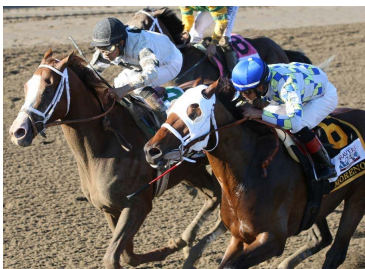


THE COACH TAKES CHARGE

The dream year of resurgent Hall of Fame trainer D. Wayne Lukas continued Saturday at Saratoga when Willis Horton's **Will Take Charge** (Unbridled's Song) inhaled pacesetting longshot **Moreno** (Ghostzapper) in the final strides to win the GI Travers S. by the length of his nose and throw the sophomore division into utter disarray. **Orb** (Malibu Moon) took over from Moreno with a rail-skimming move at the top of the stretch, but the GI Kentucky Derby winner tired noticeably and just held on for third. "At the three-eighths pole, I thought we'd get a piece of it, but I didn't know if we'd get up," admitted Lukas. "He's a little over 17 hands and just starting to find himself. This is a horse who's going to get better. He's getting his act together." **Cont. p3**

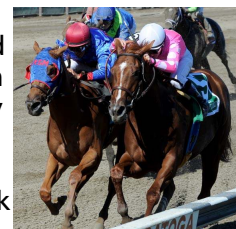

SWEET LULU PASSES ANOTHER TEST

Steve Beneto's **Sweet Lulu** (Mr. Greeley), shipped across the country, was making her first stakes appearance and first start on conventional dirt, but still overcame a seasoned field of eight sophomore fillies to earn a determined victory over **Wildcat Lily** (D'wildcat) in Saturday's GI Test S. at Saratoga. **My Happy Face** (Tiz Wonderful), some seven wide into the stretch, was closing powerfully late to finish a neck back in third. "She's done everything we've asked her to do," winning trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said of the filly who is now four-for-four. "I didn't know if I should ship her this soon and come back here and try this, but she was doing so well and showing speed, and this is a Grade I and a very important race for pedigree, so we decided to try it." **Cont. p5-6**

CAPO BASTONE SOARS IN KING'S BISHOP

A late-running sprinter from the Todd Pletcher barn won Saturday's GI Foxwood's King's Bishop S. Just not the one most expected. **Forty Tales** (Tale of the Cat) was sent off the 5-2 favorite in the seven-furlong event, but it was stablemate **Capo Bastone** (Street Boss), disregarded at 28-1, who flew down the lane to overtake pacesetting **Mentor Cane** (Mizzen Mast) and surge clear to a two-length victory. "When I asked him, he picked it up, and he did the job," said winning rider Irad Ortiz, Jr. "He was ready today. The horse was great, that's all I can say." **Cont. p6-7**

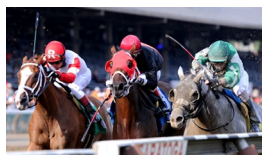
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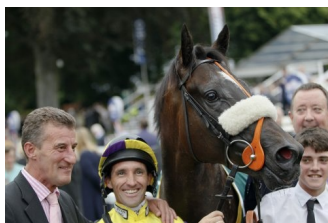

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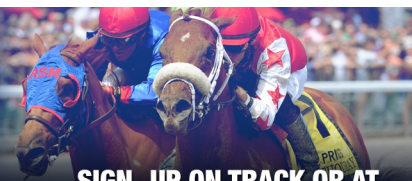
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Will Take Charge Takes Travers (cont. from p1)

Moreno sprinted out to the early lead and loped along on a clear lead through fractions of :24.40 and :48.88, as 8-5 favorite **Verrazano** (More Than Ready) and longshot **Romansh** (Bernardini) chased from third and fourth, with Orb and Will Take Charge running in tandem some five lengths off the pacesetter. Jose Lezcano committed to an inside trip with Orb and the Derby winner inched closer after three-quarters in 1:13.43. Orb grabbed the lead off the turn, while the long-striding Will Take Charge was revving up for his run while five wide into the stretch. Moreno momentarily reasserted control after a mile in 1:37.47, but Will Take Charge found his best stride in the final sixteenth to just get his nose in front on the wire. Orb just held on for third over the late-closing **Palace Malice** (Curlin), who raced uncharacteristically far off the pace after missing the break. Verrazano faded to seventh.

Lukas, who won the GI Preakness S. with Oxbow (Awesome Again), was winning his third Travers and first since Thunder Gulch took the Midsummer Derby in 1995. He also won the race in 1991 with Corporate Report. This was his first Travers starter since 2002. "It feels pretty good," Lukas admitted. "They were reminding me it's been a long time between drinks, but when they come like this, they come double."

Owner Willis Horton was always confident his horse would win the Travers. "We knew we had a good horse, a well-fed horse," Horton said. "He's going to have to catch up with his growth, and we had to get him going; and we kept pushing on and pushing on trying to get him quicker. But we finally made it here today, and this is a real pleasure." **Cont. p4**

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Asked how he felt after the biggest win of his racing career, Horton added, "Well, it's hard to describe, you know? I'm so happy."

While the owner was confident, jockey Luis Saez, in his first year riding in New York and earning his first Grade I victory, wasn't sure he had won. "When I was coming to the wire, I thought I could win it maybe if I rode a little harder," Saez said. "So I did, and then when I crossed the wire I didn't know. I had to ask the outrider and he told me I won."

With three different winners of the Triple Crown races and a fourth winner of the Travers, the sophomore division is up for grabs and Lukas will be busy planning his next move for championship honors.

"John Nerud, the wonderful trainer who has turned a hundred now, he told me years ago, 'Wayne, championships are never won in the spring; they're only won in the fall,'" Lukas said. "And there is a lot of truth to that. We'll go to the next dance, and we'll look at it and get together, Willis and I, and figure out what we're going to do next."

The regally bred Will Take Charge, a \$425,000 KEESEP yearling, entered the Kentucky Derby picture with a hard-charging win over stablemate and subsequent GI Preakness S. winner Oxbow in the Mar. 16 GI Rebel S., but the strapping chestnut was well-beaten in all three Triple Crown races. He began the second half of his season with a blinkers off and solid runner-up effort behind Palace Malice in the July 27 GI Jim Dandy S. last time out.

Will Take Charge becomes the third 2013 Grade I winner for his recently deceased sire Unbridled's Song. His multiple Grade I-winning dam Take Charge Lady (Dehere) produced an Indian Charlie filly in 2012 and a War Front filly in 2013. An Arkansas native, Willis Horton previously owned D R Horton Custom Homes. He also campaigned 2006 GI Kentucky Oaks winner Lemons Forever (Lemon Drop Kid) with Dallas Stewart. *To read TDN's May 18 interview with Horton, [click here](#).*

What the Travers Also-Rans were Saying

Eric Guillot, trainer of runner-up Moreno

"Brutal, huh? Last jump. He couldn't have done any better--stay in the three-path, stay off the rail, make them come to you, don't let them go inside you, don't let them pinch you on the rail. The kid [Jose Ortiz] rode him just like I told him. He knows the horse and he rode him perfect; we got beat. He said the horse kind of waited on them that last part. What are you going to do?"

Shug McGaughey, trainer third-place finisher Orb

"He ran a good race. You can't cry over spilled milk. We got him back on the right track, and now we'll point for something else."

Jose Lezcano, jockey aboard Orb:

"I got a very good trip. I got the position I wanted. The break was good, and he gave me his race. At the quarter pole, he accelerated, but the other horses kept going, too."

Todd Pletcher, trainer of fourth-place finisher Palace Malice and seventh-place finisher Verrazano:

"Verrazano got a beautiful trip. He got exactly where we thought he'd be; the only difference was we thought he'd be stalking Palace Malice. Mike [Smith] said [Palace Malice] missed the break. He slipped behind and dropped way back, not his characteristic spot. Mike thought he was much the best; the break killed him. It's horse racing. It happens every day, every race, 14 times a day sometimes. We would have liked to have won it, but we've had a great meet and we're not going to cry about it. We'll regroup and try again."

John Velazquez, jockey aboard Verrazano:

"I was very happy where I was. By the half-mile pole, he was off the bridle and ust went through the motions. He really didn't put in much effort."

Sweet Lulu opened her career with a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ performance sprinting six furlongs at Hollywood Park May 30 and added a 6 1/2-furlong tally at that oval June 29 before stretching out to a mile for a front-running 4 3/4-length tally at Del Mar July 24.

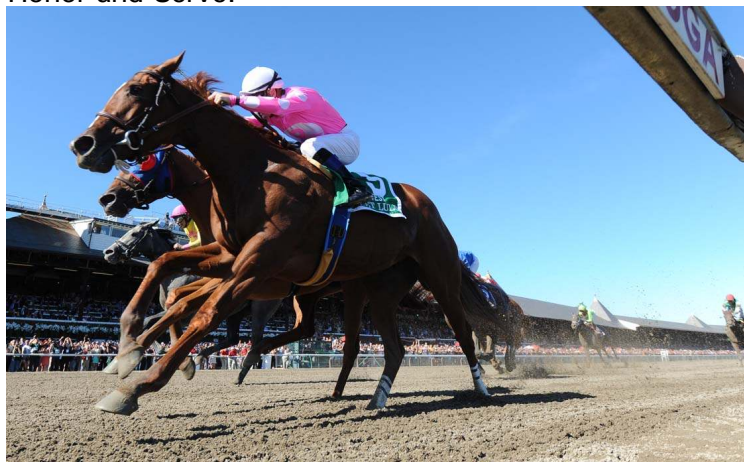
Favored at 9-5 in this stakes unveiling, Sweet Lulu went to the early lead and was quickly joined by longshot Baby J (J Be K) along the rail. Those two battled through fractions of :22.28 and :44.95 with Wildcat Lily shadowing the top two from third. Sweet Lulu put Baby J away at the top of the stretch, but soon had a new challenger in Wildcat Lily, who forged past the favorite with a furlong to run, but Sweet Lulu battled back for the narrow victory.

"The speed is pretty good today, so we wanted to have a clear trip on the lead or somewhere close," said winning rider Julien Leparoux. "We got a perfect trip. Johnny [Velazquez, aboard Wildcat Lily] came to me, and it looked like he came maybe even in front of me, and she fought back and came back to win. We were confident today, and she proved she was the kind of filly we thought she was."

Chad Brown, trainer of My Happy Face, admitted the filly's trip could have cost her the race. "She ran huge," Brown said. "Unfortunately, there were a lot of horses stopping at the quarter-pole. Mike [Smith] just felt that there were a lot of tired horses ahead of him and they all decided to stack themselves across the track, trying to give themselves the best shot they could. Unfortunately it spun us seven-, eight-, nine-wide. She ran her race; it's just one of those things when you have a big field in horse racing. Sometimes you're not going to get the best trip. Mike did the best he could. I thought she ran her 'A' race, probably just lost a little too much ground turning for home."

Steve Beneto, a member of the California Horse Racing Board, has been involved in racing since the 1960s. He is the previous owner of Beneto Truck Line, a hauler for oil companies in California, and now buys and sells corporate jet aircrafts.

Sweet Lulu is out of graded stakes winner Successful Outlook. The 9-year-old mare has a Tapit colt scheduled to sell at Keeneland September, as well as a weanling filly by Malibu Moon and she is currently in foal to To Honor and Serve.

In an ambitious juvenile campaign with trainer John Sadler, ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Capo Bastone went from a debut win at Del Mar directly to Grade I company and acquitted himself well with a fourth-place effort in the Sept. 5 GI Del Mar Futurity and third-place finishes in the Sept. 29 GI FrontRunner S. and Nov. 3 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Transferred east to the barn of trainer Todd Pletcher, the chestnut colt resurfaced with an optional-claiming victory at Gulfstream Feb. 16. He rebounded from a ninth-place effort in the Mar. 23 GIII Spiral S. to be a late-closing second behind Forty Tales (Tale of the Cat) in the Apr. 27 GIII Derby Trial, but ran a lackluster seventh in the June 8 GII Woody Stephens S. last time out. Let Em Shine (Songandaprayer) took the field through an opening quarter in :22.34, but Mentor Cane took over through a half in :44.60, while Capo Bastone settled near the back of a strung-out field of 14. Mentor Cane skipped clear into the stretch and had a three-length advantage with a furlong to run, but Capo Bastone was rallying boldly down the center of the track and he swarmed clear to the wire.

"He's shown, on his good days, that he's good enough to compete in a race like this," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "He was pretty close to Forty Tales in the Derby Trial, and it seemed like he was training better than ever. Based off his breeze with Verrazano [on Sunday], we felt like it was time to take a shot. It seemed like everything was gelling at the right time, and he was sitting on a good one, so we felt like, 'Let's try a big one.' It seems like he has found his niche. I think he gets a mile, no problem, but this was a good set-up for him today."

Favored Forty Tales closed late to be fourth. "He got in a little traffic, but when he got in the clear, he really came running," reported jockey Julien Leparoux. "No more dirt in his face. Around the turn, I asked him to run; he took a little time to get going, but he ran big."

Capo Bastone, owned by the 2-year-old Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners syndicate run by Aron Wellman, is out of the stakes-placed Fight to Love (Fit to Fight). The 20-year-old mare produced a filly by Flatter this spring. She also has an unraced 2-year-old filly by Corinthian.

After proving dynamic from the front when scoring on debut over this track and trip May 25, Astaire was unable to boss the G2 July S., and ended up in sixth in that Newmarket contest July 11. Back in a domineering mood in a confidence-restoring conditions event over this trip 16 days later, the bay repeated the dose here to provide trainer Kevin Ryan with a third renewal since 2005. Hassled early by the well-supported Parbold, he was always traveling the better of the two and kept up the relentless grind in the rain-softened conditions late as Wilshire Boulevard made unconvincing inroads into his advantage. Jockey Neil Callan was impressed. "This is a lovely horse--I won on him in his maiden here and I couldn't praise him enough," he said. "You could see he had class that day, as he had to do it the hard way and make his own running. He was just going so well then, and this was a copybook race. We were on unknown ground, but when I let him down two out he took two lengths out of them and that made the difference." His conditioner added, "When the rain came, we were very worried, as he's very enthusiastic and I was worried he was doing too much in the first furlong. He likes to hit the gates and use his stride. We knew he had improved a lot since his last run and had been working very well. He's starting to grow up and mature, and is a real likeable horse who wants to please. I'd say he'll go straight to the G1 Middle Park S. [at Newmarket Oct. 12]--he doesn't look a typical sprinter and is a tall horse who looks like he would go further, but we'll cross that bridge next year."

You would imagine he'll have no problem getting a mile, but we'll take one day at a time."

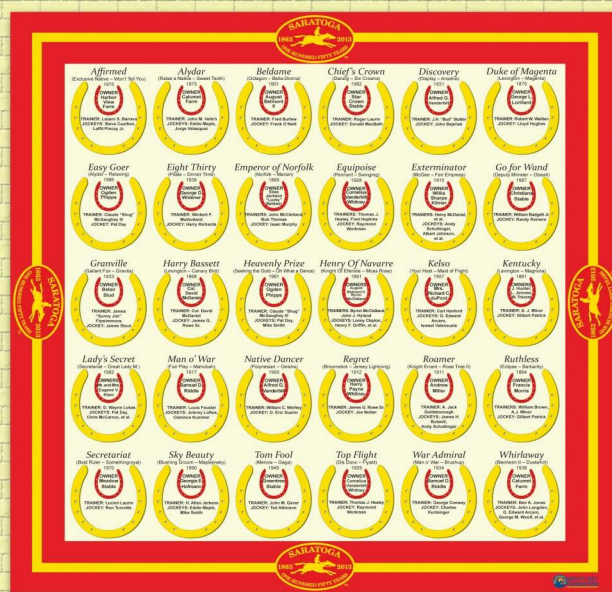

Javier Castellano, on the beaten favorite and fourth-place finisher Hungry Island, felt the course hindered his mount. "The only way I got beat today was because the track is so fast," Castellano. "You don't see horses coming from behind. I think we just got beat because the horse that went to the lead never stopped, and my horse is a come-from-behind horse."

Comic produced a colt by Dubawi (Ire) this past spring and has an unraced 2-year-old full-brother to Laughing named Comedy King (Ire).

Planteur had not been seen since finishing runner-up in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan over an extended nine-furlong trip at Longchamp May 26, and landed in a perfect spot to be re-introduced here as meaningful opposition was at a premium. As he had when winning the Listed Winter Derby Trial S. over 10 furlongs on Lingfield's Polytrack Feb. 23, the well-traveled 6-year-old was using a class-drop as a springboard back to the heights that he had taken in when third in the last two renewals of the G1 Dubai World Cup. Keen early under Frankie Dettori, the bay was allowed to tank into the lead at the end of the backstretch. Soon clear, he faced the length of the extended four-furlong straight on his own until joined by Al Waab on his near side and, despite the persistence of that rival, he was always holding him under mainly hand riding. "He was a bit fresh and I had to make my own running, so he got a bit tired at the end but it was a good comeback race," jockey Frankie Dettori commented. Trainer Marco Botti has the GI Breeders' Cup Classic in mind, and added, "A mile and a quarter is his best trip, so we'll probably stay at that, and I think the Classic is the big aim. Personally, I think he should handle the surface and ran well in Dubai, so we should take our chance. He's in the G1 Irish Champion S. [at Leopardstown Sept. 7], so we'll decide on that later in the week. Frankie said he tried to do too much early on and never wins by far, so I'm pleased with that."

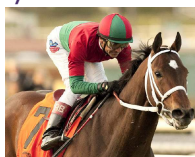

Between them, **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again), **Richard's Kid** (Lemon Drop Kid) and **Dullahan** (Even the Score) have 11 Grade I wins—including three Pacific Classics--and combined earnings in excess of \$9.1 million, but that's not to say there aren't a number of additional legitimate contenders in today's GI Pacific Classic. In addition to its \$1 million purse, Del Mar's signature event offers an automatic berth into the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and attracted a diverse cast of 13. Among the alternatives to the heavy hitters is Wright and LaPenta's **Jeranimo** (Congaree), a last-out winner of the GI Eddie Read S. over nine panels on the infield here July 20. The 7-year-old hasn't seen a main track since finishing off the board in the 2011 Pacific Classic, but he did annex the GII Strub H. at Santa Anita in 2010. "He became so overwhelming on turf, we never thought about going on the dirt with him," trainer Michael Pender explained as to the reasoning for keeping his charge on the lawn for his last 14 starts. "He has that nice grass daisycutter clip to him. He hardly raises his feet as he rolls along. You might say he's a lawnmower type." Despite the surface switch, the hard knocker is doing well and figures to be coming with his patented late run. "He's kind of a working-class kind of horse, the epitome of what you want in a good horse," Pender said. "His work ethic is second to none, and he's thriving at seven years old."

The former was second, beaten a length by Game on Dude when in receipt of 11 pounds in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup H. two back July 6, and bested fan favorite Paynter (Awesome Again) in the GII San Diego H. going a furlong shorter here July 27. You Know I Know, who has the look of an outsider, rallied from far back to beat **Holding Glory** (Brz) (Public Purse) in a local one-mile optional claimer Aug. 3.

Sheikh Ahmed Al Maktoum and Darley's **Farraaj** (Ire) (Dubai Destination) owns a pair of stakes wins at this distance on the Lingfield Polytrack, including the G3 Winter Derby S. Mar. 16. The Roger Varian pupil hasn't been seen since finishing fifth in Sandown's grass G2 Sandown Mile S. in April. The 4-year-old has handled the Stateside ship before, finishing third in the 2011 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

When Besilu Stable's champion **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) is good, she's very good, and perhaps the largest hurdle standing in her way in today's GI Personal Ensign H. is an off race. The 5-year-old didn't quite show up with her best when second beaten a half-length a year ago, but reeled off three straight wins after that, including a victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. This spot will provide an automatic berth into the renamed GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. Royal Delta failed to land a blow in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March, and belied sure-thing status when finishing a well-beaten second in Churchill's GII Fleur de Lis H. June 15. But the 'good' Royal Delta reemerged last time for the July 20 GI Delaware H., and blitzed the field for a 10 3/4-length jaw dropper while being taken off Lasix. "Obviously we were disappointed in the Kentucky race, and a little confused by it," said trainer Bill Mott. "We did take her off Lasix after that, and she'll run without Lasix again." Hall of Famer Mike Smith made the decision to hop off GI Pacific Classic favorite Game On Dude (Awesome Again) to retain his mount on the mare. "I'm sure it wasn't an easy decision [for Mike] and I hope for everyone's sake it works out well," offered Mott. "I hope she comes back and runs a good race and gets the job done to justify his decision."

Padua Stables' **Authenticity** (Quiet American) has come into her own at age six. She narrowly bested **On Fire Baby** (Smoke Glacken) in Churchill's GII La Troienne S. May 3, and fell just short of Tiz Miz Sue (Tiznow) in Big Sandy's GI Ogden Phipps H. May 27. A winner of the paceless GIII Shuvee H. over track and trip July 20, she was flattered when that heat's runner-up Flashy American (Flashy Bull) took the Aug. 9 Alada S. handily. Anita Cauley's On Fire Baby, winner of Oaklawn's GI Apple Blossom H. Apr. 12, has been off since the La Troienne, but has three consecutive seven-panel works in Louisville leading up to this.

Despite a solid win in the GI Santa Anita Derby in April, the conventional wisdom was that the bay might be best around one turn, and his connections decided to embrace that theory after off-the-board runs in the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness S. He may have been best when ridden confidently to a close second in the GI Bing Crosby S. July 28, and will be piloted for the first time here by Pat Valenzuela, who replaces the injured Joel Rosario, who had been expected to replace Kevin Krigger. Reddam Racing's fellow Doug O'Neill trainee **Handsome Mike** (Scat Daddy) took Keeneland's GIII Commonwealth S. last time he went route-to-sprint, and he'll cut back off an eighth-place run in the GI Metropolitan H. May 27. J Kirk and Judy Robison's **Wine Police** (Speightstown) was a promising sprinter at two and three, finishing third in the 2010 GI Hopeful S. and taking a stakes and finishing third in the GII Amsterdam S. the following season for Steve Asmussen. He went missing at the end of his 3-year-old year, however, and didn't reemerge until a sharp six-panel optional-claiming tally for Henry Dominguez here Aug. 1. Bob Baffert has won the last four renewals of this event, and takes two shots at number five with Pegram, Watson and Weitman's **Drill** (Lawyer Ron) and Kaleem Shah's **Fed Biz** (Giant's Causeway). The former won the GI Del Mar Futurity over track and trip two years ago, but is on a six-race off-the-board streak since annexing Betfair Hollywood Park's GIII Lazaro Berrera Memorial S. last May. Fed Biz bested eventual Grade I winner Jimmy Creed (Distorted Humor) in last August's one-mile El Cajon S. here, and cuts back off a fourth-place finish in the grassy GI Eddie Read S. July 20.

One of the John Sadler-trained pair of **Tigah (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) and **He Be Fire N Ice** (Unusual Heat) may have the best chance to pull off an upset thanks to their late-running styles should the speedy chalk grow leg weary. Tigah came from out of the clouds to take Golden Gate's GIII San Francisco S. in April and was third last time in the course-and-distance Wicker S. July 24, while He Be Fire Ice capped a three-race streak in the California Dreamin' H. for State-breds July 21.

CRUNCH TIME

Following three below-par runs so far this season, Corine Barande-Barbe finds herself in the surprising position of being on the back foot with **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) as he heads to post for today's G2 Grand Prix de Deauville. While his comeback fifth in the June 23 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and subsequent fourth in the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. at Ascot July 27 could be explained due to condition and ground issues, respectively, it is harder to excuse his latest reversal when second in the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron over 10 furlongs here Aug. 10. So impressive when taking this race by 10 lengths two years ago, the veteran needs to revive some magic as he is prepared for Ascot's G1 Champion S., which he won in 2011 and was second to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in last year. "He is very well, which is why he is running again so soon," Barande-Barbe told *PA Sport*. "He came back in good form, he was just a little outpaced the last day as it turned into a sprint. He needs lot of racing to reach his level these days, but I think he is still as good as he was. It looks like a little Group 1 and it will be interesting to see how the 3-year-olds get on against the older horses. He needs competition, and we are still thinking of the Champion S." Heading the 3-year-old attack is Horst Rapp's progressive **Tres Blue (Ire)** (Anabaa Blue {GB}), who followed a second in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg July 7 with a win in the G3 Prix de Reux over this track and trip last time Aug. 4. Unbeaten in his last five starts, Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges' **Now We Can (GB)** (Martillo {Ger}) beat **Haya Landa (Fr)** (Lando {Ger}) in the June 2 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly last time and has yet to reach the ceiling of his ability.

Royal Delta is my favorite horse in training, but it seems like I'm always picking against her. She's obviously never much of a price, and she's not the easiest horse in the world to trust. When she shows up, she wins--usually by a lot--but she also went down at odds-on here 12 months ago and two back in the GII Fleur de Lis. **Authenticity** and On Fire Baby seem like the only viable alternatives, and there really isn't much to separate them. They did, after all, finish a head apart in the GII La Troienne S. at Churchill on Oaks day. This race is a sixteenth of a mile farther than that one, and that's ultimately what swayed me to Authenticity. She sports a 3-1-2-0 record at the trip with a recent win here in the GIII Shuvee H.; while On Fire Baby was off the board in her lone try going this far (in the 2012 Kentucky Oaks), and has been away since the La Troienne and isn't particularly well-bred for the distance. It's Authenticity for me, but I won't be too upset if the good Royal Delta shows up. **Wager: \$60 Win on #5 Authenticity.**

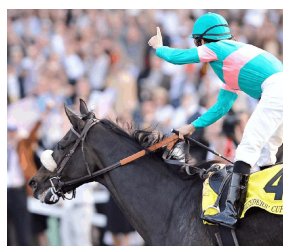

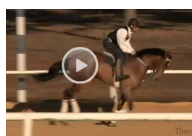
