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'MALICE' A 'FORE'-THOUGHT IN BELMONT

Cot Campbell pioneered the idea of racing partnerships in the late 1960s, but, in November 2011, announced that he was pulling back after 40-plus years in the business. Following the 13-1 upset of **Palace Malice** (Curlin) in Saturday's GI Belmont S., he may consider jumping back in fully. At 85 years of age and 23 years removed from Summer Squall's victory in the GI Preakness S. and runner-up effort in the GI Kentucky Derby, the ebullient South Carolinian was full of emotion in the winner's circle. "It's the mother of all great moments, I'll tell you that," he told Bob Costas. "I'm proud for Dogwood and for my great partners...and I'm proud for Aiken....they'll be dancing in the streets, so proud. And for the horse! The horse, the horse, I'm SO proud of him!" **Cont. p3**

At the moment, nobody here has mentioned Frankel." Among Juddmonte's other significant stallions are Oasis Dream (GB) and Dansili (GB), while the entire operation features around 900 horses.

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The Highest of Expectations...

A \$25,000 Keeneland September yearling purchase in 2011, **Palace Malice** was a different sort when he reappeared in Lexington for the 2012 Keeneland April Sale of 2-Year-Olds in Training. Hip 36 was knocked down to Campbell, who has made it something of a habit to sign for horses early in the sales. "He was

always a nice horse and we were thrilled to get him and honestly we were kind of surprised to get him for that [\$25,000] price [as a yearling]," stated Niall Brennan, whose brother Colin signed for Palace Malice as a yearling. "He had a chip in his hind ankle,

and maybe that turned some people away, but we never took it out. He was only a May foal, but he was well grown." Brennan explained the rationale for pointing the colt towards the Keeneland sale. "He was young in his mind and I decided in December that he wasn't a horse that I wanted to push on to an early sale. We wanted to give him a break for a few weeks and point for the Keeneland sale and that helped greatly. He always showed a lot of athletic talent. I thought that since he was by Curlin out of a Royal Anthem mare, the synthetic track should be to his liking, and he trained well over the track." Brennan also paid tribute to the Dogwood maestro. "I am so thrilled for Mr. Campbell," Brennan offered. "He is one of the great inspirations in our sport today. How can you not be happy for a guy like that? It's been a privilege for us to be involved."

A Promising Start...

It wasn't but three months after the sale that Javier Castellano donned Dogwood gold-and-green for his July 5 debut over five furlongs of the Belmont main track. Always held in high regard by the Todd Pletcher stable, Palace Malice was bet down to 2-1 and came running late to be second before graduating as a heavy favorite next time out at Saratoga Aug. 4. He emerged from that effort with bucked shins, so instead of pressing on to the late-season stakes, he was put away for the year and made his 3-year-old bow in a seven-furlong Gulfstream allowance contested over a sloppy strip Jan. 19. However, he had the misfortune of running into a race-fit Majestic Hussar (Majestic Warrior) and settled for the runner-up spot. That effort earned Palace Malice a chance to prove his mettle along the Triple Crown trail, and it was the GII Risen Star S. in New Orleans that would mark

his stakes and two-turn debuts. With Rosie Napravnik at the controls, the athletic bay threatened in the final furlong before finishing a close third with the likes of subsequent Classic place-getters **Oxbow** (Awesome Again), **Golden Soul** (Perfect Soul {Ire}) and Mylute (Midnight Lute) behind him. The GII Louisiana Derby beckoned as a logical next step, but what unfolded was a nightmare, as he made a solid middle move, but was blocked when the real running started and he could do no better than seventh to favored **Revolutionary** (War Pass) as the 7-2 second choice. With a Derby berth hanging in the balance, Palace Malice was sent to the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. on just two weeks' rest Apr. 13, and he looked on his way to victory, only to be nailed on the wire. According to Campbell, the colt jumped off leads when he saw tire tracks nearing the wire that day. Therefore, the decision was made to equip him with a set of blinkers for the Derby. The results were disastrous, however, as Palace Malice essentially ran off on the lead with Mike Smith, set a suicidal pace and drifted back through the field to finish 12th. Cont. p4

Fresh and Fit for the Belmont...

With those three races in the span of 36 days and with no compelling reason to go on to the Preakness, Palace Malice was programmed for the Belmont and turned in three exceptional works leading up to the race. **Freedom Child** (Malibu Moon), the GII Peter Pan S. winner, won the break, and, as trainer Ken McPeck advertised, **Frac Daddy** (Scat Daddy) was ridden for speed from the inside stall to fuel a fast early pace which saw the opening quarter go in :23.11. Oxbow was close in tow, and Palace Malice was able to get

down several paths from his high draw, but might have clipped heels with the Preakness winner and was four wide into the first turn.

GI Kentucky Derby winner **Orb** (Malibu Moon) and that race's runner-up **Golden Soul**

whipped them in as they braced themselves for the long Belmont backstretch. Frac Daddy had run his race by the halfway mark, and the Preakness winner pressed past to lead narrowly from Freedom Child after a half in a testing :46.66, as Mike Smith, who won the 2010 Belmont aboard Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) monitored things from third. Revolutionary, the Derby third, was the first to make any real noise from behind, advancing into about fifth as they approached the far turn, at which point Smith said go with Palace Malice, and the duo challenged for the lead leaving the half-mile pole. Further behind, a mud-covered Joel Rosario had steered Orb out of the kickback and into the clear, and that team made ominous progress as they looped horses on the turn. Back at the head of affairs, Palace Malice and Oxbow matched strides entering the 11th of the 12 furlongs with Orb looking dangerous from third, but the Pletcher trainee put away a game Oxbow, and, though leg-weary through the final 110 yards, proved clearly best. "I kept saying I know there's a big [race] there; I felt like [Palace Malice] had a big one in him," said Pletcher, who sent out Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy) to his first Classic win over Palace Malice's sire in 2007. "I kept waiting for it to materialize in the afternoon. He got close a couple of times but didn't quite get it done. It was an emotional win for me because of the Dogwood connection," said Pletcher, who also finished fifth with Revolutionary, sixth with the filly **Unlimited Budget** (Street Sense), seventh with **Overanalyze** (Dixie Union) and 12th with **Midnight Taboo** (Langfuhr). "They supported me from the very beginning and to win a big race for them is really gratifying." Other top Dogwood horses trained by Pletcher include Trippi, dual Classic-placed Impeachment, Grade I winner Cotton Blossom and multiple graded winner Smok'n Frolic.

Mixed Reviews for Oxbow, Orb...

Oxbow turned in yet another strong effort in the Belmont, finishing second after attending those sharp early fractions. "I was really happy with his performance today," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who was trying for a fifth Belmont win. "Anytime you could hook into a field with that much parity and that many good horses...he performed as well as we could have expected." Orb's victory in the Kentucky Derby had the racing fraternity and trainer Shug McGaughey, by his own admission, thinking Triple Crown. His fourth in the Preakness dashed those dreams, and yesterday's performance was equally frustrating. "He just ran OK," the Hall of Famer said. "He made a good run around the turn, but we had given up so much. The speed horses held all up front and we just couldn't catch them."

A Lane's End Legacy...

Palace Malice was bred, raised and sold by Lane's End, their seventh Belmont winner as a consignor (Bet Twice, A.P. Indy, Lemon Drop Kid, Jazil, Thunder Gulch and Rags to Riches). Will Farish acquired Palace Malice's dam Palace Rumor (Royal Anthem) for \$140,000 in foal to Tiznow at Keeneland January in 2008 and put the mare back through the ring in foal to Curlin, and therefore carrying Palace Malice, at the 2009 November sale. She was bought back on a bid of \$190,000. The mare has an unnamed 2-year-old filly of this year by City Zip, and a foal colt by Pomeroy. Farish parted ways with Palace Rumor in 2011, selling her in foal to Mineshaft at Keeneland November.

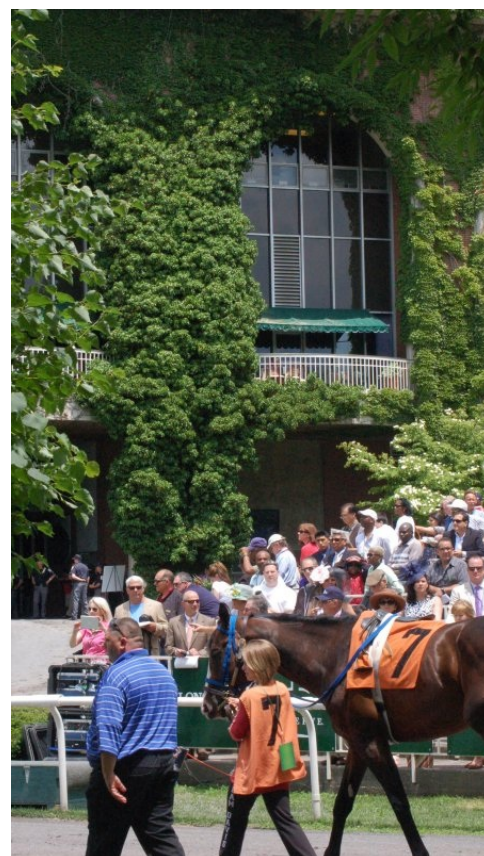

Point of Entry looked a mile the best on paper and was accordingly bet into 55 cents on the dollar. His backers had to sweat it out a bit for a few strides inside the final half-furlong, but asserted his superiority to give trainer Shug McGaughey a third Manhattan (Good Reward, 2005; Dancing Forever, 2008). The Phipps homebred was a revelation in 2012, with many calling him the best American-based turf horse in many years. He earned that reputation by amassing a five-race winning skein, which included wins in the GII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland in the spring followed by a clear-cut success in the GI Man O'War S. going 11 furlongs of this turf course July 14. Equally dominant in taking the GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga Aug. 18, Point of Entry overcame a yielding Belmont turf to best the solid European-based Treasure Beach (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational Sept. 29, a victory that propelled him into 2-1 favoritism for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 3. He found himself well off the pace of Little Mike (Spanish Steps) that afternoon, was floated five wide into the Santa Anita stretch and was getting to Little Mike late, but was forced to settle for second, beaten a half-length. Beaten out of an Eclipse Award by Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry), Point of Entry was kept in training in 2013 with an eye on a return trip to California. After a half-interest in the horse was sold to Stronach Stables, Point of Entry made a much-anticipated 5-year-old debut against Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Feb. 9.

He took that clash of the titans by 1 1/4 lengths and was to make his next start in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic on Derby Day, but the weather gods intervened, and Point of Entry was re-routed for this prestigious event.

Longshot Plainview (Street Cry {Ire}) outsprinted Optimizer and Bombagua (Borrego) to the lead and set a comfortable early pace, as John Velazquez settled Point of Entry last but two until they turned up the backstretch. At that point, the heavy chalk was pulled out to the three path and commenced a steady advance into a midfield position after six furlongs in 1:12.94. Optimizer was the first to go for home and overtook a tired Plainview midway on the turn, but Point of Entry was able to sustain his momentum, and the battle was joined at the head of the stretch. Real Solution, forwardly placed throughout, took a run at Point of Entry inside the final furlong, but couldn't seal the deal, as the favorite inched clear late.

"We all know that this type of course is not his favorite, but every time you ask him to run, he gives you everything he has," Velazquez commented. "It's really nice to be able to ride these kind of horses. Sometimes it looks like he's not going anywhere, but he's running hard. He's so big it takes him a long time to get going, but he still runs his heart out."

Stephanie's Kitten was the recipient of a perfect hedge-clipping ride by John Velazquez and outlasted fellow GISW Better Lucky to land this star-studded affair. A maiden winner over the Arlington turf at third asking, the homebred was third in the GIII Natalma S. before ending her freshman campaign with wins in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. and in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. Connections had sights on Royal Ascot and the G1 Coronation S. last June, but Stephanie's Kitten got a late start on the season, and though she was third in the GI Ashland S. in April and victorious in the Edgewood S. the following month, the overseas trip was called off. From there, she and Centre Court (Smart Strike) became close acquaintances, as she was a troubled fourth to that one in Saratoga's GII Lake George S. July 25 before evening the score in the GII Lake Placid S. Aug. 19. They hooked up for a third straight time in Keeneland's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Oct. 13, but neither could get to the front-running Dayatthespa (City Zip), with Centre Court second and Stephanie's Kitten a disappointing sixth as the favorite. The Ramsey runner made her seasonal debut in the GII Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill May 4 and caboosed the field for the opening half-mile before a stinging late rally carried her to a neck success from Hungry Island. The Just a Game lost a touch of its luster when Dayatthespa was scratched just after noontime Saturday due to the rain-affected turf, but the race produced a thrilling finish nevertheless. Cont. p7

In the absence of Dayatthespa, Mizdirection (Mizzen Mast), the second of two Breeders' Cup winners in this field, loomed as the controlling speed and had things very much her own way beneath Mike Smith, setting leisurely fractions of :24.50 and :48.13 while pressed along by a hard-to-handle Laugh Out Loud (GB) (Clodovil {Ire}). Centre Court drafted in behind those two and GI Matriarch S. heroine Better Lucky trapped out punching the wind from four wide. Stephanie's Kitten and Hungry Island raced in tandem at the back. The field began to bunch up rounding the turn, and Stephanie's Kitten snuck up the fence, first past Centre Court, then, gifted the inside by Mizdirection, past that California raider, as Better Lucky made it a line of four in upper stretch. It was the Godolphin runner who led narrowly into the final furlong, but Velazquez kept Stephanie's Kitten alive with a vigorous left-handed whip and willed her home first. "It was do-or-die, you stay there or you die in there. It was one of those things," Velazquez explained. "She handled the ground great so that was the most important thing. When I asked her, she was there for me. The opening was there. I saw Mike's horse [Smith, aboard Mizdirection] was drifting out anyway, and I was behind Julien [Leparoux, aboard Centre Court]. I know she gets out a little bit, so I sat there right next to Julien. I thought if I could hold him in there and then get through on the inside, it would be perfect. It opened up just enough for me and when I shot through there, she went."

Capo Bastone (Street Boss) to win the GIII Derby Trial S. by a neck Apr. 27. As expected, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Let Em Shine (Songandaprayer) flaunted his speed from the outside stall, cleared his rivals and got his opening quarter in a flashy :21.99 with Zee Bros (Brother Derek) close in tow. Meanwhile, Forty Tales and Capo Bastone kept each other company at the rear. Clearly Now loomed a threat three wide approaching the lane, but Let Em Shine still led, though he had to go a half in :44.73, and the back markers were set to make their mark. RACETRACK ROUND-UP

'DAN' HEADS FOSTER WORKS

Successful Dan (Successful Appeal) and **Take Charge Indy** (A.P. Indy) were among those sent trackward yesterday morning in preparation for Saturday's nine-furlong GI Stephen Foster H. Victorious in the GIII Ben Ali S. at Keeneland in Apr. 23, the gelding breezed a half-mile over Keeneland's Polytrack in :48.40. The work ranked 20th of 66 at the distance.

"He worked well and galloped out really strong," said trainer Charlie LoPresti. "He was hard to pull up after the work, because he wanted to do more and we wouldn't let him do more than that. We didn't want to go fast today. We just wanted :12s at every pole and he couldn't have done it any better. He cooled out really well and now it's just a matter of keeping him happy till the race."

Also on yesterday's Churchill Downs worktab was Take Charge Indy, who breezed a half-mile in a bullet :47 under regular exercise rider Johnny Byrne. The winner of the GIII Alysheba S. launched his four-furlong work at the three-eighths pole before crossing the wire in :34.40. The 4-year-old completed the move in :47 and galloped out five furlongs in 1:01.40.

"Johnny did a great job of putting a little speed back into the big fella," trainer Pat Byrne said. "I wanted to put a little air into him today and we've got him ready for next Saturday. He's training as good, if not better, for this race as he did for the Alysheba."

In his latest start May 31, Take Charge Indy breezed five furlongs in 1:03.80 under Rosie Napravnik at Churchill Downs.

"He went slow, because he's smart," Pat Byrne explained. "The track was empty and he likes to chase a horse, because he's competitive."

Added Johnny Byrne, "I've worked a lot of good horses and a lot of bad ones, but he's probably the trickiest horse I've worked. If you don't ask him to work, he'll just diddle-daddle around there. He's competitive and he's clever. If he sees something to run at, he'll do it easy."

Also working toward Saturday's feature is **Pool Play** (Silver Deputy), who took the 2011 edition of the Stephen Foster and **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown), who finished in a dead-heat for the win with Alpha in last year's GI Travers S.. Pool Play breezed five furlongs in 1:01.20 and Golden Ticket went the same distance in 1:00.80. Pool Play, under Miguel Mena, started his work two-lengths behind stablemate Troubadour Tango and finished two lengths in front. He galloped out six furlongs in 1:13.80.

"When we won the race in 2011, even though we were longshots, we were confident," said assistant trainer Norman Casse. "This is a much tougher rendition of the Stephen Foster. I hope the real Pool Play shows up and he can be competitive against some of the best horses in the country."

Accompanied by Marvin Abrego, Golden Ticket worked in company with GIII Matt Winn S. contender Bellarmine (Magna Graduate). Golden Ticket recorded fractions of :12.40 and :36.60 before galloped out in 1:14. Golden Ticket finished about four lengths ahead of Bellarmine, who was credited with a five-furlong time of 1:01.60.

"I think both horses got what they needed out of the work and they both came out of it well," said Phil Bauer, assistant to trainer Ken McPeck.

In his latest start, Golden Ticket won a one-mile optional claiming race at Churchill Downs May 2.

"I think Golden Ticket is coming into the race in good shape," Bauer confirmed. "He seemed to like the surface here in his last race and so, if he can stretch it out to two turns against some better competition then he should be good."

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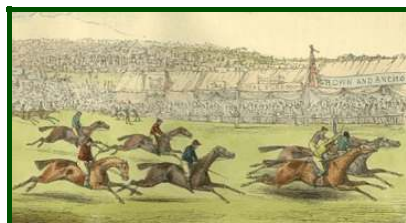
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FARHH OUT OF ROYAL MEETING

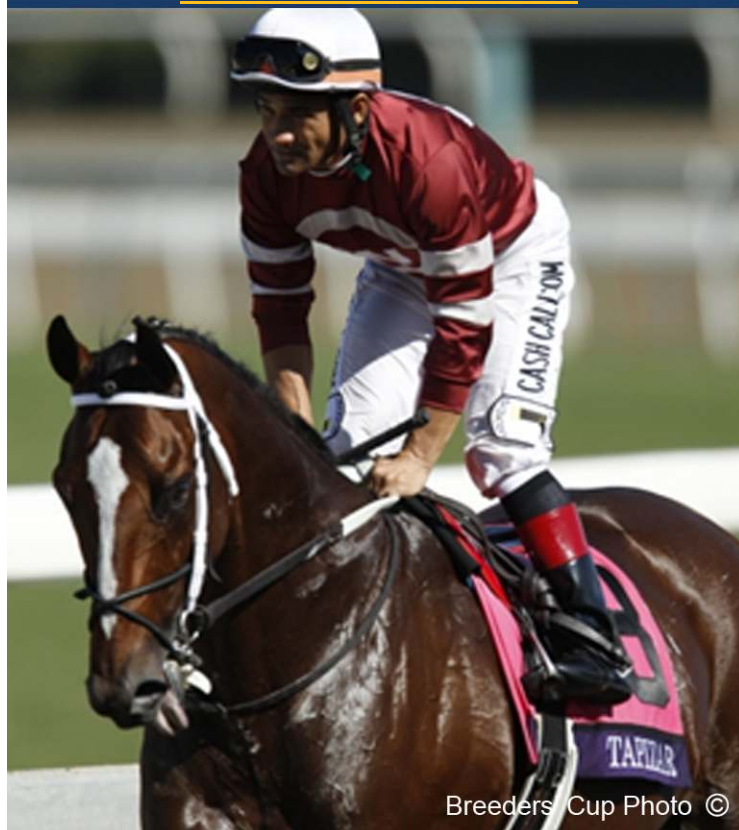

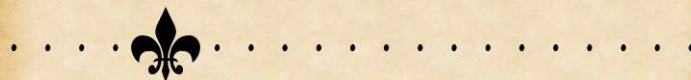
