



BEHOLDER SHINES BRIGHTEST IN DISTAFF

While the pre-race hype focused squarely on the rematch between two-time GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) and GI Kentucky Oaks victoress **Princess of Sylmar** (Majestic Warrior), it was 2012 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies champion **Beholder** (Henny Hughes) striding home first as the sun set on day one of championship weekend at Santa Anita Friday. Beholder, who became the first Juvenile Fillies winner to return to take the Distaff, gave veteran rider Gary Stevens his ninth career Breeders' Cup win. "I've been lucky enough to have many good mares in my years of training, but this mare might have to be the best of all," commented winning trainer Richard Mandella, who was saddling his first Distaff starter Friday. **Pages3-5**

All Gold Exacta in Dirt Mile

W C Racing, Dave Kenney and RAP Racing's **Goldencents** (Into Mischief) ran them off their feet in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile Friday, setting swift fractions over the quick Santa Anita surface before reporting home a convincing 2 3/4-length victor. Closers **Golden Ticket** (Speightstown) and **Brujo de Olleros (Brz)** (Wild Event) rounded out the exacta and trifecta respectively, while favored **Verrazano** (More Than Ready) settled for fourth after a rough trip. **Page6-7**

Outstrip Outpaces in Juvenile Turf

Godolphin's **Outstrip (GB)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) came flying late to complete a rousing start to Breeders' Cup weekend for the championship meet's leading rider Mike Smith with a half-length win in the GI Juvenile Turf. Smith also captured the GII Marathon aboard **London Bridge** (Arch) in the first 2013 Breeders' Cup championship race. It was another late-running victory for the European contingent as **Chriselliam (Ire)** (Iffraaj {GB}) powered home a much-the-best winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. CLASSIC REMATCH AT SANTA ANITA

The top three finishers in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic, plus the race's beaten favorite, are among the 11 runners set to line up in today's renewal of the 1 1/4-mile race. Defending champion **Fort Larned** (E Dubai)--who will take up stud duties at Adena Springs next year (**story p23**)--has had an up-and-down 2013, but trainer Ian Wilkes has found himself in demand this week at Santa Anita as the 5-year-old prepares for a second Classic.

"I have done a lot more interviews this year," Wilkes said. "Last year, we were way under the radar." Of his charge's chances today, Wilkes added, "We are good to go here, no excuses."

Last year's favorite **Game on Dude** (Awesome Again) will likely be the crowd's choice again today as he looks to cap a perfect 2013 campaign. The dark bay gelding was stymied by a slow break in 2012 and came home only seventh. Recalling last year's race, Wilkes acknowledged today's Classic could be won or lost at the start. "You can talk about the shape of the race, but the most important key to the race is the break," Wilkes said. "What if Game On Dude doesn't break well like he did last year? What if Moreno doesn't break well? What if we don't break well? That's why I will leave it all up to [jockey] Brian [Hernandez Jr.]." **Cont. p15**

Beholder Roms in Distaff

Princess of Sylmar broke awkwardly and soon trailed the field, while defending champ Royal Delta took the field into the first turn. Beholder settled just off the champ while three wide into the turn. Royal Delta yielded her advantage to **Authenticity** (Quiet American) into the backstretch, but she maintained contact with the pacesetter through an opening half in :46.30 and Beholder was never far off the lead. Royal Delta packed it in with a half-mile to run and Beholder strode up to challenge for the lead after three-quarters in 1:10.28. Gary Stevens barely moved on Beholder and the bay filly took charge turning for home and she effortlessly extended her advantage down the stretch to score by 4 1/4 lengths.

"We trained her this way [to run from off the pace]," winning trainer Richard Mandella said. "We've just never had to use it before. She's so naturally fast, you don't have to train that into her and she's made the lead so easily in many of her races. Today, she had to come from off of it and she did it--and boy do I love it."

Gary Stevens, who returned to the saddle in March after an eight-year retirement, added, "She was a little fractious going into the gate and a little anxious. I was afraid she might over-break, but she settled and broke beautiful. This is the best race she's ever run. I was hoping that Authenticity would carry the lead a little farther but Beholder moved up nice, went by her easy and then really opened up." The Distaff was Stevens' first Breeders' Cup win since taking the GI Mile with War Chant in 2000.

Owner B. Wayne Hughes paid tribute to his champion filly. "I think I'm going to quote Pete Carroll who says that you can't be a champion unless you defeat champions. And today, I think we defeated two champions. I sort of second Richard's comments about the gameness of the other owners and the other horses, and I'm glad they came right now, but I was a little nervous before the race."

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Beholder was named Eclipse champion 2-year-old filly after her win in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. After beginning the year with a runner-up effort in the Jan. 21 GI Santa Ynez S. She returned to the winner's circle in the Mar. 2 GI Las Virgenes S. and Apr. 6 GI Santa Anita Oaks. Fractious before the start of the GI Kentucky Oaks, even unseating jockey Garrett Gomez, Beholder took the lead in the stretch before being past late by Princess of Sylmar. Given time to regroup, the sophomore filly returned with wins in the Sept. 1 Torrey Pines S. and most recently in the Sept. 28 GI Zenyatta S.

Beholder was purchased by Hughes's Spendthrift Farm for \$180,000 out of the 2011 Keeneland September sale. Clarkland

Farm purchased Beholder's dam Leslie's Lady (Tricky Creek) for \$100,000 out of the 2006 Keeneland November sale. She is also the dam of Spendthrift stallion and Grade I winner Into Mischief (Harlan's Holiday), who was represented on Friday's Breeders' Cup card by GI Dirt Mile winner Goldencents. The 17-year-old mare has a weanling filly by Curlin and was bred to Eskendereya this spring. Beholder's sire Henny Hughes will stand the 2014 season in Japan after being sold to Yushun Company in Hokkaido. The 10-year-old had most recently stood at Rangeview in Western Australia.

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Say What?

"[Mike Smith] tried to get her to go on a little more on the first turn and she didn't. She'd worked very well coming into the race. I thought she was doing well going into the race. She's had three hard campaigns. I've been very blessed to have a lot of good horses and it's difficult to have more than two good campaigns with any horse. This mare has come back and won Grade 1s this year and I see no reason why she wouldn't be champion older mare. She didn't win the Breeders' Cup, but she's been good to us. She's won two championships and maybe three, and won a couple of Breeders' Cups. It's not a bad career. Maybe it's time. Maybe it's time. I think Gary [Stevens] had the plan to wait and make a little run. She did and his filly ran a tremendous race."

Trainer Bill Mott on Royal Delta (4th)

"She didn't have it today. No spark, man. Early on, I knew it. She usually takes the race to somebody, but not today. I thought when Beholder come up to her, she would pick it up, but she didn't. I asked and I asked and nothing. I'm kind of dumbfounded."

Jockey Mike Smith aboard Royal Delta

"She ran big today. She broke well and put me in the race. I was tracking the leader [Authenticity] because it looked like she was going well. When I called on my filly at the 3/8ths pole, I thought I had a good chance, but Gary's horse [Beholder] had another gear."

Jockey Joel Rosario aboard runner-up Close Hatches

"Authenticity ran her race. She ran well. She fought hard for third and I thought she ran a really good race. Princess of Sylmar kind of stumbled leaving the starting gate and broke out awkwardly and kind of went down a little bit. She came away well last, not exactly where you want to be on this track for sure. [Jockey Javier Castellano] said she didn't get over the track at all and struggled with the surface throughout."

Trainer Todd Pletcher on Authenticity (3rd) and Princess of Sylmar (6th)

"She stumbled really bad at the gate. I blame the track. It's all speed, speed, speed and unfair to come-from-behind horses. Unfortunatley, she didn't handle the track at all. She was spinning her wheels. Usually at the half-mile pole, she pulls, and today she didn't pull at all."

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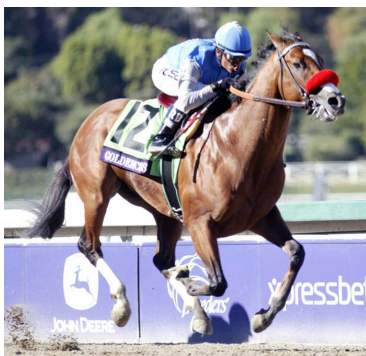


Handle, Attendance Rise On Day One...

Total handle for Friday's opening day of the Breeders' Cup meeting at Santa Anita realized total handle of \$51,521,146, an improvement of 8% from the 2012 figure of \$47,586,765. Of that number, \$35,549,196 was wagered on the five Breeders' Cup races. Total attendance Friday at Santa Anita was 35,833, which represented a 3.5% increase over the 34,619 on hand for last year's opening program. "We're off to a very solid start for what promises to be an excellent weekend of world class racing and we are encouraged by the response of the fans both here and around the country," said Breeders' Cup President and CEO Craig Favel.

Making Cents

Goldencents turned in a front-running tour de force over the speedy Santa Anita surface in yesterday's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile, Quarter Horsing his way to the lead early and forgetting to stop in the lane. Hustled from his outside draw by pilot Rafael Bejarano, the sophomore established a narrow advantage into the first turn as **Broadway Empire** (Empire Maker) kept up the pressure inside of him through splits of :22.12 and :44.75. The field was extremely spread out down the backside, but Goldencents still seemed to be going well turning for home as all but his nearest pursuer appeared to have too much left to do. Golden Ticket cut the corner nicely to briefly look as if he could challenge for the top slot, but the leader was always doing enough and crossed under the line by daylight. "I wasn't worried at all [about the fast fractions] because I know how good this horse has trained," said Bejarano. "He broke so good from the gate, but [Broadway Empire] wanted to go to the lead and put pressure on me. I made sure [my horse] got clear and then, at the three-eighths pole, I knew what he would do."

Goldencents aired by 7 1/4 lengths in his Del Mar unveiling 14 months ago, and shipped to New York to check in second behind eventual juvenile champion Shanghai Bobby (Harlan's Holiday) in Belmont's GI Champagne S. last October. His connections opted to bypass the 2012 Breeders' Cup, but were rewarded with a \$600,000 consolation prize for a victory in the \$1 million GIII Delta Downs Jackpot that November. He would add a track-and-trip tally in the GIII Sham S. in January, and faded to fourth after getting caught in a speed duel in March's GII San Felipe S. **Cont. p7**

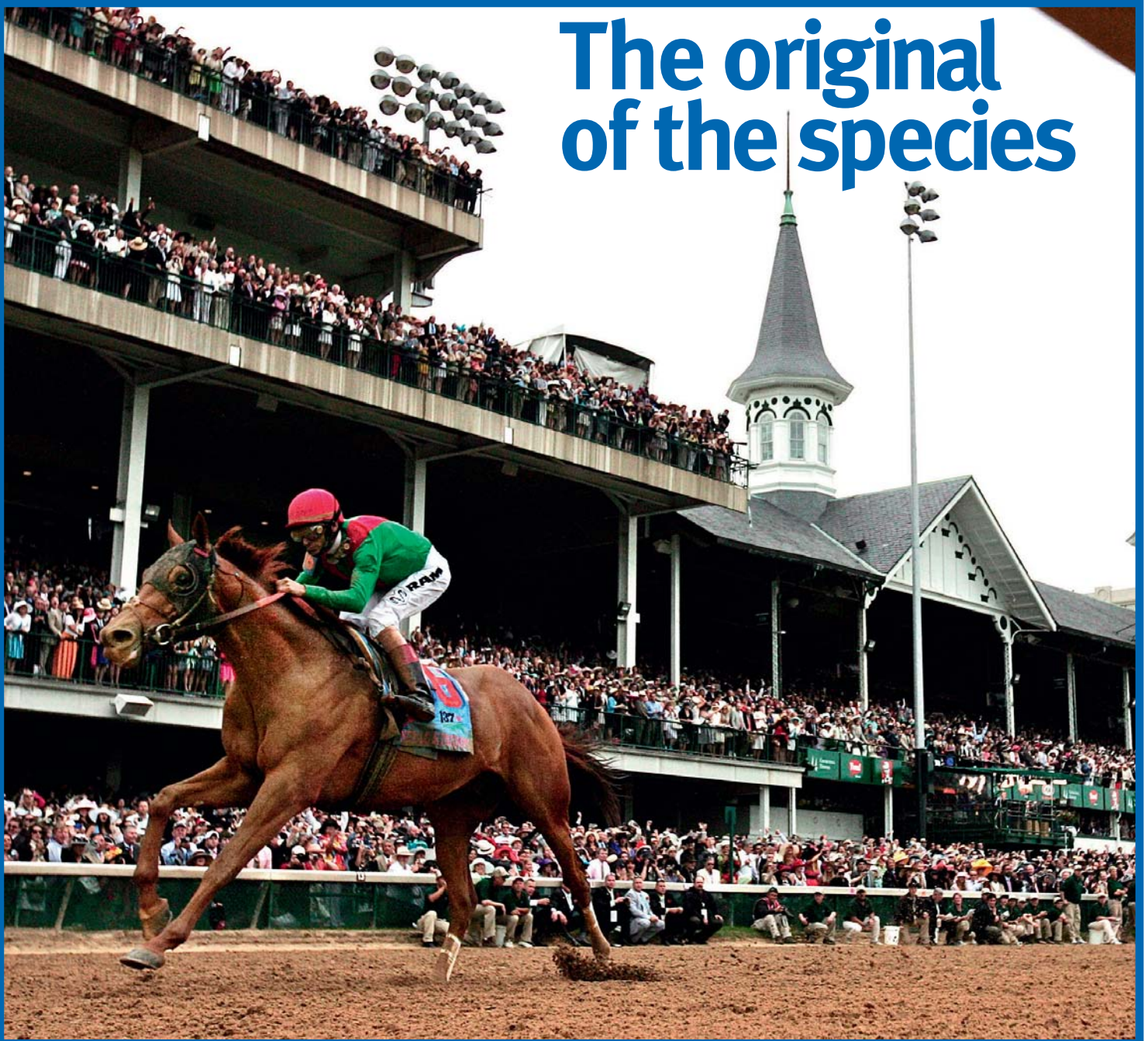
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Goldencents bounced back in a big way to take the GI Santa Anita Derby over an additional furlong Apr. 6, but failed to see out Classic distances in either the GI Kentucky Derby or GI Preakness S. Reinvented as a sprinter after a brief freshening, he checked in second in Del Mar's July 28 Bing Crosby S. and Aug. 25 GII Pat O'Brien S. He filled the same slot behind ill-fated Points Offthebench (Benchmark) in the GI Santa Anita Sprint Championship Oct. 5 last time, earning a career-best 109 Beyer Speed Figure.

"My only doubt was when they went a half in 44-and-change," offered winning trainer Doug O'Neill. "But [Bejarano] knew he was on the best horse and he rode him the easiest way to get in the winner's circle. What a horse. We were really confident, but you never know."

W C Racing is the nom de course of Glenn Sorgenstein and Josh Kaplan, who operate a precious metals and coin auction site called goldencents.com. Co-owner David Kenney is president and CEO of Westrux International, a Santa Fe Springs, California diesel truck dealer. Rick Pitino, longtime University of Louisville basketball coach, races as RAP Racing.

"It's a great group of guys," said O'Neill. "You really dream of these kind of horses and you want people like them who love the sport and love the animals as much as they do to be blessed enough to have one. Their main concern is always about Goldencents and doing the right thing. We've just been extremely blessed with him."

Centralintelligence Suffers Fracture in Dirt Mile

Centralintelligence (Smarty Jones), victor of the GI Triple Bend H. in June, was eased in yesterday's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile and vanned off of the track. X-rays showed that he suffered a condylar fracture to his right foreleg. "Centralintelligence was vanned off after the jockey got off after the race, and the problem is in the right front," said Dr. Wayne McIlwraith. "Radiographs show a fracture of the lateral condylar of the distal cannon bone in the fetlock joint."

Say What?

"[Jockey Joel Rosario] rode a good race and my horse ran a good race, but like Ricky Bobby said 'If you ain't first, you're last.' No I'm just kidding. My horse ran great and I'm really proud of him." --Ken McPeck, trainer of Golden Ticket

"We had a great trip and this horse was loaded all the way around. He ran a lot better for me today than he did in the [Sept. 28 GII] Kelso last time. Golden Ticket went by me at the half-mile pole and I just followed him. He ran hard all the way." --Alan Garcia, rider of Brujo de Ollerros

He got a horrible trip into the first turn and got banged around pretty good. He lost all chance. --Jockey John Velazquez, aboard Verrazano

It was just one of those things. This track is so speed favoring and everyone is just send, send, send. It changes everything. --Verrazano's trainer, Todd Pletcher

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Outstrip Flies Late to Take Juvenile Turf

Outstrip (GB) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) was outfooted into the first turn and dropped back through the field to race near the back of the pack as favored **Bobby's Kitten** (Kitten's Joy) zipped out to the early lead. The pacesetter pulled jockey Javier Castellano through fractions of :22.27, :45.70 and 1:09.53.

Giovanni Boldini (War Front) made a big move to engage Bobby's Kitten in upper stretch and it looked like the race would come down to those two, but Outstrip was unwinding a huge finish down the center of the course to just get up in the shadow of the wire.

"The trip was really good," said Mike Smith. "I managed to get covered up, just make my way, and follow the right horses. I was following two of the greatest turf riders here in America, Gary Stevens and Corey Nakatani. They showed me a great way to go, and it really worked out for me."

Outstrip, a debut winner at Newmarket in June, missed by just a neck when second in the July 31 G2 Vintage S. He overcame a green run to win the Sept. 14 G2 Champagne S. at Doncaster and was coming off a third-place effort behind the much-hyped War Command (War Front) in the Oct. 12 G1 Dewhurst S.

While Smith was extending his advantage as the winningest rider in Breeders' Cup history, the victory was the first Breeders' Cup win for trainer Charlie Appleby. Appleby, who has been with Godolphin for 15 years, served as assistant trainer to David Loder, Saeed bin Suroor and Mahmood Al Zarooni. **Cont. p9**

Chriselliam Completes European Sweep

Chriselliam (Ire) (Iffraaj {GB}) was unhurried in the early going and settled under cover in midpack, while **My Conquestadory** (Artie Schiller), the likely favorite before drawing post 14, was forced to rush out to clear the field. But it was longshot **Nesso** (Roman Ruler) who was quickest away and led the field into the first turn. Nesso raced along eagerly through fractions of :22.47 and :46.31. The pacesetter was tackled by My Conquestadory and **Kitten Kaboodle** (Kitten's Joy), who moved in tandem on the turn and the three rivals came into the stretch in a line. My Conquestadory briefly took the lead, but Chriselliam was surging and the Irish-bred powered to the front and was much the best. My Conquestadory tired to fourth as **Testa Rossi (Fr)** (Dr Fong) closed powerfully, but belatedly, after being angled out for running room in deep stretch.

Chriselliam, a maiden winner at Warwick July 11 in her second start, earned her way into the Breeders' Cup with a 28-1 upset win in the Sept. 27 G1 Shadwell Fillies Mile.

Chriselliam's victory was sweet Breeders' Cup redemption for former jockey Willie Carson, who was denied victory in the 1990 G1 Breeders' Cup Sprint when Dayjur famously jumped a shadows on the track before being edged by Safely Kept. The 71-year-old Carson, along with music mogul Chris Wright and Emily Asprey, purchased Chriselliam for 40,000gns at last year's Tattersalls October sale. "Bloody marvelous," Carson said. "What else can you say? Will we get a clean run? That was my only worry. But when I saw her enter into the straight, I knew the way she was going, she would make a hole. One wouldn't have to appear. We could have made one the way she was going."

Wright recalled the first time he and Carson had teamed up on a yearling. "I think a couple of years ago at Newmarket Yearling sales I was having a pretty nice lunch, and I think I drank a little bit too much wine, and I ended up buying a filly," he explained. "And I persuaded Willie, who had been drinking a little bit with me that he should take half of it, and we took her home and we called her after our two wives, Janice and Elaine. She was very talented, but she won a race and we sold her to come to the States."

"Charlie bought this filly by himself," Wright continued. "We didn't particularly go and buy the filly, but he bought her. When he bought her, we said to Charlie, if it's all right with you, we'll take her, and we took her."

Chriselliam is out of the Ballylinch-bred and raced Danielli (Ire) (Danehill). Just a few weeks after the juvenile's win in the G1 Shadwell Fillies Mile, her yearling half-sister by Lope de Vega (Ire) brought a final bid of 280,000gns from John Ferguson at this year's Tattersalls October sale. The mare also has a weanling colt by Lope de Vega, the 2010 G1 French Derby and G1 French 2000 Guineas winner, who stands at Ballylinch in Kilkenny.

London Bridge Takes Down Marathon

European invader London Bridge--acquired privately by Paul Fudge's Waratah Thoroughbreds following a fourth-place finish in Deauville's 1 7/8-mile Prix Michel Houyvet Aug. 15--handled the switch to dirt with a hard-fought one-length victory in the GII Breeders' Cup Marathon. The New York-bred, adding first-time Lasix here, was settled off the pace in seventh through a grueling half mile in :46.71. With Mike Smith aboard, London Bridge was under the whip entering the far turn, and continued to grind it out on the outside after several left-handers to reel in Blueskiesnrainbows in the dying strides. "This is absolutely fantastic," Mikael Magnusson, co-owner and assistant to trainer Jo Hughes, said. "It's been our plan all along. We sold the horse prior to this race and he will now go and race in Australia." He continued, "We had targeted this horse for this race for a long time because he needs very fast ground; and in England, the ground was gone, so we had nowhere to go with it."

Slightly favored South American invader Ever Rider (Arg) (Rider Stripes {Arg}) was done early and pulled up by Gary Stevens. "He was done after six furlongs," Stevens said. "I took care of him after that. He should be fine."

He graduated next time out routing there June 16 and closed gamely to finish just a neck short in an optional claimer trying the Del Mar turf July 19. The gray closed from off the pace to win next out under those conditions Aug. 31.

Rookie Sensation was away well here and rated along the rail in midpack behind the leading group. The Stronach homebred remained unhurried through the final turn and began to rally along the inside at the top of the lane. With Dry Summer (Any Given Saturday) leading the way along the rail, he tipped out to the two path to squeeze by him and the rallying Gervinho in the final furlong to win going away. "We liked this horse quite a bit and wanted to bring him along slowly, so we tried to space his races appropriately," said winning trainer John Shirreffs. "I just wanted to let my horse do his thing in the beginning, and from the last three-eighths of a mile, I tried to make my way in between horses," explained winning rider Victor Espinoza. "Sometimes there are different strategies in a race, but I did not have any other options because of the way the race set up. I sneaked in on the inside and everything worked out very nice today. Once I got my position I knew I would definitely win the race. He's been a nice horse in his last few races. He always runs unbelievable races, but now he's even more ready than before. Each race he is getting better and better."

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Classic Rematch at Santa Anita (cont. from p1)

Mucho Macho Man (Macho Uno), a gallant second in last year's Classic, is also sitting on go. "He's ready to run," trainer Kathy Ritvo said. The strapping bay is coming off a strong performance over the Santa Anita track in the Sept. 28 GI Awesome Again S.

"It's going to be a good race," Ritvo said of the Classic. "I was sorry to see Ron the Greek scratch. I like all these horses. We've been running against these horses for a long time. They're all such nice horses."

Trainer Bill Mott lost one Classic contender when forced to scratch Ron the Greek (Full Mandate) due to a quarter crack, but the Hall of Famer still has an excellent shot in the race with two-time GI Jockey Club Gold Cup winner **Flat Out** (Flatter). The 7-year-old veteran was third a year ago and looks to rebound from a troubled third-place effort last time out in the Sept. 28 Gold Cup.

"We've put him behind horses in the morning, and he doesn't seem to mind it," Pletcher said. "We'll just have to see how the racetrack is playing. [Thursday] the track seemed to be playing to speed. I think he's going to be a horse that's forwardly placed no matter what. I think he'll have the ability to sit off it a bit."

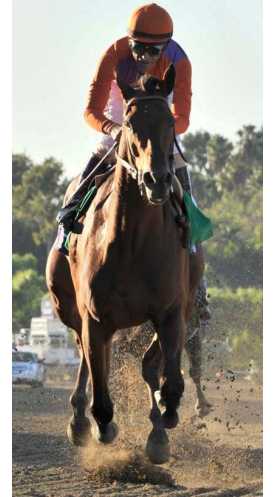

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SOPHOMORES LOOK TO DOUBLE UP

Magdalena Racing's **Pure Fun** (Pure Prize) seeks her second-consecutive graded stakes tally as she takes on her elders in this evening's GII Chilukki S. at Churchill Downs. A winner of last December's GI Hollywood Starlet, the Ken McPeck trainee went winless in her first three tries as a sophomore, culminating in a sixth-place finish in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 3. The chestnut returned better than ever off a five-month break to annex the sloppy GII Indiana Oaks with a career-top 94 Beyer Speed Figure Oct. 5, the highest last-out number in the field. "That was a great win for her," McPeck said of the Indiana Oaks. "She had problems in the spring--from a fever to an ankle--and we were behind the eight ball trying to get her ready. She proved she's a top filly." She'll have to overcome the far-outside draw, but McPeck isn't particularly concerned. "It's unfortunate to draw the 12-hole, but we have a long run to the turn in the one-turn mile so she should be okay," he said. "She's hitting on all cylinders." Fellow 3-year-old **Sky Girl** (Sky Mesa) also looks to complete a graded stakes double. The Bill Mott-trained Alpha Delta Stables colorbearer took the seven-panel GIII Dogwood S. here Sept. 21, but she has carried her speed farther before. Previously conditioned by Paul McGee, the dark bay has a one-mile optional claiming win over this strip in June and checked in third in the nine-panel GIII Arlington Oaks July 20. TK Stables's **Devious Intent** (Dixie Union) could be a live longshot. She upset Ellis's one-mile GIII Gardenia H. at 15-1 over next-out winners **Magic Hour** (Awesome Again) and Groupie Doll (Bowman's Band) two back Aug. 10, but hasn't been seen since an off-the-board finish in the Open Mind S. Sept. 14.

WinStar Farm stallion **Harlan's Holiday** (Harlan--Christmas In Aiken, by Affirmed), the reigning champion juvenile sire in North America, was

euthanized late Friday at Haras Firmamento in Argentina, where he was standing the Southern Hemisphere breeding season. He was 14.

According to a release from the farm, Harlan's Holiday had an uneventful cover Friday afternoon, but collapsed while returning to his stall and lost all use

of his hind end. He prolapsed intestine from his rectum and was in shock when veterinarians reached him, but subsequent attempts to repair the problem were unsuccessful.

"This is a horrible tragedy," said Chris Baker, WinStar General Manager. "There is some comfort in knowing that I was at Firmamento just two weeks ago and found Harlan's Holiday to be the picture of health receiving the highest standard of care. In the end, we are greatly saddened by this loss, not only for the shareholders but also for the breed." **Cont. p22**

Bred in Ohio by Double D Farm and campaigned by Starlight Stables, Harlan's Holiday won the GI Florida Derby and GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at three and added the GI Donn H. the following season. He was also runner-up in the 2003 G1 Dubai World Cup and retired with nine wins from 22 starts and earnings of \$3,632,664. He entered stud in 2004 at Airdrie Stud, and among his best first-crop performers was Into Mischief, who won the GI CashCall Futurity and is the sire of yesterday's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile hero Goldencents. In late 2010, Harlan's Holiday was moved to WinStar Farm, and the stallion was represented in 2012 by Shanghai Bobby, who completed an undefeated season in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and helped his sire post record juvenile progeny earnings of \$2,954,556. He remains at the head of this year's juvenile sire's table, with four juvenile stakes winners and eight juvenile stakes horses. He is number six on the current general sire list. Other stakes winners sired by Harlan's Holiday include Grade/Group 1 winners Majesticperfection and Mendip, GSW and multiple Classic-placed Denis of Cork, MGSW Tasha's Miracle and current MGSW General Election.

"It was an honor and a privilege to own Harlan's Holiday throughout his racing career," said Starlight Racing's Jack Wolf, who campaigned Harlan's Holiday and many of his top progeny on the racetrack, including Shanghai Bobby. "He gave my family and our partners many thrills, and helped deepen our appreciation of the equine industry. It is a sad day for all involved."

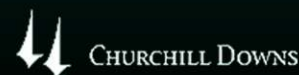

Beaten only by Karakontie (Jpn) (Bernstein) on his debut seven furlongs at Compiègne July 1, the form of that contest has taken on new dimensions subsequently, as the winner has gone on to glory in the G3 Prix la Rochette and G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, and is Ectot's chief adversary for leading domestic honors as the handicappers mull their respective merits. After breaking his maiden at Clairefontaine July 29, the bay annexed the Listed Criterium du FEE over this trip at Deauville Aug. 20 before slamming the eventual G3 Prix de Conde scorer Elliptique (Ire) (New Approach {Ire}) in the Prix des Chenes. Keen exiting the gates, he was sent to the head of affairs by Gregory Benoist in an effort to settle him into a rhythm, and was first to cross over to the hedge in early stretch. Tackled by the previously unbeaten Earnshaw for much of the final quarter mile, he required just a flick with the whip to comfortably hold that labored rival and the wide challenger Prestige Vendome to maintain his sequence. "It was not the plan to make the running, but he was very keen out of the gate and the jockey did well to let him go," trainer Elie Lellouche said. "He was idling a bit in front and was also courageous at the end, where his class prevailed. He is definitely better on good ground and will be put away now so we can dream of the Classics."

Amaron was one of Germany's leading juveniles in 2011, winning the G3 Zukunfts-Rennen at Baden-Baden and finishing third in the G3 Preis des Winterfavoriten at Cologne. Starting off his sophomore campaign in encouraging fashion when successful in the G3 Dr Busch-Memorial over 1 1/16 miles at Krefeld in April, the chestnut was beaten two short-necks and a nose when fourth in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at Longchamp the following month. Two subsequent off-the-board efforts preceded a first win at the top level in the San Siro's G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua in September, but this term had yielded just one place from four starts, and that came at this venue when third in the Apr. 9 G3 Prix Edmond Blanc. Putting a disappointing unplaced run in Longchamp's G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein Oct. 5 behind him here, he stalked his compatriot Sommerabend and, after subduing that rival approaching the final furlong, asserted to lead home a German one-two. "He is always reluctant to load, but in the race he gives his best," jockey Fabien Lefebvre explained. "They went a decent pace and we kicked on very early in the straight, but he was very gutsy and the ground was greatly in his favor."

METANOVIC TEAMS UP FOR SUCCESS

Nearly every successful bloodstock agent has one breakout horse in his or her career, of which can be said, "That was the one that really put me on the map."

For the up-and-coming California-based Mersad Metanovic, the horse could be--or maybe already is--**She's a Tiger** (Tale of the Cat--Shandra Smiles, by Cahill Road). The 2-year-old California standout will be among the favorites in today's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and is entered in Monday's Fasig-Tipton November Sale. Hill 'n' Dale Sales consigns her as [hip 145](#).

She's a Tiger, trained by Metanovic's friend and business partner Jeff Bonde, comes into the Juvenile Fillies with three wins and two close-up seconds in five starts. Her victories include the seven-furlong GI Del Mar Debutante S. Aug. 21.

She just failed to last in the GI Chandelier S. at Santa Anita Sept. 28, going down to Secret Compass (Discreet Cat) by a head after setting fast fractions.

She's a Tiger is one of two Breeders' Cup horses Metanovic had a hand in buying. Along with Bonde, he purchased the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hopeful Majestic Stride (Trippi) for \$50,000 at OBS August.

Metanovic selected She's a Tiger out of last year's Keeneland September Sale and purchased her for \$150,000. He put together the partnership that now owns her, which includes Mark DeDomenico, Allen Aldrich, Lisa Hernandez and Stuart Downey.

She's a Tiger is Metanovic's first Grade I winner as a bloodstock agent buying solely by himself, which is fitting, as it was the filly's three-parts brother, Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger), who got Metanovic's foot in the door in the business.

Metanovic got involved with Smiling Tiger's ownership--Phil Lebherz and Alan Klein--as well as Bonde, just as Smiling Tiger was beginning his career. The chestnut would go on to win three Grade I races in 2010-11 and earned over \$1.4 million.

"Jeff took a liking to me, and I started going to all the sales around the country with him, which was a good education," said Metanovic. "That's the 'Harvard business school of horse racing degree,' really. He taught me how to look at a horse's conformation, and the ins and outs of what I should be looking for. He talked about not wasting people's money. I wouldn't buy something that's just average, because I wouldn't do it with my own money. For every purchase, there's a reason we've made that purchase."

The reasons behind She's a Tiger's purchase are obvious, said Metanovic. "Being a 3/4-sister to Smiling Tiger, that was good enough for me to go look at her," he said. "And pretty much immediately I decided that she was the best horse that I would ever buy--that's how I felt about it. She had size, she had a great back end--very strong--and she had an amazing stride. When we look for horses, we're looking for a 'perfect 10' walk, and she had it. She also had a great demeanor. Her brother was a fireball--he'd rip your head off. She just was very special."

In fact, Metanovic didn't think the filly would be in his price range. "I was very surprised I got her, truthfully," he said. "I was prepared to go to \$250,000 for her, and I was able to get her for only \$150,000."

Metanovic's background doesn't read like the typical bloodstock agent. Born and raised in Campbell, California, he frequented the now-defunct Bay Meadows with his father, which instilled a love of racing in him.

But he didn't spend his youth mucking out stalls or showing horses at sales, like many others in the business. Instead, Metanovic had embarked down a career in marketing and sales, primarily with hardware and software companies. And while the money was good, "I just didn't have a passion for it," he said. So Metanovic began making connections at the track, including Bonde and Lebherz.

Success came quickly. Bonde and Metanovic teamed to purchase the likes of MGSP **Sway Away** (Afleet Alex), a \$75,000 juvenile-in-training buy; and this year's wickedly fast 3-year-old **Distinctiv Passion** (With Distinction), a \$65,000 OBSAUG yearling buy who, after winning a pair of Southern California stakes, ran a strong third in the GI Santa Anita Sprint Championship last out.

"I think, if that horse stays healthy as a 4-year-old, he'll be a Breeders' Cup champion," asserted Metanovic. "He will be something special."

Other purchases include SW & GSP **Amarish** (Scat Daddy); MSW & GSP **Unusual Way** (Unusual Heat); SW **Nachez Dawn** (Indian Charlie); and **Mega Dream** (Medaglia d'Oro), a \$40,000 KEEJAN acquisition who beat Mizdirection (Mizzen Mast) in the Great Lady M S. last year and ran second by a head in the GII Royal Heroine Mile.

Metanovic has also purchased several good horses for owner Jerry Durant, including this year's GIII Iowa Derby runner-up **Betweenhereandcool** (Unbridled's Song). **Cont. p27**

But Metanovic's biggest success, other than She's a Tiger, came with another horse selling at Fasig-Tipton, the Grade I-winning filly **Cambina (Ire)** (Hawk Wing--Await {Ire}, by Peintre Celebre), who will be consigned by Three Chimneys Sales as [hip 13](#). The 5-year-old, who dead-heated for the win with Nereid (Rock Hard Ten) in the 2011 GI American Oaks, sells in foal to Exchange Rate.

Metanovic, in partnership with Archie St. George, purchased Cambina privately in Ireland. Transferred to Bonde's barn, she became a star, with her other wins including a tally in the GII Providencia S.

"She's a very small-made filly--she was the smallest horse in the barn by a mile--but what she is is all heart and guts," said Metanovic. "When you look at the American Oaks, she dead-heats with a filly who was about twice her size after getting shut down in the stretch. It was amazing."

Metanovic uses "we" a lot when he talks, and is well aware that his success has been a team effort. He credits Bonde often, and says that Leberherz has been a big influence. When talking about She's a Tiger, he commented, "All the credit goes to Jeff and his staff. Some of those guys have been with him for 20, 25 years."

Jeff's assistant trainer, Miguel Carranza, has done a phenomenal job keeping her on her game, as have the grooms."

The next step for the team is the stallion business. Leberherz recently bought land in California and has launched Premier Equine, which will stand Smiling Tiger, Hold Sway and two other former Leberherz runners. Mersad, who serves as Leberherz's racing manager, will handle Smiling Tiger's book.

"The response has been great for Smiling Tiger and the other stallions," said Metanovic.

"It's been a lot of work and it's still going on, but we're very excited."

Metanovic reiterates that it's all been a team effort. "At the end of the day, I owe my education and success in this business to Jeff and Phil Leberherz," he said. "Jeff has such a great eye, and Phil's been incredibly supportive. We're not spending a crazy amount of money on these horses, and we're doing okay."

Later today, they might be doing very okay.
