadler's Wells only slightly better at an appalling rate commercially of just 1.6.

Going further, linebreeding to the male shows us that even the breed bender Danzig doesn't really work. His figures are only slightly better than the two already mentioned, and if one was forced into a description it would be: failed.

This does not mean the decline of the Northern Dancer influence, and again his dynasty was prominent on both paternal and maternal sides of nine individual Group 1 winners of 14 races in 2011/12.

Look no farther than Black Caviar and Frankel. The two have Northern Dancer on both sides as a reminder of the grip the Canadian-born son of Nearctic still has worldwide. However, in 20 years will it be the same? The answer is no, as even the greatest influences fizzle out after five or six generations.

Stallions slide in influence as stud masters search for an outcross, yet mares are perennial, the real heroes of the breeding barn, their influence surviving long after the male is forgotten.

And yet we worship the male progenitor despite the far superior strike rate of the mighty matriarchs, downing even Danehill with their percentage of stakes winners from named foals.

A great mare from a leading family will get a good runner from a bad stallion. Very rarely does it work the other way.

It's not widely recognized, but the mare is our greatest resource despite her limited sphere of influence, due to the opportunity of only one foal a year. They are the silent heroes of the turf, and before we find the stallion, let's get hold of a good mare first.

And don't just go for the pretty one. If the dominant females I have seen are any guide, looks are not part of the equation. Lady Giselle (Nureyev), the dam of Zabeel (Sir Tristram), sire of 40 Group 1 winners at last count, was small and plain.

Easy Date (Grand Chaudiere), mum of Snippets (Lunchtime), a rare influence in Australia, was the same. She proves breeding ain't no beauty contest. Nor a search for over-hyped, celebrity stallions. That path will only prove Rilke right. Just find that good mare and the rest will follow.

We have given our two TDN crack handicappers, Brian DiDonato and Steve Sherack, a mythical \$1000 bankroll and told them they can bet no more than 5% of that on any given day at Saratoga on a straight win bet. The winner, at the end of the meet, gets \$100 in a TVG betting account, along with bragging rights until next July.

DiDonato: Saturday - I may still have a 0% win rate, but I'm up to almost 36% with top-pick scratches. Now *that's* impressive! Alternate play **Fredericksburg** threw his head up right at the start of the fifth, and was pretty much out of it at that point from his outside draw. She sold for \$95,000--the second-highest price paid for a 2-year-old by the very underrated Include over the past three years. Out of an unraced daughter of solid turf runner Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}), sire of MGISW Presious Passion, Summer of Fun's female family is all distance and mostly turf. Her second dam was MSP in France and produced U.S. Grade I winner and French Group 1-placed Louis Cyphre (Ire) as well as French Group 2 winner and MG1SP Psychobabble (Ire). While George Weaver's numbers with 2-year-olds debuting in turf routes aren't spectacular, he does do exceptionally well at Saratoga in general, and his two recent wins in the relevant category came here at 8-1 and 6-1. He also ran a close second with another turf debutante at the Spa in 2010 at 40-1, and one of those two winners came last year for this same ownership group--Bona Venture Stables. Summer of Fun can't really get bet too strongly off the paper, so I'm looking for a nice price on an intriguing under-the-radar runner. **Play:** \$25 Win (Turf Only).

RAJSAMAN TO LA CAUVINIERE

Rajsaman (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}--Rose Quartz {GB}, by Lammtarra) has been retired to stand at Haras de la Cauviniere, it was announced yesterday. Four times a winner in Pattern company, the Aga Khan-bred 5-year-old will join Le Havre (Ire) and Air Chief Marshal (Ire) at Sylvain and Elisabeth Vidal's Normandy base for the 2013 breeding season. Aside from his wins in the 2010 G3 Prix de Fontainebleau and G3 Prix Perth and the following year's G2 Prix du Muguet and G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein, the grey was also third in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan and G1 Prix du Moulin last term. He retires as the winner of six races from 22 starts and over €550,000 in prize money. "In our opinion, Rajsaman has all the assets and qualities needed to become a successful sire," the stud's Mathieu Alex commented. "He has a fine pedigree and a physique to match. He was precocious at two and went on to become a top miler, combining the vital elements of speed and courage. We will support him in the same way as we have with our other stallions to ensure he has a high quality book of mares from the start."



Italy

FRESH CRISIS LOOMS

Promised funding of €35-million, which was earmarked for Italy's beleaguered horse racing industry by agriculture minister Mario Catania in February, has not been forthcoming and, combined with the refusal of Banca Nazionale del Lavoro (BNL) to extend credit to independent governing body Assi, has plunged racing into a fresh crisis. Assi's future is uncertain, and proposals are in place to replace the organisation with Lega Ippica, a representative body formed by groups such as breeders and racetracks. With purse levels for 2013 set to be cut for a second straight year, other possibilities include the suspension of racing for the final quarter of the year to alleviate the burden on the prize money pool, a move likely to provoke consequences for each of the 50,000 people directly involved in the industry. Italy's government has proposed a bill due for consideration Aug. 20 which, if passed into law, will see the majority of Assi's responsibilities transferred to the Ministry of Agriculture. The government's treasury department will take control of the betting sector. "I am not the minister who holds the cash," Catania told *Racing Post*. "I can act as a go-between for the racing industry within the ministry of economy, but I still don't have the direct financial assets needed to solve certain problems. Horse racing has been in a crisis for a couple of years now, which is not helped by the decrease in betting movement. I will work with the racing industry to try to find all the possible solutions." Franco Raimondi, director of SGA Sales, disagreed with the idea of cancelling racing from September through December, and added, "The BNL problem is a technicality and the situation is chronic regarding the lack of financial support. Investment has been lacking in the good years, and the crisis means expectations have fallen. Therefore horses are sold and, in the last three months, 15 horses of good level have been sold to foreign buyers which is a sign of internal market weakness. Strikes or long stops in the sport have coincided with a breakdown in betting movement, and you can only claw back very little of what is lost with the restart. Freezing the activity means freezing income and betting movement. Lega Ippica is a private organisation created by racecourses, breeders and other sections of the industry, that's the only opportunity there is at the moment for a reorganization of the system."

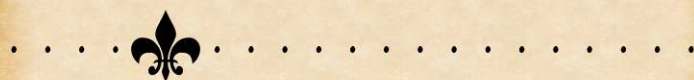
