

PURSE HIKE FOR BELMONT STAKES

The purse for the 146th running of the GI Belmont S. will be \$1.5 million, the New York Racing Association has announced. The Belmont had previously offered a purse of \$1 million since 1998.

The other two races that comprise the Triple Crown, the GI Kentucky Derby and the GI Preakness S., currently offer purses of \$2 million and \$1.5 million, respectively. Earlier this month, the Maryland Jockey Club announced that the Preakness purse would be raised \$500,000 from the \$1 million that had been offered since 1998.

"The Belmont S. is the main attraction of the biggest day of the year at Belmont Park, and we feel this increase suitably reflects the race's status as one of the sport's prestigious Triple Crown events," said Martin Panza, Senior Vice President of Racing Operations for NYRA. "I am grateful to Steven Duncker, Bobby Flay, Barry Ostrager, Leonard Riggio and Rick Violette of the NYRA Racing Committee for their help and cooperation in making this increase possible."

The purse for the 2014 Belmont will be divided amongst the first eight finishers with \$800,000 to the winner, \$280,000 to second, \$150,000 to third, \$100,000 to fourth, \$60,000 to fifth, \$45,000 to sixth, \$35,000 to seventh, and \$30,000 to eighth. In recent years, the Belmont S. purse had been shared amongst the first five finishers on a 60-20-11-6-3 percent basis.

"Belmont S. runners represent the very best of their respective foal crops," said NYRA Stakes Coordinator Andrew Byrnes. "This purse increase helps ensure the fullest, most competitive field possible, and even an owner whose horse finishes eighth can earn good purse money for his or her commitment."

ON CUE IN THE MR. PROSPECTOR

Herman Van Den Broeck's **Singanothersong** (Songandaprayer), second at 50-1 in the GIII Swale S. in March, broke through with a career high in Saturday's GIII Mr. Prospector S. at Gulfstream Park. Placed just off the flank of favored leader **Star Harbour** (Indian Charlie) through hot fractions of :22.36 and :44.75, the 4-1 chance hit the front in the stretch and kicked clear to take it by 1 3/4 lengths. **Fort Loudon** (Awesome of Course) rallied for second. Star Harbour was third. "We thought [Star Harbour] would be on the lead and we thought we'd just lay off him," trainer Ron Pellegrini said. "We thought he could take the lead anytime he wanted, and we were pretty confident he would win. It was harder for other people to realize it than us. This is a pretty nice horse." The gray had surgery to remove a knee chip following a third in Calder's Big Drama S. Apr. 27, then returned from the shelf to finish second in a \$32,000 optional tagger in Hallandale Oct. 20. He entered the Mr. Prospector after posting a sharp win at that level Nov. 17. "When he came back this year after the operation, now he's run three bang-up races in a row," Pellegrini continued. "We felt that this would be a good spot for him to run. He's right here in Florida, and now we'll just weigh our options and see where we want to go from here." Pellegrini concluded, "Our ultimate goal is to get him to the Breeders' Cup Sprint. We're going to pick spots and not over race him and do whatever we can to get him there."

Defending McKnight champ Twilight Eclipse didn't mind this one coming off the grass one bit and put on an impressive display. The West Point colorbearer had only one prior attempt on the main track--a close third in Belmont's Temperance Hill S. last October--but had been knocking heads versus top company since his world-record setting performance in Gulfstream's GI Pan American S. Mar. 23. He lined up in five consecutive Grade Is, including a pair of solid second-place finishes in Belmont's GI Man O' War S. July 13 and Saratoga's GI Sword Dancer Invitational Aug. 17. A lackluster fifth in Belmont's GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational Sept. 28, he entered off a respectable sixth at 34-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita Nov. 2. Jockey Jose Lezcano shrewdly switched up tactics this time, placing Twilight Eclipse on the lead through easy early fractions of :26.46 and :53.66, and he had plenty left in the tank, re-breaking in the stretch to win going away. "Things worked out today," West Point's Tom Bellhouse said. "He trains like a monster on the dirt, but you don't know until you actually run in the race. He ran up at Belmont once on the dirt and it was a little green, but today to see this type of performance, it gets us excited for the future. Then to run like this and win back-to-back McKnights is just a thrill for the partners."

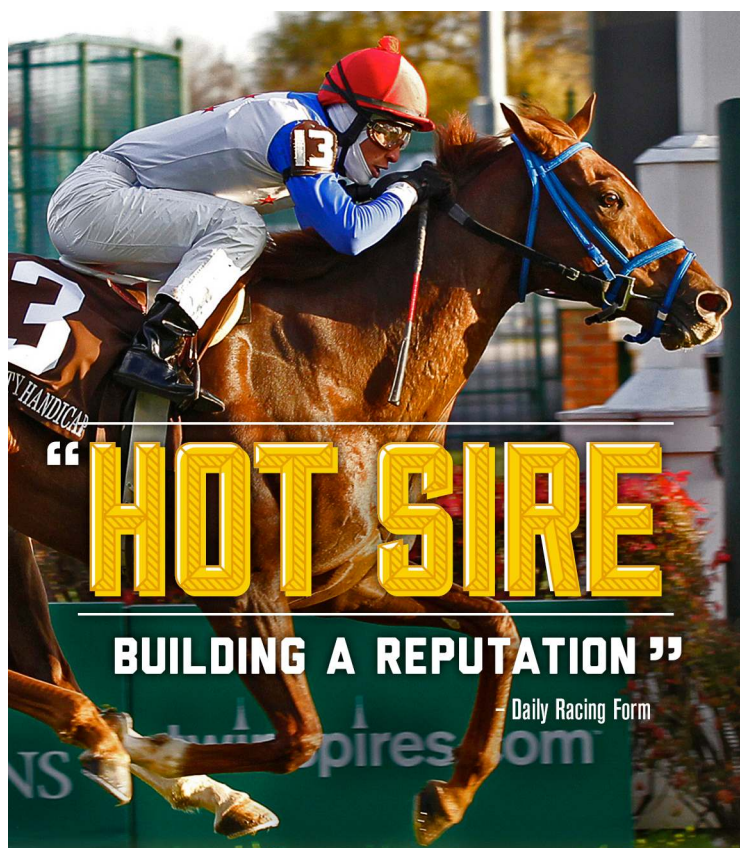

course Sept. 27, he reported home a close fourth in the BC Turf Sprint Nov. 2. He most recently dead-heated for third in the Hollywood Turf Express H. Dec. 8. Placed within striking distance in fifth through fractions of :21.80 and :43.36, the bay came through

along the inside in the stretch and charged late to post a narrow victory as the chalk. "We'll have him here for the winter and hopefully we'll have a series of races to run him in," assistant trainer Scott Blasi said. "He likes the course here, so this is the right place to have him. He's actually run well on the dirt here, too, if you look at his form, so we'll just see what's next." Jockey Corey Nakatani added, "Today, we got the trip we wanted to get and it all worked out. As honest as he is and as hard-trying a colt as he is, I just have to thank the connections for keeping me on him. He's a gem to ride and he's only getting better with age. He's back, he's at his home track now and it was a great win."

"He broke sharp and, coming off the 5 1/2- and six-furlong races, we thought he'd be very forward in the race. Once I got the first quarter slow, I wanted to see if I could slow it down for the half. 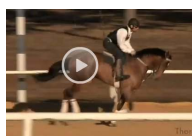
