CAVIAR AS GOOD AS EVER FOR SMITH

Trainer Peter Moody is hesitant to say that **Black Caviar** (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) can improve on her recent victories in the G1 Black Caviar Lightning S. Feb. 16, achieved in course-record time, and under the Moonee Valley lights in the G1 William Reid S. Mar. 22. That being said, Moody clearly wouldn't swap places with anyone and virtually assured that the supermare will take her record to 25 from 25 in Saturday's G1 T J Smith S. at Royal Randwick. "Facts and figures suggest there's not another horse on the planet that can beat her under these conditions over this distance," Moody said in an interview Thursday. Although he is taking nothing for granted, Moody is looking at possible next starts in Brisbane or Adelaide and even a return trip to Royal Ascot, though added that any start could be her last. **Hay List** (Aus) (Statue of Liberty) has finished second to Black Caviar on each of the four previous occasions they have met, including in this event in 2011, where he was defeated 2 3/4 lengths. The 7-year-old emerged from the shadow of Black Caviar to win the 2012 G1 Newmarket H., but went missing for 358 days off a defeat at long odds-on in the 2012 Reid. He resumed with a useful fourth in the G2 Challenge S. Mar. 16 and can improve, but will need that in abundance. **Bel Sprinter** (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) is a place candidate if he can reproduce his last, an upset victory in the G1 Galaxy S. Let It 'Ry'de...

Ryduilluc (Medaglia d'Oro) carries outstanding grass form into this synthetic debut and is a good bet to run his race, providing he can work out a trip from the 13 hole. Well back in a main-track maiden behind Delhomme (Dixie Union) at Belmont last October, Ryduilluc has won his three tries since changing surfaces, including an easy win last time in the GIII Palm Beach S. Mar. 3 at Gulfstream. Trainer Gary Contessa opted for this over the Spiral to give the colt a bit more time. **Java's War** (War Pass) could give his sire a pair of Derby contenders. Third in the Breeders' Futurity here last fall, he ran a bang-up race to be closest to Verrazano (More Than Ready) in the GII Tampa Bay Derby last time Mar. 9 and can go even better in his second seasonal appearance. Longshot players could do worse than **Tesseron** (Tapit). A close second in the GIII Grey S. over the Woodbine Poly Oct. 7, he was a decent fourth in the Kentucky Jockey Club and filled the same spot behind Spiral winner Black Onyx (Rock Hard Ten) in a Gulfstream turf allowance Feb. 23.

A Winning Conundrum...

Though horses like Thunder Gulch (1995) and Street Sense (2007) emerged victorious on the first Saturday in May despite Blue Grass defeats, you have to go all the way back to Strike the Gold in 1991 for the last horse to successfully complete the double.

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NO LUCK OF THE DRAW FOR OXBOW

For the fifth time in his last six starts, Calumet Farm's **Oxbow** (Awesome Again) has been marooned in a post position of 10 or higher and has the outside box facing nine fellow sophomores in today's GI Arkansas Derby. A longshot fourth to the now-retired Violence (Medaglia

d'Oro) in the GI CashCall Futurity last December, the colt, out of a full sister to Tiznow, has done very little wrong in 2013, but has just an 11 1/2-length win in January's GII Lecomte S. to show for it. Still his speed figures have managed to inch forward, despite

finishing fourth in the blanket finish in a much-criticized running of the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 22 and by a head to stable companion Will Take Charge (Unbridled's Song) in the GII Rebel S. here Mar. 16. Gary Stevens gets aboard for the first time--Stevens and Lukas have teamed to win the Kentucky Derby with Winning Colors (1988) and Thunder Gulch (1995)--and the key will be the trip, as there are several other speed types in the field.

New Shooter Declaring War...

It took Baffert until last year with Bodemeister (Empire Maker) to knock out his first Arkansas Derby, and he's back with a live shot in the form of Smith, Tabor and Magnier's progressive **War Academy** (Giant's Causeway). The \$450,000 Keeneland September purchased defeated the well-respected Treasury Bill (Lemon Drop Kid) sprinting at Hollywood Nov. 9, then finished fourth of six behind stablemate Shakin It Up (Midnight Lute) in the GII San Vicente S. over seven furlongs Feb. 17. He stretched out to a route of ground Mar. 15 and pulled away to beat barnmate Manando (Bluegrass Cat) by a convincing margin, earning a field-best 99 Beyer Speed Figure in the process. He is favorably drawn in two for 2005 Derby-winning rider Mike Smith and should be in the thick of it. Baffert's other entrant, the remarkably consistent and hard-trying **Den's Legacy** (Medaglia d'Oro) might just get the right set up this afternoon if Robby Albarado can get him to drop into midfield early. Runner-up to Flashback (Tapit) in the GII Robert B. Lewis S. Feb. 2, he looked a winning chance in the Rebel and was right there entering the final furlong before being overhauled by the two Lukas runners. **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union) beat Normandy Invasion (Tapit) in the GII Remsen S. to close out 2012, but endured a difficult trip in the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 2 and could do no better than fifth to Vyjack (Into Mischief). Trainer Todd Pletcher reaches out for Rafael Bejarano to replace the injured John Velazquez.

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MADISON A WIDE-OPEN AFFAIR

Today's GI Madison S. at Keeneland has drawn an evenly matched field of filly and mare sprinters, and leading the betting at 7-2 on the morning line is **Fantasy of Flight** (Tiznow). A winner in her lone start over this track and trip last April, the Michelle Nevin charge enters this off a second-place finish to Golden Mystery (Awesome Again) in the GIII Hurricane Bertie S. at Gulfstream Feb. 10. She will have to contend with the widest draw here. Glencrest Farm's **Jamaican Smoke** (Latent Heat) broke her maiden over this strip last April, and followed up with a first-level allowance score at Churchill five weeks later, Beyering 96. She kicked off her 4-year-old campaign with a close third against optional claimers at Gulfstream Mar. 8, and looks to go for the lead here. Jamaican Smoke comes in off a bullet five furlong work in :59 1/5 at Palm Meadows Apr. 6.

Dr. Diamonds Prize (Pure Prize) and **Kune Kune** (GB) (Sir Percy {GB}) both hold longshot chances. The former finished a half-length behind Great Hot (Brz) (Orientate) and Groupie Doll (Bowman's Band) in the GII Raven Run S. over this track and trip in October 2011, and collected a win here the following April over Don't Tell Sophia (Congaree) before finishing second over the Woodbine Polytrack in the GII Hendrie S. She enters off a dull fifth in an Oaklawn optional claimer Mar. 15, but that effort came on the dirt off a nine-month layoff and without blinkers, which she gets again here. Kune Kune was a winner in her lone synthetic appearance at Kempton in England in 2011, and has shown improvement with each start since arriving in America in November.

Pin Oak Stable's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Alternation** (Distorted Humor) boasts five wins from seven tries over the strip, including front-running success in this event a year ago over subsequent GI Stephen Foster H. winner Ron the Greek (Full Mandate). Correction S. for a first black-type success. The bay continued her ascent up the Beyer Speed Figure scale last time, earning a gaudy 106 when besting open optional claiming foes by 9 1/4 lengths on the inner track here Mar. 14. Cluster of Stars's ample early speed has proven an

asset in her brief career, but the morning-line favorite will have company early in this graded stakes bow. Among the other speeds is Farnsworth Stables's **Spectacular Sky** (Sky Mesa), winner of the Manatee S. at Tampa two back Feb. 9 and second to **"TDN Rising Star"** **Aubby K** (Street Sense) in Gulfstream's GII Inside Information S. Mar. 17. "Last time she had the number one post, and it's almost impossible to win from that post when you're going seven-eighths at Gulfstream Park," trainer Marty Wolfson said of Spectacular Sky's last race. "[Jockey Joel] Rosario broke her sharply and she was able to get to the lead before Aubby K collared her near the quarter pole. Aubby K is a nice filly who had a little better trip than we did that day." Wolfson, whose reputation as a dangerous shipper was validated when Swagger Jack (Smart Strike) upset the GI Carter H. a week ago, also sends out **Nakano** (First Samurai), who is an off-the-pace threat. The grey capped a four-race win streak with a victory here a year ago when this race was rained off and subsequently downgraded, but she was upended next out at 2-5 in BetFair Hollywood Park's grassy Great Lady M S. in May. She wasn't seen again until the Breeders' Cup, but early tote action proved for good reason as the 6-1 shot flew home from out of the clouds to best Unbridled's Note (Unbridled's Song) by a half-length. Mizdirection resurfaced Jan. 6 to annex the course-and-distance GII Monrovia S., and led gate to wire last time for a decisive success in the eight-furlong GII Buena Vista S. Feb. 18. The prohibitive choice will break from post six of six. "It's a good draw," trainer Mike Puype said. "You can do whatever you want from out there." Puype will also saddle Ran Jan Racing homebred **Schiaparelli** (Ghostzapper), a 3 1/2-length optional claiming winner over this trip Mar. 14.

The grey is certainly bred for graded success here--her dam Cambiocorsa (Avenue of the Flags) won the 2006 renewal of this race and is a full-sister to local 2009 Breeders' Cup Sprint hero California Flag. "We expect a good race from her as well," Puype said. "She ran well with blinkers last out and they stay on Saturday." **Purim's Dancer** (Purim) also likes this unique strip--she's three-for-three over it, most recently taking the Feb. 10 Wishing Well S. for Tom Proctor.

But the gray was never really a threat that afternoon, finishing fifth, and was sidelined off a fourth behind Contested (Ghostzapper) in the GI Acorn S. May 28. Gary 'Red Dog' Hartlage worked On Fire Baby three times over seven furlongs leading up to this return to action and she upset the apple cart at overlaid odds. Quickest away from the six hole, On Fire Baby was slightly quicker to the first turn than Grace Hall (Empire Maker), forcing that one to steady for a few strides entering the bend. Joel Rosario guided the even-money chalk into the clear down the backside, but On Fire Baby was enjoying a leisurely time of it up front and took them into the final turn. Summer Applause (Harlan's Holiday) tried to apply pressure from the two path, Grace Hall quickened three wide and Don't Tell Sophia made it a line of four at the head of the stretch, but On Fire Baby cut the corner and hugged the fence into the stretch. Tiz Miz Sue advanced in hand at the rail approaching the lane and was questionably peeled out widest for her attack. She ultimately had the best crack at On Fire Baby, but the wire came too soon. Don't Tell Sophia held for a 1-2-3 sweep for local horses. Grace Hall could not match strides late and trailed in seventh.

Winner of the 2012 GIII Ben Ali S. in track-record time, Wise Dan was a head second to Ron the Greek (Full Mandate) in the GI Stephen Foster H. last June, then overcame ground easier than he likes to romp by five in the GII Fourstardave H. at Saratoga Aug. 11. He followed that with a dominating victory in the GI Woodbine Mile Sept. 16, and, with John Velazquez committed to ride at Belmont, Joze Lezcano was at the controls for the GI Shadwell Turf Mile Oct. 6, but the results were the same, as the chestnut cruised in by 2 1/4 lengths. The 9-5 chalk for the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, Wise Dan was always in touch, made the lead leaving the eighth pole and held off Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) by 1 1/2 lengths. Silentio (Silent Name {Jpn}) led from Skyring (English Channel) through the stretch the first time here, as Wise Dan was a handy, if eager, third. He raced mouth wide open tracking the top two from the three path, while Data Link followed not far behind. Wise Dan crept closer under a hold on the turn and got first crack at the leaders, but soon had Data Link breathing down his neck. He raced almost greenly and was tardy switching his leads, but did so approaching the eighth pole and stuck on gamely for the win. "People asked me earlier, 'What horse do you fear?' I said, 'I fear the layoff the most,'" trainer Charlie LoPresti admitted. "I didn't crank him as tight as he needed to be for this race. Turning for home, I hoped he was going to win, but I knew he might get a little tired." Lopresti said he was unlikely to press on to the GI Woodford Reserve on the Derby undercard May 4 and would consider Wise Dan for this year's Foster June 15.

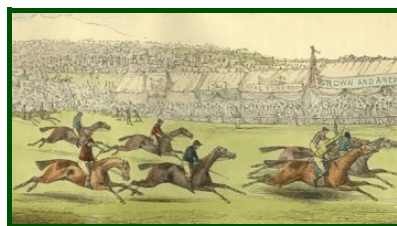
NYRA SUPPORTS 'SAFE ACT'

The New York Racing Association came out in support of the SAFE Act at its board meeting Wednesday. Sponsored by Senator Mary Landrieu (D-LA) and introduced March 12, 2013, the Safeguard American Food Exports Act of 2013 would prohibit the knowing sale or transport of equines or equine parts in interstate or foreign commerce for purposes of human consumption. A letter NYRA drafted in support of the bill reads, "As a leading Thoroughbred horseracing organization, NYRA is deeply concerned about the treatment and ultimate fate of the horses that run at its racetracks. Pursuant to its own anti-slaughter policy, NYRA will permanently revoke the stalls of any horseman who knowingly sells a horse for slaughter. It is without question that racehorses are not bred or raised for the purpose of human consumption. As a result, almost all racehorses are treated at some time in their lives with various medications, the use of which renders consumption of these horses by humans prohibitively unsafe." In the Senate, the bill has five co-sponsors and currently sits with the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions. The bill has also been introduced in the House of Representatives as H.R. 1094, sponsored by Patrick Meehan (R-PA), with 70 co-sponsors. It has been referred to the Subcommittee on Livestock, Rural Development, and Credit. At the same time, the Obama administration has included a proposal in its 2014 budget to prevent money from being spent on the inspection of horse slaughtering facilities, which would effectively ban the slaughter of horses for human consumption.

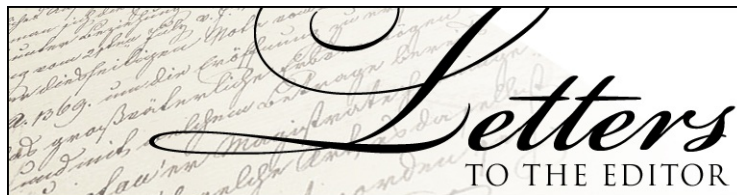

Susan Magnier's G1 Racing Post Trophy winner will miss the G1 QIPCO 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 4, with a prep in one of the recognised trials for the June 1 Epsom Classic on the agenda. "I don't think there's any change to the situation we were in before," his rider said. "He's back cantering and we're hoping he'll be ready to run in a Derby trial somewhere. He was working very well before he had the setback and he's an exciting horse for this year." Aidan O'Brien also told the *Racing Post*, "**Mars (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) is still very much in the picture for the Guineas, although we haven't made a definite decision yet as to whether he will go to Newmarket or for one of the Derby trials instead. **Lines of Battle** (War Front) is also in the picture for Newmarket along with **George Vancouver** (Henrythenavigator), **Cristoforo Colombo** (Henrythenavigator) and **Pedro the Great** (Henrythenavigator). The picture about what we will run in the Guineas should be a bit clearer in about a week's time."

STEVE SHERACK:

Last Week - As expected, **Verrazano** (\$2.20 to show) delivered in the Wood as the heavy chalk, but I lost some valuable ground on my opponent after a disappointing performance by **Power Broker** in the Santa Anita Derby. Two wide-open races today--time to start rallying.

GI Blue Grass S. - Far from a fan of the synthetics, especially Keeneland's Polytrack, but that can all change in a hurry with a big effort by longshot **West Hills Giant**. From the first crop of the promising Frost Giant, the flashy chestnut has already proven that he can handle turf and dirt just like his versatile sire, who captured the GI Suburban H. at 1 1/4m on dirt as well as the grassy G3 Kilternan S. at the Classic distance in Ireland. A game two-turn maiden winner versus New York-breds over the Saratoga lawn last summer, West Hills Giant has run well in defeat twice over the Big A inner this term. A close third in the six-furlong Java Gold S. while stuck on the rail throughout the stretch in his first start off the bench--subsequent GIII Bay Shore S. third The Truth and K G was second that day--he returned to stay on for runner-up honors at 30-1 when stretched to 1 1/16m with blinkers added in the GIII Gotham S. There's plenty of other speed entered in this one, but he's tactical enough to be in a good position from his outside draw. Far from impossible to make an impact here if he handles the synth and takes another step forward in his third start off the layoff. Dangerous Terranova barn is no stranger to upsetting big races at Keeneland--Lilacs and Lace pulled off a 48-1 shocker in the 2011 GI Ashland.
Selection: #12 West Hills Giant (20-1)

GI Arkansas Derby - Will be the first to admit that I was never the biggest **Overanalyze** fan last year (couldn't wait to play against him in the Gotham), but he may be sitting on a big effort at an overlay here. His game victory in the GII Remsen S. at this distance (he's the only Arkansas Derby entrant to own a win at 1 1/8m) looks a lot better now after Normandy Invasion's big run in last weekend's Wood. Ran like a horse that needed a race under his belt when a non-threatening fifth in his seasonal bow in the GIII Gotham S., and appears to be working smartly since. Has bounced back from two previous defeats with wins. Let's see if his form pattern continues. **Selection: #9 Overanalyze (4-1)**

Last Week - I may become a professional show bettor. . . It's amazing how wrong you can be and still get paid. **Vyjack** (\$2.50) was third best in the Wood and **Super Ninety Nine** (\$3.40) didn't get clear and was beaten 9 3/4 lengths by pace-pressing **Goldencents**, but he still managed to hang on for the show spot in the Santa Anita Derby.

GI Blue Grass S. - Proud to say I've managed to resist the temptation to pick **My Name Is Michael** again after he's disappointed me as the chalk twice this year. Watch him win and pay \$30. Instead I'll go with recent graduate **Footbridge**, who I expect to take to the Polytrack in a big way. The Eoin Harty trainee stretched none other than next-out GIII Sunland Derby romper Governor Charlie to a neck in a mile maiden at Santa Anita two back Feb. 17. While the chart claims he was 'outgamed,' you could certainly make the case that he was intimidated on the inside as Martin Garcia on the winner did his best to make things tight as they battled down to the line ([video](#)). Either way, losing by a neck to Governor Charlie doesn't look too bad. The bay appears on paper to have regressed slightly when breaking his maiden back in Arcadia Mar. 17, but he was briefly swept up into a four-way speed duel early down the backside, then was taken back and re-rallied before digging in gamely to don cap and gown ([video](#)). Despite just one win from four starts, Footbridge's BRIS Speed Ratings match up well with this group and I'm expecting him to run a new top. His dam was a stakes winner on turf in France but, more interestingly and less obviously, she's also a half to these connections' Marietta (Machiavellian). That runner earned her diploma by daylight over this same course and distance in 2007, and later took the GIII Arlington Oaks on Polytrack. Footbridge is by Street Cry (Ire), who is a son of Machiavellian, so he's bred very similarly to Marietta. Footbridge also trains over a synthetic surface at BetFair Hollywood Park, so one would think Harty would have a good idea as to whether his charge will appreciate the surface switch--I'm betting he will. **Selection: #10 Footbridge (20-1)**

GI Arkansas Derby - I hate to go chalky here, but I have a hard time seeing **War Academy** finish off the board and I do have a lead to protect, after all. Bob Baffert's absolute dominance at Oaklawn is well-documented, and the Coolmore colorbearer couldn't have been much more impressive stretching out in a Santa Anita allowance last time Mar. 15. His stablemate Manando--third to Goldencents in the GIII Sham in January--was allowed to get away with absolute murder on the front end, but War Academy blew by him in the lane like he was standing still and galloped out well. The \$450,000 KEESEP yearling is by Giant's Causeway out of an A.P. Indy dam, so an extra sixteenth should be no problem. **Selection: #2 War Academy (2-1).**

"The safety of my horses has been and always will be the most important thing to me. The mysterious deaths are personally troubling and of great sadness to me, my family and the owners of the horses. My heart goes out to the horses' owners.

"I am working with everyone, including the California Horse Racing Board (CHRB), my veterinarians and staff at the tracks to find causes for the unexplained deaths. California Horse Racing Board's Bo Derek and the state's equine medical director, Dr. Rick Arthur have made it clear that nothing I have done has caused any horse I have trained to suffer equine sudden death syndrome. My professional focus will continue to be to provide the best care for my horses, with constant concern for their well-being.

"I hope that research by CHRB and its pathologists will discover information helpful to understanding the reasons that I, and many of my colleagues, have had horses suffer this unfortunate fate."

NYTHA Launches Retirement Program:

The New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association has created a retirement program for Thoroughbreds stabled at New York Racing Association tracks called "TAKE THE LEAD." This program will partner with already established aftercare facilities to rehabilitate, retrain, and rehome racehorses ready to begin their careers off the track. "New York owners and trainers are committed to providing aftercare for retired racehorses," Rick Violette Jr., NYTHA President, said. "NYTHA has always lent its support to organizations like New Vocations and the Exceller Fund, and TAKE THE LEAD will enhance our efforts to ensure safe and happy new homes for our horses." A horse must be registered with The Jockey Club and stabled with a NYRA track based trainer for at least six months per year to be eligible for the program. Colts and stallions must be gelded in order to be accepted into the program. Horses can be submitted free of charge, though a donation is encouraged. "Providing the best care possible for our horses is a responsibility that trainers take very seriously, and part of that responsibility is knowing when it is time to retire a horse," trainer Rick Schosberg said. "But finding a new home is not always an easy task. Aftercare organizations have made adoption a more viable option, and TAKE THE LEAD will serve to expedite the process for our horsemen while making sure that our adoption partners have the funding they need to continue their good work."

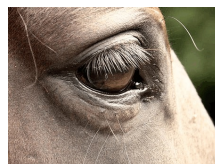
