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BACK ON THE GLORY TRAIL

The sound of deflation following the defeat of Toronado (Ire) in last Saturday's G1 2000 Guineas could be heard far afield, but his less flashy stable companion **Olympic Glory (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) can put some pep back in the step of trainer Richard Hannon if he can overcome a wide draw in today's G1 Poule

d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp. Tasting defeat only once so far on only his second start at the hands of Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) in Royal Ascot's G2 Coventry S. in June, Sheikh Joaan bin Hamad Al Thani's likeable colt seemed to find winning coming easily

afterwards. Doing only what was required in Newmarket's G2 Superlative S., Goodwood's G2 Vintage S. and this track's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, he looked even more languid on his return in the G3 Greenham S. at Newbury Apr. 20. Appearances can be deceptive, however, and Richard Hannon is confident that the best is yet to come. "Olympic Glory is our big hope, but we have not been lucky with the draw and he will have to be on his A-game to defy the 12 stall," he said. "However, this has been the plan since before the Greenham at Newbury, where he looked to be a horse crying out for a step up to the mile. The race certainly did him good as his work has been sharper since. He slipped under the radar last season and we probably did not realise just how good he was until he won at Glorious Goodwood. We then stepped him up to the top table in France on Arc day and he won really well. The only time he has been beaten was by Dawn Approach in the Coventry, so his form is rock-solid. We just need luck in running from that wide draw."

SEA THE STARS COLT SMASHES RECORD

Europe's Breeze-Up carnival descended upon Saint-Cloud yesterday and Arqana's record book was torn asunder within the first hour of trade as a Sea the Stars (Ire) colt, already named Salamargo (Ire), broke through the half-million barrier to set a new benchmark when selling to Newmarket conditioner Marco Botti, acting on behalf of Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum, for €520,000. Offered by Alban Chevalier du Fau and Jamie Railton's The Channel Consignment as Hip 13, the February-foaled bay, who is out of the dual stakes winner Navajo Moon (Ire) (Danehill), returned a handsome profit on the €200,000 he cost when passing through the Deauville ring at last year's August Yearling Sale. "I have three juveniles by his sire with me, and he is probably one of the best I've seen," Botti told *Racing Post*. "They usually need a bit of time, but he looks like he will be a mid-summer 2-year-old." Railton added, "He's always been a very special horse who is going to a great home. It's always a risk to bring expensive yearlings to the breeze-ups, but we have had a fantastic sale." Cont. p9

Mor To Follow?...

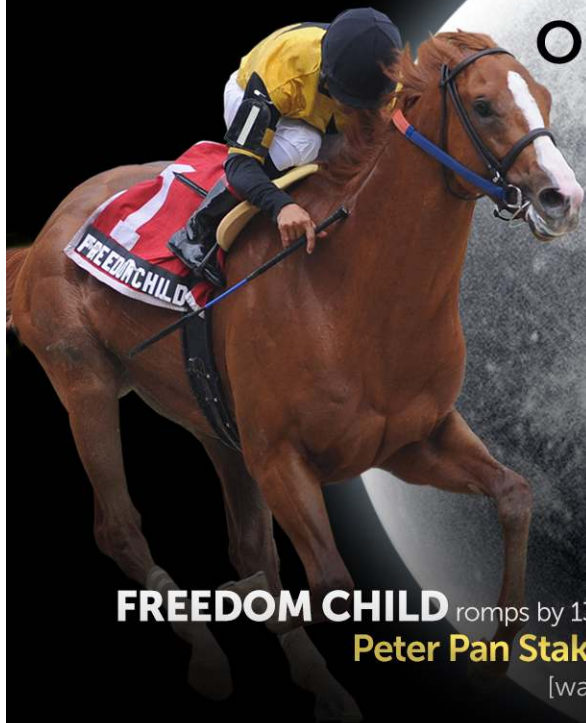
When **Morandi (Fr)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) won the nine-furlong G3 Prix de Conde here and the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud over a furlong further by a combined total of 19 lengths, the sky seemed the limit, but there are questions to answer after his defeat in the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau over this track and trip Apr. 14. Looking in need of further than this mile on that occasion, he at least has a better draw than the surprise winner **Gengis (Fr)** (King's Best) as they re-oppose, and two of the last three winners of this Classic had been beaten in that prep. Back in third and just run out of things there was Ecurie Jean-Louis Bouchard's **Us Law (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) and trainer Pascal Bary is hoping his stamina lasts out here. "He ran very well there and had to do all the work in front, so he got tired," he said. "He will have improved for the race, but a mile is his maximum and he is more of a horse for the G3 Jersey S. over seven furlongs. He is maybe not good enough to win this, but he is a nice horse."

Leading the Style Stakes...

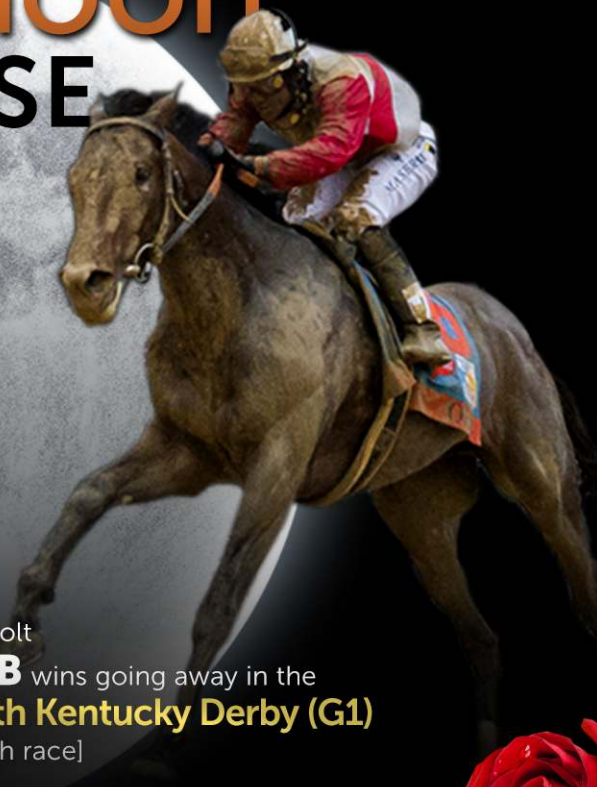
One who has entered the picture quietly is Count Andre de Ganay's **Style Vendome (Fr)** (Anabaa), but he beat several of these including last year's G3 Prix Eclipse and G2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte scorer **Penny's Picnic (Ire)** (Kheleyf) in the Apr. 4 G3 Prix Djebel at that venue last time and trainer Nicolas Clement is hoping he can hold his own. "He is the kind of horse who can accelerate in a furlong and put two or three lengths between him and some nice horses, so we think he's the real deal," he said. "We are looking forward to it and he was a nice 2-year-old, but not a champion. This year, he looks to have taken a step forward to compete in the big league. He is the perfect racehorse--he is very relaxed and easy to train and can quicken off a fast pace. We hope he's good enough to go close. I've had a few nice milers like Stormy River and French Fifteen, and this horse is right up there and maybe above them." One of Style Vendome's wins at two came because the saddle slipped on Olympic Glory's barnmate **Havana Gold (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) near the end of Deauville's Listed Prix Francois Boutin, and Qatar Racing Limited & CSH's consistent colt will provide a more accurate marker as to the merit of Toronado after he was four lengths adrift of him in the G3 Craven S. at Newmarket Apr. 18.

"Havana Gold is drawn next door to Olympic Glory and is a decent horse. He would have been hard to beat in the [G3] Dee S. at Chester, but the owners wanted to go to France and that is fine by me. He is rated seven pounds behind Olympic Glory, but he has earned a tilt at the big boys." Aidan O'Brien has won this with three colts who were not at the top of his pecking order at the time and Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Gale Force Ten (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) is worthy of respect. Last year's G2 Norfolk S. runner-up beat Dont Bother Me (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}) in convincing style in the Listed Patton S. over seven furlongs on the Polytrack at Dundalk Apr. 5, and that rival has since run respectably in the 2000 Guineas.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a ▲ will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a + will indicate first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

The Pau Set...

Jean-Claude Rouget won his first domestic Classic only recently, but there is no doubt that he occupies pole position among the country's finest conditioners and his representatives **Alterite (Fr)** (Literato {Fr}) and **Vaunoise (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) are worthy of inspection. While the latter appears to have something to find on her latest third in the Listed Prix Finlande over nine furlongs here Apr. 7, Alterite proved she can mix it with the best when third in the Marcel Boussac. Martin Schwartz's daughter of Rouget's beloved G1 Champion S. hero warmed up for this with defeat of the subsequent G3 Schwarzgold-Rennen winner Beatrice (GB) (Dr Fong) in the Listed Prix la Camargo at Saint-Cloud Mar. 26. Fourth on that occasion was the Marquesa de Moratalla's **Dauphine Russe (Fr)** (Russian Blue {Ire}), who went on to finish in the same spot in the G3 Prix de la Grotte over this track and trip last time Apr. 14. Only beaten 1 1/2 lengths in total by Guy Pariente's **Kenhope (Fr)** (Kendargent {Fr}) there, she has fared the best in the draw of all the protagonists who contested that trial. "The most encouraging thing about her is the draw in three, but her overall level of form appears just short of this grade having finished a length and half behind one of Sunday's opposition Kenhope," jockey William Buick commented. "With a bit of luck, we could be in the shake up."

Godolphin's **Tasaday** (Nayef) was runner-up in that prep, surrendering an unbeaten record which had been extended through the test of the G3 Prix des Reservoirs at Deauville in October. She had **Cocktail Queen (Ire)** (Motivator {GB}) a length back in second on that occasion and that Jeff Smith homebred was only fourth on her comeback behind **Zurigha (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in a mile conditions event on Kempton's Polytrack Apr. 13. Zurigha hails from the Richard Hannon stable already successful in the G1 1000 Guineas with Sky Lantern (Ire) (Red Clubs {Ire}), and her trainer commented, "We run Zurigha and she has fared even worse [than Poulains contenders Olympic Glory and Havana Gold] in the draw, being parked outside in stall 17. On form she has a bit to find, but she has been working well with our good horses. Although she lacks experience, we hope that she will run well."

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Freedom Child set the pace and ran a huge race to place second at 49-1 behind GI Kentucky Derby hero Orb (Malibu Moon) going a mile at the Big A Nov. 24. Freshened and stretched to 1 1/16 miles, the chestnut finished third behind Saint Vigeur and next out winner Wabbajack (Midnight Lute) at Gulfstream Feb. 9. He broke through with a decisive wire-to-wire tally over the promising Bellarmine (Magna Graduate) going nine furlongs in Hallandale Mar. 10. Off in a tangle after being held by an assistant starter in the Wood, he gave it a good go to reach contention, then tired to finish a well-beaten 10th while running for purse money only. Off a beat slow from his rail draw here, Freedom Child rushed up within his own restraint to show the way through fractions of :23.51 and :46.67, and dropped the hammer while drifting a bit through the stretch. "I think we're going to go to the [GI] Belmont S. in about four weeks," West Point's Terry Finley said. "I hope Orb runs well in the Preakness and the whole world is watching on [June 8] for the Belmont, and I hope we have the chance to upset the apple cart."

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Mylute In, Street Spice Out...

Whisper Hill Farm and Gold Mark Farm's **Mylute** (Midnight Lute) has been green-lighted for Saturday's GI Preakness S., trainer Tom Amoss reported yesterday morning. "I talked with Paul Bulmahn [of GoldMark] and Mandy Pope [of Whisper Hill] and we discussed how he was doing and how he was training and the decision was made to go to the Preakness," Amoss explained.

"He is booked on the plane for Wednesday morning to go to Baltimore." Runner-up to Revolutionary (War Pass) in the

GI Louisiana Derby Mar. 30, Mylute is exiting an excellent fifth-place effort behind Orb (Malibu Moon) in the GI Kentucky Derby, and will bring jockey Rosie Napravnik back to her roots in Maryland. "Get your PREAK ON baby I'm coming home ;-) I promise you there is no other jockey who wants to win the #Preakness more than me! MYLUTE," the 25-year-old rider tweeted shortly after learning of connections' decision. Napravnik was named by trainer Richard Small to ride Ringofdiamonds for her very first mount June 9, 2005, and she went wire-to-wire and straight into the winner's circle. "I remember thinking that I was so glad that it was first race of the day and I didn't have to wait and be anxious all day. Even leading up to it, it was surreal that it was even happening. I remember not even knowing how to read the *[Daily] Racing Form*. I had handicapped the race to the best of my ability and I figured I would be somewhere near the front of the pack. I was in the one-hole going two turns, which really isn't that easy to do at Pimlico," she recalled. Napravnik believes Mylute is heading in the right direction coming into the Preakness. "I think he's going to move forward a lot off that race," she commented. "I don't think it's something where it took everything out of him and would cause him to regress at all. He's maturing and has the competitive drive of a really good race horse."

Street Spice (Street Sense), a product of two of the top horses campaigned by owner Jim Tafel, will not press on to the Preakness, trainer Greg Geier informed Pimlico officials Saturday morning. "He worked good this morning, but we're going to stay here and look for something else," Geier said of the son of 2007 Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense and GSW Allspice (Coronado's Quest). Street Spice, most recently fifth to Preakness hopeful Departing (War Front) in the GI Illinois Derby Apr. 20, went five furlongs over the Arlington Polytrack in 1:01 Saturday morning. Arqana Breeze-Up cont.

Nicolas de Watrigant's Mandore International Agency was one of the underbidders on the session topper, but gained immediate compensation when striking at €230,000 for Hip [14](#), a Raven's Pass colt. Continuing The Channel Consignment's golden hour, the February-foaled bay is out of the dual winner Nawal (Fr) (Homme de Loi {Ire}), who hit the board in the 1996 G3 Prix d'Aumale, and is thus a half-brother to the 2008 GI Hollywood Gold Cup hero Mast Track (Mizzen Mast). He was another pinhooking success, albeit modest, having been purchased for €220,000 here last August.

The Channel Consignment's sweep of the podium was completed by a daughter of New Approach (Ire), offered as Hip [1](#), who sold to Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock for €175,000. She had already provided one pinhooking success, jumping up from a €24,000 ARQDEC foal to become a €95,000 ARCOCT yearling, and further bolstered her profile with a healthy profit here. Out of a winning Sinndar (Ire) mare, the March-foaled chestnut's fourth dam is the 1983 G1 1000 Guineas heroine Ma Biche (Key to the Kingdom), and she is bound for William Haggas' Newmarket stable. "I loved everything about her," Brown told *Racing Post*. "She did a super breeze, looks great in the flesh and is by a fantastic sire."

Fourth highest price of the one-day sale was registered by another son of Sea the Stars (Ire), Hip [48](#), who went the way of Maisons-Laffitte trainer Jehan Bertran de Balanda for €165,000. Consigned by Ecurie Prevost-Baratte, the March-foaled chestnut is a half-brother to the 2008 G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere victor Naqoos (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), and hails from the family of six-time Group 1 winner Pilsudski (Ire) (Polish Precedent). "I have bought him for Alan Potts and if he doesn't make the grade on the Flat he could always go jumping," the dual-purpose trainer told *Racing Post*. "He is late maturing and has a nice, big action."

Despite box-office prices for the upper echelon, the aggregate yield, including private sales, failed to usurp 2011's €7-million gross, but the smaller book outstripped last year's comparative figure by just over 1%. Benefitting from a greatly improved clearance rate and 17 six-figure transactions, the average jumped 18% to €66,772, while the median marker also made a significant advance, rising 19% to €50,000. At the close of trade, Arqana chairman Eric Hoyer commented, "The demand was very sustained at the top end of the market and all the major players had traveled to Saint-Cloud and got involved in some nice bidding wars. The same applies to the middle market, which is noted for its very European flavor. As such, a large proportion of the horses bought are likely to stay in training in France, a country which benefits from prizemoney which offers a better possibility of return on investment. In this sense, the Breeze-Up Jackpot brings an added incentive thanks to a €200,000 package entirely financed by Arqana. We would like to thank all investors who made the trip to Paris to take part in the sale and we would like to highlight the quality of the horses which were entered by all buyers as well as the excellent level of preparation of all their 2-year-olds. Added to this the reduced number of horses catalogued and the more rigorous selection were determining factors in the dynamism of the sale. NOVEL APPROACH

With his compatriot Pastorius (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB}) making a splash in the major European prizes, the return of **Novellist (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) in today's G2 Grosser Preis der Badischen Unternehmer at Baden-Baden takes on extra weight. It was that rival who denied him the G1 Deutsches Derby glory that had seemed almost a formality after winning Frankfurt's G3 Albert Von Metzler-Rennen and Cologne's G2 Oppenheim-Union-Rennen by a cumulative margin of 11 lengths. Again one place behind his nemesis when fourth in the wake of Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) in September's G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, Dr Christoph Berglar's homebred came to the fore at the San Siro the following month with a resounding 4 1/2-length triumph in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano. He carries a six-pound penalty here as a result, as does fellow top-level scorer and Deutsches Derby third **Girolamo (Ger)** (Dai Jin {GB}). He annexed the G1 Preis von Europa over 12 furlongs at Cologne in September before being outclassed by St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) and company on his return in the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic.

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THE BATTLE PLAN

Today's G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial is the pre-eminent Irish prep for the Epsom and Curragh Classics, thanks largely to its importance in Aidan O'Brien's process of readying his best middle-distance colts. Among his nine victors are Galileo (Ire), High Chaparral (Ire), Dylan Thomas (Ire) and Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire})), while it is arguable that Yeats (Ire) could have added to the stable's Derby record had he not been injured ahead of the blue riband. Step forward **Battle of Marengo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire})), who bids to emulate High Chaparral, Fame and Glory and the 2011 scorer Recital (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}) in defying a penalty here. Earning that extra burden with a win in the G2 Beresford S. on heavy ground at The Curragh in September, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's handsome colt was re-introduced over this course and distance in the Apr. 14 G3 Ballysax S. and he managed to give the subsequent G3 Sandown Classic Trial winner Sugar Boy (Ire) (Authorized {Ire}) five pounds and a 1 3/4-length beating there. Jockey Joseph O'Brien is hoping that the ground does not become too testing. "I'd be hoping the rain stays away as, although he has run very well on heavy ground, he is definitely a better horse on better ground," he told *PA Sport*. "One of his best performances was when he won in Leopardstown last year on good ground. The saddle slipped that day and he still broke the track record. I'd love to get him on a bit of nicer ground again and, hopefully, he'll get that on Sunday. He was good in the Ballysax, it was his first run of the year and hopefully he'll have come on for that." Also penalized are Jim Bolger's unbeaten G1 Criterium International winner **Loch Garman (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) and Team Valor's G2 Futurity S. scorer **First Cornerstone (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}). The latter was fourth when last seen behind Battle of Marengo's stable companion Kingsbarns (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster in October and trainer Andrew Oliver said, "He has developed physically and we are very happy with him. We had a hold-up with our gallops earlier in the year, so all of my horses were quite behind and are taking a run. Having said that, I'm fairly happy with his preparation but I expect him to come on for the run. We hope he is well equipped with both speed and stamina to deal with stepping up in trip and being able to travel well and quicken."

You have to go back to 1986 to find the last winner of the G2 Prix Hocquart to follow up in the G1 Prix du Jockey Club, and there are seven colts attempting to follow in the steps of Bering (GB) in today's renewal. Ironically, it may be the sole filly in the line-up in **Ferevia (Ire)** (Motivator {GB}) who proves the fly in the ointment if she can build on her latest impressive success in the G3 Prix Penelope over 1 5/16mile at Saint-Cloud on her latest outing Apr. 16. "Like all of Motivator's, she was a bit nervous and needed time, but improved a lot after winning a small race and won well last time," trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias said of Leonidas Marinopoulos' homebred, who is not entered in the G1 Prix de Diane. "She surprised me there and we think she will go a mile and a half." Derrick Smith and Michael Tabor's **Tableaux** (Giant's Causeway) goes unpenalized for his success in this track's G2 Prix Noailles over 1 5/16mile Apr. 22, where **Art Contemporain** (Smart Strike) and **Max Dynamite (Fr)** (Great Journey {Jpn}) were close up in third and fourth respectively, and bids to provide the all-conquering Andre Fabre stable with another Derby trial and a record seventh renewal. 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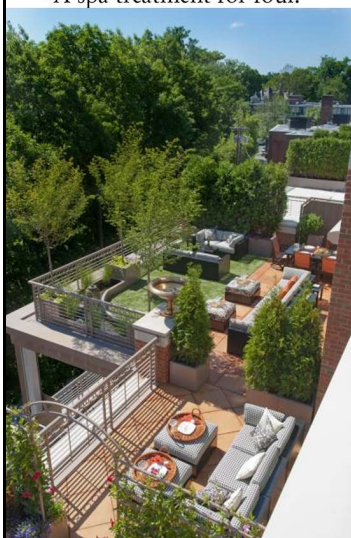

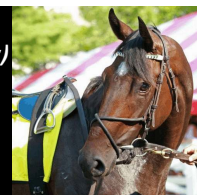

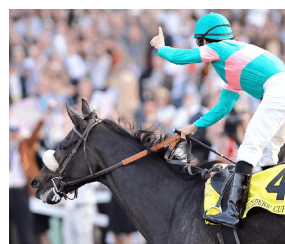
