win, in the 2011 G1 Prix Ganay, out of 12 tries at the highest level and hit the board when third to Monterosso (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) in last term's World Cup when racing in the colors of Ahmed Al Falasi.

"Sheikh Joaan wanted to compete in the Dubai World Cup with a good horse," bloodstock agent Nicolas de Watrigant told the *TDN's*

sister publication, *Jour de Galop*. "Planteur finished third in the event last year, having not run since September 2011, and trainer Marco Botti thinks he is even better than 2012."

Planteur opened this term with a victory in the Feb. 23 Listed Winter Derby Trial S., breaking Lingfield's 10-furlong track record in the process. Jockey Ryan Moore has been booked to ride for a second time, having partnered the Wildenstein-bred in the \$10-million contest last year.

"Planteur has been sold to Sheikh Joaan to stay in the yard and will run in his colours in the Dubai World Cup," Botti told *Racing Post*. "The new owner was looking for a ready-made Dubai World Cup contender, and there aren't many that can be bought just before the race. I am delighted to welcome another new owner into the yard."

MORE CAVIAR AT SEVEN?

On the eve of her attempt to equal Kingston Town (Aus)'s record of 14 Group 1 victories in tomorrow's G1 William Reid S. at Moonee Valley, rumors are circulating that **Black Caviar (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) could remain in training beyond the current racing season. "She's been well looked after, well-managed, patiently guided by her owners," trainer Peter Moody told *Australian Associated Press* after Black Caviar galloped Tuesday. "I think she's going as good as ever. Maybe there is another season in her." Still, Moody is approaching Friday night's race as the supermare's last appearance in Victoria. "That's probably the way we're approaching it. But once again, you never say never," Moody told *AAP*. Black Caviar's Tuesday morning trackwork, expected at 4 a.m., didn't come off without a small hitch, however. "[Jockey Luke] Nolen slept in," Moody told *AAP*. "He obviously felt he didn't need the practice. He must think he's riding well enough."

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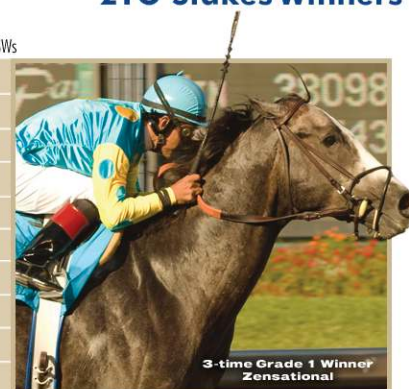

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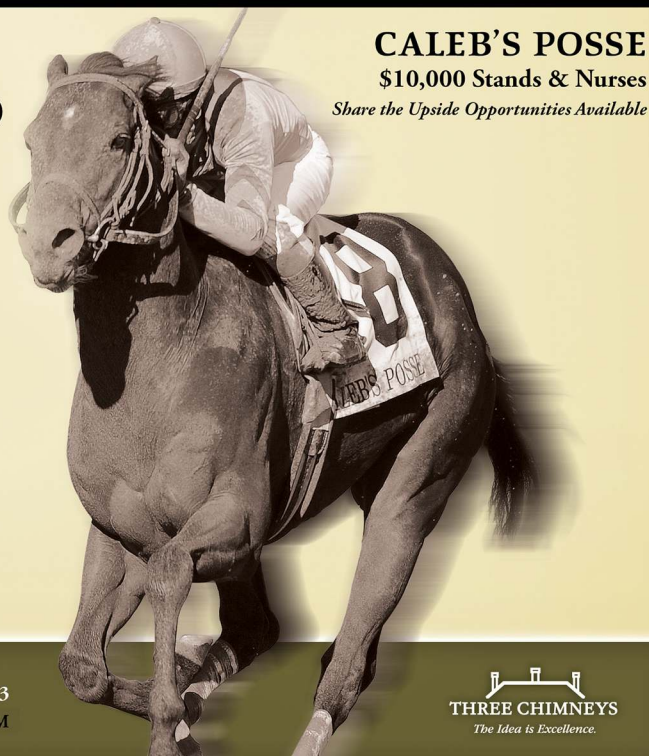

making his Group 1 debut, Lord Kanaloa turned the tables on that foe in the G1 Sprinters' S. last Sept. 30, then became the first Japanese horse to win the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 9. Given some time off thereafter, the bay returned to action with a narrow victory

in the G3 Hankyu Hai at Hanshin Feb. 24. "To win the Takamatsunomiya Kinen at Chukyo Racecourse, you need both speed and stamina, which is why we had him start off the season with the Hankyu Hai at Hanshin over 1,400 meters," trainer Takayuki Yasuda said.

"We made sure he wasn't overworked in the training ahead of the race, and while he was a little slow to quicken on the third and fourth turns, he finished pretty strong. I think he'll be in the best shape possible for the race. I'm convinced his performance will be nothing short of outstanding." The main competition is expected to come from **San Carlo (Jpn)** (Symboli Kris S), runner-up in this in 2011 and 2012. He is exiting a fourth in the Hankyu Hai. "We managed to find space down the stretch where we were hoping to keep up with Lord Kanaloa [in the Hankyu Hai], but he pulled away," commented jockey Yutaka Yoshida. "But our goal for the spring has always been to win the Takamatsunomiya Kinen, not the Hankyu Hai. If he sheds a little bit more weight, he should be much better. We're looking forward to it."

RECORD PURSES FOR ROYAL ASCOT

Prize money at Royal Ascot will be a record £5 million this year, representing an 11% increase on 2012, and the track has also announced that the [G2] Windsor Forest S. has been renamed as the Duke of Cambridge S. As well as reaching the £5-million milestone for the first time, annual prize money for all races in 2013 will be in excess of £13 million.

Johnny Weatherby, Her Majesty's representative at Ascot, commented, "We are delighted to be able to announce these prizemoney increases today and a £5-million Royal Meeting is a real milestone for the country's flagship flat race meeting. We are also naturally thrilled that Her Majesty The Queen has graciously consented to renaming the Windsor Forest in honour of her grandson [William], The Duke of Cambridge."

Charles Barnett, Ascot's Chief Executive, added, "We have worked hard to make the international races competitive globally in recent years and our focus this year has been to enhance the top 3-year-old races, the feature handicaps, the 2-year-old championships and the programme generally. It is very important to us to have a significant minimum amount on offer, and we have set that at £60,000.

We have seen some remarkable racing at Ascot in recent years and, whilst the importance of winning at Royal Ascot, both in terms of prestige and in value to the bloodstock industry, can't be denied, increasing prize money is equally crucial to attracting the best horses to run in a highly competitive market. The top four horses in the world last year on official ratings--Frankel (GB), Cirrus des Aigles (Fr), Black Caviar (Aus) and Excelebration (Ire)--all ran at Ascot.

ELIZA PARK FOR SALE

Eliza Park Stud, which encompasses six Australian properties and shares and standing rights in 14 stallions, will be offered for public auction by William Inglis. The closing tender date is Apr. 26. Eliza Park stands 10 stallions in Victoria, including Black Caviar (Aus)'s sire Bel Esprit (Aus), and four stallions in Queensland.

"As a third generation breeder, Eliza Park is the culmination of a life-long ambition, although when starting out I never imagined it would grow to what it is now," Eliza Park's principal Lee Fleming said in announcing the sale. "It is with somewhat mixed emotions that I've made the decision to offer the stud for tender. I'm immensely proud of Eliza Park's diversity, its continued growth and its position as one of the nation's top Thoroughbred operations, but this has been in the planning for some time.

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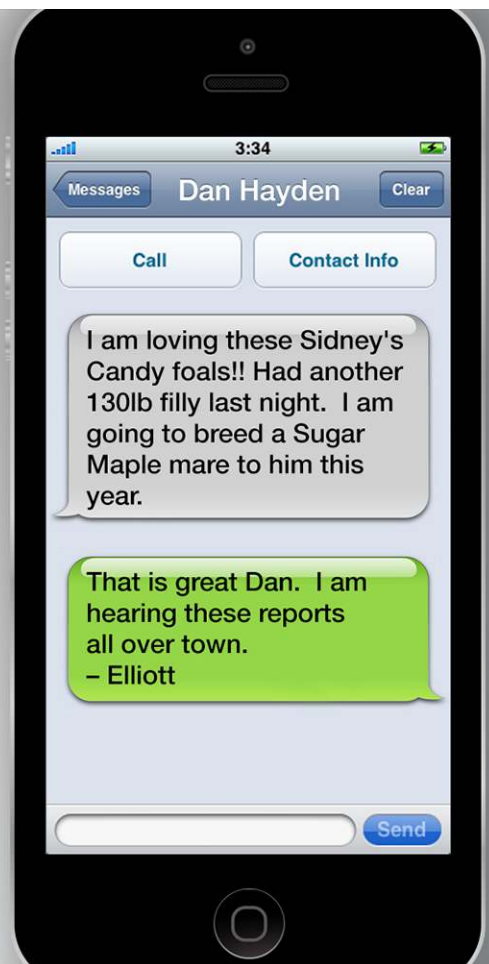

LEGISLATION WOULD REDUCE CAPITAL GAINS HOLDING PERIOD FOR HORSES

Congressman Andy Barr (R-KY) introduced the Equine Tax Parity Act (H.R. 998) earlier this month. If passed, the legislation would reduce the capital gains holding period for horses from 24 months to 12 months. It has been referred to the House Committee on Ways and Means.

Unlike most business assets that must be held for more than one year before gains from their sale are eligible for a lower capital gains tax rate, horses must be held for at least two years before the more favorable capital gains rate applies. This legislation would create parity between horses and most other business assets.

"The legislation I have introduced would finally eliminate a 44-year-old tax provision that discourages investment in the equine industry, bringing much needed relief to an economic sector that supports 1.4 million full-time jobs," said Barr.

"This change to the capital gains tax treatment of horses will make investment in Thoroughbred racing and breeding stock more attractive," said Alex Waldrop, President and CEO of the NTRA. "Our industry thanks Congressman Barr for his commitment to this important tax-fairness issue."
