Newmarket's track record and chalk up a notable double. Sent off at 9-2, the grey quickly established the lead against the stand's-side rail and clocked regular splits of around 10 1/2 seconds to see off all comers and score by 1 1/2 lengths from Diamond Jubilee runner-up **Society Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}). "He's been razor-sharp after Ascot and I think he's

confirmed today that he's pretty good," trainer Clive Cox commented. WAR FRONT 1-3 IN VA DERBY

Magdalena Racing's **"TDN Rising Star"** **War Dancer** (War Front) came out the narrow victor of a three-way battle to the wire in yesterday's GII Virginia Derby, besting **Charming Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) by a head with another head back to **Jack Milton** (War Front).

Favored **Ryduilluc** (Medaglia d'Oro), previously unbeaten on the turf, faded in the stretch to finish a dead-heat eighth after chasing the pace. Three wide out of the stretch for the first time, War Dancer traveled about three off the inside and raced in the slipstream of the chalk as they approached the final

sweeping turn at Colonial. Three wide into the stretch, he was full of run, but so too were Charming Kitten--who was gifted a rail run by his weakening stablemate **Redwood Kitten** (Kitten's Joy)--and Jack Milton, who had to wait off heels before delivering his challenge on the wide outside. Those three came to the wire together, with War Dancer in the middle just getting his nose down first. [Rider Alan Garcia] did a great job," said winning conditioner Ken McPeck. "We always felt this was a real nice horse." Of what could be next for the dark bay, McPeck offered, "There are a lot of great options. I'd like to try and make the Breeders' Cup in some fashion. You never know how 3-year-olds are going to be able to compete with older horses at that time of year." **Cont. p7**

Flashing his natural but unfurnished talent at two when fourth in the G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot and G2 Vintage S. at Goodwood, Lethal Force struggled to make an impact last term as many sophomores do in Europe. Despite a second placing in the Listed Carnarvon S. at Newbury last May, a third in the Listed Sandy Lane S. at Haydock in June and fourth in the G3 Jersey S. back at the Royal meeting, the feeling was that Lethal Force was holding back, and first-time blinkers were applied in the G2 Hungerford S. over seven furlongs at Newbury in August. It may be that the headgear helped connections to discover his raw speed, but that all-the-way success was put down to a possible fluke after he faded to be third under similar tactics in the G2 Park S. at Doncaster the following month. Kept at seven furlongs for the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in October, he failed to see out the trip on heavy ground and returned with the emphasis back on sprinting when lining up for the G2 Duke of York S. over six furlongs May 15. Beaten a head by Society Rock while in receipt of five pounds there, he turned that form on its head in the Diamond Jubilee, but still had his doubters with him appearing to enjoy the run of the race in front there. Casting all aspersions aside, he flowed along against the fence setting fractions of 10.62, 10.48, 10.67 and 10.7 after the first furlong and drew the sting from the likes of the 3-1 favorite **Shea Shea (SAf)** (National Emblem {SAf}).

Only a brief jink before the furlong pole gave Adam Kirby any concern, and it was Society Rock who gave honest pursuit in vain as the grey kept digging in up the rise to the line to set his own personal seal on this prestigious race. Clive Cox, who was forced to take out Reckless Abandon (GB) (Exchange Rate) two days ago, has a myriad of options open to the winner now and added, "He'll give us a clear indication where to go by how he comes back from here, but he's a seven-furlong Group 2 winner, so the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest [at Deauville Aug. 4] is a possible. Beyond that, we've had lots of kind invitations from as far afield as Australia and Hong Kong, so we'll take it a step at a time. He knows he's the real deal now and does compose himself very well, so he will be the best judge."

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Grand Prix de Paris cont.

Flintshire, who is a son of the 2002 G1 Prix de Diane runner-up and dual pattern-race scorer Dance Routine (GB) (Sadler's Wells), did not race at two but immediately showed more ability than his 5-year-old full-brother and stable companion Dance Moves (GB) when scoring over 10 furlongs at Chantilly May 7. Coming unstuck on testing ground when runner-up at 3-5 in a conditions event over 1 5/16 miles here at the start of June, the bay brushed aside **Park Reel (Fr)** (Country Reel) back on a sound surface in the Prix du Lys, and it was that rival who again provided the pace here as Maxime Guyon was content to wait on the hot favorite. With his stable companion **Ocovango (GB)** (Monsun {Ger}) holed up on the rail in early stretch, Flintshire was asked to make his move out wide and in a matter of strides he had loomed to the front and into the clear. Heavily eased in the final 50 meters with the race in safe keeping, he flattered Manndawi and Ocovango with their proximity, even if the latter may have been closer with a clear run.

Verema showed she was the classy staying type that her connections excel with when winning the G3 Prix de Lutece over 15 furlongs here in September before filling fourth spot in both the G2 Prix Chaudenay and G1 Prix Royal-Oak, also at this venue, the following month. Third in the G3 Dubai Gold Cup over two miles on her seasonal bow at Meydan Mar. 30, the bay was second to Last Train (GB) (Rail Link {GB}) in the G3 Prix de Barbeville back here Apr. 28 before disappointing when only fifth returning for the May 26 G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier. Settled in third early by Christophe-Patrice Lemaire as Les Beaufs (Fr) (Apsis {GB}) set off in isolation, as usual, the homebred was ridden confidently with significant ground still to make up in early stretch, but justified that faith by inhaling the long-time leader passing the furlong marker en route to a comfortable score. "The key to this filly is the ground," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre commented. "The faster the better for her and she got exactly what she loves here. She stays well and had proven her quality before. I have no race in mind for her, maybe the G2 Prix de Pomone [at Deauville Aug. 10], but not the G1 Yorkshire Oaks."

sidelines, but that void has been capably filled by
consistent veteran

Boisterous came to hand
at the end of his 3-year-
old year and was a
multiple graded stakes
winner by the end of the
following season. A close
third in last year's
Manhattan, the dark bay
stretched Rahystrada
(Rahy) to a neck in what

would be his second of three GIII Arlington H. titles (see
below) last July. After failing to make an impact in the
GI Arlington Million, Boisterous successfully defended
his GIII Knickerbocker S. and GII Red Smith H. titles
before finishing second at odds-on in Churchill's
GIII River City H. Nov. 25. Second behind Successful
Dan (Successful Appeal) in a paceless running of
Keeneland's GIII Ben Ali S. on the Polytrack Apr. 21,
Boisterous defeated subsequent GI United Nations S.
hero Big Blue Kitten (Kitten's Joy) in the GII Monmouth
S. June 9.

choice settled into a perfect mid-pack spot as longshot
Folk Singer (Forest Danger) tried to do his best
impression of Presious Passion (Royal Anthem)--or
Mission Approved (With Approval) considering his
connections--through splits much too quick for the
distance. The field began to bunch on the home turn as
the pacesetter dropped anchor, and it looked briefly like
Boisterous might get trapped behind him. But pilot John
Velazquez took his mount off the rail and he sliced
through a seam and out into the clear at the top of the
stretch. Leader Twilight Eclipse braced for the
challenge, but he couldn't hold off Boisterous past
midstretch as that one edged away steadily in the run
to the line.

"I'm going to smile on this one, because this horse
deserves to win a Grade I," said the always reserved
Derby-winning McGaughey. "He had been training so
good. His three races this year have all been really
good. We kind of caught a turf today we liked. I was
looking for a little bit of rain. I'm tickled to death, not
for me, but for the horse."

As for what's next, the Hall of Famer said, "We'll
think about the [GI] Sword Dancer [at Saratoga
Aug. 17]. We'll think about the [Aug. 17 GI] Arlington
Million. We'll think about the [GI] Pacific Classic [at Del
Mar Aug. 25]. When we get up there, we'll see how
he's doing. The Arlington Million I'm a little bit gun shy
on because I don't really understand why he ran bad
there last year. Somebody said, 'He didn't run all that
bad. He was ninth, beaten [5 3/4 lengths],' but he ran
bad."

Emollient flashed her talent as a juvenile last season, Beyering 98 when breaking her maiden second out and finishing second in the GII Demoiselle S. She opened her sophomore account with an optional claiming

victory at Gulfstream Feb. 16 and--after finishing 30 lengths adrift of Dreaming of Julia (A.P. Indy) in the GII Gulfstream Park Oaks Mar. 30--recorded a career high when wiring the GI Ashland S. by nine lengths. She failed to factor when finishing a well-beaten sixth in the GII Black Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May. 17. Favored for this turf debut, Emollient took up a ground-saving position in third into the first turn. Sensing the tepid pace, jockey Mike Smith switched the bay to the outside down the backstretch, and they

confronted the pacesetters heading into the turn. Poking her head in front at the top of the lane, the winner held off a stubborn Emotional Kitten in the final stages. Rodolphe Brisset, assistant to trainer Bill Mott, said, "She answered a couple of questions today. We didn't know about the grass and we didn't know about the 1 1/4 miles. That was a very good race for her. She's definitely going to stick to the turf, but we can keep in mind she won a Grade I on the synthetic, too. It's one or the other, we can keep everything open."

Book Review became a Grade I winner last time she cut back from a route to a sprint, and the angle again proved productive as the 4-year-old stamped her ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Santa Anita Nov. 1. The homebred kicked off her career with Chad Brown, and first signaled that she had a bright future when earning back-to-back 98 Beyer Speed Figures--first behind eventual champion Questing (GB) (Hard Spun) in a Belmont allowance last June and then when she took a Saratoga allowance the following month. She failed to fire in the GI Test S., but bounced back with listed stakes tallies at Charles Town and Belmont before a fifth in the GI Gazelle S. going nine panels at Aqueduct in November. Subsequently transferred to Bob Baffert, the bay rallied late to best Reneesgotzip (City Zip) in Santa Anita's GI La Brea S. Dec. 26. She hadn't been seen since back-to-back second-place finishes around two turns in the GII La Canada S. Jan. 20 and GII Santa Maria S. Feb. 16.

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Dropping back early while climbing a bit as Winding Way (Malibu Moon) and Teddy's Promise knocked heads up front, Book Review sprang into action on the home bend and began to cut into the top two's edge in the lane. She struck the front at the sixteenth pole, and strode out beautifully to win convincingly.

"She loves this distance and it helped that we had a couple of good front runners," said Mike Marlow, assistant to Baffert. "It set up well. It's actually what we had in mind. [Rafael Bejarano] rode her well. That was her first start on synthetic and that might have been her best footing. I think she really liked it. I'd guess there would be something for her at Del Mar." Bejarano added, "She likes to make one big run, so I just put her where she would feel comfortable and by the three-eighths pole I decided to move in closer and start to make my move. I knew she would come running at the end."

Aljamaaheer suggested he was more than capable of winning a pattern race when third in the G3 Jersey S. at the Royal meeting here last June and in Goodwood's G3 Thoroughbred S. in early August. Third again in the

latter venue's G2 Celebration Mile later that month, the chestnut was on the shelf until the Apr. 27 Listed King Richard III S. and was caught late on when ridden from the front in that seven-furlong Leicester contest. Taking a step forward when third behind Farhh (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) in Newbury's

G1 Lockinge S. May 18, he was denied just 3/4 of a length by Declaration of War (War Front) in the G1 Queen Anne S. over the straight mile at the Royal meeting here a month later. This task eased by the refusal to enter the stalls of Afsare (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}), and Aljamaaheer was restrained to race towards the rear by Paul Hanagan after showing early keenness. Traveling best in early stretch, he was delivered wide to wrest the lead from Mull of Killough with 150 yards remaining and had enough in reserve to put safe distance between himself and the closers. "He well deserved that, running tremendous races at the top level," trainer Roger Varian said. "He's taken a little while to get the hang of it, but we've always had faith in him and he's learning to settle in his races. He's got a tremendous cruising speed, but gets the mile, and if we can curtail that early energy and allow him to use his turn of foot at the end of his races, he is pretty useful. Earlier in the year, we thought we would either go the sprint route or a mile and now it's hard to drop back. As we move along, we can go back up to Group 1, and he has the speed to go back to seven if we decide that. He's in the G2 Lennox S. [at Goodwood July 30] over seven, the G1 Sussex S. a day later and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois [at Deauville Aug. 11] over a mile and the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest [at Deauville Aug. 4] over 6 1/2 furlongs and he'll go for one of those, but which one we'll have to see."

Still chugging along at the age of nine, Rahystrada became the first three-time winner of this traditional GI Arlington Million prep, having proved successful in 2010 and again 12 months ago. Dark Cove won for the fourth time in his last five starts and established a new course and stakes record, shaving 0.11 seconds off the previous mark held by Cetewayo since 2002. There were no takers on that occasion, nor was anyone willing to bite when Dark Cove won a \$40,000 claimer over the Gulfstream turf Feb. 10 and when runner-up for \$50,000 in Hallandale Mar. 7. From there, trainer Mike Maker got to thinking outside the box and stretched his charge out to 12 furlongs for the GI Elkhorn S. in Lexington Apr. 26. Not only did he run off by 4 1/4 lengths at 8-1, but he earned the Ramseys a gold tray for their eighth graded stakes win at the historic track. Dark Cove affirmed his affinity for marathon trips with a half-length score in the GIII Louisville H. at Churchill May 25, and was heavily favored to continue his streak here. Neatly positioned in second by Rosie Napravnik behind the free-running and defending champion Ioya Bigtime (Dynaformer), Dark Cove clocked that one as he put up honest fractions for the distance. Napravnik turned up the pressure on the pacemaker and poked his head in front nearing the stretch, and had Suntracer to deal with late, but proved easily best in the finish.

Glen Hill Farm's accomplished mare **Marketing Mix** (Medaglia d'Oro) takes on the boys in today's 12-panel GIII Sunset H., the closing day feature at what will be Betfair Hollywood Park's final spring meet. While Marketing Mix has faced her same sex in each of her 17 prior trips to the post, she sports a very solid resume and more-than-competitive form. An earner of over \$1.8 million, the dark bay scored her first victory at the highest level in Santa Anita's GI Rodeo Drive S. Sept. 29. She came up 3/4 of a length short of Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune) when second in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Nov. 2, and got the job done on seasonal debut with a hard-fought decision in the local nine-furlong GI Gamely S. May 27. This will be the farthest race of Marketing Mix's career, but she is 3-2-1-0 at 1 1/4 miles. **Dhaamer (Ire)** (Dubai Destination) comes into this race the same way he did last year, with clear a victory in the Round Table S. May 12. He will be partnered by Julien Leparoux--trainer Mike Mitchell's son-in-law--for the first time since annexing last year's Sunset by a decisive 3 1/4 lengths. Coudelaria Jessica and trainer A.C. Avila have had their fair share of success in graded stakes in Southern California with South American imports, and they'll send out **Hawk's Eye (Brz)** (Public Purse) to his North American debut. The homebred took a pair of Group 1s in his native Brazil last year.

NEW APPROACH TO BE RESTED

New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), last year's European Champion first season sire, will not shuttle to Australia for the 2013 Southern Hemisphere season, and will instead be rested at his base at Dalham Hall Stud in Newmarket, England.

Darley noted that New Approach does not have a great capacity to cover large books of mares, and his book size has been limited in both hemispheres since retiring to stud. The decision to rest him was made in the interests of his long term career.

"We are sorry that New Approach will not be traveling this year, as we strongly believe he has a bright future in Australia," said Darley's Chief Operating Officer Olly Tait. "We recognize it is very close to the breeding season and we will obviously try our best to work with breeders with mares booked to him to accommodate them with our other stallions. As always, we greatly appreciate their support."

New Approach, sire of champion 2-year-old and classic winner Dawn Approach (Ire), currently sits third on Europe's general sires list, behind his sire Galileo and fellow Dalham Hall stalwart Dubawi (Ire) (Dubai Millennium {GB}). He currently sits fourth on the Australian first season sires table, with progeny including Group 3 winner Montsegur (Aus).

SKY LANTERN TEAM CONSIDERS APPEAL

Connections of Friday's G1 Falmouth S. runner-up **Sky Lantern (Ire)** (Red Clubs {Ire}) could appeal against the decision by the Newmarket stewards to allow Elusive Kate (Elusive Quality) to keep the race. Carried across the track by the eventual winner, Ben Keswick's G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Coronation S. heroine went down by a neck and jockey Richard Hughes believes it could be turned around. "I just feel that you have to be beaten a short head to get a race [in the stewards' room] and I thought I'd get it," he said yesterday. "There was enough sustained interference and a couple of belts in the face [with the winning jockey William Buick's whip] didn't help either. My filly traveled quicker in the last furlong than the winner. I believe in giving the winner the benefit of the doubt, but you can't say if my filly hadn't run in a straight line she definitely would have got beaten. It's up to the owners whether to appeal or not." Earlier, Richard Hannon Jr. had pondered the runner-up's targets. "She deserves a little break now and we might bring her back for the [Sept. 7] G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown--who knows, we might have a rematch with Elusive Kate there, and they say that revenge is a dish best served cold," he said. "There are some valuable races waiting for her towards the end of the year, so if we want some juice left in the lemon we need to opt out of some of the midsummer dances. We are all keen to try her over a mile and a quarter some time and the [Nov. 2 GI] Breeders Cup Filly & Mare Turf at Santa Anita would seem the logical race, as the draw would not be quite so crucial there as it would be if we went for the Mile. Ben Keswick, Sky Lantern's owner, lives in Hong Kong, so there is also the big international meeting at Sha Tin in December to consider, and both there and in California you would like to think that the grey filly would get her favored fast ground."

KENTUCKY PERSONNEL BOARD UPHOLDS VEITCH FIRING

Ignoring the recommendation of a hearing officer's report, the Kentucky Personnel Board, by a vote of 6-0, upheld the firing of former chief state steward John Veitch. The former trainer was an employee of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission, part of the Public Protection Cabinet, and the hearing officer said that the firing should have been handled by the racing commission. Veitch was dismissed from his duties five months after a Racing Commission hearing into the Life At Ten incident at the 2010 Breeders' Cup, where she finished last after jockey John Velazquez told television reporters that she'd been warming up quietly. The hearing officer's report stated that Public Protection Secretary Robert Vance lacked the authority to fire Veitch, but Mark Sipek, executive director of the Personnel Board, said the body ruled that Vance did have that authority and also that Veitch was a 'non-merit' employee, meaning he could be fired without specific cause. Sipek said that the ruling can be appealed to the Franklin County Circuit Court.

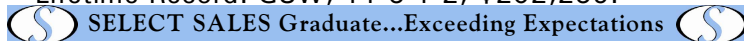

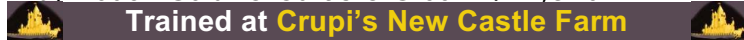
