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TWILIGHT ECLIPSE SEEKS MCKNIGHT REPEAT

West Point Thoroughbreds's **Twilight Eclipse** (Purim) gets some class relief today as he looks to defend his title in Calder's GII W. L. McKnight H. The bay upset this event as a lightly raced sophomore last November at 11-1, and resurfaces here off of five straight tries in Grade I company. The Tom Albertrani pupil broke the world record for 12 furlongs on turf when he annexed the GII Mac Diarmida S. at Gulfstream last March in 2:22.63, but settled for fifth over yielding sod in Belmont's GI Manhattan

H. in June. Twilight Eclipse bounced back from that effort with a runner-up finish in the GI Man o' War S. a month later, and filled the same slot in Saratoga's GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. Aug. 17. Fifth in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic back in Elmont Sept. 28, he did not disgrace himself when sixth--beaten just 2 1/4 lengths--in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 2. The 3-1 morning line second choice will be piloted by Jose Lezcano for the first time today, and will be re-opposed by **Mucho Mas Macho** (Macho Uno) and **Vertiformer** (Dynaformer), second and third here a year ago.

Favored on the morning line at 5-2 is Juddmonte Farms colorbearer **Slumber** (GB) (Cacique {Ire}). Thrice Group 3-placed in his native Britain for Charles Hills, the bay was a close fourth in the 2011 GI Hollywood Derby. He joined Bill Mott's barn for a 4-year-old campaign, but only made one start last year, taking a Saratoga optional claimer. He resurfaced just over a year later to win at the Spa again, and finished a close fourth as a popular pick in the Joe Hirsch. Slumber was last seen finishing sixth as the favorite in Woodbine's GI Pattison Canadian International Oct. 27, but has been working quickly on the Payson Park dirt in the interim.

JACOBSON BREAKS NEW YORK WIN RECORD

Trainer David Jacobson broke the single-season record for wins by a trainer on the New York Racing Association circuit yesterday when Tiz Gianni (Giacomo), owned by Drawing Away Stable and Jacobson, provided the 59-year-old with his 160th NYRA win of 2013 in Aqueduct's seventh race. The New York native, who tied for last year's NYRA training title with 110 wins, eclipsed Gary Contessa's mark set in 2007. "It's something very special," said Jacobson. "I thought after we had a really good meet at Saratoga, I might have a shot. It worked out. It was great to have [rider] David [Cohen] and Drawing Away Stable involved in this special moment." **Cont. p3**

Drawing Away, whose managing partner is Ed Boden, currently leads the NYRA owner standings with 88 wins. Jacobson, whose late father Buddy Jacobson earned five NYRA titles as a conditioner, returned to training after a 25-year hiatus in 2007. He won his first meet title at the 2011 Aqueduct spring meet, and enjoyed his first Grade I victory on the flat earlier this year in the Forego S. with Strapping Groom (Johannesburg), also owned by Drawing Away and Jacobson. "Setting records wasn't a goal when I came back to training; like any other professional sport, I was just trying to win a race at a time," he said. "Hopefully, we'll keep this going for a long time and break the record next year."

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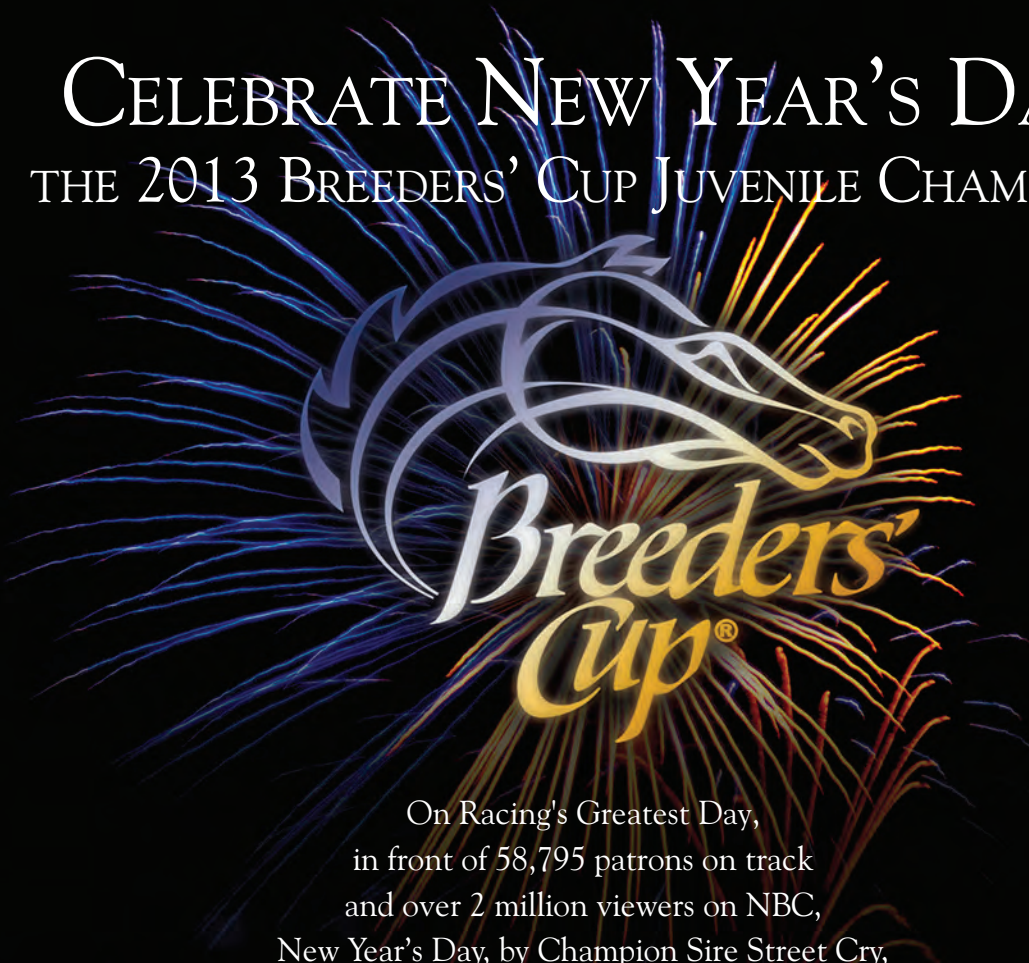

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RACETRACK ROUND-UP

Fiftyshadesofgold Back in Action...

Promising juvenile filly **Fiftyshadesofgold** (My Golden Song) returned to the work tab at Fair Grounds Friday with a three-panel move in :37.80. This was her second breeze since injuring herself in Saratoga's Aug. 11 GII Adirondack S., where she finished fourth as a heavy favorite before being promoted to third after a nightmare trip. Trainer Bret Calhoun blamed interference in the race for the injury.

"They put her through the fence that day and she came out with a fractured cannon bone that required a screw that we put in for 60 days and then took it out," Calhoun said. "She also had a small chip in her knee."

Prior to the injury the gray filly broke her maiden impressively at Lone Star May. 24 by 10 lengths. She then shipped to Churchill Jun. 22 to take the Debutante S. with ease as an eight length winner.

Calhoun is thrilled to have her back in action, but he's not looking too far into the future.

"She's had two really easy 3/8 works," he said. "We are just happy to have her back on the work tab and

hopefully she'll work every seven days from here on and we will get her back sometime in the spring. There is really no use having a schedule this far away. The weather could set us back, she could get sick. You never really know."

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Baffert Reflects After Up and Down Day...

Conditioner Bob Baffert was feeling philosophical yesterday after experiencing both the highs and lows of racing the day before. While the Hall of Famer started his day by losing GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner **New Year's Day** (Street Cry {Ire}) to a career-ending injury, he ended it with three victories on Santa Anita's opening day card, including the GI Malibu S. with **Shakin It Up** (Midnight Lute). "Every day is like a roller coaster," the 60-year-old said from Clocker's Corner. "Every once in a while I might have like two days in a row that are good. But this is part of the sport. Every morning, it's something, minor, major, whatever. I've been around horses for 40 years, so you have to deal with it. Sometimes, if you let it eat you up, it will destroy you. You'll have a heart attack." Baffert had a heart attack in Dubai last year while preparing to run Game On Dude (Awesome Again) in the GI Dubai World Cup.

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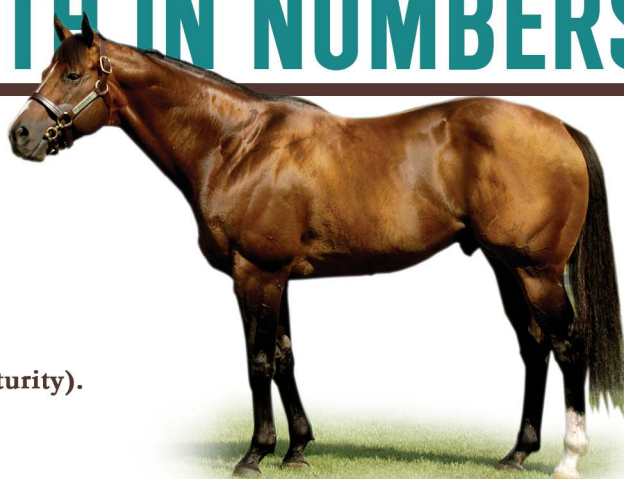

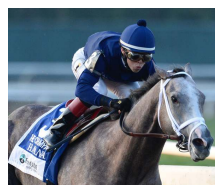
