NO DELTA, BUT 'GREEK' ROMPS IN GOLD CUP

On his day, **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate) is very good. And Saturday, he was at his very best, racing atypically close to the pace, rallying inside of a tiring **Alpha** (Bernardini) at the quarter pole and storming away to best GI Belmont S. hero **Palace Malice** (Curlin) by a solid six lengths in Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup at Belmont Park. **Flat Out** (Flatter), the two-time

defending Gold Cup champion, was an even third. "You gotta love Ron. Everybody loves Ron the Greek!" said winning trainer Bill Mott. "Every once in a while, he'll throw one of these. I can't determine when, but he did it today." **Cross Traffic** (Unbridled's Song), stretching out to the Classic distance of a mile and

a quarter off his front-running success in the GI Whitney H. in early August, was slow to begin and sluggish throughout, beating just one home. "He just didn't break, and that was it," said jockey John Velazquez. "The race was lost right there. It wasn't his style. We tried to make a run, but it was too much to make up." Last home was GI Kentucky Derby winner **Orb** (Malibu Moon), who never looked to be traveling especially well and trailed in. "He was going down the backside fine and just dropped the bit and didn't do any running. It's pretty puzzling," trainer Shug McGaughey explained. "He'd been doing well. He broke good and was sitting in a good position, but at the five-eighths pole, I could see that he dropped the bit, and that was the end of it. He never tried to run after that." **Cont. p3**

'ROYAL' NO MATCH FOR 'PRINCESS'

What was billed as a two-horse affair in Saturday's GI Beldame S. at Belmont Park ultimately ended up that way, but it was King of Prussia Stable's **Princess Sylmar** (Majestic Warrior) who dished out the punishment, easily outfinishing two-time defending GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic (Distaff) heroine **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) by a comfortable two lengths. "We have a lot of respect for how good Royal Delta is, and it says a lot about

[owner] Ed Stanco that we could have gone to what appeared to be an easier spot on paper [the \$1-million GI Cotillion S. at Parx Racing] and we came here and took on the defending champ and were a deserving winner." **Beldame cont. p6**

THE SANTULLI 'BOWL' AT BELMONT

Trainer Alan Goldberg and owner Richard Santulli had never been represented by an entry in a Grade I race, let alone by two horses that had legitimate claims in the event. After 10 grassy furlongs of Saturday's GI Flower Bowl

Invitational S. at Belmont Park, not only did the Goldberg/Santulli axis have the first two home in the form of front-running **Laughing (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) and the closing **Tannery (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}), but they also emerged with a leading candidate for Eclipse Award-winning turf female. "If somebody jumps up and runs a great race in the Breeders' Cup [Filly/Mare Turf], they'll just make them champion, but as far as anybody who has run, I don't think there's anybody that's done what she's done this year," Goldberg opined. **Cont. p5**

Meanwhile, Good Friends Stable's Private Zone (Macho Uno) put himself in the zone for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint with a scintillating score in the GI Vosburgh Invitational, stopping the clock in a stakes-record time of 1:08.00. The victory also got the ball rolling on a coast-to-coast Grade I double for his sire.

The win in the Gold Cup earns Ron the Greek a trip to Santa Anita for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, and the massive bay will be returning to a track over which he has performed well in the past.

The clear winner of the 2012 GI Santa Anita H., the Florida-bred was a good fourth in last year's Classic, then returned from a layoff to decimate his rivals, including favored Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno) by 11 1/4 lengths in the Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park Jan. 19. Fourth behind Game On Dude (Awesome Again) in defense of his Big 'Cap title this past March, Ron the Greek was an excellent third to that leading Horse of the Year candidate in the GI Charles Town Classic Apr. 20. A non-threatening third to Fort Larned

(E Dubai) in that one's GI Stephen Foster H. romp June 15, Ron the Green made a big move, but flattened late to be fourth to Cross Traffic in the Whitney and was exiting an even fourth to Alpha in the GI Woodward S. Aug. 31.

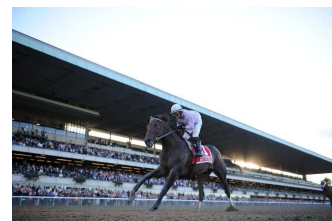
Despite proven Grade I credentials, he was let go at better than 20-1 here and made the doubters suffer.

Alpha, who narrowly got the better of Flat Out in the Woodward S., was the beneficiary of the flat-footed start from Cross Traffic and sailed along on an easy lead, tracked by Palace Malice as Ron the Greek took advantage of his inside draw and rode the rails through an opening four furlongs in :47.28. Flat Out raced in a centerfield down the backstretch, while Orb came off the bridge with five furlongs left to race and Cross Traffic was never really heard from. Alpha still held the call at the head of the lane, but vacated the fence enough for the big-framed Ron the Greek to sneak through, and the veteran put the race to bed in a few strides, kicking away to score impressively. Palace Malice tracked the pace throughout and had every chance at the quarter pole, but could not quicken with the winner. Flat Out stayed on for third.

"I had a flashback to the race in Florida this winter when he won the Sunshine Millions," Mott added. "I said, 'Man, oh, man. He's up there close to the pace today.' I just told Jose [Lezcano] to let him place himself, the way we always do. He's old enough--he knows how he wants to run, and he wanted to run big today."

Preliminary plans call for Mott to be represented in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic by Ron the Greek and Flat Out, while Royal Delta's status will be decided later.

"We always think about [running Royal Delta in the Breeders' Cup Classic]," he commented. "From my perspective, it looks like I have maybe a pair [Ron the Greek and Flat Out] to run in the Classic. I'd like to cover the Distaff as well. That has to be talked about with [Royal Delta's owner] Mr. [Benjamin] Leon."

What a difference a year makes. Given his first crack at the mile and a half in last year's GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational, Priscilla Vaccarezza's Little Mike hoisted the white flag with fully a third of the race to go and trudged home nearly 30 lengths fifth, albeit on a severely rain-affected surface. Of course, he would put pay to that effort with a 17-1 upset of the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, and a title defense--which earlier this year looked to be in great doubt--is now in the cards after the gutsy gelding held off an unlucky Big Blue Kitten for an improbable victory. Little Mike accompanied stablemate Dullahan (Even the Score) to Dubai this winter, but emerged with nothing to show for it. Eighth in the G1 Maktoum Challenge-R3 Mar. 9, he then set the pace, but gave way readily when 11th in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Mar. 30. The Florida-bred returned to action in the GI United Nations S. July 6, coming home a pacesetter fourth behind the rail-skimming Big Blue Kitten and was most recently sixth in defense of his title in the GI Arlington Million in Chicago Aug. 17.

Connections could easily have lost faith, but they pressed on ambitiously and were rewarded with another dour performance. With recent claim Joe's Blazing Aaron (Graeme Hall) entered to ensure an honest pace for his Grade I-winning stable companions, Little Mike was consigned to a midfield trip, about three off the inside, as the good miler King Kreesa (King Cugat) did the chasing from second through a half in :47.70. Little Mike improved into fourth while racing in the clear down the backstretch and was called upon for a bit of run into the far turn. King Kreesa inherited the lead from the spent Joe's Blazing Aaron, but Little Mike took over from that tiring rival and led them turning for home. Real Solution loomed up boldly three wide and appeared the main threat to Little Mike, but it was Big Blue Kitten who made the most late noise, rallying up the fence after being blocked in upper stretch. It took a photo to split them, but it was Little Mike who got the most favorable of head bobs. "This is a big win for this horse and for the barn," admitted winning trainer Dale Romans. "We've had kind of a rough year, and this is our first Grade 1 of the year. He's finally rounding back into form. His form hasn't been that bad, if you analyze it. They've gone after him early in his last two races. We needed to change tactics and come from off of [the pace]. Nobody was giving us easy leads like they were last year. He just proved how versatile he is. I knew we needed to try something different to get him back to the level where he was last year. It worked, so I want to thank Mr. [Ken] Ramsey for putting the rabbit [Joes Blazing Aaron] in there and changing things around."

A half-sister to Hong Kong legend Viva Pataca (GB) (Marju {Ire}), Laughing has steadily emerged as a leading candidate for Eclipse Award honors. The bay made a successful seasonal debut in the GIII Eatontown H. June 29, besting GISW Dayatthespa (City Zip), then got away with a slow early pace before holding on by a head in the GI Diana S. at Saratoga July 27. She remained perfect on the season with a front-running success over Pianist (More Than Ready) in the GII Ballston Spa S. upstate Aug. 24 and was part of an entry here with GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. fourth Tannery at 3-5.

With no other speed signed on, Laughing, trying a distance this far for the first time, looked to own a serious tactical advantage, as she was allowed to walk the dog beneath Jose Lezcano and laid down pedestrian fractions of :25.68 and :51.46 with Somali Lemonade (Lemon Drop Kid) applying only token pressure. Still going very comfortably and never really out of a high gallop during the middle portions of the race, Laughing clicked off six furlongs in 1:16.02 and it was all over but the 'laughing' from there. Popped the question by Lezcano in upper stretch, she sprinted her final three-eighths of a mile in :36.32--final quarter in less than :23--and proved easily best. Tannery raced well off the pedestrian pace, came out for the drive and snatched second from perfect-trip Mystical Star in the dying strides. The winning owner admitted to being confident going into the Flower Bowl and supports the notion that she's in line for a championship. "She's won two Grade Is, a Grade II and a Grade III. Who's done better?" he commented. "I told him [trainer Alan Goldberg] today, I don't think any of them can beat us. Tannery might beat her, but none of these horses."

Both the winner and runner-up were private purchases on behalf of Santulli by TVG's Frank Lyons and bloodstock agent Niall Dalton.



Trakus Fact: Runner-up Tannery (Ire) traveled 13 feet (1.5 lengths) more than her victorious stablemate Laughing (Ire), who won by 3/4 of a length. Tannery also recorded the fastest final quarter, stopping the clock in :22.37.

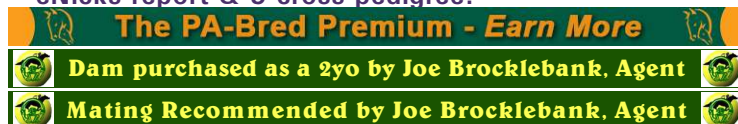

In the end, it really was a bit of a mismatch. Just not the way most thought it would turn out. After all, the Royal Delta--Princess of Sylmar exacta was essentially a money-back proposition. Two-time defending GI Breeders' Cup Distaff and Eclipse Award winner Royal Delta was sent off as the 1-5 choice to successfully defend her title in the GI Beldame S. at Belmont Park Saturday, but her younger adversary, the second choice at a shade over 2-1, drew alongside at the quarter pole, and easily outfinished Royal Delta to score convincingly, sewing up her divisional championship. Royal Delta was off just a touch slowly, but quickly got her feet back under her, then conceded the early advantage to longshot Roman Invader (Roman Ruler), who got the opening quarter in an easy :23.78, but the half in a more testing :46.71. An always-confident Mike Smith sent Royal Delta to the front rounding the turn, but Javier Castellano had Princess of Sylmar closer to that pace than has been her custom and eased his filly off the inside to follow the run of Royal Delta leaving the three-eighths marker. The stage was soon set for the match race everyone expected, and Royal Delta carried a narrow advantage into the lane. But that lead was soon gone, as the athletic sophomore filly--in receipt of a three-pound age allowance--took it right to the champ entering the final furlong and sprinted past with little response from Royal Delta. "We've always had contingent strategies," winning owner Ed Stanco said, referring to a possible start in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. "I don't really want to travel to California with her. Without pushing her, you can see what she's done. I'm on the board of directors, Todd's the CEO." Princess of Sylmar was winning her four consecutive race in the Beldame, a streak that began with her 38-1 upset of the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3. Freshened for the second half of the year thereafter, she decimated her rivals by a half-dozen lengths in the GI CCA Oaks at Saratoga July 20 and was most recently a 2 1/2-length winner of the GI Alabama S. Aug. 17. She becomes the first sophomore filly to win the Beldame since Imperial Gesture (Langfuhr) back in 2002. "I just wanted to emphasize, 'Let her run her race. Don't chase. Wherever you are, let it be on her terms, and just try to sit back and play to her strengths,'" trainer Todd Pletcher explained. "I felt like if there was anyone on paper who could do that, it was her. It was nice [Royal Delta] didn't get completely loose. We kind of got within striking distance at the quarter pole and I thought we had a big shot."

Jockey Rene Douglas celebrated one of his finest hours as a rider when replacing the injured Gary Stevens for a victorious ride on Editor's Note in the 1996 GI Belmont S. Paralyzed since a 2009 riding accident at Arlington Park, Douglas picked out Private Zone from Panama, saying he was a horse "he had to have." Now four, the

gelding scaled the heights with a dead-game victory in the Vosburgh. An unlucky loser on several occasions after showing his trademark blazing early speed, Private Zone was runner-up in four consecutive stakes tests last year, including the GI Malibu S., and was

well-fancied for the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 30, but was a disappointing ninth. The bay most recently returned from a five-month absence to take Del Mar's Pirate's Bounty S. by a game neck Sept. 4. He looked destined for another heartbreaking defeat here at the hands of GI A. G. Vanderbilt hero and 5-2 favorite Justin Phillip (First Samurai) when he was headed deep inside the final furlong. But the gelding counterpunched from the fence and found the wire a head to the good. Justin Phillip was first into stride, but Martin Pedroza had Private Zone in front soon after and had him under a stranglehold through an opening couple of furlongs in :22.62. Still not in top gear after a half in :44.86, he was first to face the judge, but had Justin Phillip breathing down his neck. The Zayat runner collared him and put a head in front, but Private Zone dug in with dogged determination after brushing repeatedly in the final sixteenth of a mile, then survived a claim of foul and a stewards' inquiry for the victory. "This horse has a tendency to do [wait on the lead], and it's a credit to [jockey] Martin Pedroza for knowing the horse," said Jack Sisterson, assistant to trainer Doug O'Neill. "Just the way he was traveling, it looked like he could have opened up because he had a lot of horse. Justin Phillip came and headed him and then passed him, and he dug down deep and got the win." The final time shaved 0.12 seconds off the previous stakes record set by Henny Hughes in 2006.

The narrowest of runners-up in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic behind Fort Larned (E Dubai), Mucho Macho Man displayed that he is more than ready to try to atone for that defeat as he took an accomplished field of handicap horses to task in the Awesome Again. A winner of half of his six starts last season as a 4-year-old, the lanky Florida-bred began the season in what seemed an innocuous-enough spot in the Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park Jan. 19 and was made the 2-5 favorite against a classy field that included the likes of fellow Florida-bred Ron the Greek (Full Mandate). **Cont. p9**

But the weather gods were against the attractive bay, rendering the main track a sloppy mess, and Mucho Macho Man would have nothing of it, as he was pulled up and eased out of the race by Mike Smith after six furlongs. Given the rest of the winter off, he returned to action in the June 14 Criminal Type S. at Belmont Park, but he caught a track with some moisture in it yet again and was well short of his best when third to San

Pablo (Jump Start) in the one-turn, 8 1/2-furlong event. The Reeves runner was therefore let go at odds of 17-2 in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 3, and, while he could do no better than third to loose-on-the-lead Cross Traffic (Unbridled's Song), it did hint at a return to better form. Mucho Macho Man was entered for the GI Woodward S. Aug. 31 at the Spa, but trainer Kathy Ritvo made the decision to come out of that race when the track remained sloppy, and soon after shipped her charge to

California to prep for another Classic try.

Summer Hit (Bertrando) bounced the gates and crossed and cleared to lead passing the mirror for the first time with GI Swaps S. hero Chief Havoc (Giant's Causeway) closest in tow, while Mucho Macho Man was in touch, but four deep into the clubhouse turn. He lost a spot and was midfield down the backside as Paynter slid up the fence into contention, but re-engaged and made a line of four across the track as the field raced into the far turn. He poked a head in front outside of Chief Havoc nearing the quarter pole, quickly put three lengths on his rivals, was ridden out the remainder and galloped out as if to say 'bring on that 10th furlong.' Paynter finished well outside for second, while Soi Phet attended the pace and held for third.

"The race was pretty much over at the three-eighths pole," said winning jockey Gary Stevens, who has never won a Breeders' Cup Classic. "He has a tremendous stride and he runs the turns really well. He's very athletic. I let him stretch himself a little at the three-eighths pole and had him pick it up again at the quarter pole. Had the race been a mile and one quarter I probably wouldn't have been as aggressive as I was but they told me to get a good race in and get a good gallop out of him afterwards, which I did. This horse only has to make up a neck from last year's Breeders' Cup Classic and I think he's a bigger, stronger horse than he was last year."



Trakus Fact: Winner Mucho Macho Man traveled the widest distance of the 10 runners at 6045 feet, the equivalent of about two lengths. The winner also posted the fastest final furlong of :12.49.

The likeable Cal-bred Tiz Flirtatious didn't hit the racetrack until October of her 3-year-old campaign, but she has certainly made up for lost time over the last three seasons--she has yet to finish off the board, and her eight tallies include six stakes victories. She earned her first black-type victory against state-breds in her third outing December 2011, and last year added another Cal-bred stakes tally.

However, she proved herself amongst the best against open competition as well, recording game second-place efforts in the G1 Matriarch

and G3 Robert J. Frankel S., and a third place finish in the G2 La Canada. The homebred at last got off the mark in graded company in the G2 Santa Ana S. Mar. 24 making up ground late to deny dual Grade I-winner Lady of Shamrock (Scat Daddy) by a length over this strip. A three month break ensued, and the 5-year-old returned to record a career best when hitting the lead in the stretch of the G1 Gamely at Betfair Hollywood Park May 27 before going down by a heartbreaking head to Marketing Mix. Tiz Flirtatious rebounded off another freshening to take the G2 John C. Mabee at Del Mar Aug. 11, and was sent off the favorite here. Tackling 1 1/4-miles for the first time, Tiz Flirtatious was placed in fourth on the fence early by Julien Leparoux, about six lengths off the lead of 28-1 shot Vionnet, who was tracked early by second choice Marketing Mix.**Cont. p10**

While Marketing Mix took first run at the crawling pacesetter approaching the quarter pole, Leparoux took Tiz Flirtatious four-wide on the bend, and began to wind her up at the top of the lane. Vionnet, who held on gamely until the dying strides, was confronted by Tiz Flirtatious and Marketing Mix inside the final furlong, and it was the Cal-bred on the outside who got up in time to record her first victory at the highest level. "She finished strong," Leparoux remarked. "She had to fight because those other fillies did not stop. It was a good race for her and she got the Grade I she deserves. I think she has a great chance for the Breeders' Cup. We knew she was really good but it was nice to see her handle the distance." Trainer Martin Jones added, "This horse is something else. She deserved this today because she's been so close in Grade I's. What a feeling. I was a little hesitant there at the top of the stretch, but she got the win. Hopefully she comes out of this race good." Jockey Gary Stevens expressed his satisfaction of Marketing Mix's performance. "I think this set us up pretty well going forward. She ran her race today, we just got out-kicked. It was a funny-run race, hopefully there will be more pace in the Breeders' Cup."



BEHOLD THE QUEEN

Beholder (Henny Hughes) was on the board in four of five starts at two, including a nose defeat by Executiveprivilege (First Samurai) in the GI Del Mar Debutante S. on the Polytrack. After a runaway allowance score in her dirt debut over this racetrack last October, she turned the tables on Executiveprivilege and closed out the season with a front-running win in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Named the champion 2-year-old filly following that effort, Beholder was a close second in her seasonal return in the 6 1/2-furlong GII Santa Ynez S. Jan. 21 before bouncing back to take the one-mile GI Las Virgenes S. Mar. 2. Back in the winner's circle following the Apr. 6 Santa Anita Oaks, she was let go at generous odds for her first attempt at nine furlongs in the May 3 GI Kentucky Oaks, and ran a bang-up second behind Princess of Sylmar (Majestic Warrior), who has since returned to annex a trio of Grade I's, including yesterday's GI Beldame S. against her elders. Given plenty of time off following her trip to Kentucky, she was given plenty of support in her return to the Polytrack for the Sept. 1 Torrey Pines S. at Del Mar and she didn't disappoint, scoring by 2 3/4 lengths.

Sent off the 7-5 choice in this 'Win and You're In' prelude to the Nov. 1 GI Breeder's Cup Distaff, Beholder took charge early and was left alone by Grade I winners **Include Me Out** (Include) and **Joyful Victory** (Tapit) through moderate early splits of :23.73 and ::47.36.

Meanwhile, **Authenticity** (Quiet American) was nestled in along the rail in fourth, and appeared to have something to offer turning for home, but required racing room to get through. As Include Me Out began to retreat, Beholder was given her cue at the head of the lane, and she raced away to show her elders little respect. "They have done such a good job with her, she's really matured from what I've seen just being a fan of hers and then being able to ride her right now," said winning rider Gary Stevens. "I just try and stay out of her way. She's particular about what she wants and as long as she gets it she's easy to deal with. When she swaps leads coming off the turn, she lunges and it's like she covers two lengths of what a normal stride is. I haven't got close to the bottom of her yet." As for facing her elders for the first time, winning trainer Richard Mandella explained, "Anytime you try something different it makes you nervous, when you're responsible for a horse like this. She couldn't look any better or be doing any better, so I had a lot of confidence." According to Mandella, the filly will head to Breeders' Cup Distaff for her next start.

Generally locked and loaded in the most important baby races in California, trainer Bob Baffert offered a three-pronged attack in yesterday's GI Chandelier S., a 'Win and You're In' prep for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies over track and trip in November. The least-fancied of Baffert's trio at 10-1, Secret Compass was allowed to settle in a stalking position as stablemate, 6-1 chance Awesome Baby (Awesome Again), rushed to lead with Harlington's Rose (Harlington) in hot pursuit.

As Awesome took the advantage through a half :46.25 and Harlington's Rose began to wilt, She's a Tiger kicked on to take the lead approaching the turn and appeared to be poised for victory. Secret Compass had other designs, however, as she steadily closed on that rival and had dead aim on her midstretch. With the game leader looking for the wire, Secret Compass forged to the front in the dying strides to collect her first win at the highest level. The 2-1 second choice She's a Tiger was third, while favored Fascinating rounded out the trifecta. "I was worried when I got to Gary's [Stevens] horse [She's a Tiger] that he would sprint away, said winning rider Rosie Napravnik. "He did for a little bit but my filly just kept running and she was all out sticking her nose out for the win. We'll have to see if I'll be riding her in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. I don't know where Bob [Baffert] is going with her, so we'll see." Secret Compass kicked off her career with a useful fourth in a five furlong test over Hollywood's Cushion Track July 6 before getting the monkey off her back while favored in a six-furlong test on Del Mar's Polytrack July 28. Stretching to seven panels for her latest, Secret Compass was fourth behind She's a Tiger and Fascinating in the GI Del Mar Debutante D. Aug. 31. "[Secret Compass] was very disappointing at Del Mar [GI Debutante Aug. 31]," said winning trainer Bob Baffert. "Today, she had to gut it out down the stretch, but I always thought she'd be better going two turns." Regarding Napravnik, who was winning her first Chandelier, Baffert added, "Rosie was open and I needed a rider, so I put her on there. It was a no-brainer. We've had a lot of success together. I think she's an excellent rider so I put her on and she sort of turned her loose and let her run her race. She's ready to roll." Regarding beaten favorite Fascinating, Baffert said, "She was so far back. I was a little worried about her today, because I thought she was going to be a victim of the race track. She falls so far back and then comes running, but I really think she'll move forward off of this. They'll both be a lot better for the Breeders' Cup [Juvenile Fillies Nov. 1]." Despite having to settle for second this time, trainer Jeff Bonde was already looking ahead to bigger and better things for She's a Tiger, a \$150,000 Keeneland September purchase. "I was real proud of my horse," said Bonde. "She relaxed much better today than she had in her prior races. [Jockey] Gary [Stevens] was pumped after the race and he told me that this horse will be really hard to beat in the next one. She has a two-turn race under her belt now and she's learning how to relax. I'll be running her in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies next."

Bond Holder was set a difficult task on his debut in the July 13 Hollywood Juvenile Championship and was fifth, then showed some improvement when third in a Del Mar maiden two weeks later. The 10-1 gamble continued to gain on the bend, was steered off the rail and to the outside for the drive and powered past the weakening pacesetters en route to an ultimately convincing success. Dance With Fate, bothered into the first turn by Ontology (Tapit), held for second from Tamarando, who missed the break and closed well to be third. "This race set up great for my horse because he likes to come from behind," winning jockey Mario Gutierrez commented. "He seemed to like the distance today and I think that played a major part in his win. I don't think the dirt made much of a difference because he runs everywhere; it was the distance that was the biggest factor."

"He didn't break super sharp, but Edgar was able to get into the position we wanted to be in and the fractions were reasonable," said trainer Todd Pletcher after winning his second graded stakes event of the afternoon. "He was able to hold off some challenges. It was good. We're going to the Breeders' Cup, but I don't know that we've decided which race just yet. We've got plenty of time to sort it out." Fort Larned tuned up for a defense of his GI Breeders' Cup Classic title in workmanlike, if not entirely spectacular, style, staying on well enough in the inaugural running of this event. It's been a frustrating and eventful 2013 for the homebred entire, who began his season by dropping jockey Brian Hernandez Jr. and running wild and free in the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 9 and followed with an extremely dull fifth in the GII Oaklawn H. Apr. 13. After passing on the GII Alysheba S. Derby week in favor of more spacing, Fort Larned was back to his brilliant best in the GI Stephen Foster H. June 15, leading past every pole to score by 6 1/4 lengths. They elected to not go after Cross Traffic (Unbridled's Song) in the GI Whitney H. Aug. 3, electing to stalk and try to make a run, but it backfired and he finished fourth. Ian Wilkes originally had Fort Larned penciled in for Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, but reasoned that he could run out of the barn at Churchill, avoid a ship and take path of least resistance to get back to Santa Anita.

Kicked away from the stalls, Fort Larned was a bit slow to get his feet underneath him, but headed his rivals off as they raced around the clubhouse turn. He took no pressure whatsoever on the engine, built up an imposing advantage on the final bend and was put to the whip late, but won with something in hand and refused to let the runner-up by on the gallop-out.

"We got the performance we needed out of him," said Hernandez Jr. "He went around there and did his job and galloped out really good. Now we're ready to go to California. He got a little tired, but I went ahead and I made him gallop-out pretty good so we can have him at a 100% for the big one."

Added Wilkes, "That was good. He was a different horse today. He was very quiet in the paddock. I didn't know what to think. Charlie [LoPresti]'s horse ran good. I think this race is going to help us a lot. You see he got a little tired at the end and we needed this race."

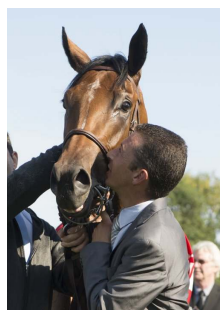

All of Sky Lantern's best performances have been marked by a turn of acceleration from in behind, and when that situation has been compromised either through misfortune or a misjudged ride, she has failed to shine. When things fell right for the grey, she was electric in the G1 Moyglare Stud S. at two and in the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot June 21, and was also able to annex the G1 1,000 Guineas in less flashy fashion over this track and trip May 6. Luck had been against her in November's G1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf and also this term when carried across the July Course by **Elusive Kate** (Elusive Quality) in the Falmouth when and hampered by Winsili (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the Nassau at Glorious Goodwood, but Hughes sought clear daylight for her this time and the tactic paid off handsomely. Content to allow **Just the Judge (Ire)** (Lawman {Fr}) and Elusive Kate a substantial headstart, Hughes waited until the former wilted and the latter started her usual drift leftwards heading downhill inside the final quarter. Integral eventually gave him the most concern on the far side as she struck for home, but Sky Lantern was delivering her irresistible surge to stamp her authority on proceedings. Richard Hannon Jr commented, "It's great to see her back. I think we'll go to Hong Kong, as the owner is very keen and so am I. It's a gutsy call to take a 3-year-old filly out there, but I think we can do it with her. We might look at the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. [at Ascot Oct. 19] before and decide whether we go a mile or a mile and a quarter at Sha Tin after that. It's a very similar track at Ascot and she'll love it."

Like all the best middle-distance prospects, Berkshire showed enough early speed to be tried over six furlongs in a Newbury maiden and only came up short by a length when third to the more streetwise Championship (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) in that May 17 contest. Making giant strides when next seen at Royal Ascot, the imposing dark bay romped away with the spoils in the Listed Chesham S., which can often be one of the meeting's least competitive events. This time, the June 22 renewal boasted several burgeoning stars including the runner-up Bunker (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}), who gave some indication as to the merit of the form when beating the subsequent G3 Prix la Rochette winner Karakontie (Jpn) (Bernstein) in a Listed race at Deauville next time. The third was the filly Ihtimal (Ire) (Shamardal), who had taken the G3 Sweet Solera S. and G2 May Hill S. and finished third in the G1 Fillies' Mile in the time that Berkshire was stabled at Whitcombe. Somewhat and Sir Jack Layden had finished eight lengths and more in arrears in the Chesham, and it was the former who set off to dictate the fractions to suit his own cause under Gerald Mosse as his main market rival was anchored in behind by Jim Crowley. Berkshire was shaken up for a few strides at halfway, but was quickly back on the bridle and on the heels of Somewhat and Washaar, who had ensured that rival was unable to gain a soft lead.

Challenging wide entering the "dip", he was marginally ahead of the game front-runner with a furlong remaining and, despite looking green, still battled to the line to prevail. "He was a bit gassy and fresh early on and he took me on a little," jockey Jim Crowley commented. "We've always said he wants fast ground--he might not want it that quick. He's got the job done and is going to be an even better 3-year-old. He stayed the trip very well today and the second horse has clearly improved a fair bit." Trainer Paul Cole added, "He looked a bit green, but had not run for a long time and 2-year-olds have to re-group sometimes. Whether he got unbalanced or not I don't know, but if they are good they'll get there. It's a bit early to say whether he will run again this year, but he won't be having a busy time. He probably won't run again, as he's a big horse and next year is going to be his year."

Favored at 2-1 on the morning line is Alto Racing's ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Sweet Whiskey** (Old Fashioned). The Todd Pletcher trainee ran to her reputation when she aired by 5 1/4 lengths with a field-best 86 Beyer Speed Figure at the Spa Aug. 11, but could do no better than a well-beaten fourth behind impressive winner Sweet Reason (Street Sense) in the sloppy seven-furlong GI Spinaway S. Sept. 1. The \$300,000 OBSMAR buy should appreciate the return to a dry strip, and the strength of her debut has since been flattered by a trio of next-out graduates.

Cal MacWilliam and Neil Teitelbaum homebred **Miss Behaviour** (Jump Start) ships in from the Midlantic as she looks to stretch her unbeaten record to three. The bay defeated **Gracer** (Exchange Rate) in a state-bred heat at Parx July 22, and dueled through hot splits before drawing off to score by 8 1/4 lengths in Monmouth's Sorority S. Sept. 1. The aforementioned Gracer, trained by Tony Dutrow for Team D, cruised by 6 1/4 lengths when shipped up to the Spa for her second try Aug. 25. She defeated Sweet Whiskey's stablemate Potosi's Silver (Silver Deputy), herself an open-length winner a week ago. While Grosse Point Farm colorbearer **Ocean Boulevard** (Fusaichi Pegasus) appears up against it from a speed figure perspective, she is the lone confirmed closer in the field, having gone last to first for Ian Wilkes third out upstate Aug. 26.
