



'STELLAR' PERFORMANCE IN SANTA YSABEL

Purchased privately by Hronis Racing LLC and transferred to trainer John Sadler after airing in a maiden special weight at Laurel Park Dec. 18, **Stellar**

Wind (Curlin) posted an eye-catching 2 3/4-length victory over **Light the City** (Street Sense) while making her two-turn debut in Saturday's GIII Santa Ysabel S. at Santa Anita. "Her maiden win was very impressive," owner Kosta Hronis said. "We went and took a look at her and we were impressed with what we saw. She's looked so good here in the mornings. She's so fluid, she just floats over the track. She ran great and I thought her gallop out was very

strong." Asked if the GI Santa Anita Oaks Apr. 4 would be next, Sadler added, "That would be a logical spot at this point. I think she's going to be better at a mile and an eighth, a mile and a quarter." **Cont. p3**

HERE COMES THE RAIN

Torrential and persistent rains in the Greater Miami/Fort Lauderdale region forced the cancellation of the majority of Gulfstream Park's card Saturday, including the GII Fasig-Tipton Swale S. and GIII Palm Beach S. Both races will be brought back for next Saturday's card. The GIII Herecomesthebride S., meanwhile, was transferred to the very sloppy main track and automatically downgraded to listed status. Stronach Stables' **Devine Aida** (Unbridled's Song) didn't seem to mind one bit. Possessed of solid dirt form, the gray filly was second on her 5 1/2-furlong debut over this track Sept. 27 and went one better next time out, scoring by five solid lengths across town at Gulfstream West Oct. 25. Switched to the grass for her first try against winners eight miles west Nov. 15, she struck from close range to win by a nose and remained perfect on the turf with a 3 1/2-length success in this track's Ginger Brew S. Jan. 3. Sent away as the narrow second favorite behind **Temper Mint Patty** (Congrats) in the Herecomesthebride, Devine Aida raced in third early on, but was asked for an early run by Jesus Rios to take command five furlongs from home. **Sweet Swingin** (Street Sense), trying two turns for the first time in her career, took a bit of a run at her turning for home, but, despite a circuitous route in the lane, Devine Aida held sway for an easy 6 3/4-length victory. **Cont. p4**

'PRIDE' STEALS BLUE DIAMOND

Trainer Peter Snowden and jockey Damian Browne posted back-to-back successes in the A\$1-million

G1 Blue Diamond S. as **Pride Of Dubai (Aus)** (Street Cry {Ire}) overcame serious interference in the straight to win by a head from Shadwell's 100-1 shot **Reemah (Aus)** (Redoute's Choice {Aus}). The imposing colt missed the break and was pushed along to keep up with the early pace yet managed to secure a mid-field position on the rail, stalking the short-priced favorite, Robert Smerdon's unbeaten filly **Fontiton (Aus)** (Turffontein {Aus}). **Prompt Return (Aus)** (Beneteau {Aus}) ensured that there was plenty of speed early on and the leaders began to weaken turning for home. When Fontiton pulled off the front-runners' heels to deliver her challenge, she and Pride Of Dubai bumped on numerous occasions as Mark Zahra tried to hold his main rival in a pocket. However, the strongly built colt fought his way through the narrow gap, picked himself up and rallied home to score impressively, resisting the storming late challenge of the David Hayes and Tom Dabernig trained Reemah. "It was a bit hairy trying to get the gap," winning hoop Browne commented. "On straightening, Mark [Zahra] tried to shut the gate on me, but lucky I'm on a big, strong, good horse." Zahra subsequently earned a 10-meeting suspension from the stewards for careless riding. **Cont. p5**

Stellar Wind made two previous starts at Laurel Park for prior owner Barbara Houck and trainer Donald Barr. Steadied at the start in her Nov. 20 unveiling going six furlongs, the chestnut rushed up early into a hot pace and ran on well late to finish a close third behind subsequent Maryland Juvenile Filly Championship S. heroine Spotted Heart (Lion Hearted). She successfully stretched to a one-turn mile with an 8 3/4-length graduation Dec. 18. Stellar Wind posted five

works at Santa Anita since switching hands, including three straight six-furlong breezes in February. Removing the hood here, Stellar Wind was one of the last into stride and raced worse than midfield and four or five off the inside as 'TDN Rising Star' Enchanting Lady (Tale of the Cat) set the pace from--somewhat surprisingly--Light the City. Glory and Stellar Wind came with runs out wide on the second turn and made a line of four leaving the final corner. Enchanting Lady was first to call it a day and Glory dropped away soon after, but, despite her relative lack of experience, Stellar Wind drew off smartly and galloped out a mile ahead of her competition. Stellar Wind covered 27 more feet than Light the City, according to Trakus. Stellar Wind is the two-time winning mare Evening Star's first foal. She also produced a filly by Exchange Rate in 2013 and a colt by Birdstone in 2014.

Pride Of Dubai became the first maiden in two decades to win Victoria's richest 2-year-old event. Not only that, but the first three home were among four maiden horses going into the race, as Coolmore's A\$1-million yearling purchase **Lake Geneva (Aus)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), an eye-catching second in the G3 Widden S. on debut Jan. 31, finished strongly in third. The impressive second-placed Reemah had two previous runs under her belt, including a second in a 1000-meter plate at Moonee Valley last time out. Market favorite Fontiton traveled well but failed to deliver her customary change of gear and will now be rested until the spring. "She did have a hell of a hard run here in the [G2 Blue Diamond] Prelude and she seemed to be back on deck, but that was probably her grand finale and she might have been over the top today," her trainer Robert Smerdon said.

Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa's homebred Pride Of Dubai was third behind Godolphin's Ottoman (Aus) (Exceed And Excel {Aus}) on his Rosehill debut Dec. 20 before running a fast-finishing second to **Of The Brave (Aus)** (Starspangledbanner {Aus}) in the G3 Blue Diamond Prelude. That Mark Riley-trained colt raced prominently Saturday, but showed signs of tiredness entering the stretch and only beat two home.

Pride Of Dubai provided Peter Snowden with his third Blue Diamond winner in five years, the first for the partnership he has been operating with son Paul since last May. Snowden Sr. was previously head trainer for another Sheikh Mohammed--bin Rashid Al Maktoum--under the Darley banner, with his son acting as Melbourne foreman. The team scored in last year's Blue Diamond courtesy of Earthquake (Aus) (Exceed And Excel {Aus})--who could only manage 10th in the G1 Oakleigh Plate Saturday--and in 2011 with Sepoy (Aus) (Elusive Quality).

"It's always great to win these races, especially for Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa," said Paul Snowden. "This is the first group of horses he's given us, so it's a big result. We picked this bloke out as a yearling. Out of a group of about 10 or 12 yearlings, he was the number one pick out of that bunch, so it was good of him to give him to us."

Reflecting on the race, the co-trainer commented, "If he didn't win today, he would have been a certainty beaten. To his credit he's picked himself up off the canvas and has proven himself a worthy winner." Snowden Jr. kept all options open regarding the colt's future, identifying the G1 Sires' Produce S. over 1400 meters and G1 Champagne S. over a mile as ideal targets, although not ruling out a tilt at the 1200-meter G1 Golden Slipper.

Pride Of Dubai is the fifth foal out of Al Anood (Aus) (Danehill), a A\$500,000 yearling purchase for Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa. She is a half-sister to G1 Prix de Diane heroine Rafha (GB) (Kris {GB}), who went on to produce seven black-type performers including the leading sires Invincible Spirit (Ire) (Green Desert) and Kodiak (GB) (Danehill).

fortnight ago. Jumping out well under regular partner James McDonald, he was able to secure an ideal position, getting cover two-wide from G1 Epsom H. winner **He's Your Man (Fr)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), one of eight Chris Waller trainees in the 15-strong field. He's Your Man started closing on the pacesetter Weary (Fr) (Astronomer Royal) around the home turn and Contributor followed suit before hitting the front four wide with 200 meters to go and stretching out to the line. He's Your Man hung on gamely, but couldn't hold off the late-rallying **Hartnell (GB)** (Authorized {Ire}), who came from second-last with a jaw-dropping turn of foot.

Bred by Lady O'Reilly's Petra Bloodstock Agency, Contributor carried the silks of George Bolton to four victories in the UK, including a pair of listed events over 2000 meters, from only nine starts. A private purchase for Godolphin on the back of his comfortable win in the listed Wolferton H. at Royal Ascot last June, the 5-year-old opened his Australian account at first asking with an impressive display in the 2000-meter G3 David Jones Cup at Caulfield, before being well beaten in the G1 Emirates S. over a mile on firm ground. He was quick to make amends when cruising to the easiest of victories in the G2 Apollo S. at Randwick Feb. 14. The runner-up, 4-year-old Hartnell, was a smart stayer for Mark Johnston and Sheikh Mohammed Al Maktoum in Great Britain, winning five of his 15 starts including the 1 5/8-mile G3 Bahrain Trophy as well as a two-mile Listed event at Royal Ascot.

O'Shea commented, "It was a great team effort more than anything. It is good because all of the team are here today and they have worked hard to get this result. It is only the start."

Explaining how the pair had arrived in his care, he said, "Fergy [John Ferguson] turned up one day and said there is a couple coming down. He was very relaxed about it. When they gave us the names, we had a look at their form and we were all very excited. Who would have thought it would turn out like this." 'SUAVE' MOVE IN FUTURITY

The G1 Futurity S. was supposed to be heavy favorite **Dissident (Aus)** (Sebring {Aus})'s stomping ground, however the pint-sized **Suavito (NZ)** (Thorn Park {Aus}) finished with a late burst to lift her first top-level victory and deny that rival his fifth. The bay tracked an eager Dissident in fifth perched two deep through the early stages before keeping closer contact with the leaders leaving the bend. Shifted to the extreme outside with 200 meters left,

Suavito put away **Smokin' Joey (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) to her inside and kicked away to win in style. Dissident stayed gamely on to be third.

Suavito, a consistent campaigner at the group level started off her season with a win in a plate race here Aug. 30, but, although never out of the top three, wouldn't return to the winner's circle until four starts later in the G3 Eliza Park International S. Oct. 25. She annexed the 2000-meter G2 Momentum Energy S. Nov. 8 and was shortening up for the Futurity's seven-furlong distance.

Originally targeting the G3 Mannerism S. earlier on the card, winning trainer Nigel Blackiston opted for the weight-for-age Futurity instead. "She was first-up and I thought she'd end up carrying 59 [kilograms] against the mares," said Blackiston to *racenet.com.au*. "I thought the tempo would be a little more forgiving in the Futurity and it worked out perfectly. [Jockey] Damien [Oliver] knows her so well and he gave her a beautiful ride. The Blamey was the race we were looking at next for her, but now we have the pleasant task of a Group 1 penalty, so I will see how she comes out of this before making a decision."

year-old to the center of the track with 300 meters left to travel before setting her loose. The response was immediate, as Shamal Wind produced a sharp turn of foot to reach contention inside the final furlong and found the front in the shadow of the wire to win by a comfortable margin over **Under the Louvre (Aus)** (Excellent Art {GB}) who out-bobbed **Fast n' Rockin (Aus)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}) in third. Race favorite **Earthquake (Aus)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) lacked the needed finishing punch and ran 10th. Shamal Wind, first in a barrier trial last August, was third in the Sportingbet Sprint S. two starts later, before placing fourth in an 800-meter barrier trial at Cranbourne Oct. 6.

She earned a trio of thirds in the G3 Sportingbet Series Final here Oct. 11, the G2 Perri Cutten Caulfield Sprint over 100 meters shorter later that month and in Flemington's G3 G.H. Mumm S. Nov. 6. Back in the winner's circle after being spelled in the listed W.J. Adams S. over 1000 meters at Sandown Jan. 26, she was overlooked behind last year's G1 Blue Diamond S. winner and G1 Golden Slipper second **Earthquake (Aus)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}).

"To be honest I'd lost sight of her and I was watching the other horse," winning trainer Robert Smerdon told racenet.com.au. "He was in front of her in the right spot and getting the cheap runs and I thought we had it-then she arrived on the outside. Obviously, it's a really good outcome, I've got to see the replay to appreciate it. The owners wanted to give her another try, keep her fresh and have a crack at a Group 1, so all credit to them."

The first foal out of Firemaid, Shamal Wind is the 17th Group 1 winner for her sire Dubawi (Ire) and has a 2-year-old half-brother by Stratum (Aus). 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RIVALRY RENEWED IN GOLD CUP

Reigning Horse of the Year **Designs on Rome (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) and **Military Attack (Ire)** (Oratorio {Ire}), who carried that title in the previous season, square off again in today's Citibank Hong Kong Gold Cup, elevated to international Group 1 status for the first time.

Designs on Rome has slowly worked his way into peak fitness for trainer John Moore and earned his second win at the highest level two starts back, defeating Military Attack in the final jump of the G1 Longines Hong Kong Cup over this course and distance Dec. 14. The duo was supposed to line up together in the 1800-meter Centenary Vase H. Feb. 7, but Military Attack was forced to miss the race after a period of what trainer Caspar Fownes labeled 'inappetence' and weight loss. That left Designs on Rome as the starting highweight on 131 pounds and he drifted late in the wagering to be off as 'only' the 6-5 favorite. He left it until very late, but Joao Moreira coaxed one final late lunge out of the 5-year-old and scored by a short head. Designs on Rome is prepping here for the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 28.

Military Attack arrived on the international scene really and truly beginning with this event in 2013 and he successfully defended his title last term. He missed by a head to **Blazing Speed (GB)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) in the G2 Jockey Club Cup Nov. 23 ahead of his Hong Kong Cup near-miss, and is ready to use this as a steppingstone to the G1 Dubai Turf in a little less than four weeks. The 7-year-old gets blinkers for the first time this afternoon.

"He'll have the blinkers on to help him concentrate a bit more," explained Fownes. "You can see in a couple of his races, the last part, he just shies away from the winning post and runs out a little bit and that has cost him. Hopefully, with the blinkers on, he'll just run through to the line strongly. If he can do that, well he's already racing very well this season so if he can stay where he's at he will be very competitive."
