caused a surprise of major proportions in yesterday's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe when wearing down the 7-2 favorite **Orfevre (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}) in the final

strides to score by a neck. In doing so, the homebred provided trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias with a first renewal of the great race and her rider Olivier Peslier with a record-equaling fourth at a huge 41-1. "It is a really great day, and to win the Arc with all my friends and family around me is a moment to savor," commented Laffon-Parias, who enjoyed a red-letter day after his juveniles--**Silasol (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) and **Topaze Blanche (Ire)** (Zamindar)--went one-two in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac earlier on the card. "I am lucky to train for such great people as the Wertheimers, who have trusted me for many years. I have to say, I was going into the race hoping for a place only, but we were very happy that the rain arrived for her, and Olivier made the difference today. He was the star and the day belongs to him--he gave her an amazing ride and deserves great credit." **Cont. p3**

GLORY AT RACING'S OLYMPICS

Sent off the 6-5 favorite for yesterday's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on the back of wins in the

G2 Superlative S. at Newmarket July 14 and Aug. 1 G2 Vintage S. at Goodwood, **Olympic Glory (Ire)** (Choirsir {Aus}) brought an instant dividend to Sheikh Joaan bin Hamad Al Thani's recent investment by battling to success in Longchamp's

heavy conditions. Settled in mid-division early by Richard Hughes, the bay got first run on his chief market rival **What a Name (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley), and after cutting down the eventual third **Indian Jade (GB)** (Sleeping Indian {GB}) with 100 meters remaining, comfortably held the filly by 1 1/4 lengths. "He is a top horse," Hughes commented. "I was worried about the ground, and I always had to be after him a bit, but he picked up very nicely." **Cont. p7**

IN LINGERIE REVEALS HERSELF IN SPINSTER

Gary Barber and Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners's **In Lingerie** (Empire Maker) upped her synthetic track record to three-for-three and secured her spot in the starting gate for the Nov. 2 G1 Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Keeneland yesterday with a convincing two-length defeat of her elders in the G1 Juddmonte Spinster S. **Mystical Star** (Ghostzapper) took second from **Upperline** (Maria's Mon), while

defending champion **Aruna** (Mr. Greeley) settled for sixth. Tucked away in the pocket under pilot John Velazquez behind splits of :24.20, :47.97 and 1:12.41, the 2-1 favorite called out for running room at the top of the lane. She tipped out to stretch her legs in midstretch, and quickly narrowed the gap on Mystical Star, lengthening her margin of victory as she pleased after bursting to the fore. "She had a perfect trip," said Velazquez. "She broke really well, so we got into nice position. I was a little worried because the horses in front of me, I was expecting they were going to come back to me. Actually they lasted a little longer than I expected, which did help me a little bit. Once I got out at the sixteenth pole and she was in the clear she responded right away. I'm very proud of her." **Cont. p11**

Solemia needed three attempts to register a black-type success, and it came in the Listed Prix Joubert over this trip at Saint-Cloud in September before she was second to Vadamar (Fr) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris over this course and distance the following month. Returning to score by four lengths in the Listed Prix Lord Seymour again over this track and trip Apr. 19, she was third, before being promoted to second, when meeting significant trouble in running behind Allied Powers (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) on a third visit in the May 8 G3 Prix d'Hedouville.

By the time she tackled Saint-Cloud's G2 Prix Corrida, she was beginning to emerge as a genuine contender for the leading distaff events, and she was able to nose out Shareta (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}) in a head-bobbing finish to that May 28 1 5/16-mile contest. The third on that occasion, Siyouma (Ire) (Medicean {GB}), managed to win the G1 Sun Chariot S. recently, so there was a genuine argument that her starting price here was artificially inflated. Her two most recent efforts, when fourth under a penalty in Deauville's G2 Prix de Pomone Aug. 11 and third in the Vermeille, were enough for the astute Wertheimer brothers to let her take her chance against some of the world's heavyweight performers, and her prospects rose with each drop of the persistent autumnal rain.

Soon towards the fore before the babble of pacemakers took up their roles with varying relish, she traveled strongly for Peslier against the fence while those in behind scrambled for racing room. As the rabbits ran out of steam on the final turn, she was left in clear daylight with Masterstroke alongside at the head of affairs, and was still full of run as Soumillon glided on the wide outside on Orfevre. Although he quickly gained two lengths on her, he veered right to the rail and gave Solemia an opening she took with relish, as she broke the hearts of the raider's followers with a withering effort close to home. **Cont. p4**

Orfevre Settles for Silver...

Orfevre's trainer Yasutoshi Ikee had mixed emotions after Orfevre became the third Japanese challenger to be second in this race. There were shades of El Condor Pasa (Jpn) (Kingmambo) in 1999, who was also worn down late by Montjeu (Ire) after having looked to have stolen a march on the field. "I am proud of my horse, because he has beaten the French and English Derby winners and a top filly like Shareta and all the best, but I have to say I am really disappointed he didn't win," Ikee said. "I don't know why, but that's the way it is. We thought it was better to come down the

outside, as after the last two races the inside was becoming worn. We will take him back home now and see how he is before discussing his options, but he could run in the G1 Japan Cup and G1 Arima Kinen."

Godolphin's Racing Manager Simon Crisford said of Masterstroke, who was seven lengths behind in third, "We are absolutely delighted with that run, and he was the first 3-year-old to finish. Mickael [Barzalona] gave him a great ride and we have no complaints. He will go to Dubai now and afterwards join us in England for next year." Multiple Classic winner Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}), who started at 19-5, appeared to have no excuses and could only stay on at one pace to be seventh.

Camelot Back in 2013...

Derrick Smith, Susan Magnier and Michael Tabor's **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will return next season, Aidan O'Brien announced yesterday. Only seventh in yesterday's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp, the G1 2000 Guineas and G1 Epsom Derby hero reportedly lost a shoe during the race.

"He's done an awful lot for a 3-year-old, and he'll be something to look forward to next year," the Ballydoyle conditioner told *Racing Post*. "The lads are very sporting and they want their horses to compete. Hopefully, if he has a good winter, he'll be unbelievable next year. I've no doubt he's the best I've trained and everyone will see it next year. I always thought a mile and a quarter was his perfect distance, but that he would get a mile and a half. Next year he could go a mile, a mile and a quarter, and probably a mile and a half. He's a great traveler, he's determined and he quickens. Camelot has had a long, hard season, and it was very bad ground. It was sporting of the lads to have a go. Joseph always said he wants better ground. I didn't think so before the race, but the Leger obviously left its mark. Today he just flattened out."

O'Brien also stated that **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who could fare no better than 11th, will "very possibly" remain in training.

"He'll hopefully go to the Breeders' Cup," he added. "We've experimented a lot with him."

Family Affair...

The victory of Solemia is a third in the famed blue-and-white silks, with fellow 4-year-old fillies Ivanjica and Gold River (Fr) scoring in 1976 and 1981, respectively, for Jacques Wertheimer. "We were not hoping for that much, but she's such a nice strong filly and she was amazing," the owner/breeders' Racing Manager Pierre-Yves Bureaux commented. "I was very happy in midstretch, as I thought she would be second, but Olivier gave her a wonderful ride. Carlos has done a very good job with her, and we were very happy with the rain that had come in the last few days. I am very happy for the Wertheimers, and this is a deserved victory for them—we bred Poliglote as well, so she is a full Wertheimer filly."

It was a banner day for the breeding operation of Alain and Gerard Wertheimer, who led in the homebred Arc heroine Solemia and G1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner Silasol (Ire) (Monsun {Ger}). Both fillies hail from the Brooklyn Dance (Fr) (Shirley Heights {GB}) family, with Solemia being her final foal, and Silasol a granddaughter of the 1991 G3 Prix Cleopatre winner. This family has been a mainstay for the Wertheimers, coming into the fold when *Green Valley II (*Val de Loir) was acquired as a

yearling for FF410,000 in 1968 from the dispersal of Gertie Widener, according to *Racing Post*.

Green Valley never raced, but went on to produce six stakes winners topped by 1975 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero Green Dancer (Nijinsky II). Among the numerous additional stakes winners on the page is 2007 G1 Epsom Derby hero Authorized (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}).

In addition to Solemia, Brooklyn's Dance is the dam of multiple Group 3 winner and Group 1-placed Prospect Park (GB) (Sadler's Wells) and Group 2 winner Prospect Wells (Fr) (Sadler's Wells). She also produced listed winners Never Green (Ire) (Halling), Brooklyn's Gold (Seeking the Gold) and Gold Dodger (Slew O'Gold).

Silasol is the second foal from Stormina (Gulch), a granddaughter of Brooklyn's Dance. Third in the

2005 G2 Prix de Sandringham, Stormina went on to win a trio of black-type races in the U.S. She has a yearling colt by Invincible Spirit (Ire) and produced a Cape Cross (Ire) filly this past March.

The Wertheimers also campaigned Solemia's sire Poliglote (GB) (Sadler's Wells), who captured the 1994 G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud.

Ridasiyna, who went unraced as a juvenile, opened her account with a spectacular five-length debut score going 11 furlongs here May 13, earning ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ status in the process, and was equally impressive when registering another five-length triumph in the June 8 Listed Prix Melisande at Maisons-Laffitte on her black-type bow. She continued her winning streak when accounting for Romantica (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) and a stellar line-up in the July 1 G3 Prix Chloe at Chantilly, but ran flat when suffering a first defeat in fifth in the Aug. 21 G2 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville, finishing fifth as that rival exacted revenge last time.

However, the homebred bay bounced back in mighty impressive fashion to take this distaffers' highlight by daylight.

Ridasiyna was buried in mid-pack, wearing a first-time hood, and traveled smoothly throughout the contest. Inching ever closer from halfway, she

made smooth headway in the straight to sweep by Izzi Top passing the furlong marker and easily increased her margin of superiority over that rival under minimal urging as Giofra ran on well from off the pace to claim third.

"We were disappointed when she ran so badly at Deauville, but she was very nervous that day and had run her race beforehand, and that is why we fitted her with a hood today," explained trainer Mikel Delzangles. "It seems to have done the trick, as she behaved really well and was able to show her true form. The fast pace also played to her strengths, as she loves to quicken from behind. There is a strong possibility that she will remain in training as a 4-year-old next year, therefore that was probably her last race of the season. There is not much left for her besides the Breeders' Cup, and she is not a filly with which you would want to travel so far."

Olympic Glory made an impressive debut when scoring over six furlongs at Goodwood June 8, and stepped up markedly despite lacking vital experience when sent to Royal Ascot to contest the G2 Coventry S. Belying that disadvantage, he drew on his reserves of class to chase home ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}), and the subsequent exploits of that Bolger trainee shed even more favorable light on his performance when suffering just a 3/4-length defeat in that June 19 contest. Overcoming extremely testing ground and a late setback to win the G2 Superlative S. over this trip at Newmarket July 14, he defied a resulting three-pound penalty to swoop late and add Goodwood's G2 Vintage S. to his tally on good ground at the beginning of August. Bought privately by Sheikh Joaan bin Hamad Al Thani from Julie Wood in the interim, he was shown maximum respect by the Parisians and visiting Brits and Irish, and was heavily favored over the domestically trained filly What a Name.

Sticking within striking distance of the leaders throughout the first part of the race, Olympic Glory was niggled at to keep his rhythm on the cloggy surface, and, when the gap appeared inside the final quarter, he had dead aim on Indian Jade. Without being asked a serious question, he duly picked up that rival passing the first winning post as What a Name was launched with an ambitious run from rear by Christophe Lemaire. Although she tried hard, she was unable to get on terms with the colt, who was hand-ridden in the final yards to win with something left in the tank. Trainer Richard Hannon's son Richard Jr. did not rule out another outing for the winner this year.

"This is a top-class 2-year-old who had the form to win, as he has only been beaten by Dawn Approach, but we were slightly worried about the condition of the ground," he said. "He had won on it this year already, but he's a heavy horse. He traveled well and kicked very nicely, and this is a well-deserved Group 1. He might run again this season, possibly in the Breeders' Cup, but we will discuss it with Nicolas de Watrigant, who handled the deal when he was sold and all the racing and breeding interests of Sheikh Joaan. Next year, he will certainly be a Guineas horse, and whether that is in Newmarket or Paris, we'll see."

Silasol, stepping up from an off-the-radar debut effort at Deauville Aug. 24, shed maiden status over this course and distance last time Sept. 9, and continued her rapid rise through the ranks with a pillar-to-post victory to earn a massive black-type rosette in her pattern-race debut here.

Bouncing sharply from the gate to assume immediate command, she was stirred into action as the pack loomed large off the home turn and kept on resolutely under a final-furlong drive to bravely hold the late thrusts of stablemate Topaze Blanche and Listed Criterium de l'Ouest victress Alterite by a diminishing buffer.

"This is a dream come true, and I could not envisage a better outcome with both of my fillies finishing first and second," enthused conditioner Carlos Laffon-Parias. "Silasol is a tough filly, and this is a great result for the stable. I hesitated between running her and another [Wertheimer-owned] filly, Single (Fr) (Singspiel {Ire}), who was second in the [G3] Prix d'Aumale, but ultimately I made the correct decision. She was doing well at home and I figured, being by Monsun, that the [heavy] ground would help. She won in good style when making all here last time, and I did not hesitate to tell [jockey] Olivier [Peslier] to repeat the same tactics. She's a nice staying type from a family which includes Arc heroine Solemia, so I think she will be more of an Oaks filly, rather than a Guineas filly next year. The [G1] Prix de Diane could also be an objective for Topaze Blanche and, needless to say, both are now through for the season."

Wizz Kid was the ready winner of the G2 Prix du Gros-Chene at Chantilly for the second consecutive year June 3, but was well below that level when only 10th in the June 19 G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot. She ran a creditable second to Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in the Aug. 5 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 5, and firm ground offered no assistance when sixth in the G1 Betfred Sprint Cup at Haydock Sept. 8 last time.

However, a return to home shores and softer terrain did not help Wizz Kid initially here, as she broke awkwardly and was niggled along towards the rear whilst Inxile (Ire) (Fayruz {GB}) blazed his usual trail up front. Making headway as favored Mayson hit the front at the quarter pole, she was still four lengths down and ridden along as that rival went clear with Hamish McGonagall at the furlong marker. But Gerald Mosse got to work, and Wizz Kid came with a turbo-charged late run to nail that pair close home, even allowing her veteran partner to take it easy in the final strides.

"It's a victory which she deserved as she has been unlucky a couple of times in the big races," said Ballylinch Stud manager John O'Connor. "She was beaten just over a length, but only finished fifth and didn't have a particularly good run in this race last year. Today, everything went her way. She likes a good, fast pace early on, and she finishes well. She's so brave, and maybe the cheekpieces help her to concentrate a little early on. We're delighted for her, and she's a homebred, which is even better." **Cont. p10**

In Lingerie was a 6 1/4-length debut victoress at Turfway Park in January for trainer Stephen Lyster, and was purchased privately by her current connections off that promising unveiling. Second to eventual GI Mother Goose S. winner Zo Impressive (Hard Spun) in a Gulfstream optional claimer a month later, the bay returned to the scene of her debut to annex the GIII Bourbonette Oaks by an emphatic six-length margin. She followed that up with a dirt tally in Pimlico's GII Black-Eyed Susan May 18 before hitting the bench for a brief freshening. Backed down to 3-2 when resurfacing in Saratoga's July 21 GI Coaching Club American Oaks, In Lingerie had to settle for third behind Questing (GB) (Hard Spun) and Zo Impressive. She was no match for the former's nine-length tour-de-force in the Aug. 18 GI Alabama S., but finished eight lengths clear of the third-place finisher.

"We were hopeful [she would run well]," trainer Todd Pletcher said of the winner, who was venturing out of events restricted to sophomores for the first time. "She ran very well at Saratoga against the best 3-year-old fillies in the country and we knew she liked the Polytrack. We were just hoping that she'd transfer that form from Turfway early on. We knew she was training well, so we were optimistic."

As far as a trip to the Breeders' Cup, Pletcher added, "I'll talk to [Eclipse's] Aron [Wellman] and Gary [Barber] and we'll see how she comes out of it and talk about some options. I'd say she's the kind you could look at a couple of different races with."

In Lingerie is out of GII Nassau County S. winner Cat Chat (Storm Cat), a daughter of 1993 champion 2-year-old filly Phone Chatter (Phone Trick). Cat Chat has an unraced 2-year-old by Unbridled's Song, and a pair of Candy Ride (Arg) fillies foaled in 2011 and 2012.

Warren, Jr.'s **Saint Vigeur** (Smart Strike), who was runner-up going this distance at the Spa Aug. 25 in his only prior effort. "I decided to maybe enter some maidens now that they have moved the races to Monday and the weather doesn't look good for the maiden races I was going to enter," explained Brown, alluding to the decision by NYRA to push the Pilgrim and GIII Miss Grillo S. back a day due to a wet forecast that proved accurate yesterday. Yielding turf seems quite likely, which could best suit Team Valor International's **Cerro (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley), who led at every call while going seven furlongs for Marco Botti over good-rated San Siro turf June 3. He's now a member of the Graham Motion barn. **Quinzieme Monarque** (Rock Hard Ten) broke through emphatically when stretched out in his third start last time here Sept. 15. He owns the field's best last-out Beyer Speed Figure of 77 for that graduation tally.

"Taking European horses and transitioning them is one thing, and then you have them at two and trying to do that when they're still inexperienced can be a little tricky, but this horse did everything right all summer at Saratoga," Brown said. "I was surprised at how smooth the transition was for her. She basically acted like she had been here the whole time, which was a pleasant surprise. We were pretty confident when we ran her in the P.G. Johnson, and she came out of the race well." Maidens **Atlantic Dream** (Stormy Atlantic) and **Wave Theory** (Smart Strike) complete the Brown troika. Windmill Manor Farm's **Fly Again** (Fusaichi Pegasus) made a very impressive last-to-first move over seven furlongs of yielding sod here Sept. 9. The Eddie Kenneally trainee counts Grade I winners Cash Run (Seeking the Gold) and Shared Interest (Pleasant Colony) as her second and third dams, respectively.

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Lopresti Pleased with Wise Dan...

Trainer Charles Lopresti indicated yesterday that Saturday's GI Shadwell Turf Mile hero **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) has come out of the race in good order, and is on track for the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita Nov. 3. "It worked out perfect," said Lopresti of Wise Dan's 2 1/4-length victory. "I was concerned going in because of the new rider [Jose Lezcano] and traffic with a lot of horses." Saturday's victory for Wise Dan came three weeks after he took the GI Woodbine Mile. The 5-year-old gelding now owns four graded stakes win at Keeneland, which equals the record set by Take Charge Lady (Dehere) for the most stakes tallies at that track. Lopresti indicated that Wise Dan would likely target the GI Breeders' Cup Mile rather than the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "I am going to talk it over with [owner/breeder Mort] Fink, but we will probably stick with the Mile," Lopresti said. "I am a little concerned about the track out there being a bit loose and speed favoring. For him to run on a track that he never has been on and face a horse like Game on Dude (Awesome Again) that has won over the track would be like throwing him to the wolves."

Pletcher 2-Year-Olds Exit Races in Good Shape...

Saturday's GI Foxwoods Champagne S. winner **Shanghai Bobby** (Harlan's Holiday) and GI Frizette S. winner **Dreaming of Julia** (A.P. Indy) both exited their races in good order according to Whit Beckman, assistant to trainer Todd Pletcher. "Both 2-year-old stakes winners seemed to exit their races in good shape," confirmed Beckman. "They both looked good this morning." Beckman also noted that Stonestreet Stables' Dreaming of Julia will head to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Santa Anita Nov. 2. Plans for Starlight Racing's Shanghai Bobby are undecided. Beckman also issued an upbeat bulletin on **Darwin** (Big Brown), a \$1.3-million Fasig-Tipton Florida 2-year-old purchase who broke his maiden at first asking and earned the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ distinction at Belmont yesterday for Pletcher and owners Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith. "He came out of the race in really good shape," Beckman said. "His race was very impressive. He stepped up and showed he has some ability."

Dullahan Breeders' Cup Bound...

Trainer Dale Romans has attributed the fifth-place finish by **Dullahan** (Even the Score) as the favorite in Saturday's GI Jamaica S. at Belmont to the 3-year-old colt's distaste for soft going. "He has proven to be quite finicky in that regard," said Romans. "If he doesn't get firm ground, whether it's synthetic, dirt or grass, he just doesn't run." Romans noted that the Donegal Racing colorbearer will ship back to Kentucky before heading to Santa Anita for the Breeders' Cup Nov. 3., where he could compete in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic going 1 1/4 miles on the dirt, the GI Breeders' Cup Turf over 1 1/2 miles, or the GI Breeders' Cup Mile on the turf. "We'll take him to California and [Donegal's] Jerry Crawford and I will figure out what to do," said Romans. "The track is the key thing. We'll leave everything open."

Acclamation Out of Breeders' Cup...

Acclamation (Unusual Heat), last year's Eclipse Champion Older Male, has been ruled out of the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 3 by trainer Don Warren on account of a sprain of the horse's left foreleg. "It heated up on me, the sprain that he had a month ago," Warren explained. "He worked good on the training track four or five days ago, but it heated up the next day, so we're going to give up on the Breeders' Cup." Although the 6-year-old will not race again this year, Warren noted that the six-time Grade I winner would "probably" stay at Santa Anita. A winner at the highest level on both turf and synthetic surfaces, Acclamation was unbeaten in two starts this year, in the GI Charles Whittingham H. June 9 and the GI Eddie Read S. July 21.

Live Thoroughbred racing in New Jersey now moves to the Meadowlands in East Rutherford for eight all-turf cards beginning Oct. 12.
