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'DAN' SEEKS GRADE I SUCCESS IN FOSTER

Morton Fink's **Successful Dan** (Successful Appeal) faces five Grade I winners as he seeks his own first victory at the highest level in Saturday evening's

GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs. The \$500,000 event offers a "Win and You're In" berth to the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "That would be the ultimate," trainer Charlie LoPresti said of the half-brother to 2012 Horse of the Year Wise Dan (Wiseman's Ferry). "I'd like to see him get a Grade I." While Successful Dan doesn't boast an official Grade I tally on his resume, he did cross the wire first in the 2010 GI Clark H., only to be disqualified and placed third for interference. Forced to miss all of 2011 with a suspensory injury,

Successful Dan bested Foster opponent and eventual Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Fort Larned** (E Dubai) in the GII Alysheba S. last May before being upended by that foe in the GIII Cornhusker H. at Prairie Meadows in June. He was then forced to the sidelines yet again. "It's been frustrating," LoPresti said of the homebred's stop-and-start career. "That's the best way to put it. Had he not been plagued with the injuries he's been plagued with, you probably would have seen a potential Horse of the Year in him at some point." But with a victory over last Sunday's GII Monmouth S. winner Boisterous (Distorted Humor) in Keeneland's GIII Ben Ali S. Apr. 21, Wise Dan comes into this heat the right way. "Historically, his second race [off a layoff] has been even better. He's 110% right now. I couldn't have him any better." Of who he fears most in this short, but extremely contentious field, LoPresti said, "I think Fort Larned has to be respected an awful lot. He's the Breeders' Cup Classic winner. The other horse I'd worry about is **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate), who beat Wise Dan by a head [in this race] last year. Those are the two I fear the most." **Field p3**

DAWN APPROACH CONFIRMED FOR ASCOT

In a surprise move, Godolphin's **"TDN Rising Star" Dawn Approach (Ire)** (New Approach {Ire}) will bid to bounce back from his G1 Epsom Derby debacle in Tuesday's G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, it was confirmed yesterday. Initially slated for a break after losing his unbeaten record in the June 1 blue

riband, Jim Bolger's trainee will bid for redemption dropped back down to a mile on the meet's opening day. "He's been left in the St James's Palace and, subject to a satisfactory piece of work [today], he is an intended runner," Bolger told godolphin.com. Racing manager Simon Crisford added, "Jim is very happy with how Dawn Approach has done since the Derby and he is keen to let him run at Royal Ascot if everything continues to go well with his preparation between now and the race. We had a discussion this morning and decided to let him run if he pleases in his work. Jim has been delighted with how relaxed Dawn Approach has been in his training."

Royal Ascot June 18. The 5-year-old chestnut went five furlongs in 1:03.00 under jockey Paul Carberry at trainer David Lanigan's Kingsdown yard in Lambourn.

"It went well," said trainer Graham Motion, who was in England to oversee the work of the GI Kentucky Derby and G1 Dubai World Cup winner. "I wasn't looking for a real hard work for him. I wanted him to do something within himself, and I think it went very smoothly. I was very pleased. It was kind of similar to what we did with him before the Breeders' Cup." RACETRACK ROUND-UP

'NAME' AMONG KING GEORGE ENTRIES

Sheikh Abdullah bin Khalifa Al Thani's **Very Nice Name (Fr)** (Whipper) is being aimed at Ascot's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. July 27, for which 29 initial entries were unveiled yesterday. Not seen since finishing third behind fellow entry **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan Mar. 30, the Alban de Mieulle-trained 4-year-old is a star name in Qatar and connections are set to take the plunge in the midsummer feature where he will be partnered by Olivier Peslier. "The horse has been good since Dubai," de Mieulle explained. "We hoped to run in the G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly last week, but the ground was not right for him so we decided to wait. He will go straight to Ascot now. We were very pleased with his performance in Dubai. He didn't have a good draw and, although he wouldn't have won, I think he would have been closer to the second had he been drawn better. He has proved he is high-class there and that's why we want to run him at Ascot. He did a very good piece of work under Olivier Peslier one morning recently when we were preparing him to run at Chantilly and I'm hoping there is more to come from him on the track." Most notable among the list for the £1-million Betfair-sponsored 12-furlong contest is **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) and Susan Magnier's G1 Epsom Derby hero **Ruler of the World (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who headed a 10-strong Ballydoyle contingent including last year's G1 2000 Guineas and English and Irish Derby scorer **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}).



HISTORY IN MOTION

Training racehorses, like many other aspects of the Thoroughbred industry, could be described as a fine balance between science and art. International campaigns provide a whole new dimension, and on June 18, British-born, American-based trainer Graham Motion will attempt to pull off a truly unprecedented training feat when he saddles Team Valor International's G1 Kentucky Derby and G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Animal Kingdom** (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot. **Cont. p6**

Derby winners have won in Dubai before and World Cup winners have emerged victorious at the Royal Meeting, but never before has a horse completed the hat trick. Animal Kingdom will become the first Kentucky Derby winner to compete at Royal Ascot since Triple Crown winner Omaha finished second in the 1936 Gold Cup. What's more, if he is successful, he will retire with Grade/Group 1 victories on dirt, synthetic, and turf surfaces on three different continents.

So how does one prepare a horse for such a feat? Motion noted that Animal Kingdom's personality has been the foundation for his success.

"He's a horse that adapts to most anything," Motion said. "He's such a sensible horse that handles things so well, and I think that's one of the reasons we're doing this. If he wasn't, we wouldn't be doing it."

This kind of challenge no doubt requires a horse of great talent and constitution, but without the right trainer at the helm, even the greatest horse's hopes would be dashed up the testing two-furlong climb to the Queen Anne finish line. Motion has truly had his wits tested in developing Animal Kingdom from a lightly raced Kentucky Derby winner into the horse he is today—including two lengthy layoffs due to injury—and preparing the colt for the Queen Anne over one of the world's most difficult courses may be his greatest challenge yet.

The trainer, who has made the transatlantic trip to monitor his champion several times over the past few months, returned to England in time to watch Animal Kingdom put in his final work at trainer David Lanigan's yard in Lambourn yesterday. The 5-year-old went five furlongs in company in 1:03.00.

Motion, who last visited when Animal Kingdom put in a racecourse gallop at Ascot May. 29, said the chestnut appeared visibly more fit six days out from the race.

"He seems to have done well since we've gone to Ascot," he said. "He looks fitter to me, so I'm very pleased with him." **Cont. p7**

Motion noted that the basic principles of Animal Kingdom's training have remained the same throughout his international travel, and the main adjustment he has had to make is to the undulating gallops and racecourses of England. Motion noted that Animal Kingdom has trained daily on a straight gallop with a steady climb, and he has also done some slow work on an undulating turf gallop that would more closely mirror Ascot. In a testament to how demanding this change is on a horse, Motion admitted it took Animal Kingdom some time to make the adjustment, but he has seen a vast improvement since the horse arrived in England Apr. 6.

"The first couple weeks it took some getting used to for him, because it was so different from what he has done before," Motion explained. "Once we worked him, he really got the hang of it, and he's been more aggressive and more on the muscle and he just goes about the gallops like he's been here all his life. Physically, he's put on different muscles. Galloping up a steady climb like that everyday, his muscles have certainly changed."

Another first for Animal Kingdom next Tuesday will be racing on a straight course rather than around an oval as he has done in America and Dubai. The straight mile of the Queen Anne includes two sizeable dips before the climb to the finish, which commences about two furlongs out. Motion noted it was for this reason that he sent his charge to test the racecourse at Ascot, something he wouldn't consider a necessity in America.

"It's certainly going to be a challenge; it's going to be difficult for him," Motion noted. "[Ascot Racecourse] offered us the opportunity to do that, so it seemed to me to make sense, but in the States I would not normally do a racetrack breeze."

Despite the unique challenges presented, Motion noted he would not change race tactics with Animal Kingdom, who will be reunited with his Derby-winning jockey John Velazquez for the first time since a Gulfstream optional claiming victory last February. Animal Kingdom's ownership group opted to replace Dubai World Cup winning jockey Joel Rosario in favor of Velazquez, who has won at Royal Ascot in the past.

NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



FEATURED LEGISLATOR:

U.S. REPRESENTATIVE JOHN YARMUTH (D-KY)

District: Kentucky's 3rd in north central Kentucky - home to the city of Louisville, Churchill Downs Incorporated and the Kentucky Derby.

Experience: Rep. Yarmuth is serving his fourth consecutive term in the U.S. House of Representatives. He was first elected in November 2006. His professional background includes positions in media, business, higher education and health care.

Impact on horse racing industry: Rep. Yarmuth has been a leader in Congress for the horse racing industry. He currently is one of a bipartisan group of seven in the U.S. House of Representatives that is drafting comprehensive reform of the U.S. immigration system. The Senate's bipartisan "Gang of Eight" crafted an immigration reform bill (S.744) earlier this year which is being debated this week on the Senate floor.

Horse racing will likely be impacted by comprehensive immigration reform as both the H-2A visa (used by farm owners for workers) and H-2B visa (used by trainers for grooms) programs are expected to be changed and/or replaced in the Senate bill. It is not clear what form the House bill will take but the NTRA has made certain that Rep. Yarmuth is aware of our industry's needs and concerns.

"He's a straightforward horse, Johnny knows him, and it comes down to the reason we're riding Johnny," Motion said. "He knows the horse and he's ridden at Ascot. If Joel was riding, I think it wouldn't be as straightforward for him since he's never ridden the course before. I'd like to think having Johnny's experience riding at Ascot will help."

"We were faced with the decision of whether to use Joel, who's obviously ridden the horse, but never ridden at Ascot, using a European rider, who's ridden the course, but never ridden Animal Kingdom, or using Johnny, whose done both, and that seems to me the logical way to go."

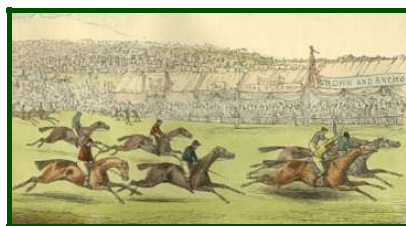

SILASOL HEADS DIANE DOZEN

The Wertheimers' **Silasol (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) yesterday featured among 12 remaining entries for Sunday's G1 Prix de Diane Longines at Chantilly. Last year's G1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner added the G1 Prix Saint-Alary to her tally at Longchamp last time May 26. "Silasol is very well, she worked yesterday morning on les Aigles and we'll just have to see how she goes on Sunday now," trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias told the *Racing Post*. She may be joined by stable companion **Ferevia (Ire)** (Motivator {GB}), who was third in the Saint-Alary and who is another recent acquisition by Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Thani, but her conditioner is watching the skies. "Ferevia is very well and I'll decide for sure on Thursday morning, but we would only supplement her if there was the prospect of soft ground and, looking at the weather forecast, we might wait for the G2 Prix de Malleret [at Saint-Cloud June 23] with her," he added. Despite the numerically small list, the 1 5/16-mile Classic is set to be a strong renewal on paper with Al Thani possibly represented by the May 12 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulisches heroine **Flotilla (Fr)** (Mizzen Mast) and Baron Edouard de Rothschild's silks set to be carried by the Andre Fabre trainee **Esoterique (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}), who was runner-up in that Longchamp Classic. The latter's stable also has the Poulisches third **Tasaday** (Nayef), who runs for Godolphin, and Gestut Ammerland's G3 Prix Cleopatre scorer **Baltic Baroness (Ger)** (Shamardal), while Jean-Claude Rouget looks set to saddle Martin Schwartz's Prix Saint-Alary runner-up **Alterite (Fr)** (Literato {Fr}).

WARREN PLACE SENDS OUT RUNNERS TODAY

Thursday's racing across Britain and Ireland will feature a quintet of runners from Warren Place Stables, which now operates under Lady Cecil following the death of Sir Henry Cecil on Tuesday. After the British Horseracing Authority granted a temporary licence to Cecil's widow, the famed yard will be represented at Newbury, Nottingham, Yarmouth and Leopardstown, with the latter venue the scene of the G3 Ballyogan S. in which Trevor Stewart's G3 Abernant S. winner Tickled Pink (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) is a significant protagonist. Fittingly, two of Cecil's most loyal and longstanding patrons--the Niarchos family and Khalid Abdullah--have runners, with the former establishment responsible for the Newbury-bound Galileo (Ire) duo Phaenomena (Ire) and Rajaratna (Ire), and the latter Morpheus (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), a half-brother to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) who goes to Nottingham. Sir Robert Ogden's recent Salisbury maiden winner **Songbird (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) completes the team in a handicap at Yarmouth. That owner's Racing Manager Barry Simpson told *PA Sport* yesterday, "I think the filly that runs at Yarmouth typifies Sir Henry's great understanding and patience with his horses. She was a very backward filly and Sir Henry didn't want to run her as a 2-year-old or a 3-year-old. I think a lot of trainers would have run her and she might never have won a race, but Sir Henry had a lot of faith in her, took his time and she won first time out as a 4-year-old very well. Sir Henry has received many great accolades, and quite rightly so. He will be very sadly missed, but he has put a wonderful marker down for other trainers to aspire to." The racing industry continued to feel the ramifications of the great trainer's passing yesterday, with more silences to commemorate his life at Kempton and Yarmouth. Sir Henry Cecil's private funeral will take place on Monday, June 24 at St Agnes Church in Newmarket for family members only, with a service to celebrate his life set to take place at a later date.

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QUARANTINE AT WOODBINE The Ontario Racing Commission quarantined one of the Woodbine barns and implemented shipping restrictions after two horses tested positive for equine herpesvirus, according to *Daily Racing Form*. On Monday, an unraced 2-year-old from Tom O'Keefe's barn was euthanized after displaying neurological symptoms. The next day an unraced 2-year-old filly trained by Paul Attard was sent to the clinic with similar symptoms. Both horses were in Barn 1, which is now under quarantine. "The barn is under full quarantine, and we're trying to manage the number of personnel allowed in," Adam Chambers, manager of veterinary services for the Ontario Racing Commission, told *DRF*. "This will probably continue for a number of days, anywhere from 14 to 28 days, depending on whether the disease spreads."

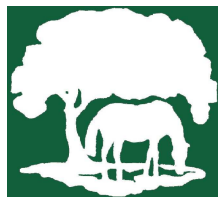
