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THAT'S THE STYLE

Described by Nicolas Clement as the "perfect racehorse" and better than his best milers of recent times, **Style Vendome (Fr)** (Anabaa) lived up to the trainer's expectations yesterday with a hard-fought success in a typically pulsating outcome to Longchamp's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains. Having taken a key prep in Maisons-Laffitte's G3 Prix Djebel over seven furlongs last time Apr. 4, Andre de Ganay's grey had a low beneficial draw and was able to enjoy a dream trip round the rail behind the leading quartet under Thierry Thulliez. Working his way to the front with 150 yards remaining, the third favorite, who paid almost 6-1 on the tote, grittily held his own as the inevitable closers arrived on the scene, headed by the neck runner-up **Dastarhon (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) and the eye-catching third **Intello (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}). "I am delighted, as this is my first Classic after a wait of 25 years training and you can imagine how happy I am," Clement said. "The owners have been with me all the way and it is a dream now that it is done." **Cont. p3**

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Style Vendome Wins Poulains (cont. from p1)

Starting out in the Listed Prix Yacowlef at Deauville in June, Style Vendome ran second to the subsequent group scorer Pearl Flute (Ire) (Piccolo {GB}) in that five-furlong anomaly for debutantes before getting his winning streak underway over slightly further at Dieppe the following month. Despite a solid effort on his first attempt at black-type in the Listed Prix Francois Boutin over seven back at Deauville in August, that win was essentially gifted to him after the saddle slipped on the certain winner **Havana Gold (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}) near the line and he was not seen again in 2012. Reappearing in the Listed Prix Montenica over 6 1/2 furlongs on the Polytrack at Chantilly Mar. 14, he followed a smooth success there with an equally fluent career-best in the Djebel and his straightforward trajectory continued when handed an ideal post in three for this contest, which is often decided on the Friday when the draw is made. Able to draft and save ground while the placed horses were forced to put in extra effort to join the early chase, Style Vendome wasted little precious energy before being eased off the fence at the end of the final turn. As he had his first clear shot at the lead in midstretch, Dastarhon was looking for room in behind and Intello was being driven by Maxime Guyon to extricate himself from the rear and deliver a wide rally.

It was the winner's old rival Havana Gold who posed the more immediate threat, as he arrived on the front end from a seemingly impossible early position, but his effort was short-lived and Style Vendome's more conventional passage proved crucial.

Asserting close home, he was safely clear of the type of blanket that is often seen in this Classic, and which included the wide-drawn Intello, whose finishing burst from five lengths in arrears marked him as a colt with

considerable prowess. Unlike that previously unbeaten performer, the

4-1 favorite **Olympic Glory (Ire)** (Choisir {Aus}) never

looked like

making his presence felt at any stage from his unfavorable post position and his labors through the race resulted in a disappointing 11th placing.

"He's a really nice horse and happily, I made the right decision to run here rather than Newmarket," Nicolas Clement added of the winner. "His record is perfect apart from his first run and he had a good draw and a good run through the race. It is definitely now either the G1 Prix du Jockey Club [at Chantilly June 2] or G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 18]."

Dastarhon's trainer Pia Brandt was understandably delighted with the advertising of her small yard by the runner-up. "I couldn't be more happy," she said. "He is still lightly raced and he proved his quality today. The jockey told me that halfway down the straight, he had the choice to go inside or out and he thinks if he had gone out he might have won. I'm happy enough anyway and hopefully now he will run in the G1 Prix Jean Prat [at Chantilly June 30]."

Intello is heading to the Prix du Jockey Club after his commendable run. The Wertheimers' Racing Manager Pierre-Yves Bureau said, "That was a horrific race. He had a bad draw, a bad trip, lost a shoe and was struck into behind, but still managed to finish very nicely. We'll see how he is, but if he is well I would imagine it will be the Prix du Jockey Club."

Jockey Richard Hughes said of Olympic Glory, "I was never traveling and always struggling going downhill on the fast ground."



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Flotilla Returns Victorious (cont. from p1)

Few would have expected that they were seeing a future Breeders' Cup and Classic winner when attending the races at Clairefontaine July 30, but they had not banked on the untapped ability that seven-furlong conditions scorer Flotilla had in store. Getting going too late when subsequently fifth on her black-type introduction in the G3 Prix d'Aumale over this trip at Chantilly in September, she took a major step forward when fourth after being holed up at a crucial point of the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac over this course and distance on Arc day. Bursting onto the international stage in the Juvenile Fillies Turf at Santa Anita the following month, she faced a tough task coming straight to this competitive renewal, even if it did look below-par in substance beforehand. Despite her favorable draw, the bay was reserved early by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire and lost vital ground as the rush to gain prominence began. As the race unfolded, it became evident that her skilled rider had chosen the perfect rival to stalk, as Esoterique glided through the pack just ahead. Allowing that previously unbeaten filly to take her into the fresh air, she surrendered a two-length advantage to the Rothschild homebred as she took the baton from her stable companion **Tasaday** (Nayef) approaching the furlong pole. Esoterique refused to give up her lead easily, but there was a sense of the inevitable as soon as Flotilla found her top stride and she was ultimately a cozy winner at the line.

"She had been slow to come to hand after the winter and there is always a doubt as to whether they are really fit or not," commented Mikel Delzangles, whose What a Name (Ire) disappointed in last week's G1 English 1000 Guineas. "We will have to make the decision now whether to step up in trip and go for the G1 Prix de Diane [at Chantilly June 16] or stay at a mile for the G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 21]."

The latter race is where the runner-up is headed, according to owner-breeder Baron Edouard de Rothschild. "She has justified the decision to supplement and we are very happy, as this run was very close after her last one," he explained. "Maybe she idled a bit in front, but she has run very well. She will go to Royal Ascot for the Coronation now."

This renewal was compromised by the current financial crisis in the racing industry and country as a whole, with overseas raiders opting to stay away and leave it to a largely moderate collection of domestic runners. One who stood out beforehand was Vedelago, and he duly delivered a career-high and a third Pattern-race success on his first try at this trip. Breaking his maiden in the G2 Prix Noailles over 1 5/16 mile here Apr. 22, Tableaux returned to win a record seventh edition for the Andre Fabre stable which continues to mop up these middle-distance preps. Having finished fourth behind his talented stable companion Intello (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}) on debut over a mile at this track in September, the chestnut was second over that trip at Saint-Cloud in October before filling third spot on his seasonal bow behind another smart colt in the Niarchos family's subsequent G2 Prix Greffulhe runner-up Bravodino (Dynaformer) in a conditions event over 1 5/16 mile back there Apr. 3. Keen initially before taking a lead from Park Reel, Tableaux stayed prominent, which paid off as nothing proved able to make up ground in another falsely run race. Prizing a narrow advantage off the long-time leader with 300 meters remaining, he kept finding as that rival rallied against the rail and Ballydoyle's Festive Cheer threatened wide. Despite being briefly headed again by Park Reel near the line, Tableaux prevailed in the bobber. His win follows an almost unprecedented purple patch in the Classic trials for his stable, contributing this trophy and that of the Noailles to a tally that now includes the Listed Prix Francois Mathet, G3 Prix la Force and G2 Prix Greffulhe, as well as the Listed Fielden S. win overseas for yesterday's G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains third Intello (Ger) (Galileo {Ire}).

Aidan O'Brien already boasted nine renewals of this race, but he was not about to relax his iron grip and duly delivered Battle of Marengo to extend his tally to double figures. Last year's G2 Beresford S. scorer has quickly become a colt to set a watch by, continuing his march towards Epsom with a comprehensive defeat of the subsequent G3 Sandown Classic Trial winner Sugar Boy (Ire) (Authorized {Ire}) giving five pounds to that rival in the G3 Ballysax S. over this course and distance in the Apr. 14. Facing a classier type in the G1 Criterium International winner Loch Garman here, the subject of a recent Derby gamble and probably his stable's number one for the blue riband, was still able to master that imposing rival, who shares his stable with Guineas winner Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}). Taking up the running after the first half mile, he had Bolger's representative at work on the final turn and, after gaining a near two-length advantage quickly, was able to hold that all the way to the line. "We were very, happy and he had to come here and have a good, clean blow," O'Brien said. "He doesn't do a lot in front and is a little bit idle, so he'll be happy getting a lead. He has won making the running, but they get a bit lazy doing that all the time. He's a well-balanced horse and the plan was always to come here for his trial." Team Valor's G2 Futurity S. scorer First Cornerstone (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}) was a late scratching due to a bad scope. Trainer Andrew Oliver told *PA Sport*, "I've spoken with the owners and we just have to reappraise and see what our route is now. It is a huge disappointment. We were heading towards the Epsom Derby. It looks like he won't get a run prior to that, so at this moment we have no firm plans. We just have to get the horse right again and find a race."

GROSSER PREIS DER BADISCHEN UNTERNEHMER-G2

Only relegated to second close home by Pastorius (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB}) in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg last July, Novelist took longer than initially expected to break through at the top level but came to the fore with an easy win in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano at the San Siro in October. Dropped in to race in the final pair on his seasonal return, the homebred looped the field on the home turn to challenge for the lead as the action angled over to the stand's rail in the style customary at this venue. Bumping Seismos (Ger) (Dalakhani {Ire}) out of his way as he went, the bay finished strongly up the fence but may have been a fortunate winner, as Waldpark threw his chance away by veering left late on. "This was tough and a great achievement under top weight on this testing going, especially as we knew that he still needed the race," trainer Andreas Wohler said. "He will now go on an international campaign, with his next options being the G2 Hardwicke S. [at Royal Ascot June 22] or the [June 23] G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud."

Establishing a stalking position two paths off the fence here, Verxina responded to the challenge of defending race winner Whale Capture on her outside inside the final furlong, putting her head in front to defeat that rival by the narrowest of margins.

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DEPARTING DRILLS AT CHURCHILL

Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Departing** (War Front) tuned up for Saturday's GI Preakness S. with a four-furlong drill in :50.40 at Churchill Downs yesterday. With former jockey Larry Melancon in the irons, the bay gelding worked through fractions of :13.20, :25.40, :38.20 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:03.80. "I wanted him to go a little slower the first part than the second part and he hit right on what we were looking for," reported trainer Al Stall, Jr. "He did enough to get the day off tomorrow. He is a gelding and doesn't carry a lot of weight. He had galloped two miles on Thursday and a spirited mile and a half Friday." Departing has won four of five lifetime starts and is coming off a win in the Apr. 20 GIII Illinois Derby. His lone loss was a third-place effort in the GII Louisiana Derby. "After the Louisiana Derby, the Kentucky Derby was off the table with the point system," explained Stall. "It worked out well for us. The Illinois Derby billed itself as a prep for the Preakness and hopefully we can make it successful for the Illinois Derby." Departing is expected to ship to Maryland Wednesday afternoon.

ITSMYLUCKDAY ON TRACK AT MONMOUTH

After heavy rain hit the Jersey Shore Saturday, the Monmouth Park track was closed for training Sunday morning and trainer Eddie Plesa, Jr. received permission to work GIII Holy Bull S. winner **Itsmyluckyday** (Lawyer Ron) between races yesterday afternoon. The colt worked a half-mile in :47 1/5 between the third and fourth races. "Perfect," trainer Eddie Plesa, Jr. said after the work. "He did just what I wanted. I caught him galloping out in :59 and change. I couldn't have asked for it to work out any better." After running second to Orb (Malibu Moon) in the GI Florida Derby, Itsmyluckyday was a disappointing 15th in the GI Kentucky Derby. Elvis Trujillo, who rode Itsmyluckyday in the Derby, was aboard for yesterday's work, but John Velazquez has the call in the Preakness. Itsmyluckyday is expected to ship to Baltimore Tuesday.

"[Owner] Mr. [Rick] Porter and I decided to pass on the Preakness with Normandy Invasion and focus on the summer campaign with him," Brown explained. Normandy Invasion, second in the GI Wood Memorial, tired to fourth after taking the lead at the top of the stretch in the GI Kentucky Derby.

ORB GALLOPS, SHUG STAYS BUSY

Stuart Janney III and Phipps Stable's GI Kentucky Derby winner **Orb** (Malibu Moon) schooled in the Belmont Park paddock Sunday before galloping 1 1/2 miles over the sloppy track. Trainer Shug McGaughey had a busier morning, dealing with a host of media requests. "I think it is a big responsibility to accomodate what's out there and try to portray what the win means to all of us--myself and my family, the Janneys and Phippses and their families and all the people at the barn," McGaughey commented. "I'd like to get it out there to people that racing can be a fun and rewarding sport." Orb is expected to work at Belmont Monday morning. "He'll break off at the half-mile pole by himself, breeze a half and hope he finishes up good and gallops out somewhat--not strong--he's fit enough," McGaughey said. "I just sort of want to put him in the ball game." McGaughey admitted a rainy week in New York made for difficult conditions. "It's been a little bit difficult this week with the track that way," McGaughey said. "This morning, with those dogs up, he was looking at those dogs and jumping here and there, but [exercise rider Jennifer Patterson] keeps telling me not to worry. So, I'm not going to worry. I'm a bit more uptight than I was last time. Not because of anything, but just you've got one under your belt, so you're hoping maybe something good can happen to make it a fun three weeks. What will be, will be."

GOLDENCENTS TO SKIP WORK

Trainer Doug O'Neill has scraped plans to work GI Santa Anita Derby winner **Goldencents** (Into Mischief) Monday at Pimlico. "It was never certain that he was going to work," explained assistant trainer Jack Sisterson. "We never worked [2012 Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner] I'll Have Another, so we're going to stay on the schedule. He's getting enough out of his training where he doesn't need to work. He's doing very well." Goldencents is coming off a disappointing 17th-place effort in Louisville. "The one thing we're starting to notice is, he's getting better each day," Sisterson, who has been with the colt at Pimlico since last week, added. "He hasn't put a foot wrong since we got here. He seems to be really getting over the track well and striding out. We're very happy with him."

As owner, Satish Sanan, who just resigned from the Breeders' Cup board of directors said, "I would strongly recommend, not just going through the motions, but honestly looking at where our industry is going, look at a strategic plan, define what is needed and then put a plan in place."

There needs to be a national/international ruling body that regulates the game of horse racing and enforces a strict drug policy.

Everyone involved made a huge mistake when allowing online gaming into the game without taking a greater portion of the profits. All the tracks lost millions, as people do not need to go to the tracks to bet and now can bet all over the world from anywhere at anytime. Betting has increased a thousand fold in the last 10 years since online betting was introduced, but the tracks and horses/owners aren't getting their share for producing the sport. This needs to be renegotiated.

There are so many ways horse racing can be improved, from paying the horses more for racing--creating more owners--to adding more advertising at the tracks, with the jockeys and owners, as well as updating the racetracks.

Take a page out of the Las Vegas play book and other sports venues. Everyone needs to work together to save this wonderful exciting sport.

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BARRETTS MAY SALE TODAY

The Barretts May Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale will be held at the Hinds Pavilion at Fairplex in Pomona, California today starting at 3:00 p.m. PDT. Sales officials hope Barretts May continues the trend set by the company's March two-year-old sale, which was up 31.1% in average from last year and 17.6% in median. Last year's May sale topper, a colt by Master Command out of Grinch (Salt Lake), was consigned by Ciaran Dunne's Wavertree Stables, sold for \$300,000 and now races for Kaleem Shah. Among the 2012 sale's most successful graduates is Dice Flavor (Scat Daddy), who was consigned by Stephens Thoroughbreds. The \$100,000 Nobuo Oda purchase went on to take the GIII El Camino Real Derby in February.

Today's sale has 142 catalogued horses and 13 supplemental entries. "We look forward to a very strong sale," said Barretts General Manager Kim Lloyd. "We have 20% more horses catalogued and the quality is also on the rise. The demand has been steady all year and we expect it to continue."

His granddam is GI Kentucky Oaks winner Blushing with Pride (Blushing Groom {Fr}) and he is a half-sibling to multiple stakes winner Martha's Moon (Malibu Moon). The colt was bred by Malibu Farm, LLC. He is consigned by Wavertree Stables, Inc. He was a \$40,000 Keeneland November weanling and was reported not sold at \$60,000 at last year's Fasig-Tipton October sale.

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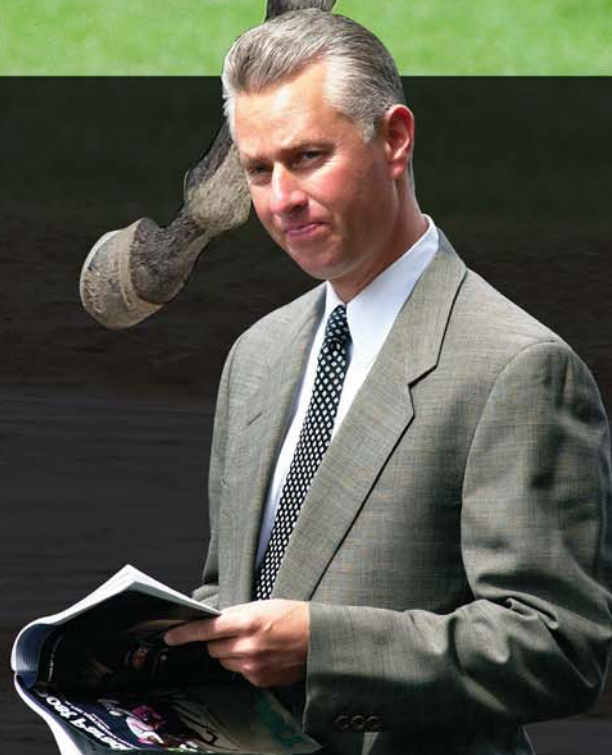
