

OXBOW GIVES LUKAS A SIXTH PREAKNESS

A Triple Crown will have to wait yet another year after Calumet Farm's **Oxbow** (Awesome Again) gave Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas--age 77--a sixth win and fellow Hall of Famer Gary Stevens--age 50 and a handful of months removed from a seven-year retirement--a third victory in Saturday's GI Preakness S. at Old Hilltop in Baltimore.

Itsmyluckyday (Lawyer Ron) looked a danger in deep stretch before settling for second, while **Mylute** (Midnight Lute) came from the back of

the pack to be third. GI Kentucky Derby hero **Orb** (Malibu Moon) was sent off at prohibitive odds of 3-5 to take this middle jewel, but raced in a bit of traffic and closer to the pace than is his custom on the backstretch and only a belated rally carried him into fourth. **Preakness S. cont. p3**

FARHH OUT

Having had a chip removed from his fetlock after finishing runner-up in the G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp in September, Godolphin's **Farhh** (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) returned to a Frankel-free world to blitz his rivals at Newbury yesterday and earn a belated first Group 1 success in the G1 Lockinge S. Sent off the 10-3 second choice as all the money was for Ballydoyle's

Declaration of War (War Front), the bay was ranked early behind the pacesetters but, when let loose by Silvestre de Sousa passing the quarter pole, sprinted clear for a four-length success from the 80-1 outsider **Sovereign Debt** (Ire) (Dark Angel {Ire}). "He won really well, which surprised me, as Saeed has had to tiptoe very quietly with him," Racing Manager Simon Crisford commented. "This is fantastic, particularly after the problems we've had in the past few weeks and a major boost to the stable." **Cont. p9**

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Slow, But Steady Progress at Two...

A \$250,000 graduate of the 2011 Keeneland September yearling sale, Oxbow did not get off to the most auspicious of debuts when he was pulled up out of an Aug. 3 Saratoga maiden and subsequently vanned off. It was back to work about 10 weeks later at Keeneland, where he was fourth to this year's GIII Coolmore Lexington S. hero Winning Cause (Giant's Causeway) Oct. 18 before finishing a distant third to the once-promising Gulfport (Unbridled's Song) at Churchill less than two weeks hence. The bay finally put it all together in career start number four, overcoming a high draw to wire a field by 4 3/4 lengths over seven-eighths of a mile Nov. 25. Connections could easily have called time on the season, but, as with many of the Lukas runners, Oxbow apparently thrived on his racing and he made the trip to California for the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 15. Dealt a death draw in 11 and forced to deal with a ship and a new surface, all was not lost in a fourth-place effort to Violence (Medaglia d'Oro).

No Rest for the Weary...

Though he made those four starts in the span of 58 days at the end of 2012, Oxbow was kept in steady training and announced his arrival as a sophomore to fear with an 11 1/2-length romp in the GIII Lecomte S. at the Fair Grounds Jan. 19. He lost little when fourth after a tough trip in the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 23, the

first of three straight races in which he left from the 10 hole. The bay made his next two starts at his Oaklawn base, dropping a head decision to stablemate **Will Take Charge** (Unbridled's Song) in the GII Rebel S. Mar. 16 before Lukas reached out to Stevens to ride the

colt in the GI Arkansas Derby Apr. 13. Though he'd clearly proved most proficient on or near the pace, Oxbow was ridden from off of the speed and found himself last after a half-mile, but improved his position late to be fifth in a deceptively good effort. Left with the inside stall in the Derby after the scratch of Black Onyx (Rock Hard Ten), Oxbow raced prominently and loomed large approaching the stretch, but weakened a bit to be sixth.



Walking the Dog...

In the capable hands of Stevens, whose two previous Preakness wins came for Bob Baffert (Silver Charm, 1997, Point Given, 2001), Oxbow was given rein and edged past **Goldencents** (Into Mischief) to lead with a circuit to travel, while Itsmyluckyday and **Titletown Five** (Tiznow) were the next-closest pursuers. Orb and GIII Illinois Derby hero **Departing** (War Front) raced as a team further back, while **Govenor Charlie** (Midnight Lute), Will Take Charge and Mylute comprised the latter third of the field into the clubhouse turn.

Oxbow traveled sweetly turning up the backstretch and there were no real deltas until Joel Rosario guided Orb off the inside and into the two path to launch a middle move between Titletown Five and

Itsmyluckyday that carried him to within two lengths of the pacesetter nearing the half-mile pole. But Titletown Five countered up the fence and Departing ranged up to his outside, and all at once, Orb was relegated to sixth and was sending out distress signals as he was niggled along by Rosario. Back at the head of affairs, Stevens was a mere passenger as Oxbow took them around the final turn after breezing the opening six furlongs in 1:13.26, and, surprisingly, his host of pursuers did not include the Derby winner. Itsmyluckyday, three or four wide the whole journey, took aim from the outside and Departing appeared dangerous for a stride or two in upper stretch, but Oxbow had managed to conserve enough energy for that crucial final furlong and stayed on well for the win. Stevens admitted that he resorted to calling an audible early in the race. "We talked about strategy and I didn't expect to be on the lead," he admitted. "In these Classic races, you don't give up anything you get for free. They gave me a free three-quarters of a mile today. I was smiling pretty good midway down the

backside. I actually thought about Wayne [Lukas] up in the grandstand. I knew he would be looking at those fractions and be pleased with what he was seeing." For Lukas, it was not only his sixth Preakness, now clearly the second-most prolific trainer in the event, but his 14th Classic overall, the winningest in Triple Crown history. It was his first Classic success since sending out Commendable (Gone West) to an upset score in the 2000 GI Belmont S. "What a story this is," the beaming conditioner said. "I'm happy for Gary [Stevens] and I'm just so

happy for [Calumet owner] Mr. [Brad] Kelley. He's trying to revitalize Calumet, and now Calumet is back in a Classic race. That's just very gratifying. It's been a while [Charismatic, 1999], but it never gets old. I have great respect for the Phipps family and Shug [McGaughey], but I was telling one of your colleagues that I get paid to spoil dreams." Asked whether he'd press on to the Belmont, Lukas said, "I've got to talk to Mr. Kelley, but I like to rack them up in the big events. So, we'll probably go."

Lukas and Stevens: A Quarter-Century of Classics...

Oxbow's win punctuated an improbable confluence of events that saw Wayne Lukas and Gary Stevens partner for a fourth Classic win together. Lukas, clearly well past his prime, but rejuvenated by the investment of Kelley. And Stevens, who called it a career--or so we thought--in 2005, returning to the saddle just shy of his 50th birthday. Saturday's victory comes just over 25 years after Lukas made the decision to let Stevens retain the Kentucky Derby mount on Winning Colors after she had won the 1988 GI Santa Anita Derby.

Disappointment for McGaughey...

As much as he preaches one step at a time, trainer Shug McGaughey admitted he'd have been lying if he said he wasn't thinking about the Triple Crown.

Disappointed as he was, the Hall of Fame conditioner was gracious and forthcoming in post-race interviews. "I'm disappointed. It was a great opportunity," McGaughey said. "This was quite a run for a couple of weeks. We'll pack it up and go back home and see what kind of horse we've got down the road and figure it out from there." He added, "I don't think two weeks had anything to do with it. Oxbow ran back in two weeks. Itsmyluckyday ran back in two weeks, Mylute ran back in two weeks. I just think he got himself in a position

where he wasn't comfortable and then without the pace scenario in front of him; they really weren't spread out a little bit more than maybe I'd hoped. That probably affected him more than anything else."

The Making of a Preakness Winner...

Oxbow is the third foal from Tizamazing (Cee's Tizzy), a full-sister to dual GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner Tiznow, who was acquired for \$1 million by Richard Santulli at the 2003 Keeneland September sale. Though she was unraced, she has excelled in the breeding shed and produced SW & GSP Awesome Patriot, a full-brother to Oxbow and \$350,000 Keeneland September yearling, in her second year at stud. Expect a Lot, a 2-year-old full-brother to Oxbow and Awesome Patriot, was bought back on a bid of \$190,000 at last year's September sale. Tizamazing is the dam of a yearling filly by Speightstown and a produced a colt by Unbridled's Song earlier this year.

TELL IT TO THE TDN...

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In what would prove a harbinger of things to come, a colt owned and bred by Brad Kelley, ridden by Gary Stevens and trained by D. Wayne Lukas wired the field at longshot odds, in this case Skyring in the Dixie S. Winner of the James W. Murphy S. on last year's Preakness undercard, the homebred had kept busy since, with no fewer than 11 starts with nary another victory, though several near misses. Third by a neck in the GIII American Derby in July, he was beaten a half-length into second by Unbridled Command (Master Command) in the GIII Saranac S. at Saratoga in September and was third at 50-1 against elder rivals in the GIII River City H. Nov. 25. He took a break from grass racing while wintering at Oaklawn Park and was narrowly beaten in the Jan. 11 Fifth Season S. before a fifth in the Essex H. Feb. 2. He was thrown to the wolves against Horse of the Year Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry) in the GI Maker's 46 Mile and attended an easy pace before weakening to fourth. The less-preferred half of an uncoupled entry, Skyring was ridden for speed by Stevens and took them along at an even clip, as his stable companion Optimizer rated in the perfect spot back in third. Nursed along by the Hall of Fame rider through the middle stages, Skyring was asked to kick turning for home, dug in gamely in the final furlong and staved off late rallies from Willcox Inn and Optimizer for his first graded-stakes victory.

Winner of the 2012 GIII Rachel Alexandra S., Summer Applause was touched off late by Believe You Can (Proud Citizen) in the GII Fair Grounds Oaks before finishing a strong fourth to that rival in the GI Kentucky Oaks. Put away for the year thereafter, the bay filly resumed in the inaugural Sam Houston Ladies' Classic Jan. 26, but endured all sorts of trouble, as Miguel Mena lost his irons at one point and she trailed in last in a toss-out sort of effort. That marked her final appearance for the Bret Calhoun barn, and she made a successful debut for this noted outfit, stretching clear to win the GII Top Flight H. by a convincing 2 3/4 lengths Mar. 2. Returned to Grade I company for her latest, the Apr. 12 Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn, she raced close to an easy pace set by On Fire Baby (Smoke Glacken), but could not sustain her bid and split the field in fourth. Facing decidedly softer here, Summer Applause took up a stalking position from second as Daydreamin Gracie (Domestic Dispute) slowed them to a walk on the front end. There was no change in the plot down the backstretch, but Moon Philly (Malibu Moon) split foes and led from between on the turn. That was short-lived, however, as Summer Applause tackled that one at midstretch and drove clear to an easy victory. "There wasn't much speed in the race," winning rider John Velazquez commented. 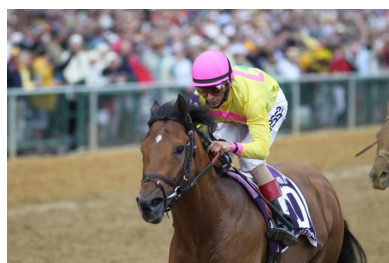

Claimed by these shrewd connections for \$50,000 last February, Sage Valley rounded out the trifecta in a starter/optional claimer at Belmont July 12 and in an entry-level allowance at Saratoga Aug. 25, but has been bulletproof since. An easy winner of a Sept. 12 starter/optional tagger at Belmont, the dark bay dismantled a six-furlong allowance rained off the turf in

Elmont Oct. 3 and was last seen winning Aqueduct's seven-furlong Mr. Nasty S. by 6 3/4 lengths Nov. 9. After emerging victorious in an extended duel for market superiority, Sage Valley took it to them on the track, stamping himself as a potential force in this

year's sprint decision. Drawn widest in this field of 10, the 4-year-old was away without incident and was fourth upon settling, as Manito (Indian Charlie) cut out the early splits. He ranged up into contention three wide on the turn, was shaken up by John Velazquez at the three-sixteenths marker and was doing some of his best running in the final 50 yards to win going away. "The race came up pretty tough," trainer Rudy Rodriguez admitted. "I was looking for a race in New York, but I'm glad I came to this one. He ran great. He's a nice horse; he's lightly raced. He's had some issues so we have to take our time with him and he'll perform. Johnny rode him nicely."

Pianist broke her maiden at second asking in July at Belmont and cleared her first allowance condition at Saratoga the next month before returning to Elmont for a first black-type win in the Sept. 20 Given S. Disappointing at odds-on when fourth in the GIII Valley View S. Oct. 19 at Keeneland and in the Nov. 21 Stardusk S. at Aqueduct, connections regrouped, and the sky seemed the limit when the chestnut returned with a visually impressive allowance victory at Gulfstream Feb. 7. But she stubbed her toe again in her latest, when fifth to next-out GISW Centre Court (Smart Strike) in the GII Honey Fox S. in Hallandale Mar. 16. With Mike Smith having his first ride for Chad Brown, Pianist broke on song and argued the pace inside of Silver Screamer (Cozzene) past the winning post for the first time before leading outright around the clubhouse turn. Though she had to go reasonably hard up front, covering the half in :46.65 and six panels in 1:10.54, she was able to find extra in the stretch and was never seriously menaced en route to her first graded-stakes success.

Farhh only got as far as the starting stalls in his first encounter with Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) at Doncaster's St Leger meeting in September 2010, injuring himself in the gates ahead of the seven-furlong conditions race that first signposted the future Juddmonte giant's considerable prowess. While his nemesis struck gold on several occasions, Godolphin's bay stayed under the radar and he boasted just two handicap successes to his tally at the time of Sir Henry Cecil's peerless

campaigner's streak to glory in this race 12 months ago. A luckless third in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot in June was the first showcasing of Farhh's raw talent, and that was quickly followed by a second in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown before he met with Frankel again

in the G1 Sussex S. at the start of August. Six lengths adrift there, he was a further length behind as that rival sauntered to a career-best in York's G1 Juddmonte International later that month before going down by a head to Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) in what amounted to a match in the Prix du Moulin in September. Nurtured back from his injury after that race, he was expected to be ring-rusty here, but there were no signs of that as he turned on the pace despite having over-raced initially as Declaration of War's rabbit Reply (Ire) (Oasis Dream {GB}) and Penitent (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}) fought for the lead. Dominating from the quarter pole as his chief market rivals floundered around him, he hit the line strongly to provide Saeed bin Suroor with a fifth renewal of a race that helped cement his reputation during the operation's earlier days. "We were slightly concerned about the trip today, but he did it so well maybe we will think about the G1 Queen Anne S. rather than the G1 Prince of Wales's S. [at Royal Ascot June 18 and 19, respectively]," Crisford said. "We'll keep both options open and see what Sheikh Mohammed wants to do. He deserved it, having kept on finishing second to the best horse of all time last year." Sovereign Debt's trainer Michael Bell was delighted with the effort of the surprise package of the race. "His work at home has always shown he is more a 120 horse than a 110, so I wasn't surprised to see him run well," he told *PA Sport*.

"He is a very exciting horse to have. He's in the Queen Anne at Ascot, which I am sure the owner will be keen to have a look at." Joseph Allen's lightly-raced colorbearer Declaration of War arrived at Newbury with serious confidence behind him judged by the betting move for him at 5-4, but could find little in the way of acceleration when asked by Joseph O'Brien before the final quarter, and trailed in a disappointing fifth.

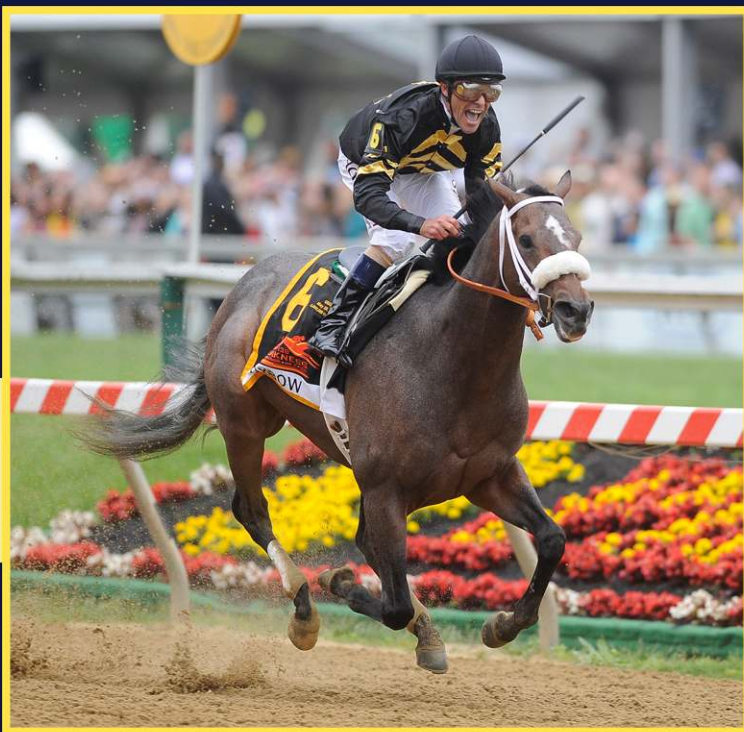

The bay filly returned with a five-length allowance tally at the Big A Mar. 10 and added a six-length optional claimer victory last time out Apr. 11. Favored in her stakes debut, she broke sharply from the rail and took the early lead, setting fractions of :22.14 and :45.04. Fantasy of Flight challenged at the top of the lane and the two rivals duked it out down the stretch, but Glorious View gamely dug in to maintain a narrow advantage. Prior to yesterday's victory it had been fifteen months since Open Water last stood in the winner's circle at Turfway Park in February 2012, although she has been far from disgraced in the interim, tangling with the best of her division on the Southern California circuit last year. Off the board in the GII Hollywood Oaks next out, she finished second in the GII San Clemente S. at Del Mar and third in the GI Del Mar Oaks in her next two outings, followed by back-to-back fifth place finishes in the GI Garden City S. at Belmont Sept. 15 and the GIII Autumn Miss S. at Santa Anita Oct. 27. She rounded out her sophomore campaign with a second place finish to Lady of Fifty in the GII Bayakoa H. Dec. 8, and resurfaced with a no-excuses sixth in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 20.

Off since that effort, Open Water drifted up from her 5-1 morning line to go off the second longest shot in the field here. Sitting about 10 lengths off the pace of runaway leaders Maker or Breaker (Empire Maker) and Sister Kate (Benchmark) down the backstretch, began to move in tandem with Lady of Fifty midway around the turn. With that rival on her inside at the top of the lane, Open Water charged past the frontrunners in midstretch, denying the favorite to post her first stakes victory. "You could tell they were rolling up front--on this track you just can't go that fast early," said winning jockey Joe Talamo. "She was in between horses at about the 4 1/2 [furlong pole], and [Lady of Fifty] was kind of pressing me a little, so I took back and went outside of her. At that time, she took a couple of breathers and I think that really helped down the lane. She was really game." Trainer Eric Guillot added: "She loves this track, that's why I gave her a little freshening after Santa Anita. She danced every dance last year and she was always the bridesmaid, never the bride. She's got a great pedigree. Maybe she's good enough to be a Southern Equine broodmare. She's a Grade II winner now and her second dam is Flanders. BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

DERBY DREAMING

Italy's racing crisis serves as a grim backdrop to today's renewal of the G2 Derby Italiano, but Classic glory remains as prized as ever, and for a brief period the connections of the contenders can suspend reality. In the absence of a real poster boy from the domestic scene in the mold of Rakti (GB) (Polish Precedent), Worthadd (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) and Crackerjack King (Ire) (Shamardal), this edition has a wide-open feel.

Scuderia Blueberry's homebred will have more time to distribute his staying power more evenly here, having attempted to draw the sting from pacier rivals from the front in the country's equivalent of the 2000 Guineas. INTERNATIONAL ATTACK

With US\$2.4 million up for grabs, the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup has attracted a global cast of top-level performers. Stall Antanando's **Pastorius (Ger)** (Soldier Hollow {GB}), winner of France's G1 Prix Ganay last out Apr. 28, has been earmarked as the early favorite. A back-to-back Group 1 winner in his native country as a sophomore last season, Pastorius failed to make it three straight when finishing third, a length behind G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) in September's G1 Grosser Preis Von Baden. The Mario Hofer charge rebounded to take Hoppegarten's G3 Preis Der Deutschen Einheit before rounding out his season with a fourth-place effort behind Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in Ascot's G1 Champion S. in his first overseas voyage. Representatives of Hong Kong have yet to win this event, but that country is represented by two live chances here in the John Moore pair of **Military Attack (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}) and **Dan Excel (Ire)** (Shamardal). The former secured his position as one of the world's leading middle distance runners with a victory last out in the G1 Audemars Piguet QEII Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 28, and the gelding looks for a fourth straight victory here. Dan Excel, a Group 3 winner in his native country as a 3-year-old, was transferred to Hong Kong for the start of his 4-year-old campaign last year and recorded a belated first victory in that country last out in the G1 Champions Mile May 5. He has hit the board just once in six attempts over this distance. The globetrotting **Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) recorded a career high when taking last year's G1 Hong Kong Vase, and ran a remarkable race to finish second in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 30. He comes into this event off a third place finish in Japan's 3200 meter G1 Tenno Sho last out Apr. 28. **Hunter's Light (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) looks to provide Godolphin with its second renewal of this race after it took the 2002 edition with Grandera (GB).

SUPER SINGAPORE SPRINTERS

Singapore-based runners have swept the last two editions of the G1 KrisFlyer International Sprint at Kranji, and they have a chance to go three straight with Michael Freedman saddling the formidable pair of **Super Easy (NZ)** (Darci Brahma {NZ}) and **Mr Big (Aus)** (Elusive Quality) today. Super Easy earned Horse of the Year honors last year on the merit of 12 straight victories, including a sweep of Singapore's Triple Crown. Although he lost four straight races thereafter, the 4-year-old indicated he is returning to top form with a victory in the SG1 Lion City Cup last out Apr. 28. Mr. Big, second in this race last year, has yet to finish out of the top three in 20 races in Singapore, including 10 victories. Fifth in the G1 Al Quoz Sprint at Meydan to kick off this campaign, the 4-year-old finished second to his stablemate in the Lion City Cup. Hong Kong's **Lucky Nine (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}), a four-time Group 1-winner, has been a shade disappointing in his last two outings, but he did win the G1 Chairman's Sprint Prize three starts back. The 6-year-old gelding was most recently seventh in the Sprint Cup at Sha Tin Apr. 28. Having completed the taxing South Africa to Dubai quarantine period, **Kavanagh (SAf)** (Tiger Ridge) took a few starts to shake off the rust over the winter, but he registered a victory at the handicap level in his fourth outing at Meydan Mar. 2 before finishing sixth in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 30, and could be one to watch while returning to the turf off the freshening. Second in that Golden Shaheen was **Balmont Mast (Ire)** (Balmont), an Irish-based runner who has shown great improvement as of late. Flying the Australian flag will be **Bel Sprinter (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}), who registered a career high when winning the G1 Galaxy S. at Rosehill Mar. 30 and was most recently third behind Black Caviar (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) in the G1 T J Smith S. at Randwick Apr. 13.

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READY, SET, GO IN SINGAPORE

As expected, Saturday morning's trackwork did not send the media running to their keyboards, with most of the horses barely raising a sweat. In fact, most of the track watchers had decided to have a lie in after the Singapore Guineas the night before. But the few who had managed to respond to the ring of the 4 a.m. alarm were rewarded with the sheer beauty of Japanese contender **Dasher Go Go (Jpn)** (Sakura Bakushin O {Jpn}) flying down the turf track at full speed.

A 6-year-old, the bay entire is an imposing individual and a beautiful mover. Morning after morning we have seen hints of what he is capable of, with steady canters that have promised much, but with no sign of any speed work on offer. When queried as to why Dasher Go Go has not had a breeze yet, assistant trainer Keiichiro Yasuda explained that, back in Japan, it is the norm to only breeze a furlong or two one day before the race.

Hence, the intrepid early risers lined the rail as Dasher Go Go finally made his appearance. Again, he proceeded round the track in his customary beautifully collected canter and one could be forgiven for wondering whether he was really going to sprint up after all. Yet approaching the final bend, the TV cameras showed an almost imperceptible increase in the speed of the big bay.

Cornering beautifully, Yashuda waited for Dasher Go Go to straighten up, before he finally opened the throttle as he reached the 400-meter marker. The entire responded instantaneously, flying down the turf in an impressive display of sheer speed and power. Of the Krisflyer contenders we have seen so far, this was definitely the most dominant sprinting display and with the Australian speedster **Bel Sprinter (Aus)** (Bel Esprit {Aus}) still battling with dehydration issues, it will come as no surprise if Japan adds an International Sprint trophy to their collection.

Italian-born Umberto Rispoli will be in the saddle on Sunday and, having steered Rulership (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) to victory in the Audemars Piquet QE II Cup in 2011, he is no stranger to the tight South East Asia tracks. Dasher Go Go may not be in the league of Japan's champion sprinter Lord Kanaloa (Jpn) (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), but he

is spot on for Sunday's Krisflyer and, if this morning's work is anything to go by, he might prove very hard to beat.

The only other contender to stretch his legs was the Edward-Lynam trained **Balmont Mast (Ire)** (Balmont). The gelding has been warming up daily on track four before having a six-furlong canter on the Poly, ending in a breeze up for the final furlong. There was a minor upheaval yesterday with Balmont Mast casting a shoe.

Lynam explained that the gelding has very delicate feet and that they were worried about having to replace a shoe so close to raceday. Luckily, it went well and there was certainly no sign of discomfort as Balmont Mast stretched out for the final furlong. **Mawingo (Ger)** (Tertullian), **Hunter's Light (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) and **Lucky Nine (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}) continued their marathon practice sessions again clocking up between 2000 and 3000 meters during their morning workouts.

Michael Freedman, trainer of Mawingo confirmed that he is happy with his new acquisition, who has gradually improved during the week. The steady daily work has proved to have had a calming influence with Freedman adding that Mawingo is settling in much better now and getting used to being left by himself.

One of the often forgotten problems of international travel is that the international horses are usually split between the quarantine barns, depending on their country of origin. Here in Singapore, this segregation has resulted in some horses such as Mawingo and Dasher Go Go being in a barn by themselves. Being herd animals, horses prefer company and often, ingenious plans have to be made by the connections to keep their charges calm when they are isolated. Pat Shaw famously opened all the stable doors in Rocket Man's quarantine barn at Sha Tin allowing the gelding free rein of the entire barn and as already reported, Dasher Go Go has his collection of soft toys keeping him company.

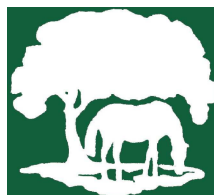
