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## FULL FIELDS ABOUND FOR BREEDERS' CUP XXX

A total of 172 horses, including an unprecedented nine runners looking to record consecutive championship victories, have been entered for the 30th running of the Breeders' Cup to be held Friday and Saturday, November 1 and 2, at Santa Anita Park in Arcadia, California, with purse money of \$27 million to be offered across the 14 events. Twenty horses have been cross-entered in multiple races, accounting for a total of 192 pre-entered runners. Final declarations and the draw for all 14 races is Monday. And with the exception of Friday's featured GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, which will accentuate quality over quantity, bettors can expect full fields.



**Game On Dude heads a field of 13 for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic** *Benoit*

The GI Breeders' Cup Classic, to be aired in prime time by NBC at 8:35 p.m. Eastern Time, has attracted 13 pre-entries, including Janis Whitham's defending champion **Fort Larned** (E Dubai) and the three horses that chased him home last year--**Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno), **Flat Out** (Flatter) and **Ron the Greek** (Full Mandate). **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again) is set for a third consecutive appearance in the \$5-million test, having finished runner-up to Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor) at Churchill Downs in 2011 before a disappointing seventh as the favorite last year when very little went according to script. The Bob Baffert stable will also be represented by **Paynter** (Awesome Again), who at this time last year was battling for his life and who seemed the unlikely of candidates to make this field. Those seasoned older horses will face a stern challenge from the cream of this year's 3-year-old crop in the form of GI Belmont S. hero **Palace Malice**, a son of 2007 Classic hero Curlin, and **Will Take Charge** (Unbridled's Song), who comes into the 10-furlong affair off turn-the-corner wins in the GI Travers S. and GII Pennsylvania Derby. Added Classic intrigue comes from overseas, as **Declaration of War** (War Front), a dual Group 1 winner in England this year on grass, but undefeated in three synthetic-track starts, carries the hopes of Ballydoyle and Joe Allen, while **Planteur (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) brings a pair of placings in the G1 Dubai World Cup to the table.

## RECORDS FALL AT SUPERB FTKOCT

A Hill 'n' Dale-bred and -consigned Smart Strike filly set a new standard at the 2013 Fasig-Tipton October Fall Yearling Sale when selling to Borges Torrealba Holdings for \$800,000 yesterday, a transaction that both helped propel the sale to record gains, and put a spotlight on the remarkable turnaround of an auction that was sitting on the chopping block just four years ago.

After three days of horse trading in Lexington, the cumulative average at October stood at a sale-record \$34,117, up 30.6% from last year's average of \$26,127. Likewise, the median of \$17,000, up 33.3%, established a new benchmark. The depth of the market was underscored by the buy-back rate, which came in at a very low 16.2%.

"It was a terrific horse sale," said Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning, Jr. "We're in a nice place in the market, where both the buyers and the sellers are happy. It shows a good balance. Buyers don't find it easy to buy horses, and sellers don't think it's easy selling horses."

For the session, the average of \$36,671 was up 36.4% from a year ago; the median of \$19,000 was up 41.7%. The session RNA rate was just 13.6%.

"We started off with a bang today with an \$800,000 filly, and people were still in the back walking ring when the last horses in the addendum to the catalog went through," said Browning.

The \$800,000 Smart Strike filly was the sale's second-highest-priced horse ever. In 1999, Pure Charm, a filly by Storm Cat--Testy Trestle, sold for \$925,000. Fasig-Tipton October Sale cont. p12

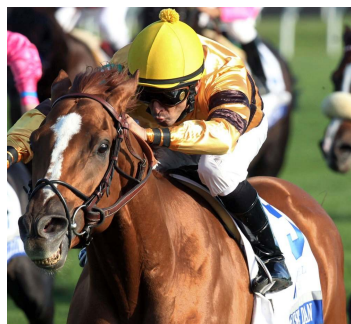

In addition to Fort Larned looking to join Tiznow as the only back-to-back winners of the Classic, six other horses return to defend their respective titles. Reigning Horse of the Year **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry) will attempt to defend in the Mile, while **Royal Delta** (Empire

**Mizdirection** (Mizzen Mast) will look to confirm her status as queen of the downhill course in defense of her Turf Sprint title and fellow distaff sprinter

**Groupie Doll** (Bowman's Band) is likely making the final start of her career in the Filly/Mare Sprint. Blue-

collar **Little Mike** (Spanish Steps) goes for two in a row in the Turf, while **Trinniberg** (Teuflesberg) will be a longshot proposition to make it consecutive Breeders' Cup Sprints. For good measure, both winners of the juvenile filly races from 2012 return to the scene of their finest hours, with **Beholder** (Henny Hughes) expected to take plenty of action against Royal Delta in the Distaff and **Flotilla (Fr)** (Mizzen Mast) is a something of a wild card against Wise Dan in the Mile.

## Baffert Has Two Cracks at Classic Glory...

Bob Baffert is no stranger to the Breeders' Cup winner's circle, with eight victories to his credit, but none to date in the Classic. With last year's flop by **Game On Dude** in the rear-view, Baffert is looking forward to atonement and is taking everything in stride.

"We're used to running lots of favorites in these big races and I think the pressure comes if you don't feel like you're prepared," he commented. "We feel like he couldn't be training any better, he looks great. Last year just didn't go right, but I think he's a different horse than he was last year. He's really run some outstanding races and he doesn't show me any signs of tailing off. He looks much better than he did last year. I think the break is going to be crucial, but mentally he's a different horse than he was last year." And despite an obvious plethora of speed signed on, race strategy will be straight-forward. "Mike Smith knows him really well, so all I can do is get him ready and give Mike the keys to the car and tell him to get him around there as quick as you can." The Baffert barn will also send **Paynter** out in the Classic as he tries to improve on his runner-up effort to Mucho Macho Man in the GI Awesome Again S. Sept. 28. "He's doing very well," Baffert confirmed. "I think with all the speed in there, he should be running late. I think he really moves forward off that last race. He looks great, he looks well and he likes this track.

### Mott Knows Way to Winner's Circle...

Trainer Bill Mott has nine Breeders' Cup wins to his credit, five alone in the Distaff and a pair in the Classic, including the aforementioned Drosselmeyer two years ago. The Hall of Famer has five horses pre-entered for four different clients, and looks for his fourth straight Distaff overall, having saddled Unrivaled Belle

(Unbridled's Song) to a success in 2010 ahead of **Royal Delta's** repeat scores. Mott said Royal Delta has come out of her Beldame defeat at the hands of **Princess of Sylmar** (Majestic Warrior) well and is ready for the three-peat attempt. "She's doing fine," he stated, referring to the 5-year-old mare. "I didn't think she ran her very best race [in the Beldame]. She got beat by a very good filly, she seems to be doing well and we've let her works pick back up." Mott added that while the Classic was pondered

earlier this year, the decision to run in the Distaff came fairly quickly. Mott will be double-barrelled in the Classic with G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup hero **Ron the Greek** and **Flat Out**, third to his stable companion Sept. 28. "I'm hoping he can repeat something close to that," Mott said of the former. "He's always a solid competitor and seems to have come out in good order. Both horses ran credible over the racetrack last year and hopefully they'll do the same this year." Mott also won the '95 Classic with Cigar.

### Mandella Ever-Dangerous at Santa Anita...

Trainer Richard Mandella has seven Breeders' Cup victories to his credit, all of them at Santa Anita and all but one in years ending in '3.' After sending Phone Chatter and Kotashaan (Fr) to scores in the Juvenile Fillies and Turf, respectively in 1993, the affable conditioner recorded an historic four-timer 10 years ago with Halfbridled (Juvenile Fillies), Action This Day (Juvenile, for B. Wayne Hughes), Johar (Turf dead-heater) and Pleasantly Perfect (Classic). **Beholder** gave Mandella a seventh trophy last year and the half-sister to Spendthrift sire Into Mischief will try to become the first in the history of the Breeders' Cup to win the Juvenile Fillies and Distaff in back-to-back years a week from Friday. "She couldn't be doing any better," Mandella stated. "She seems to be improving as time goes by. She's growing up and I don't think you can ask for one to be better than she's doing." And Mandella expects the strapping filly to be at or near the head of affairs next Friday. "We've never had to teach her anything about speed--she's got an abundance of that. We're not looking to change anything."

"We will put him away for next season, when the Breeders' Cup will be his ultimate target. It was always going to be one or the other, but Olympic Glory has come out of last week's QE II victory at Ascot better than we could have hoped so he will be our representative in the Mile. Sheikh Joaan is keen to have runners at the meeting and we will also be talking **Shamshon** (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) for the Juvenile Turf." Olympic Glory is one of 22 foreign pre-entrants.

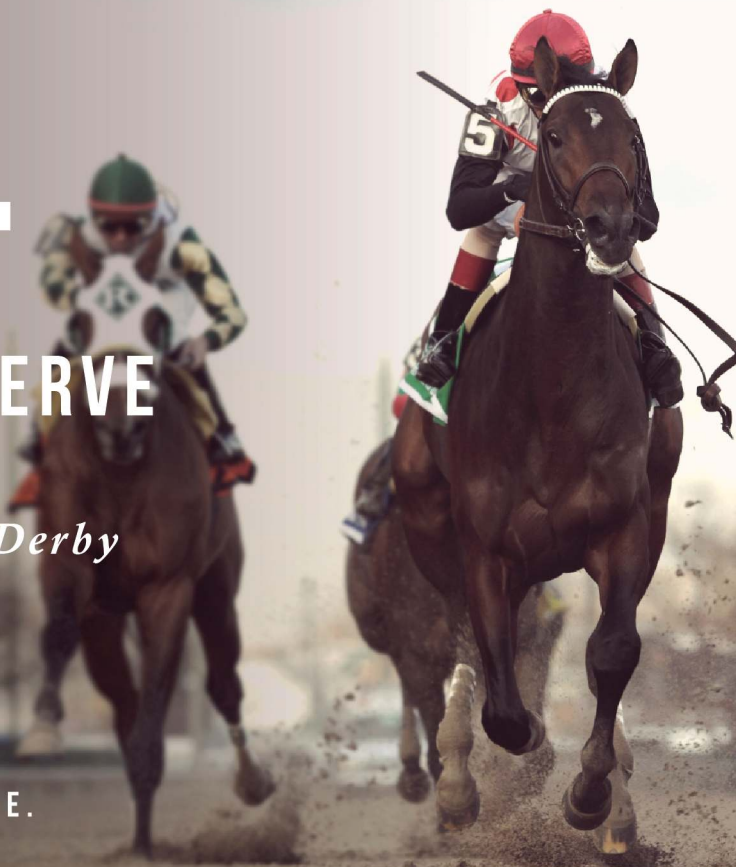

**PREPARE NOW FOR THE BREEDING STOCK SALES**

For those attending the 2013 breeding stock sales, it is worth looking at a tax incentive that may apply to purchases this year. The Expense Provision allows the purchaser to expense (write-off) all or a portion of the purchase price of a horse or horses, including broodmare prospects. This incentive can apply to a single purchase provided the horse qualifies and is placed in service in 2013. Since, like most tax provisions, there are technicalities which must be met, a purchaser who wants to use this provision should consult with their tax advisor to make sure it applies to their situation. Below are some details of the Expense Provision.

A purchaser can deduct up to \$500,000 of the cost of a horse or horses purchased in 2013, provided (1) the total of all purchases of horses and other depreciable business property does not exceed \$2 million and (2) the horse is placed in service by the purchaser in 2013. If the purchase exceeds \$2 million, the amount that can be expensed in 2013 is reduced one dollar for each dollar the amount of such purchases exceeds \$2 million.

Having transferred to Xavier Thomas-Demeaulte's yard after two unsuccessful efforts for Francis-Henri Graffard, **Stellar Path (Fr)** (Astronomer Royal) made an immediate impact for her new stable when registering scores at Vichy July 18, and at Dax Aug. 21. She was then stepped up to black-type company, running second in the Sept. 9 Listed Criterium de l'Ouest at Craon, and winning the Oct. 9 Listed Grand Criterium de Bordeaux last time. Stellar Path was steadied in rear after breaking alertly from the outside box upped in grade once more here. Stoked up with 350 meters remaining, she moved into third entering the final eighth and was driven out to swoop for a career high nearing the line. "She has improved with each run since joining my yard and won very easily at Bordeaux last time," Thomas-Demeaulte commented. "I thought she had a good shot at the race today, so that's why we came."

"She's not the easiest filly to ride and Gregory Benoist did a good job settling her as we know she has a tremendous turn of foot. Her season is finished now. We will see how she goes through the winter and hope that she can make it at the highest level next year."

In the lead-up to October, sale officials insisted the auction was no longer an afterthought in the minds of sellers, no longer a place to just send horses that had missed previous engagements. The results sheets over the last few days proved them correct. The sale showed considerable strength at the top end of the market, with 15 horses selling for \$200,000 or more. Last year, six horses eclipsed that mark.

Breaking things down further, there were five horses that sold for \$300,000 or more, compared to two last year, including the \$440,000 Speightstown--Betty's Pet colt who topped the 2012 auction.

For sale officials, one stat that was especially satisfying was the clearance rate. "It was terrific," said Browning. "Today was the lowest buy-back rate of the three days, but all three days were under 20%. It shows that there's demand for horses right now."

Browning said the sale put an exclamation point on good few months of selling yearlings. "It started off on a positive note in July, and I think that set the table for a successful yearling sales season in North America in 2013," he said. "It was nice to finish up strong, and obviously it bodes well for the sales coming up in November. The marketplace is vibrant. It's not irrational or crazy, but it's full of good commerce across the board."

In March of 2009, Fasig-Tipton announced it was striking October from its sales calendar, saying it was no longer "viable." A few weeks later, after objections from buyers and sellers, Fasig reversed its decision.

"I think it's safe to say the sale is cemented on the calendar now," laughed Browning. "The sale has credibility and the confidence of the marketplace. It's nice to hear a cross section of buyers and sellers say to me that this is, 'My favorite sale of the year.' That's music to our ears. It's become an important sale for us, and an important sale on the North American sales picture."

### Borges Torrealba Lands Topper...

The star of Wednesday's final session of the Fasig-Tipton October sale came early Wednesday when [hip 760](#), a Hill 'n' Dale-bred Smart Strike filly became the auction's highest-priced horse in years when selling to Borges Torrealba Holdings for \$800,000. Bloodstock agent Doug Cauthen, representing the Brazilian family, signed the ticket for the filly. The May 19-foaled miss was produced by MSW & GISP Handpainted (A.P. Indy) and is a half-sister to SW & GSP Patena (Seeking the Gold) and SP Oil Painting (Distorted Humor). It's the extended family of the Grade I winners Touch Gold, Brilliant Speed, et al. Handpainted didn't have a foal in 2013 and is back in foal to Speightstown.

"[Borges Torrealba] is looking for classy, athletic fillies that have some pedigree, and this filly fit the bill," said Cauthen, who was on the phone with the operation's head Goncalo Torrealba during the bidding. "We narrowed this filly down as the class of the day, but we didn't expect her to be that expensive. I was hoping between \$400-\$500,000. But she's just a beautiful filly and has the pedigree, and is the kind you want. The really good ones cost a lot."

The Borges Torrealba family, a vested partner in Three Chimneys Farm, has made a big impact on the American sales scene since announcing its partnership with the Midway, Kentucky nursery a year ago. They purchased the sale-topping \$4.5-million Pure Clan (Pure Prize) at the 2012 Keeneland November Sale, and more recently, and in partnership with Three Chimneys, acquired four horses at Keeneland September for a total of \$3.27 million. Their purchases, all fillies, include a \$1.75 million Tiznow half-sister to Speightstown (Gone West).

## Another Star for Hill 'n' Dale...

Seven hips into Tuesday's second session at October, Hill 'n' Dale Sales sold the sale's top-priced colt, a \$500,000 Distorted Humor yearling. Seven hips into Wednesday's finale, John Sikura's operation sold the auction's top-priced filly, an \$800,000 Smart Strike miss.

The symmetry worked well for Hill 'n' Dale, which has jumped from strength-to-strength at the sales this year. At Fasig's Saratoga Sale, it sold one of the two horses

that brought seven figures, a \$1 million Distorted Humor-Cascading filly. A few weeks later at Keeneland September, Hill 'n' Dale sold four seven-figure lots at Keeneland September,

including the \$2.2

million Indian Charlie half-sister to Take Charge Lady and the \$1.7 million Medaglia d'Oro half-brother to Super Saver. Yesterday's score, meanwhile, was noteworthy in that it was care of a family that John and his brother Glenn have curated for years.

"We spent a lot of years and money trying to obtain significant mares, those pedigrees that are really special, and to sell horses from those families to people like [Borges Torrealba] here, to Live Oak in Saratoga, to Mandy Pope at Keeneland, it's very rewarding," said Sikura. "It's a great market for the unique offerings."

While yesterday's Smart Strike filly had a pedigree that would have fit in any select auction in the world, Sikura said the game plan was always to bring her to the October Sale.

"She was a late foal and I had nominated her to September, but I never had any intention of selling her there," he said. "If she had made a big step forward, we might have sold her there, but I think she needed the time. And this sale has become more than just a clearing house--it's a place to sell really good horses. We were well rewarded for bringing her here. We sold the high colt and the high filly here, so it's been a great sale for us, and a great year for us."

## Perretti Secures Eight Belles Kin for \$370,000...

The Florida-based horseman J.J. Crupi bought Wednesday's third-dearest horse, an eye-catching filly by Unbridled's Song, on behalf of Perretti Farms for \$370,000. Gainesway consigned the daughter of Miss Abita (Dixie Union) as [hip 986](#), and the farm's Brian Graves was celebrating a smart pinhook, having purchased the filly for \$190,000 last year at Keeneland November.

The filly is a close relative to the brilliant Eight Belles, another by Unbridled's Song. Her dam Miss Abita is a three-parts sister to SW Away (Dixieland Band), dam of the ill-fated GI Kentucky Derby runner-up. It's also the family of the good sire Belong to Me (Danzig).

"This filly just had everything in the right place," said Crupi. "She just acted with so much class, and she looks like a runner. And you can get a runner by Unbridled's Song."

Bill Perretti's Perretti Farms, for over two decades one of the leading operations in Standardbred racing, has been making its presence felt on the Thoroughbred scene in recent months. It's very first Thoroughbred, Forty Tales (Tale of the Cat), won a trio of graded stakes this summer, including the GII Woody Stephens S. and GII Amsterdam S. The man who sold him the horse was none other than J.J. Crupi.

"I've known Bill for 35 years," said Crupi from the rear walking ring yesterday. "I used to fool with the Standardbreds years ago. Bill's 86, and he just loves it. I've got two other 2-year-olds I broke for him. Todd [Pletcher] ran one and he ran second; Carl Domino ran one, and he ran second, too. Both in New York maiden specials. So Bill's on a roll. He thinks it's easy!" **Cont. p14**

And Perretti's just getting started. "I spent \$1.9 million for him at [Keeneland September], and at Saratoga we probably spent \$800,000. He's rolling."

The Unbridled's Song filly was Perretti's first buy at October.

Perretti will skip the Breeders' Cup with Forty Tales, though Crupi himself is well-represented. He broke the GI Spinaway S. heroine Sweet Reason (Street Season), and pinhooked the GI FrontRunner S. upsetter Bond Holder (Mineshaft). He also broke last year's GI Turf winner Little Mike (Spanish Steps), recent hero of the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic at Belmont.

## Casse, Nardellis Team Up on Another Medaglia...

Trainer Mark Casse has enjoyed success buying Medaglia d'Oro yearlings from the Kim and Rodney Nardelli at Fasig-Tipton. Three years ago, at the Saratoga Sale, he acquired the filly Funny Proposition from the husband-and-wife duo for \$275,000, and earlier this year soundly upset champion Royal Delta (Empire Maker) with the 4-year-old in the GII Fleur de Lis at Churchill.

Casse went back to the well yesterday at October, going to \$440,000 to purchase the sale's third-highest-priced yearling, a colt by the Darley sire from the good producer Listen Now (Storm Bird). The May 12-foaled gray was consigned by the Nardellis, who bred him in partnership with Susan Bunning and Michael Spirito, as [hip 924](#). Casse deputized his brother Justin to handle the bidding duties on behalf of an undisclosed client.

"This colt has a stallion's pedigree," said Justin Casse.

"He's a half to four stakes horses from a strong mare, and he was the complete package physically. He's very strong and well-balanced. He might not be as stretchy as a lot of the Medaglias, but when you look at him, all the parts are there, and you know he's going to grow up and be a nice horse. Even though he's nowhere near what a pinhooker would pay, he's the kind of horse a pinhooker would love. He looks like he could be precocious."

Of the price, he added,

"We were about at our limit. There wasn't a whole lot of meat left on the bone."

The Nardellis have enjoyed success with the colt's dam Listen Now for over 15 years now. They purchased the Whitham homebred as an unraced 2-year-old broodmare prospect in 1996, the same year Listen Now's half-sister Listening (Night Shift) won the GI Hollywood Oaks. The pedigree would enjoy big updates in the coming years, as another half, Beautiful Noise (Sunny's Halo), won the GII Santa Ana H. in 2001, and a third sister, Solar Echo (Spinning World), became a multiple Grade I performer.

In the meantime, Listen Now was doing her part to fill her page with black-type. Her foals included the 2002 GII Amsterdam S. winner Listen Here (Gulch), whom the Nardellis raced, and the SW Indy Bird (A.P. Indy). She's also the dam of the GSP Listen (Chester House) and SP Parade the Flag (Distorted Humor). Listen Now was also a good sales producer for the Nardellis, giving them their best-ever result at auction, an Unbridled's Song filly who sold for \$600,000 in 2004.

"She's a good mare that's taken us a lot of places," said Rodney Nardelli.

Listen Now, now 19, did not have a foal this spring, but is back in foal to Midnight Lute.

Nardelli reported her Medaglia d'Oro colt had been catalogued for September, but grabbed a quarter in his near fore just before the sale and was a late scratch.

"We had to take care of that, and it healed up perfect," said Nardelli. "We were happy to take him here; we always like to do business with Fasig-Tipton. They always get the buyers here, and it's a great market."

The Nardellis are located not far from Lexington. "We're based between Georgetown and Midway," said Nardelli. "We have 250 acres and do horses and Angus [cattle]--a little bit of everything."

They have bred or co-bred, among others, the Grade I stakes winner Mona de Momma (Speightstown).

### KING'S BESTS FILLY TOPS AS OCT ROLLS ON

While the quality on offer at Arqana's October Yearling Sale tapered off yesterday, a solid trade saw a top price of €75,000 paid by Jean-Claude Rouget for a daughter of King's Best with smart connections. Offered by Haras du Cadran as hip [341](#), the April-foaled bay is a half-sister to a former member of the Pau-based trainer's Whipsaw City (Fr) (Elusive City), who went on to be stakes-placed for Martin Schwartz and Chad Brown. From the family of the G1 Grand Prix de Paris-winning champion Montmartre (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}), she was purchased for Daniel-Yves Treves. Late in the session, Rouget stepped in to secure a son of Diktat (GB) for €67,000. Hip [484](#) from La Motteraye Consignment is a half-brother to two notables from Spain in Alonso (Spa) (Green Tune), winner of the Gran Premio Nacional à Madrid, and Navarra (Spa) (Caradak {Ire}), successful in the Gran Premio Beamonte (Oaks Espanol). Laurent Benoit's Broadhurst Agency paid €66,000 for a son of Elusive City from the extended family of Aquarelliste (Fr) (Danehill) consigned as hip [354](#) by his breeder Haras du Mont Dit Mont. That sale was followed by a €62,000 purchase of a daughter of Duke of Marmalade (Ire) by Brian Grassick Bloodstock. Hip [370](#) from Ecurie des Monceaux is out of Ballerina Blue (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}), who placed fourth in the 2008 G3 Prix Cleopatre and who is a half to the 2004 G1 Prix du Jockey Club hero Blue Canari (Fr) (Acatenango {Ger}).

In the dying embers of trading, George Mullins paid €65,000 for Haras des Eclous' hip [491](#), a son of Mastercraftsman (Ire) out of a half to the dual Group 1-winning sire Court Masterpiece (GB) (Polish Precedent).

## NEWS TODAY

### ATLANTIC JEWEL OFFICIALLY RETIRED

Coolmore's four-time Group 1 winner and Champion 3-year-old filly **Atlantic Jewel (Aus)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}--Regard {Aus}, by Zabeel {NZ}), ruled out of Saturday's G1 Cox Plate earlier this week due to swelling in the lower tendon sheath of her off-fore flexor tendon, has been officially retired and will travel to Coolmore's base in Ireland to be covered by Galileo (Ire) next year on Northern Hemisphere time. A A\$320,000 purchase from the 2010 Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, Atlantic Jewel signaled her brilliance from the start, winning three straight to begin her career before adding the 2011 G1 Thousand Guineas in her fourth start. She dominated the G2 Wakeful S. thereafter, but was forced to miss the G1 Crown Oaks--and handed six months on the sidelines--due to a stress fracture in her back. She returned without a hitch to add the G2 Sapphire S. and G1 All Aged S. the following April before being forced out of competition once again, this time by a tendon injury that kept her out for 16 months. The imposing bay looked no worse for the wear when thrashing her foes first up in the G1 Memsie S. at Caulfield Aug. 31, and added the G2 Stocks S. next out with similar ease. She suffered her first and only defeat in what would be her penultimate outing when forced to set the pace in the G1 Underwood S. at Caulfield Sept. 21, and was unable to hold off the challenge of Australian 3-year-old Triple Crown winner It's A Dundeel (Aus) (High Chaparral {Ire}), succumbing by a short head. Back off the pace in the G1 Caulfield S. 12 days ago, Atlantic Jewel overwhelmed her rivals, in the process establishing herself as the Cox Plate favorite. The 5-year-old retires with 10 wins from 11 starts and earnings of A\$1,587,925 (US\$1,532,824). Michael Kirwan, General Manager of Coolmore Australia, told Australia's Sky Sports Radio that Atlantic Jewel would stay with Kavanagh for her initial recovery before serving a quarantine period at Coolmore's Australian base in the Hunter Valley. "We've decided this is the time to retire her," Kirwan told the radio station. "It's a very difficult decision but not a hard one. She'll do 30 days quarantine here at Coolmore before she leaves for Ireland, which will probably be in December. She will be served by Galileo in February." Out of the unraced Regard, Atlantic Jewel is a half-sister to Commanding Jewel (Aus) (Commands {Aus}), who made it back-to-back Thousand Guineas scores for the family when taking Caulfield's filly feature in 2012. The pair of Group 1 winners are the only two foals produced by Regard, who died following a paddock accident in 2011.

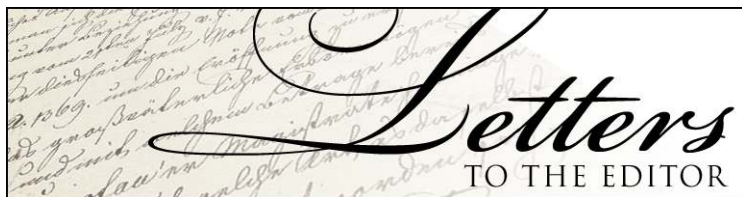

## LAMINITIS SETBACK FOR ST NIC

Coolmore yesterday issued a statement regarding **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), whose recovery from injury has met with a setback. "St Nicholas Abbey has suffered a setback over the last 24 hours, having developed mild laminitic changes in the left fore," a tweet from the operation read. "This is disappointing, as he is now weight-bearing and walking well on the operated leg which has healed amazingly well to date." The news is a latest unwelcome twist in a saga which began with a fractured pastern in July and has also involved a serious bout of colic and the breaking of a steel weight-bearing pin in a cannon-bone. "Although laminitis could be a life-threatening complication, we are hoping the condition will stabilise," the tweet continued. "Obviously, the next weeks are critical in his recovery, but St Nicholas Abbey remains comfortable with a good appetite and incredible attitude."

I have enjoyed the interviews by Barry Irwin on the IFHA.

The current status of the IFHA can be found in a tale of two countries: Japan and the United States.

When the IFHA started in 1967, the image of Japan racing was very low. It was so low, it was like U.S. racing today. On the other hand, U.S. racing was riding high, so high that in 1968, the horse winning the Kentucky Derby was disqualified just for using Bute.

Japan did not try to clean up all racing in their country. They couldn't. Like here in the U.S., the problem was too big and too political. Instead, they cleaned up the highest level and shifted the lower levels out of the public eye. It took years and is a model for vision, investment and return. Japan now leads the world in handle and purses, with the JRA brand a clean image for racing and the people involved in the sport.

U.S. racing took the opposite direction; by expanding the lower levels of racing; by reducing integrity at all levels with legal and illegal drugs; by allowing bets after the gates opened; all those and more have resulted in a low image for racing and the people involved. Who made that decision for U.S. racing? Who made that decision for all the people involved in the sport and breeding?

The folks who changed racing in the U.S. are not concerned about the IFHA and what Louis Romanet and Jim Gagliano have to say about integrity. They care about making a living and the law is on their side, not by intent, but by definition.

The influence of racehorse owners and breeders was used to pass the Interstate Horseracing Act (IHA).

They intended to boost U.S. racing to the moon and that is where it was headed. They did not intend for the IHA to give trainers control of U.S. racing and implement the changes above.

The IHA gives approval by the host track's racehorse owners to protect their purse account from the host track giving away the races for less than full value. But instead, the IHA used the word horsemen, defined as trainers and owners. Horsemen organizations are primarily trainers.

Purse accounts get half the takeout for up to 10% of the wager. Horsemen gave approval for the host tracks to give away races to other tracks for 1-2% of the wagers. How can anyone say that protects the host purse account, the intent of the law? There are a lot of confused reasons why the tracks and horsemen have done what they have done under the IHA, but there is time to set it right.

The IFHA countries had high hopes the Breeders' Cup would lead the way to change in U.S. racing drug rules. The trainers' representatives with IHA approval stopped it.

The image of U.S. racing at the time Louis Romanet's father started the IFHA was the beacon for the world to aspire. But, one definition of a word in the IHA, though well-intentioned when written by a good friend, set in motion an unintended chain of events that are destroying U.S. racing.

Every country in the IFHA adheres to the legality of property rights; i.e. your home, your land, your intellectual property, your horse. Property rights are the most basic foundation of business.

Trainers have no property rights to your horse. Government must establish the legality of racehorse owners' property rights in the IHA. Racehorse owners and breeders must now use their influence to revise the IHA from horsemen to racehorse owners.

I believe the rebirth of racing in Japan and the failure of racing in the U.S. are directly related to whether the highest level of the sport is separated, organized and marketed as a brand, which then becomes the public face of the sport. Like in Japan, lower level U.S. racing can easily be moved to less prominent days.

U.S. racing is the hole in the IFHA. If properly filled, it will provide harmony among racing countries, however, harmony should be a strategy instead of an objective. The objective of owners and breeders around the world should be the growth, development and protection of Thoroughbred racing.

The two words never mentioned in the IFHA interviews were racehorse owners, which reflects the current structure of racing around the world. We need to have that conversation. We need to bring together individuals who understand the potential of racehorse owners' property rights to transcend international borders.

Then the IFHA can fulfill the dreams of harmony between racing countries and enjoy a future where the whole is greater than the sum of its parts.

### Calvin Borel Injured at Keeneland:

Hall of Fame jockey Calvin Borel was thrown from Sonic Dancer (Suave) and then hit by another horse in the sixth race at Keeneland yesterday, after Sonic Dancer went down just before the first turn. Borel suffered a concussion and complained of leg pain before being transported to the University of Kentucky Medical Center. "He was stable, somewhat alert and suffering the effects of a sports concussion," said Dr. Barry Schumer, Keeneland Medical Director. "He was complaining of pain in his left leg but he was able to move it." Sonic Dancer, a 3-year-old Kumud and Rakesh Sikand homebred trained by Larry Lay, was euthanized. The 1 1/16-mile maiden special weight on the lawn was declared a no contest by the stewards shortly after the incident.

### 'Single 6 Jackpot' Added to Churchill Wagering Menu: Edited Press Release

Officials at Churchill Downs have received permission from the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission to launch the 'Single 6 Jackpot' at their upcoming fall meet beginning Oct. 27. The wager challenges bettors to select six consecutive winners, and those that have the most winners in the sequence will share equally 80% of the money wagered into the pool, with the remaining 20% going to the Single 6 Jackpot. The jackpot will be paid only if there is one winning bet with the six winners at the required minimum 50-cent level. If a bettor hits the Single 6 Jackpot twice on one ticket--meaning he or she "scratched into the favorite" and used both horses in the race; or used two horses in a race and they finished in a dead-heat; or played the same 50-cent ticket twice for a total of \$1--he or she is not eligible for the jackpot aspect. There can only be a single winning wager placed at the required minimum bet value for the jackpot to be paid. The low probability of a single winning wager means there's a high chance for the jackpot to grow daily and reach lottery-like levels, which creates tremendous excitement and the possibility of a financial windfall and score of a lifetime. There is one exception: the jackpot must be paid out on the final day of the five-week meet (Saturday, Nov. 30), which means all money, including the jackpot, will be distributed that day to those with the highest number of winners in the six-race sequence.

Multiple graded stakes winner **Prospective** (Malibu Moon--Spirited Away, by Awesome Again) has been retired and will stand at Ocala Stud for the 2014 breeding season. ### THIS WEEK IN HISTORY:

**October 23, 1982...**The ill-fated Landaluce took the GI Oak Leaf S. by two lengths in what would be her final career start. The meteoric filly died a month later after contracting Colitis-X.

**October 24, 1877...**The United States Congress adjourned so its members could go to Pimlico to watch a race between Parole, Ten Broeck and Tom Ochiltree.

**October 24, 1953...**Tom Fool won the Pimlico Special by eight lengths to cap off a perfect 10-for-10 four-year-old campaign. The Special was his fourth consecutive race run as a non-betting exhibition. He was voted the 1953 Horse of the Year over Native Dancer, whose lone loss that year came when he finished second in the Kentucky Derby.

**October 25, 1870...**Pimlico, the nation's second-oldest racetrack, opened for its inaugural meet.

**October 25, 1901...**Imp won for the 62nd and final time in his career when he took a Morris Park H. by four lengths.

**October 25, 2003...**The first dead heat in the history of the Breeders' Cup occurred when Johar and defending race champion High Chaparral (Ire) hit the wire together in the GI BC Turf. It was just a head back to Falbrav (Ire) in third.

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
