A NEW WORLD ORDER

As **Dawn Approach (Ire)** (New Approach {Ire}) burned his bridges on the Epsom Downs, it was left to the wannabe champion **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) to take full advantage of the favorite's complete capitulation and win yesterday's 234th running of the G1 Investec Derby. He was one of five entries from Ballydoyle chasing the dream which seemed out of reach provided that Godolphin's G1 2000 Guineas winner stayed the testing trip, but the unbeaten half-brother to Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) was able to draw on his stamina that so necessary in this and emerge victorious at 7-1. Impressive when winning the May 9 G3 Chester Vase, the bay--who became the first blue riband winner to sport cheekpieces--was settled towards the rear early by Ryan Moore with the over-exuberant Dawn Approach just ahead. Following that rival as he tugged Kevin Manning to the lead downhill to Tattenham Corner, he surged to the fore passing the quarter pole and on to a 1 1/2-length success from the strong-finishing **Libertarian (GB)** (New Approach {Ire}). Dawn Approach, favored at 5-4, was already backtracking passing the three-furlong pole and was eased to be last of the dozen. "We feel very lucky to be standing here," John Magnier said. "This is what it's all about. We didn't know where the horses were this year because of the weather and that's why the Derby is such an interesting race, as its all still unfolding. We are just going through a good patch--everybody knew how good my father-in-law [Vincent O'Brien] was and this fellow [Aidan O'Brien] isn't bad either." **Cont. p3**

NEW CLUB RULES

Now in its ninth year as a Classic run over the intermediate trip of 2100 meters, the G1 Prix du Jockey Club offers a contrasting test to its predecessor staged over the traditional 1 1/2 miles "Derby" distance. Won in the past by strong stayers like Top Ville (Ire), Caerleon, Darshaan (GB), Bering (GB), Old Vic (GB), Hernando (Fr), Peintre Celebre and Dalakhani (Ire), it now requires a touch more zip from its main protagonists more in the mold of Shamardal, Lawman (Fr) and Lope de Vega (Ire), a son of the former. One of the rare ones who could fit both categories is the Wertheimers' **Intello (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}), who has a perfect blend of stamina and miling speed in his pedigree, and who arguably would have won the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains had he not suffered from the vagaries of the draw and momentum-stopping traffic in the straight. Finishing with a rattle to be third in that May 12 Classic, he had previously put the subsequent G1 2000 Guineas runner-up Glory Awaits (Ire) (Choirir {Aus}) to the sword in the Listed Feilden S. over nine furlongs at Newmarket Apr. 17 and it will be a surprise if he does not manage to pick up a Classic this term. **Prix du Jockey-Club cont. pxx**

While Kingsbarns (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), **Battle of Marengo (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and even **Mars (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) were establishing their respective Derby claims last term, Ruler of the World was quietly developing at his own rate among the battalions at Rosegreen and was still in the shadows by the time he emerged for a 10-furlong Curragh

maiden Apr. 7. Despite not even starting favorite for that race, he emerged on top with a staying display after which Aidan O'Brien prophesied that "it was one of those races where one of them could have wings." That looked ambitious thinking after the runner-up

Manalapan (Ire) (Six Sense {Jpn}) failed to place in two subsequent starts, but Ruler of the World had his own agenda and went to Chester with a head of steam which saw him take the once-important trial by six lengths. As a result, he entered this race as the only colt to have won over the trip, but was not asked to employ his stamina from an early point with only Libertarian and Mars behind in the initial furlongs.

Ryan Moore, who had been set to ride Telescope (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) before that colt was ruled out by Sir Michael Stoute, had dead aim on Dawn Approach and was able to enjoy a smooth passage up the field on the outside as that rival tanked his way to the front past the steady pacesetter Battle of Marengo at halfway. After the Guineas winner called it a day passing the three-furlong pole, it was Ruler of the World's stable

companion Battle of Marengo who was the target, but no sooner had he joined his barnmate with a quarter mile to race, was he sent into the clear and it was just a case of keeping him rolling from there. "I planned to be a bit closer, but I just didn't get away

very well and it was a very messy race," explained Ryan Moore, who was becoming the first since Commander In Chief in 1993 to win this after being unraced as a 2-year-old. "It was quite a tactical race, they didn't go mad and I got some cover and followed Dawn Approach. The pace started to lift coming down the hill and I was able to creep into it nicely. He quickened up very impressively and got there very quickly and easily, then had a little look when he got there. I had to go on when I did, as, although it was a bit soon and he was very green, I knew he'd stay the trip very well. He's improved a lot from Chester, and I think he'll get further. He showed a really likeable attitude, as for a horse having only his third run, he was at the front quickly enough, but he really toughed it out. I'm very lucky to be in this position and be riding these horses. This is the most important race for me." Aidan O'Brien, who was collecting his fourth edition, added, "All the jockeys had their own plan and all the horses were doing their own thing and that is the way it ended up, but this horse won like a very good one at Chester."

Dawn Eclipse...

The sense of anti-climax was palpable afterwards, with Dawn Approach ruining his chance with a previously unseen fieriness from the early stages. His wide move around rivals on the downhill run was Frankel-like, but unlike that brilliant performer, his engine cut out quickly in early stretch. Trainer Jim Bolger was philosophical in the immediate aftermath. "He jumped out alright and was okay for 10 strides, but there wasn't much pace on and he grabbed his bridle, and from then on he was more or less out of control," he explained. "He'd been running over a mile where there was a strong pace and Kevin had let him bowl. I doubt he'll be running over a mile and a half again." Kevin Manning added, "He did everything 100% and was very relaxed going down, so there was nothing that gave me any indication as to what he was about to do, but after 100 yards it got tight and he lit up and basically bolted with me. I can throw no light on it--I was a passenger and he took me completely by surprise. That was it--it was all over then. I'd been dragging him for a long way by the time he went to the front. I'd tried to get him in behind and that wasn't working, so at that stage he was pulling me to the front, but all the damage was done at that stage. His temperament was always a big plus and he'd not given me any of these vibes. He was just normal beforehand."

The Rise of the Libertarian...

The North of England last sent a winner of this to post in 1945, and Libertarian was only one place off ending the long drought as the leading British-trained contender. Staying from behind to snatch second on the line, the G2 Dante S. scorer could square off with Ruler of the World again in the G1 Irish Derby in four weeks' time. "It's a fantastic run, and if I'd have said we would be second in a Derby at the beginning of March this year, you'd have carried me off in a white coat," trainer Elaine Burke's husband Karl said. "We would have loved to win and thought we had a serious chance, but we have no complaints. William [Buick] said he came down the hill as well as we could have hoped, but because they had slowed it up at the top, it just caught him out for a hundred yards. He was flying home, and The Curragh has got to be a better track for him, but he'd need to be supplemented for the Irish Derby. There is also the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 27] and the G1 St Leger [at Doncaster Sept. 14]--that would have been the route if he had won, so I see no reason to change." Trainer David Wachman was delighted with the much-improved effort of the third **Galileo Rock (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). "We came here thinking we had a little squeak and he ran accordingly," he commented. "Everything is open and he'll be a nice 4-year-old and to travel the world with."

THE CLUE WAS IN THE NAME

In 2012, the powerful Coolmore-Ballydoyle team took off from Epsom with both the G1 Investec Derby trophy and the G1 Coronation Cup, and 12 months on, one of only two things to change was the color of the silks borne by the Derby winner, Ruler of the World (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). The names Magnier, Tabor and Smith

still sat alongside that of the Classic victor and the treble Coronation Cup hero St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), but Ruler of the World carried Ryan Moore instead of Joseph O'Brien, wearing the navy blue silks attributed to Susan Magnier.

It's a moniker that could not have been given lightly, and in fact it was Mrs. Magnier who settled upon the title Ruler of the World

for the horse who now has a Classic victory in keeping with his regal bloodlines. Her husband John Magnier explained, "All our horses are rated by their pedigrees and rated as individuals. Sue decides on the names, and this horse had made his way to the top of the order. Sometimes we get it right and sometimes we get it wrong--we've had a lot of bad American presidents."

The level of success attained by Coolmore at Epsom alone--including five Derby victories since Ruler of the World's sire Galileo became the first winner of the Blue Riband for Sadler's Wells in 2001--implies that they get it right more often than not, though naturally theirs is a team with an awesome array of potential superstars at its disposal. Even by the Irish operation's very high standards, Ruler of the World owns a pedigree of mouth-watering appeal as a future stallion prospect. By arguably the world's pre-eminent sire, his half-brother Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) annexed five Group 1s in the spring and summer of 2008 and is now in the stallion barn in Fethard alongside Galileo. And that's just for starters. With the blue-hen Urban Sea in the top half of his pedigree, nestled in the third generation on the bottom line is Lassie Dear, whose influence is legendary, her family including such stellar names as A. P. Indy (Seattle Slew) and Lemon Drop Kid (Kingmambo). Magnier added, "Ruler of the World's dam was on her way to the breeding shed to be covered by Fastnet Rock and I rang Aidan and said, 'Is he any good?', and Aidan said, 'Oh, he is', so we sent the mare back to Galileo."

For O'Brien, it was Derby winner number four at Epsom, 12 years on from the victory of Galileo, whose offspring now dominate Ballydoyle's stableyard. The trainer, who regularly fields multiple representatives for the race--which appears to mean more to the Coolmore team than any other--is famously reticent prior to the race as to which candidate offers the best chance of success. In the post-race press conference, however, he conceded that Battle of Marengo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Ruler of the World were at the head of the list before adding, "But you're never sure." O'Brien said, "Ruler of the World has been highly rated ever since he came to Ballydoyle and that's why he was given the name--I think that speaks for itself." Asked why the colt was unraced last season, the trainer replied, "I was afraid to run him at two with a name like that!"

Jockey bookings usually reflect the team's favored horse, and this year, the trainer's son Joseph was aboard Battle of Marengo, yet another son of Galileo, who started second-favorite to Dawn Approach and eventually finished fourth. Apparently being aboard Ballydoyle's second string didn't faze Ryan Moore, who had ridden Ruler of the World to win the G3 Chester Vase on only his second start.

"He's unbeaten, but his Chester win was in a small field with a slow pace, so it was hard to gauge exactly what we had, but when Aidan told me I was riding him, I was delighted," said Moore, who won his first Derby aboard Workforce (GB) (King's Best) in 2010. Moore, whose post-race responses are often notably brief, was in a loquacious mood at Epsom before dashing off to ride at Lingfield's evening meeting. He added, "The whole Thoroughbred breed hinges on the Derby--it's what racing is about for everyone working in stables and studs. I'm sure the lads will celebrate tonight, but we'll all go back to work in the morning."

St Nick a True Epsom Great...

Pretty Polly, The White Knight, Petite Etoile, Triptych and Warrsan have each won the Coronation Cup twice, but St Nicholas Abbey surpassed them all on Saturday when becoming the first horse to secure a hat-trick of victories in the Group 1 contest.

His trainer Aidan O'Brien has dominated the race in the last decade, winning with subsequent four-time Ascot Gold Cup winner Yeats (Ire) in 2005, Scorpion (Ire) (2007), Soldier Of Fortune (Ire) (2008) and Fame of Glory (GB) (2010) before St Nicholas Abbey's string of successes. For a horse who has now won six times at Group/Grade 1 level, St Nicholas Abbey has somehow never quite received the credit he deserves and for this O'Brien is quick to blame himself.

"He is very classy and everyone forgets that he won a [G1] Racing Post Trophy by five or six lengths," he said. "He turned on the speed as a 2-year-old, so he's had that class all the way through. Obviously his trainer destroyed him at three, and it's taken him three years to get back. He's an incredible horse."

Now six, the son of the late and much-missed Montjeu can also boast a GI Breeders' Cup Turf and this year's strike in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic in addition to his historic trio of Coronation Cups. The peculiarities of Epsom's camber make it very much a track for course specialists, and St Nicholas Abbey can be counted as one of the very best to have graced the turf at the Surrey track.

"He's a great traveler--as he comes down the hill he slowly moves up in gears. For us it's a real privilege to be involved with him, he's a joy to have," added O'Brien.

St Nicholas Abbey could be seen back in action as soon as the Royal Ascot meeting with co-owner Derrick Smith and O'Brien both nominating the G2 Hardwicke S. as his possible next target ahead of another stab at the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S., in which he finished a length and a half behind Danedream (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}) when third in that race last July.

With Ocovango (GB) (Monsun {Ger}) performing so creditably at Epsom yesterday, the Niarchos Family's **Bravodino** (Dynaformer) must come into the equation despite his wide draw. Runner-up to that rival in the G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud last time May 4, the half-brother to Kris Kin (Kris S.) looks as if he would appreciate a stiffer stamina test than this, and he will need everything to fall right from his post position. Beyond that duo, this renewal has a wide-open feel to it, and His Highness The Aga Khan's second-string **Shikarpour (Ire)** (Dr Fong) could enter the picture despite his inexperience. He beat the Fabre trainee Paco Jet (Ire) (Westerner) in a debutantes contest over 11 furlongs at Longchamp May 12 and may have more scope for improvement than the owner-breeder's May 14 G3 Prix de Guiche winner **Dalwari** (More Than Ready), who faces a tall task from stall 16. Jim Bolger's disappointment at the wayward performance of his stable star Dawn Approach (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) at Epsom yesterday could be lessened by a big run from his homebred **Loch Garman (Ire)** (Teofilo {Ire}). Reportedly in need of the race when a promising second to the close-up Epsom Derby fourth Battle of Marengo (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G2 Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial S. at Leopardstown May 12, last year's G1 Criterium International scorer remains an intriguing prospect, but he will have to deal with a potential rough-house environment for the first time here. Godolphin, who are also smarting from the dramatic eclipse of Dawn Approach, field a strong contender in the unbeaten **Sky Hunter (GB)** (Motivator {GB}), a half-brother to the classy pair Nayyir (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and Highest (Ire) (Selkirk). Successful in three minor events so far, he needs to find a bit more to be competitive in this race, but has caught the eye each time he has appeared, and it is interesting that his trainer runs him against Intello.

Three years ago, the Derby happened without St Nicholas Abbey after he was ruled out late due to an injury, but the leading European money earner of all time at nearly £5 million has made up for that misfortune by exercising an iron grip on this prestigious race. Few expected the five-time top-level scorer to be denied an unprecedented third renewal by his sole serious rival Dunaden in this impoverished edition, and the market confidence proved correct once again. Patiently ridden by his number one fan Joseph O'Brien with only that foe behind early, he was in cruise control as he was moved up to take command approaching the quarter pole. Any thoughts of a match were quickly dispelled, with Ballydoyle's 6-year-old pointing his toe and rushing to the line to make history with real authority.

"He has matured over the winter and lobs down to the start on a long rein now, and it's the same in his races, so you can put him where you like," his rider explained. "In his blow at home, he was exceptional the other morning and he's much better than ever, so he's a force to be reckoned with. He loves this place and the undulations and never puts a foot wrong--he's so well-balanced and has so much pace I never had a moment's worry. We hope this year he can show what we hoped he would over the last couple of years. He's entitled to be up there with the best of them now." This was the 11th time that St Nicholas Abbey has been on a left-handed track and his seventh win accordingly, with nine of those outings coming over this trip or further. Only Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) has managed to overcome him when racing under his ideal conditions in last year's G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, which he returned to garner at the end of this March. That was his first start since he was unable to defend his crown in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita in November, which came at the end of a busy spell during which he was made to look ordinary by Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Juddmonte International over an extended 10-furlong trip at York in August. Now that the way is clear of that heavyweight, the major races could be at the mercy of Derrick Smith's apparently improved performer, and his proud owner is looking forward to campaigning him aggressively. "He's a horse I have loved from the first time he ran and dare I say, he's better than he ever was," he said. "The G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. [at Ascot July 27] springs to mind and we might go to the [June 22] G2 Hardwicke S. there first and keep running him." Trainer Aidan O'Brien added, "He's an incredible horse and has everything you want in a racehorse--he travels and quickens and is a joy to be around. Joseph said he has been very fresh for the last three weeks, as it's been a while since he ran. What everyone forgets is he won a Racing Post Trophy with speed as a 2-year-old, so he had that class all the time and the trainer destroyed him at three. It's possible he'll go to Royal Ascot for the Hardwicke, as he would have to go away for a racecourse gallop before the King George anyway."

Though Clubhouse Ride didn't have Game On Dude (Awesome Again) to deal with, another tough foe from the Bob Baffert barn named Liaison stood between the 5-year-old and a breakthrough victory at the graded-stakes level. But the 3-1 second choice employed his tactical speed to sit closer to the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and held sway late for a richly deserved success. Acquired by these connections from the Craig reduction at Barretts in early 2010, the chestnut was a stakes winner and third to Comma to the Top (Bwana Charlie) in the G1 CashCall Futurity at two, but had just one additional victory in 20 subsequent appearances, a downhill allowance at Santa Anita last Oct. 25. He was looking to snap a streak of five consecutive runner-up efforts, the last three to Game On Dude in the GII San Antonio S. Feb. 3, the GI Santa Anita H.--albeit 7 3/4 lengths in arrears--and in the GII Charles Town Classic Apr. 20. Away without incident from the inside box, Clubhouse Ride settled in third with Liaison fourth, as Batty Man (Arg) (Manipulator) and Blueskiesnrainbows (English Channel) kept each other company up front. Without being asked, the chief market rival crept into contention approaching the turn, and, with Garrett Gomez taking a confident glance over his right shoulder, swept to the front three wide approaching the five-sixteenths. Liaison was in full flight as well, but was spun wider into the stretch, and though he looked dangerous for a stride or two late, Clubhouse Ride was always holding him in the run to the wire.

We'll probably have to ride him differently [in the G1 Durban July]. Between the Guineas and Daily News 2000 I haven't really wound him up that much. I think this horse has still got a bit to come, but he's going to need it in the July."

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BLACK-TYPE PREVIEWS

LORD LOOKS TO REIGN AGAIN

A solid field of milers lines up to contest today's G1 Yasuda Kinen at Tokyo Racecourse, and they will all have to bring their best to tackle last year's G1 Longines Hong Kong Sprint hero **Lord Kanaloa (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), the 2-1 morning-line favorite. The 5-year-old earned his first top-level victory in last year's G1 Sprinters S.--where he defeated defending champion Curren Chan (Jpn) (Kurofune)--and that win kicked off a four race streak, which included the Hong Kong Sprint next out as well as his first two races this year: the G3 Hankyu Hai Feb. 24 and the G1 Takamatsunomya Kinen Mar. 24. The Lord Horse Club colorbearer looks for his first win at this distance. "Because of the extra distance this time, we've been pushing him less to fire him up and letting him ease into things a bit more," said trainer Takayuki Yasuda. "Up to this week we'd worked on getting him physically fit and this week we worked him on the woodchip course. It's his first time over the Tokyo course, and even though he had this distance once as a 3-year-old, he's a different horse now so, for all practical purposes, this is really like his first time at the distance." **Glorious Days (Aus)** (Hussonet) makes his first voyage out of Hong Kong, and he carries with him top form from his country. Second to Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus}) in the G1 Longines Hong Kong Mile in December, the John Size charge defeated Group 1 winners Dan Excel (Ire) (Shamardal) and California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}) in the Stewards' Cup at Sha Tin. Jan. 20. He was most recently fourth to Dan Excel in the G1 Champions Mile May 5. The local contingent includes **Grand Prix Boss (Jpn)** (Sakura Bakushin {Jpn}), who finished 12th in the Hong Kong Mile and rebounded to take his belated seasonal debut in the G2 Yomiuri Milers Cup Apr. 21, and the 4-year-old filly **Verxina (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}), who recorded a career high in the G1 Victoria Mile last out May. 12.

Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Thani goes into today's G2 Prix de Sandringham at Chantilly double-handed with two serious fillies in **Topaze Blanche (Ire)** (Zamindar) and **What a Name (Ire)** (Mr. Greeley), who are both on a retrieval mission following respective Classic disappointments. While the former was 13th in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches at Longchamp May 12, What a Name managed only a seventh placing in the G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket May 5. They had already proven their ability at the highest level at two, when runner-up in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, respectively, on the Arc undercard, and those efforts are probably a fairer indication of their ability. What a Name's trainer Mikel Delzangles said, "She is in great form and we found after the Guineas at Newmarket she was in season, which explains why she ran disappointingly. She is fine now, I am happy with her and I hope she will bounce back this weekend. If all went well, we would look to run her in the [June 21] G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot." Marquesa de Moratalla's **Dauphine Russe (Fr)** (Russian Blue {Ire}) was a place behind Topaze Blanche when fourth in the G3 Prix de la Grotte won by **Kenhope (Fr)** (Kendargent {Fr}) over this trip at Longchamp Apr. 14, but she fared better than that duo when fifth in the Poulaches.

ALL THE MOVES COVERED

Andre Fabre has eight renewals of the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly on his resume and saddles a trio today, headed by Khalid Abdullah's **Dance Moves (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), who is the type of slow-burner that his trainer excels with. Fourth in this 12 months ago, the homebred went on to annex the Listed Prix de Boulogne over 10 furlongs at Longchamp in September, where the subsequent G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris and G3 Prix Exbury winner **Saga Dream (Fr)** (Sagacity {Fr}) was back in third. Last seen finishing fourth in the Listed Prix Vase d'Argent over 10 furlongs at Toulouse Apr. 26, he is joined by Teruya Yoshida's **Pirika (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) who beat **Haya Landa (Fr)** (Lando {Ger}) in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville over 12 furlongs at Longchamp last time May 8; and OTI Management's **Only a Pleasure (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). Third in the G3 Prix de Lutece over 1 7/8 miles at Longchamp in September, he was a disappointment on his seasonal finale when ninth in the G2 Prix Chaudenay back over that track and trip in October.

Always in a Tiz Works, Belmont Decision Pending...

Always in a Tiz (Tiznow) breezed five furlongs in 1:01.12 at Belmont Park, and a decision on the colt's participation in Saturday's GI Belmont S. is pending. "He worked well [Saturday] morning, and galloped out well," said Dominick Schettino, who trains Always in a Tiz for MeB Racing Stables and Brooklyn Boyz Stables. "I will speak to the owners tonight and we'll make a final decision after that." Runner-up to **Vyjack** (Into Mischief) in the Traskwood S. last December, Always in a Tiz was third, beaten a half-length as the favorite, behind the Belmont S.-bound Will Take Charge (Unbridled's Song) in the Smarty Jones S. at Oaklawn Park Jan. 21. The dark bay has finished well down the field in his last two starts, a fifth in a sloppy renewal of the GIII Southwest S. Feb. 18 and a ninth in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 6. "I'm going to watch him train at Churchill the next couple of days and we'll decide Monday," McPeck said. "He seems to be going in the right direction. 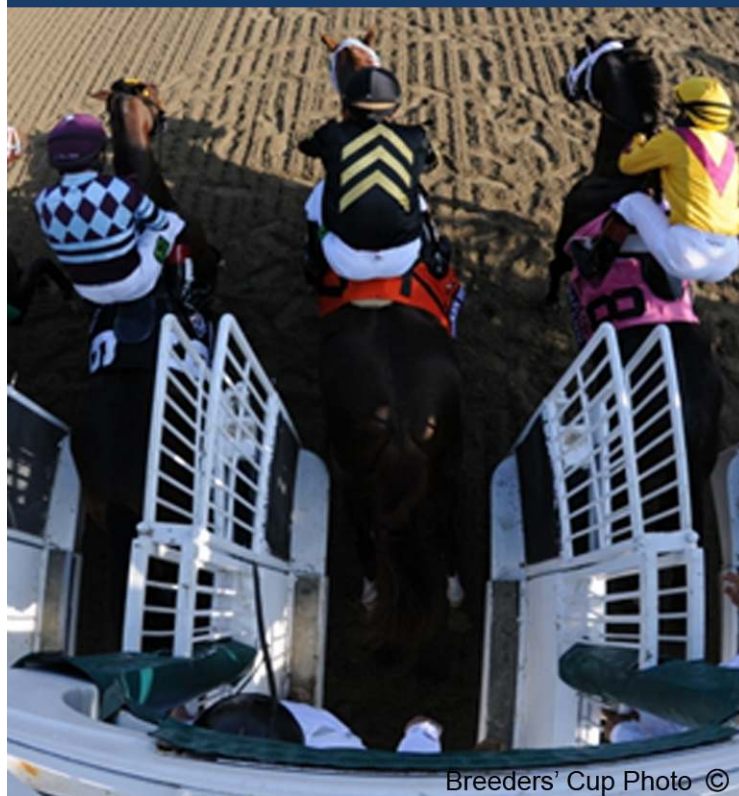
