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GOLD SHIP SAILS TO NAKAYAMA WIN

A "Win and You're In" event for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita this November, this year's G1 Takarazuka Kinen took a hit when its defending champion Orfevre (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) was withdrawn 10 days ago after bleeding mildly in a work. Ironically, connections are now reportedly considering a run in the Turf as an alternative to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, but it was reigning champion 3-year-old colt **Gold Ship (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}) who earned the automatic berth at Santa Anita with a dominating score in front of 70,413 fans at Nakayama.

Drawn wide and with only G1 Japan Cup winner and G1 Sheema Classic runner-up **Gentildonna (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) to his outside, Gold Ship was ridden positively by Hiroki Uchida to race in a handier position, and settled in a distant fourth as **Silport (Jpn)** (White Muzzle {GB}) opened up by as many as 12 lengths down the backstretch. **Danon Ballade (Jpn)** (Deep Impact {Jpn}) came next, followed by the two market leaders, who raced side by side. They began to close in on the weakening pacesetter approaching the final 400 meters, and Danon Ballade led briefly before being overhauled by Gold Ship at the furlong grounds. Gold Ship was always doing the best of the bunch and ran out a convincing winner, as Danon Ballade held second from the one-paced Gentildonna. "This horse was in very good form, so I was able to take him towards the front while saving enough energy for the finish," Uchida explained. "I'm very glad that we were able to win over the other two strong rivals and look forward to more great performances in the future." *Cont. p3*

NOVELLIST ON TOP AT SAINT-CLOUD

With the returning **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) a victim of his own freshness in Sunday's G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, a Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" test, the race was left wide open, and the talented German raider **Novellist (Ire)** (Monsun {Ger}) took full advantage to add another success in a top-level French contest to his country's tally, following Pastorius (Ger) (Soldier Hollow {GB})'s win in the G1 Prix Ganay two months ago. "We will consider the King George if he is well and later on, the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe [at Longchamp Oct. 6] is the target," trainer Andreas Wohler said. *Cont. p3*

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MOTT HAPPY WITH CLOSE HATCHES

Close Hatches (First Defence) exited her 7 1/4-length victory in Saturday's GI Mother Goose S. in fine shape, according to trainer Bill Mott. "She looks great; I'm happy," Mott said. "[Saturday] she just kind of shot to the lead and seized the race at the three-eighths pole, and kept going. She trains like she had a race like that in her. She ran well last time [second in the GI Acorn] and didn't embarrass anyone [when seventh] in the GI Kentucky Oaks, although probably that wasn't her best race. She ran very average in the Oaks, and good in the Acorn, and real good yesterday." Mott added the Juddmonte filly will likely make her next start in the July 20 GI TVG Coaching Club American Oaks at Saratoga.

Trainer Todd Pletcher was also satisfied with the way **Dream of Julia** (A.P. Indy) exited her runner-up finish in the Mother Goose. "She came back well," Pletcher said. "She'll head to Saratoga [Monday] and prepare for something, possibly the Coaching Club, possibly the Alabama [Aug. 17], possibly both."

Gold Ship won five of his six outings in 2012,
including the G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas)
and G1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St. Leger), but a close
fifth to Deep Brillante (Jpn) in the G1 Tokyo Yushun
(Japanese Derby) between those scores cost him a
chance at the Triple Crown. In the absence of Arc
runner-up Orfevre, Gold Ship validated favoritism in
Japan's year-end championship, the G1 Arima Kinen
Dec. 23, then picked up where he left off with a handy
success in the G2 Hanshin Daishoten at a dime on the
dollar Mar. 17. He would use the G1 Tenno Sho
(Spring) Apr. 28 as a springboard to this, but he was
never a serious threat to win and finished fifth behind
Fenomeno (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}).

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He settled in fourth within shouting distance of the free-wheeling Cirrus des Aigles. Moving through a gap opened up by the sideways maneuver of his rabbit on the final turn, he tackled the favorite in early stretch and quickly had his measure as the petrol gauge was close to reading empty on the returning champion.

Asserting after the quarter pole, the homebred was beyond recall by the time Dunaden emerged with his customary belated effort. Connections of the winner are considering a tilt at

Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. July 27. "Last year, he was not quite himself in the Derby, and the Grosser Preis von Baden was a strangely run race after which he had an allergy the next day," trainer Andreas Wohler explained. "He finished the season well, and I was very pleased with his comeback run." Dunaden is also being aimed at the latter race, but is due a break beforehand, according to connections. "He traveled well, but didn't have his usual kick and is maybe a little tired after a heavy campaign in the early part of the year," the owner's Racing Manager David Redvers said. "He will come back after a nice summer off with the Arc in mind." Haya Landa's conditioner Loic Audon said, "Once again, she has run a very good race, and the ground is the key to her, as the softer the better. Depending on that, she could go for the [Aug. 25] G2 Grand Prix de Deauville or the [Sept. 1] G1 Grosser Preis von Baden."

Novellist found Pastorius (Ger) too tough to handle in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg last July, after looking to seal his position as the leading domestic 3-year-old beforehand. Only fourth in the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden in September, the bay traveled to the San Siro to annex the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano in October and signed off on the season there. Back with a workmanlike win under a penalty in the May 12 G2 Grosser Preis der Badischen Unternehmer over 11 furlongs, Novellist was helped by the pace set by Lateran Accord (Ire) (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) here.

Riding the River captured last year's GII King Edward S. by a neck and returned to add the GII Nijinsky S. by the same margin. He was runner-up in the GII Play the King S. before concluding 2012 with a fourth-place finish in the Sept. 16 GI Woodbine Mile. He closed to be second, beaten just 3/4 lengths, in the May 26 GII Connaught Cup in his

only previous start this term. The even-money choice was taken in hand and sat a stalking fourth behind fractions of :23.41 and :46.20. Tipped out three wide turning for home, Riding the River took a narrow lead in upper stretch and idled briefly before outbattling a game Valentino Beauty to the line for a narrow victory. "He made the lead quite easily and then he pulled up and hung on me," said winning rider Todd Kabel. "He had me pretty nervous coming down the lane, but once he saw the one horse [Valentino Beauty] come up on the inside, he started digging back in again and wouldn't let him by." Winning trainer Dave Cotey was surprised to see his charge favored. "He hasn't had any respect in the past," Cotey said. "When I saw 6-5, I thought, 'Oh no,' but the old guy took care of him there and bailed us out. I was almost under the table with my eyes shut the last few yards."

Pacific Rim started out with a fourth over 10 furlongs at Longchamp Apr. 14 before breaking her maiden over this trip at Maisons-Laffitte May 22 and adding a conditions race at Longchamp last time June 10. Entering this test a bit light on experience and boasting no black-type form, the bay emerged with the laurels in a tactical affair in which she was ideally placed by Umberto Rispoli. Settled close to the steady pace in a stalking role, the homebred was committed passing the quarter pole and soon held a decisive advantage, as she was pushed out to score in comfortable fashion. "She was not with me last year and is obviously a late-maturing filly who won very well last time and had improved since," trainer Mikel Delzangles said. "She had a very good trip today and showed nice acceleration, so will step up in class now. The [Aug. 22] G1 Yorkshire Oaks may come too soon for her, so the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 15] is probably more of a target.

Neatico captured the G3 Herzog von Ratibor-Rennen at Krefeld in November 2009 and, despite maintaining an admirable level of consistency in the interim, had yet to register a second black-type success. Runner-up on his three starts so far this term, most recently in Cologne's Listed Premium Dreierwette May 30, the bay ended the long wait with a typically determined display here. Stalking Empire Storm throughout, he wore down that rival approaching the furlong pole and asserted to win with something in hand. Owner Manfred Ostermann summed up matters when saying, "He really deserved this victory, he was unlucky a few times recently, and he is such a game and consistent horse."

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

KING GEORGE THE PLAN FOR EKIHAAM

Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's **Ektihaam (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) was yesterday reported as unscathed for the slip that cost him his chance in Saturday's G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot and remains on course for Ascot's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. July 27. In the clear after the first half-mile, he lost his footing and unshipped Paul Hanagan in the contest won by the ill-fated Thomas Chippendale (Ire) (Dansili {GB}). Connections are buoyed by the fact that he had previously beaten that rival by six lengths in the Listed Buckhounds S. at the Berkshire venue May 11. "He seems A1 this morning and hopefully he's none the worse," trainer Roger Varian told *PA Sport*. "You have to try to keep things in perspective when you see what happened to the winner, and the main thing is our horse is in one piece and so is Paul. It was a nasty incident and could have been an awful lot worse. However, when you sideline all that, it is extremely disappointing and frustrating. When you consider we beat the winner by six lengths the time before, I'm not saying we would have done the same again, but form doesn't normally turn around that much and in effect we had six lengths to play with. We'll see how he comes out of the race, as it would have been quite a shock for the horse. He did extremely well to stand up. We won't run him again until we're 100% happy with him. He's in the [July 11] G2 Princess of Wales's S. at Newmarket and later on the King George. The King George wouldn't be completely off the radar. I don't think we'd be talking off the wall looking at the King George, and it wouldn't be ruled out. We'll just make sure he's physically and mentally right before we do anything. We won't rush him back."

GI Apple Blossom H. winner **On Fire Baby** (Smoke Glacken), who was forced to miss the GII Fleur de Lis H. after spiking a fever, has resumed training with trainer Gary Hartlage at Churchill Downs. "She's been going back to the track for three days and we're just taking it easy on her," Hartlage said. "She jogged 1 1/2 miles and galloped 1 1/2 miles this morning." In her most recent start, the 4-year-old filly was second in the May 3 GII La Troienne S. Hartlage said no future start has been targeted. "I don't know where we'll go from here," he commented. "We'll take our time. She'll tell us."

FIFTYSHADESOFGOLD FINE AFTER DEB WIN

Clarence Scharbauer Jr.'s **Fiftyshadesofgold** (My Golden Song) exited her eight-length victory in Saturday's Debutante S. in fine shape, but her future start is up in the air. "Everything is good today," trainer Bret Calhoun said Sunday. "She's doing well." Stablemate **Bahnah** (Elusive Quality), a debut winner at Churchill June 6, is being aimed at the July 19 GIII Schuylerville S. "We don't have any plans for Fiftyshadesofgold at this point," Calhoun said. "We'll try to get a plan together in the next week or so, but I don't even know what's out there outside of the race at Saratoga, which is where Bahnah is going. Right now, I don't think I'd want to run them both there."

RYDILLUC WORKS FOR VIRGINIA DERBY

Rydylluc (Medaglia d'Oro) turned in a seven-furlong work over the turf at Belmont Park Sunday in 1:27.60. The colt is being aimed at the July 13 GII Virginia Derby over 1 1/4 miles at Colonial Downs. "The Virginia Derby is kind of the middle of a 'Y' and if he can handle a mile and a quarter, maybe he heads to Arlington for the [Aug. 17 GI] Secretariat S., but if the mile and quarter doesn't turn out to be his forte, we have two beautiful races at Saratoga, the [Aug. 9 GII] Hall of Fame S. and the [Sept. 1 GIII] Saranac S.," said Contessa. "So, I would say that we could go in either direction, we don't know, but the next step is going to be Virginia, unless he stumbles or something happens."

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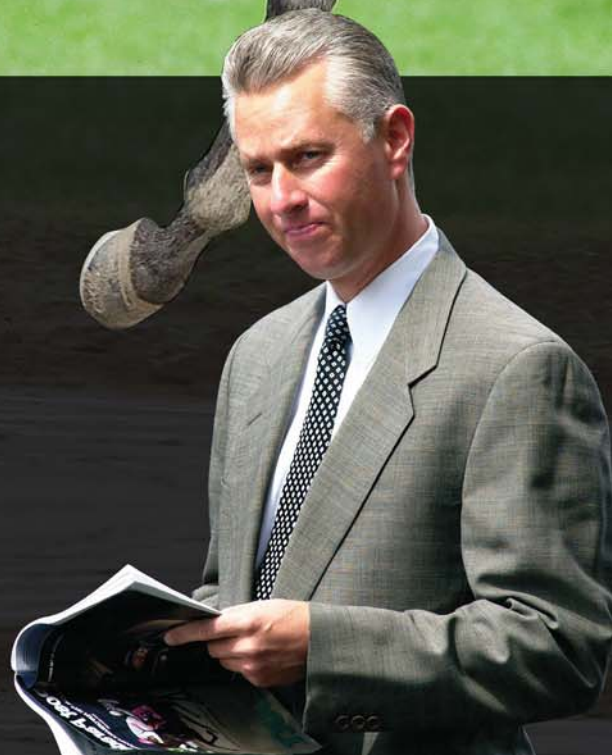

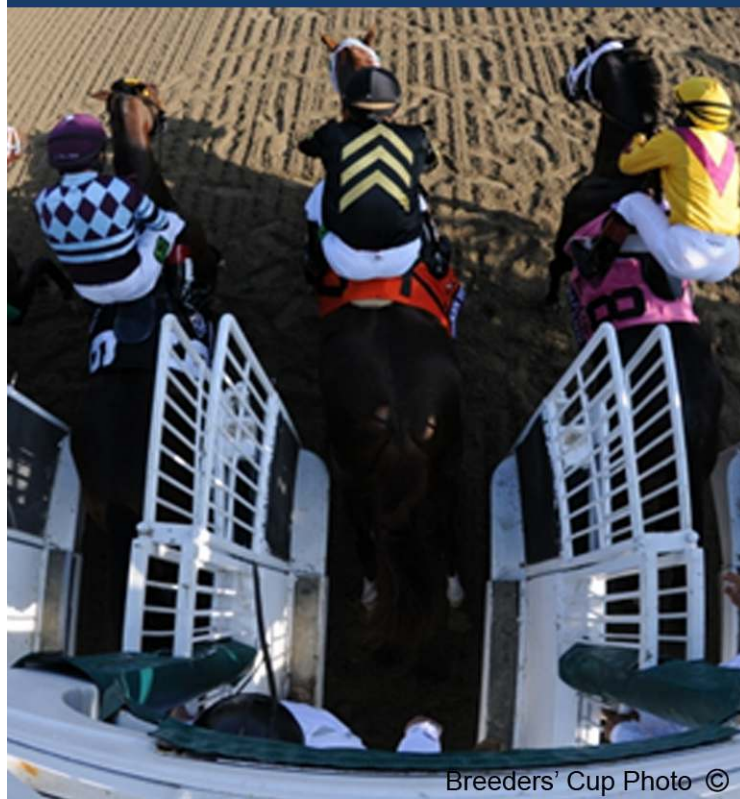
