



'HILL' TOPS AT KEENOV

It's a scenario any consignor would hope for, but many might never achieve, to sell a pair of \$4-million plus offerings on a single day. However, John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency hit the mark Wednesday

afternoon at Keeneland November when selling the session-topping **Pure Clan** (Pure Prize) for \$4.5 million and **Changing Skies** (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) for \$4.2 million.

"It's been a great day," said a visibly moved Sikura. "To sell two mares for \$4 million, it has been not only a great day, but a great 2012. I am happy for us as a consignor, but more importantly, I am happy and thankful for the people who gave us their lead horses and had the

confidence in our ability to sell their best mares."

During the second and final session of Book 1, Hill 'n' Dale rounded out the day as the leading consignor, grossing \$11,675,000 for nine sold and 11 offered at an average of \$1,297,222.

"There's a limited number of top-quality mares that come onto the market, and the people that are interested on that level are willing to pay a premium for them," said Keeneland's Director of sales Geoffrey Russell. "It's just supply and demand. There aren't very many Grade I mares out there."

Excluding last's year's Chanteclair dispersal, which sold \$8.5-million Royal Delta (Empire Maker), gross figures fell slightly from \$34,592,000 for 118 sold to \$33,840,000 for 109 this year, while average rose 5.90% to \$310,459 from \$293,153 in 2011. Median decreased from \$215,000 to \$200,000 this year.

"The comments from everybody seemed to be that it was more solid today than yesterday," said Russell.

During yesterday's session, a weanling colt by War Front brought \$800,000 from John McCormack Bloodstock, surpassing a filly by Galileo (Ire) who realized \$625,000 on Day 1, but fell short of last year's session-leading weanling, a colt by Smart Strike, that reeled in a \$1.6-million final bid.

"I thought good babies sold real well, and of course, who wouldn't be happy with the two big mares, added Keeneland's Vice President of Sales Walt Robertson. "But there were also a lot of mares we had some fun with between \$500,000 and \$1 million. I thought it was a pretty good day on all fronts."

Pure Clan Provides the TNT on Day 2...

The 7-year-old **Pure Clan** (Pure Prize) came into the ring yesterday at Keeneland November with impeccable credentials, including a pair of Grade I wins, a G1 Breeders' Cup F/M Turf runner-up finish and a bankroll of nearly \$2 million. She also came in foal to one of the world's best young sires, Bernardini. So it was no surprise that the chestnut proved the hottest commodity during the sale's second session, touching off a bidding duel within the pavilion that ended with a sale-topping \$4.5 million strike from Stud TNT's Goncalo Torrealba.

The Brazilian-based Torrealba, sitting along an aisleway on the far side of the pavilion, outlasted bloodstock agent Lincoln Collins for Pure Clan, the daughter of GSW Gather the Clan (Ire) (General Assembly) who sold from the consignment of John Sikura's Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency as [hip 279](#). The mare is a half to GSW Greater Good (Intidab) and to the dam of GISW Sky Diva (Sky Mesa).

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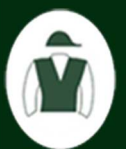

"We just loved her," said Torrealba. "You look at them and you like them or you don't. My people loved her, and we're looking for good mares."

The price exceeds the \$4.2 million that Plum Pretty (Medaglia d'Oro) brought Tuesday and equaled by Changing Skies (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) late yesterday. Pure Clan becomes the top-priced broodmare to sell at November since Changing Skies's full-sister Playful Act (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) brought \$10.5 million in 2007. That excludes last year's \$8.5 million racing prospect Royal Delta (Empire Maker).

Torrealba and his family own Stud TNT, the successful

dual hemisphere racing and breeding operation that has campaigned, among others, the brilliant turf miler Leroidesanimaux (Brz), sire of GI Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom. Stud TNT also bred this year's standout Love and Pride (A.P. Indy), heroine of the GI Personal Ensign S. and GI Zenyatta S., as well as the 2012 Brazilian Group 1 winner Vitoria Olimpica (Brz) (Northern Fleet).

The 52-year-old Torrealba is resident of Rio de Janeiro, where he lives with his wife Corina and children Rafaela, Goncalo Jr., Gabriel and Guilherme. One of Stud TNT's first American Grade I winners, the 1995 GI Hollywood Starlet victress Cara Rafaela (Quiet American), was named after his daughter. Cara Rafaela later gained fame as part of Darley's broodmare band by producing Bernardini (A.P. Indy).

Torrealba boards his mares at Robert Clay's Three Chimneys Farm, and said that Clay would likely take a piece of Pure Clan. "I was thinking we'd bring her to Three Chimneys, and Robert and I are planning on breeding her to some nice horses," he said, adding that the resulting offspring could be sold at auction. "It really depends on what comes out," he added. "The fillies we'll keep for sure. The colts we might bring to the market. I'm really not sure yet. We're trying to build a broodmare band."

Torrealba said his family has a renewed interest in breeding and racing in the U.S. To that end, he's been plenty busy at the November sales. At Fasig-Tipton on Monday, he landed To Honor and Serve's dam **Pilfer** (Deputy Minister), carrying a Bernardini full-sibling to the GI Woodward S. winner, for \$1.95 million; and the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint runner-up **Dust and Diamonds** (Vindication) for \$900,000. At Keeneland, in addition to Pure Clan, he acquired the graded winner **Kitty in a Tizzy** (Tiznow) ([hip 227](#)), selling as a racing or broodmare prospect, for \$385,000; and the graded placed **Secret File** (Smart Strike) ([hip 227](#)), in foal to Eskendereya, for \$220,000.

According to the Breeders' Cup, Torrealba is a former CEO and board member at Grupo Libra, a shipping company started by his grandfather, Wilfred Borges, in 1987. Libra is primarily in the container and oil transportation business and owns and operates the largest container terminal in Brazil. The family also has banking and investment interests.

Pure Clan was raced by Lewis Lakin, but had been sold privately after being retired in 2010 to an undisclosed ownership group. She was being offered by that group. -Lucas Marquardt

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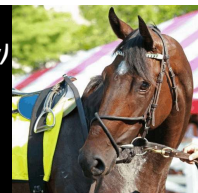

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Skies Open Up at Keeneland...

Approaching the end of Wednesday's final session of Book 1 of the Keeneland November sale, it appeared that the plenty of money was still in the house as Nicholas de Watrigant's Mandore International Agency went to \$4.2 million to secure [Hip 374](#), MGSW **Changing Skies (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells). Consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, the 7-year-old mare sold in foal to Street Cry (Ire).

"It's just a beautiful pedigree and she's very attractive," said Mandore's Benoit Jeffroy, explaining the 7-year-old's appeal. "She's by Sadler's Wells, who is an outstanding sire and she's a good performer herself, a graded stakes winner and Grade I-placed. She's a half-sister to three Group 1 winners and Nathaniel [Galileo {Ire}] was one of the best horses in Europe."

Changing Skies kicked off her career in Europe, where she finished runner-up in the G3 Prix de Psyche before being sent Stateside. Victorious in the GIII La Prevoyante H. and GIII The Very One S. and runner-up in the GI Flower Bowl S., GI New York H. and GIII Grey Goose Bewitch S., the 7-year-old is out of Group 3 winner Magnificent Style. The half-sister to Group 1 winner Siberian Summer is responsible for the top-class trio of Playful Act (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), Nathaniel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) and Great Heavens (GB) (Galileo {Ire}).

"I think she was the best-catalogued mare in the sale," said Hill 'n' Dale's John Sikura, who enjoyed a banner day yesterday. "[Her page has] current active Group 1 individuals replete with high-class horses. She is the complete package, a global mare that shown the highest of form [on the racetrack]. You have commercial success with Playful Act, and top performances recently with Nathaniel."

Hill 'n' Dale also enjoyed earlier success in the sale's ring with another member of the family, with Playful Act drawing \$10,500,000 at the 2007 Keeneland November sale. Both Changing Skies and Playful Act--who remains the second-highest priced mare ever to sell at public auction--were bred Ben Sangster's Swettenham Stud. Additionally, half-sister Distinctive Look (Ire) (Danehill), brought 825,000gns at the Tattersalls December sale in 2007.

"There are very few mares where will find that many Group 1 performers on a page," said Sikura. "She is that kind of unique dam. I want to thank Ben Sangster for letting me sell her," said Sikura. "We had great success selling Playful Act, and we now have another top mare that sold really well."



At the conclusion of yesterday's session, Hill 'n' Dale sold a total of nine head for a gross of \$11,675,000. Six of 10 offered realized over \$300,000, including City to City (City Zip), who brought \$550,000 from SF Bloodstock; and a colt by Lookin at Lucky out of Yesterday (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who realized \$500,000 from Badgers Bloodstock. Sikura, who was visibly pleased with the day's proceedings, admitted he was a little surprised the mare didn't head the day.

"She is just a queen, just a magnificent mare," he said. "Heading in to the sale, we thought she would top the sale. Purely from a pedigree point of view, she was a unique offering. It was a tremendous amount of money for a great mare. But from a physical standpoint, Pure Clan [who brought \$4.5 million yesterday] was unmatched. Physically, this mare was a bit of an acquired taste. We had many fine European judges that said, 'that mare looks exactly like what we want to see by that sire.' Now, if you get a North American breeder, they see a mare that is 16.2 [hands] and a big, round hip, they might find her a bit too this way or that way. Everybody whom I spoke to that buys quality fillies of that type said she was exactly what you want to look for. So, that gave me lots of ease. Obviously, the high-end guys were bidding. It was a great result."

The filly bore a strong resemblance to Rachel Alexandra, being a sleek, racy-looking bay with some white on her face. "[But] she doesn't quite have the crazy eye that Rachel does," Banke said. "She's not totally perfect, but we liked a lot of what we saw. A lot of the pieces are there. She's got a little sesamoiditis, so we'll give her a little time here and then send her [to be broken in] Florida, and we'll see how we do."

Both horses were produced by the 11-year-old mare Lotta Kim (Roar), a SW & GSP homebred runner for Morrison.

Banke said she the price might well have gone higher had the filly not been suffering from a "bit of sesamoiditis." She said, "That tends to put people off. Obviously it would put me off a little bit, too, if I wasn't so familiar with her full-sister." Cont. p9

Twelve hips later, Banke and her bloodstock advisor John Moynihan were bank in the mix for another horse with close ties to Stonestreet, the broodmare Moonlight Sonata (Carson City), who they secured from the Mill Ridge Sales consignment for \$750,000. Moonlight Sonata, [hip 255](#), is the dam of two graded winners, including Wilburn (Bernardini). Stonestreet purchased Wilburn for a sale-topping \$625,000 at Keeneland April in 2010 and campaigned him to a win in the 2011 GII Indiana Derby. Moonlight Sonata, currently in foal to Bernardini, is also the dam of GSW Beethoven (Sky Mesa).

"She's carrying a full-sibling to Wilburn, and she gets pretty foals," said Moynihan. "She's one we can have for a few years, and hopefully we'll get some nice ones out of her."

Moynihan said 2013 breeders plans were undecided. Asked about the market in general, he said, "For the good stuff, it's very strong." -Lucas Marquardt

Eaton's Way...

Eaton Sales had a strong showing at Wednesday's session, with a pair of offerings bringing \$800,000, including the leading weanling of the day, a colt by War Front. Sent into the ring immediately after the ultimate session-topping Pure Clan (Pure Prize) wowed the crowd with a \$4.5-million final price, [hip 280](#) far surpassed the second-highest-priced youngster of the day, a colt by Lookin At Lucky out of Yesterday (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) that brought \$500,000. The War Front was purchased by agent John McCormack, while Badgers Bloodstock bought the Lookin At Lucky.

"I just loved the colt when he first came on the grounds," Eaton's Reiley McDonald said about the session topper. "He just had the physical look, you add in War Front and his female family, I thought this colt could really break out some. At that point, you wonder if he is worth \$500,000 or \$1 million? He sold really well at \$800,000. War Front colts, in the long run, are going to be what everybody is looking for."

The Apr. 25 foal is out of the Seeking the Gold mare Questress, is already responsible for dual Grade I-winning sprinter Pomeroy (Boundary) and Gold Vault (Arch), the dam of Grade I winner Contested (Ghostzapper), who brought \$2.3 million at the Fasig-Tipton November sale Monday night.

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"I saw him a month ago, and he was just a little immature at that time, but he had this big, lovely walk," McDonald said. "He is beautifully balanced with a good shoulder and hind end."

Also realizing the same amount later in the session was [Hip 207](#), **Gracious Gift** (Giant's Causeway), out of champion 3-year-old filly Heavenly Prize (Seeking the Gold). The unraced sophomore, in foal to Distorted Humor, was purchased for \$800,000 by Japanese-based KI Farm. An eight-time Grade I winner, Heavenly Prize, a full-sister to Grade I winner Oh What A Windfall, is also responsible for dual Grade I winner Good Reward (Storm Cat), GSW Pure Prize (Storm Cat) and stakes winner Cosmic (El Prado {Ire}).

"She was a good mix for the day," said McDonald. "She is an unraced mare, but is from an outstanding Phipps family. Those horses don't become available very often."

The mare represented the highest-priced purchase for Japanese interests during the sale's second session.

"She was purchased by a Japanese buyer that hasn't really had that kind of access to this kind of pedigree. So that's why she was so appealing to them," said McDonald. "I thought several of the Japanese buyers were very aggressive this year, and they were last year as well. Their racing business is thriving."

While responsible for selling the top weanling in Book 1, McDonald indicated that the market for youngster proved tough this year.

"The sticky part of the sale, at least from my perspective, was the foals," admitted McDonald. "The really good ones sold brilliantly, but there some weanlings that would have been easy to sell last year, but the market really tightened up."

Despite the difficulties in the weanling market, McDonald felt things were better for the broodmares.

"I think there is plenty of money for the good mares," said McDonald. "Especially the high-end mares which sold in a huge way. The upper-middle mares, the \$300-\$500,000 range, have sold very well. There has been a market for that type of mare. The weanling market has contracted a little bit because for one thing, the pinhookers haven't had as good a year turning them over as yearlings as they have had in the past, and they are being much more cautious. Secondly, there aren't end-users here. So there is a very contracted demand for the foals."

During Wednesday's session, Eaton Sales sold a total of 19 head for a gross of \$5.5 million and an average of \$289,474. -C Bossinakis

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Lookin At Lucky foal sells for \$500,000...

A colt from the first crop of two-time U.S. champion Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike) sold to Badgers Bloodstock, agent, for \$500,000, the second-highest priced weanling at Tuesday's session. Catalogued as [hip 346](#), the colt is out of Irish champion 3-year-old filly Yesterday (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent, consigned the youngster. Badgers Bloodstock principal Grant Pritchard-Gordon said the colt was bought for a client who wished to remain anonymous for now.

"I think he's got the looks of his father. He's got a good walk on him, and we thought he was a very nice individual," Pritchard-Gordon said. "This colt will go to Europe."

The colt was bred in Kentucky by Richard Henry's Premier Bloodstock. Henry is an associate of the Coolmore partners, who stand Lookin At Lucky at Ashford Stud. He also bred Yesterday. Pritchard-Gordon said he thinks Lookin At Lucky is a promising stallion, while he really loved the female side of the weanling's pedigree.

"I love the sire. Lookin At Lucky was a champion at two and a Classic winner and champion at three. He's the best horse Bob Baffert has trained, and he's by Smart Strike," Pritchard-Gordon said. "We bought a full sister to Yesterday for top price at Newmarket two years ago. This is an amazing female line. We just love this family."

Badgers Bloodstock bought Yesterday's unraced full sister Song (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) for 1.7-million guineas at the 2009 Tattersalls December sale. Yesterday raced for a Coolmore partnership that included Henry. In addition to her victory in the GI Irish One Thousand Guineas in 2003, Yesterday was second in the G1 Epsom Oaks. She ran in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf twice, finishing third to Islington at Santa Anita in 2003 and fifth behind Ouija Board at Lone Star in 2004. The Lookin At Lucky colt is her fourth foal.

Pair of Hollendorfer Fillies Brings the Bucks...

A pair of Grade II winners trained and co-owned by Jerry Hollendorfer--**Capital Plan** (Rock Hard Ten--Miss Dahlia, by Strawberry Road {Aus}) and **City to City** (City Zip--Stormbow, by Storm Cat)--sold as breeding prospects for a combined \$1,375,000 at Keeneland November Wednesday. Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency, agent, consigned both, catalogued as [hip 368](#) and [hip 375](#), respectively. Frank Stronach's Adena Springs Farm bought 4-year-old Capital Plan for \$825,000. Eric Hamelback, general manager of Adena Springs Kentucky, said Capital

"Frank of course goes through the catalogue. Unfortunately, he wasn't able to be here, but he was very impressed with the pedigree," Hamelback said.

"Obviously she could run quite well. Physically we graded her very high. We all loved the way she looked and felt very strongly she would be well-bought at whatever price we would be able to get her. She will go into the broodmare band at this time until Frank makes a decision on the breeding."

Bred in Kentucky by Madeleine A. Pickens and Diamond A Racing Corp., Capital Plan is out of unraced Miss Dahlia, herself a daughter of the great Dahlia (*Vaguely Noble). Donato Lanni, bloodstock agent for Glen Hill Farm, bought Capital Plan for \$50,000 at the 2009 Keeneland September sale. Hollendorfer and Mark DeDomenico purchased Capital Plan privately after her maiden win in her third start in August 2011. She went on to win the GII Santa Barbara H. and the GIII Beverly Hills H. for her new owners. She retired with five wins and earnings of \$305,800 from 12 starts.

SF Bloodstock bought City to City for \$550,000. The 5-year-old mare was a four-time Grade II winner, including the Buena Vista and John C. Mabee Handicaps this year for owners William DeBurgh, Hollendorfer, and DeDomenico. She won eight times and earned \$729,726 in 31 starts. City to City was bred in Kentucky by Dr. D. Michael Cavey Jr. DeDomenico bought her for \$50,000 at the 2008 Washington Thoroughbred Breeders Association's September yearling sale. -Pete Denk

Shadwell Nabs Six Weanlings Wednesday...

After buying just a single weanling during Tuesday's opening session, a \$410,000 Quality Road--Charming Tale from Hunter Valley Farm, Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell Estate Company came away with six youngsters yesterday. The two most expensive each brought \$400,000. First up was [hip 253](#), a More Than Ready--Miss Lavinia (Speightstown) colt from Indian Creek, agent. Co-bred by Indian Creek and Santucket Stables, the colt is the second foal from his dam, a half to the 2010 GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Fillies heroine More Than Real (More Than Ready). [Hip 364](#), a colt by Harlan's Holiday--Breathtaking (Mineshaft), later matched that price. By the same sire as recent GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero Shanghai Bobby, the colt was bred and consigned by William B. Harrigan. His dam is a daughter of GISW Oh What a Windfall (Seeking the Gold), herself a full to champion Heavenly Prize.

"He was an early February foal, and just a really nice colt," said Harrigan. "We're thrilled with the sale, and really pleased with where he's going. Shadwell is such a wonderful outfit, and he'll get every chance to become a racehorse. And I think we were in the middle of a perfect storm, with Shanghai Bobby winning the Breeders' Cup Juvenile."

Shadwell's outlay for its seven Keeneland November yearlings stands at \$2.37 million, for an average price of \$338,571. Shadwell did not buy any weanlings at Fasig-Tipton. Also active for weanlings on Wednesday was Peter O'Callaghan's Woods Edge Farm, which acquired four head for \$700,000--an average of \$175,000. The Woods Edge buys were led by [hip 283](#), a \$240,000 War Front--Rag and Bone (Street Cry {Ire}) colt from Michael T. Barnett's Blackburn Farm. -Lucas Marquardt

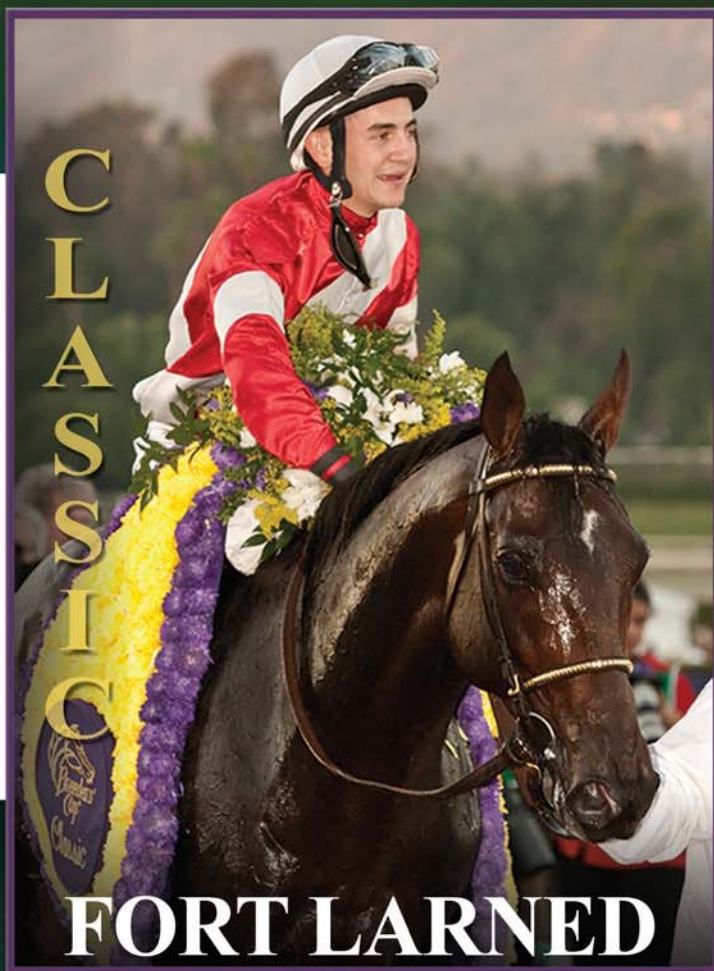

"He still has room for improvement, which is a scary thing." Magic City and McPeck also campaign GI Travers S. dead-heater Golden Ticket (Speightstown).

Hernandez to Ride at Gulfstream Park...

Fresh off the heels of a huge weekend, Brian Hernandez Jr. has announced that he'll be riding at Gulfstream Park this winter. The 27-year-old, who put a masterful ride on Fort Larned (E Dubai) in a thrilling renewal of the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, usually rode at Fair Grounds following the conclusion of the Churchill Downs fall meet. "I talked it over with (agent) Frank (Bernis) Tuesday and he was already thinking about it," Hernandez said. "It makes sense to go now. We can walk into any barn and say, 'Hey, we won the Breeders' Cup Classic.' Now is the best time to go." Hernandez also guided Neck 'n Neck (Flower Alley) to victory in Friday's GIII Ack Ack H. at Churchill. "Fort Larned and Neck 'n Neck are both going and we want to follow them," Hernandez said. "We also want to try to pick up some other business."

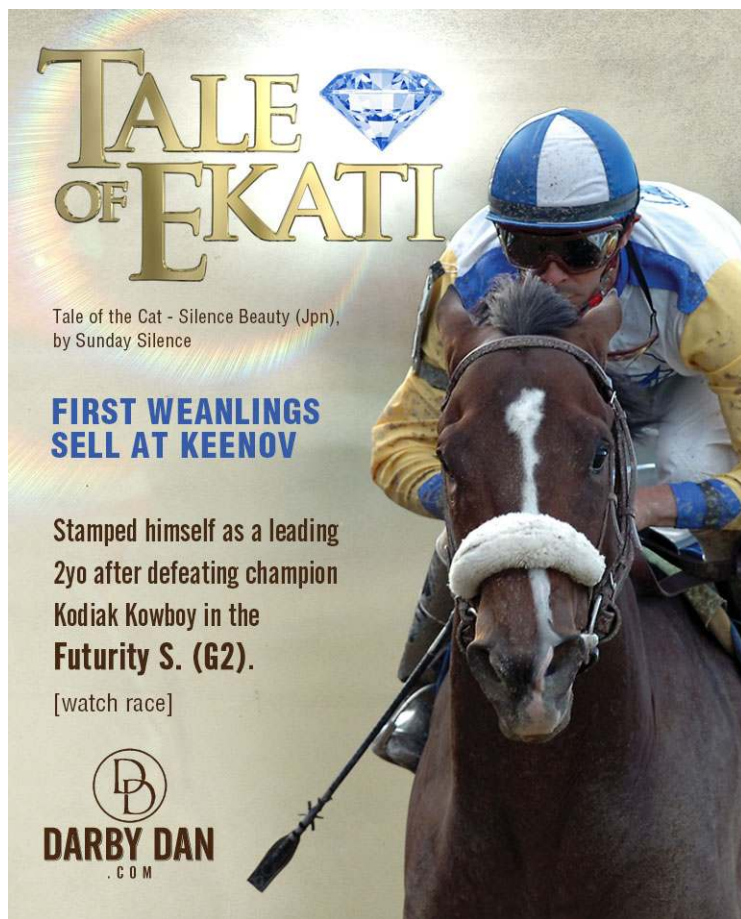

Oaklawn Bans Hawthorne Horses:

Edited Press Release

With its stable area set to open Monday, Nov. 12, Oaklawn announced Wednesday that it will ban all horses from Hawthorne in response to the growing number of horses there being diagnosed with the highly contagious Equine Herpes Virus (EHV-1).

Working in conjunction with Arkansas State Racing Commission veterinarian Dr. Joseph Lokanc and Association veterinarian Dr. Lee Cyphers, Oaklawn has updated its policy regarding EHV-1.

The policy states:

"Any horse (both Thoroughbreds and ponies) that originates from Hawthorne Race Course or horses which have been on the grounds of Hawthorne Race Course for any reason during the most recent 28 days will not be allowed in the Oaklawn stable area. In addition, all horses (both Thoroughbreds and ponies) entering the Oaklawn stable area must have a current health certificate which shows vaccination for EHV-1 not more than 60 days old and not less than 14 days old prior to their arrival. Horsemen are encouraged to contact their practicing veterinarian or Arkansas State Racing Commission veterinarian Dr. Joe Lokanc if they have any questions. Dr. Lokanc can be reached at (630) 632-1601."

"We hope to lift the ban well before our live race meet, but we have to make the safety of all the horses entering the Oaklawn barn area our top priority," said Assistant General Manager of Racing David Longinotti. "We will continue to monitor the situation closely and will rely on advice from both Dr. Lokanc and Dr. Cyphers."

Oaklawn's barn area opens Monday, Nov. 12 and the track opens for training the following Monday, Nov. 19. The 2013 race meet begins Friday, Jan. 11.

HORSE PAC-SUPPORTED CANDIDATES HAVE STRONG SHOWING ON ELECTION DAY

Federal candidates receiving contributions from Horse PAC, the NTRA's bipartisan Political Action Committee, won 91 percent of their races in this week's general election. Horse PAC-supported candidates won 35 of 37 House races and five of seven Senate races.

Horse PAC disburses directly to individual candidates and/or to their leadership PACs or other PACs that support candidates. During the 2011-2012 election cycle, Horse PAC disbursed a total of \$416,500 to candidates and PACs in 25 states. Kentucky-based candidates and PACs received \$85,000 in Horse PAC funds. Other leading states included New York (\$54,500), California (\$30,000), Louisiana (\$27,500) and Florida, Texas and Michigan (all at \$25,000).

Horse PAC supports federal political candidates who serve on Congressional committees that oversee matters pertaining to livestock and agriculture issues, Internet gaming, taxation, immigration and the Interstate Horseracing Act; are established Congressional leaders; understand horse racing's issues; have racetracks, breeding farms, training centers and ADWs in their states; are members of the Congressional Horse Caucus; or are emerging leaders meriting early support in their legislative careers.
