Besilu Stables' recently crowned champion older female **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker), last seen putting an exclamation point on her 4-year-old season with a game victory in the G1 Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Santa Anita Nov. 2, punched her ticket to the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 30 with an effortless five-length victory over **All for Thee** (Elusive Quality) in Gulfstream's GIII Sabin S. WILLIAM REID LIKELY FOR CAVIAR

Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) has the G1 William Reid S. as her probable next target, trainer Peter Moody revealed yesterday. Following the 6-year-old's 23rd success in Saturday's G1 Lightning S. at Flemington, the six-furlong contest at Moonee Valley Mar. 22 appears to be taking precedence over a return to the G1 Newmarket H. that she won two years ago at Flemington Mar. 9. "The realistic next option is the William Reid," Moody told Melbourne radio yesterday. "But I'm mindful the Newmarket is a great race on her favourite track. No doubt she appreciates racing in a straight line." Managing part-owner Neil Werrett told the *Sydney Morning Herald*, "That win opened up a lot more opportunities for her. She is back bigger and stronger and maybe even better than she was before. It's incredible really." While the William Reid is a weight-for-age event, the Newmarket would mean that she would have to give several pounds to all rivals in the race in which she set a weight-carrying record for a mare and a new race record in 2011.

SHAKE AND BAKE

Dennis Cardoza and Mike Pegram's **Shakin It Up** (Midnight Lute), a close third in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. most recently Nov. 22, gamely split horses in the stretch and kicked for home nicely to annex Sunday's GII San Vicente S. at Santa Anita. "I really don't know [what race might be next]," trainer Bob Baffert said of Shakin It Up, who was produced by an unraced daughter of Pegram's two-time champion Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy). "He was sort of fresh today. I didn't really have him super-cranked up for the race, but we've always thought highly of him, so we'll just find something for him." **Cont. p4**

TEAM PLETCHER OUT IN FULL FORCE SUNDAY

A number of trainer Todd Pletcher's high-profile sophomores peppered the worktab at Palm Meadows Sunday. Black Rock Stables's G1 CashCall Futurity winner **Violence** (Medaglia d'Oro) shared the five-furlong bullet for a 1:00.36 clocking with workmate **Palace Malice** (Curlin). The former is expected to run in Gulfstream's GII Besilu Stables Fountain of Youth S. Saturday, while the latter will ship to Fair Grounds for the GII Risen Star S. the same day. "I'm very, very pleased with his work," Pletcher said of Violence. "He galloped out strongly, came back well. He's ready to go." Also out Sunday was champion 2-year-old **Shanghai Bobby** (Harlan's Holiday), last seen finishing second in the Jan. 26 GIII Holy Bull S. "It was his first work back, a nice easy half (in :49.73)," Pletcher said. "I thought he worked great. His energy level is good." The Starlight Racing and Coolmore colorbearer is being pointed to the G1 Besilu Stables Florida Derby Mar. 30. 🌟 **"TDN Rising Star" 🌟 Verrazano** (More Than Ready), who is coming off a 16 1/4-length allowance romp in Hallandale Feb. 2, went in :48.05 for four furlongs as he eyes the GII Tampa Bay Derby Mar. 9. "He was awesome this morning," beamed Pletcher. The prolific conditioner also has Stonestreet Stables's **Dreaming of Julia** (A.P. Indy), who will make her seasonal debut in the GII Davona Dale S. Saturday. "She worked super," Pletcher said of a 1:00.62 breeze Sunday. "She's ready to go."

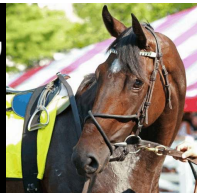

Off just a step slow after hopping at the start, ★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Royal Delta recovered quickly to vie for command while racing on the outside on the clubhouse turn. With regular pilot Mike Smith in the irons, she enjoyed a narrow advantage over All for Thee through an opening quarter in :24.06. The champ began to give them the slip following a half mile in :47.44, and did it all within herself with little encouragement from her rider to win for fun. "A sigh of relief--I'm glad it's over," trainer Bill Mott revealed after getting his picture taken. "I'm happy the way everything went coming in. She came into the race great. She worked well. Obviously, we have more to do, but it's a great way to start. I've seen horses that were 1-9 and didn't perform that way. It's good to see her continue on the same path." Smith, also the regular rider of the brilliant Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}), has been aboard Royal Delta in her last six races. "She wasn't the best coming out of the gate, but it was her first start in a while and I was able to stay on," Smith said. "Bill said he's going to work with her a lot more in the gate, so I'm sure she'll be better in her next race. It's just so exciting to have her back. She's such a special horse and to have her back again is great." Royal Delta is scheduled to head back to Dubai Mar. 17. She was a disappointing ninth in the big one at Meydan last year. "I want to get her there and do as well going into the race as she did last year," Mott added. "If she can do that, we'll be in OK shape. We're going to run against some of the best horses in the world. This is not going to be an easy task. It's a tough journey and a very tough race."

Working well for his first start since the Prevue, Shakin It Up raced within striking distance on the inside in fifth through an opening quarter in :22.88. With David Flores aboard, he awaited racing room as they straightened out for home, split horses as they began to bunch up in the

stretch, and turned on the after-burners while never seriously threatened by the late rally of Treasury Bill. "He put me in the race right away, so I just had to be patient and wait for the pocket to open, and that's pretty much what happened," Flores said. "When I asked him to go he accelerated, a tremendous acceleration."

SOUTHWEST RUNS THROUGH BAFFERT BARN

Bob Baffert swept both divisions of last year's GIII Southwest S. with Castaway (Street Sense) and Secret Circle (Eddington), and the Hall of Fame trainer heads back to Hot Springs with this year's 7-5 morning-line favorite in **Super Ninety Nine** (Pulpit). Second in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 22 after getting scratched the morning of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint, the Tanma Corporation colorbearer was a disappointing fourth as the 4-5 favorite in a Santa Anita allowance Dec. 28. Stretched to a mile in an \$80,000 optional claimer Jan. 31, Super Ninety Nine got back on track in a big way, earning a career-high 100 Beyer Speed Figure while scoring by 3 1/4 lengths ([video](#)). Alex and Joann Lieblong's **Big Lute** (Midnight Lute) dives right into the deep end following an impressive six-furlong debut win over this course Feb. 1 ([video](#)). The \$275,000 KEESEP yearling purchase fired a four-furlong bullet in :47 Feb. 11. **Will Take Charge** (Unbridled's Song) returns after posting a narrow decision over **Texas Bling** (Too Much Bling) and **Always in a Tiz** (Tiznow) in this track's Smarty Jones Jan. 21 ([video](#)).

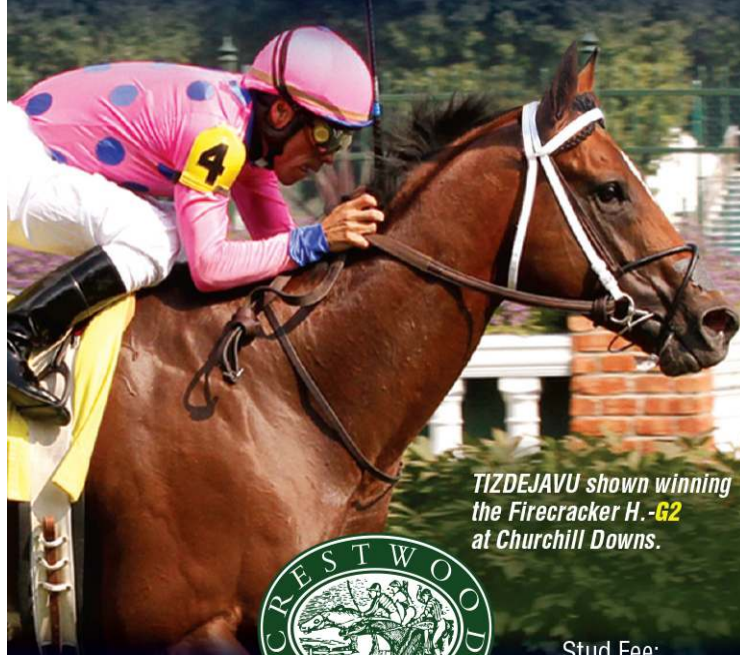

"I thought he went super, and we definitely plan to enter [the Fountain of Youth]," trainer Graham Motion said of the Jan. 26 local allowance winner who had previously been expected to resurface in the turf. GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 3. "As long as he gets a decent post position, we'll run. If he draws

lousy, we won't run him. We'll go back to our original plan and run him in the Palm Beach." The bay, who counts legendary swimmer Michael Phelps among his partners, will run in the Mar. 23 Spiral at Turfway regardless of which race at Gulfstream he goes in. As to what went into the potential change of plans, Motion explained, "I'd say partly because we saw so many of these horses skipping it. You also have to bear in mind, when you start thinking about the points and all that, you don't want to put your eggs in one basket and wait for the one race in Kentucky." The Palm Beach does not offer any points towards the new Kentucky Derby qualifying system.

Speak Logistics FOY-Bound...

Hardaway Stables's **Speak Logistics** (High Cotton), fourth last time in Tampa's GIII Sam F. Davis S. Feb. 2, will join the GII Besilu Stables Fountain of Youth S. cast. "The timing is right," said trainer Eddie Plesa, Jr., who also conditions GIII Holy Bull S. hero Itsmyluckyday (Lawyer Ron). A winner of Calder's In Reality S. last October, the bay was seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 3. "After the Breeders' Cup we gave him five weeks off on the farm in Ocala," Plesa noted.
