BREEDERS' CUP '99 TO GULFSTREAM?

There's no conformation from either Gulfstream Park or the Breeders' Cup, but speculation has the two groups announcing Gulfstream Park as the site for the 1999 event on Monday, March 23. Gulfstream Park distributed invitations to selected media in South Florida on March 19, for an "announcement of great importance to the Florida Thoroughbred industry and the economy of South Florida" at a luncheon at Turnberry Isle Resort & Club. While Gulfstream and officials at the Breeders' Cup wouldn't confirm the pending announcement, no one would deny it either. The Breeders' Cup made appearances at Gulfstream Park in 1989 and 1992, but legislative trouble in 1992 almost prevented the races from taken place. A last minute emergency session by the Florida legislators allowed the races to go forward. The necessary laws to allow the Breeders' Cup to return to Florida were passed in May 1997.

INDIAN CHARLIE INTEREST SOLD Hal Earnhardt III has sold a substantial interest in his three-year-old colt **Indian Charlie** (In Excess {Ire}), for an undisclosed price to John R. Gaines Thoroughbreds. Indian Charlie, trained by Bob Baffert, is scheduled to start next in the April 4 GI Santa Anita Derby. The colt is undefeated in three starts, most recently winning a March 13 one-mile Santa Anita allowance. "I couldn't be more thrilled to be involved with a partner like Hal Earnhardt and a horse like Indian Charlie," said Gaines.

SILVER GOBLIN BACK IN ACTION Silver Goblin (Silver Ghost), winner of the 1995 GII Razorback H., 1994 GIII Fairmont Derby and GIII Omaha Gold Cup S., returned to the races Tuesday after a 17-month absence. The seven-year-old gelding, who raced only once in 1996 and was off all of 1997, finished third in Tuesday's ninth race at Oaklawn, a \$37,000 one-mile allowance. "I'm exceptionally happy," said trainer Kenny Smith after the race. "We were just looking to get a race in him. We knew he was going to get a little tired." As for the decision to return the veteran to the track, Smith said, "He wasn't doing well. He wouldn't play, he wouldn't do anything. This (the racetrack) is a lot more fun for him." Already a millionaire, Silver Goblin put together seven straight wins before finishing second behind Cigar in the 1995 GI Oaklawn H.

RACING CALLED OFF AT HIALEAH AND

TAMPA A problem with excessive amounts of water on the clubhouse turn halted racing at Hialeah March 19. In the first race **Moscow Magic** (Nijinsky's Secret), ridden by jockey Robert Woodhouse, fell just before the mile pole. Jockey Kristi Chapman was thrown from a trailing horse. Neither jockey was injured, but Moscow Magic had to be euthanized. After the accident members of Hialeah's jockey colony walked the area of the spill and told track management they thought it was too dangerous to ride the rest of the card. Hialeah General Manager Mike Mackey said he expects the track to be back in action today. Inclement weather also halted racing at Tampa Bay Downs after eight races yesterday. The last two races on the card were canceled because of flooding and lighting strikes in the area. A track spokesperson said training would resume in the morning and there would be racing in the afternoon.

FAIR GROUNDS RAISES PURSES AGAIN Fair Grounds's Director of Racing and Racing Secretary Mervin Muniz announced yesterday the track's fifth purse increase of the 1997-98 racing season. Beginning Saturday, March 21, all purses--excluding stakes races--will be raised by \$2,000. The minimum claiming purse is now \$15,000 and top allowance purses are worth \$45,000. Muniz cites the continued success of simulcasting as the key ingredient. Additionally, purses for five of the season's six remaining stakes have been raised. The March 29 GIII Explosive Bid will be worth \$350,000. The March 22 Pelleteri Breeders' Cup H. has been boosted to \$175,000. Both the March 21 Victoria Lass H. and the March 28 Gentilly H. are now worth \$125,000, while the March 30 Red Camelia H. is now worth \$100,000.

The 25-1 outsider **Cool Dawn (Ire)** (Over The River {Fr}), trained by Robert Alner and ridden by Andrew Thornton, led from start to finish to capture yesterday's \$370,860 G1 Tote Cheltenham Gold Cup Steeplechase over 3 5/16 miles, beating **Strong Promise (Ire)** (Strong Gale {Ire}) by a length and three-quarters, with the Irish-trained 9-4 favourite **Dorans Pride (Ire)** (Orchestra {Ire}) a head away third. Cool Dawn was the fourth longest-priced winner in the history of Britain's premier weight-for-age steeplechase.

For the seventh time in eight years, D. Wayne Lukas will be honored as 1997 Trainer of the Year by the Kentucky Thoroughbred Media after winning more races at Kentucky tracks than any other trainer. Also being honored by the KTM are owner William T. Young Sr.'s Overbrook Farm and jockey Willie Martinez. The trio will receive their awards at a ceremony on March 28 at Turfway Park. The awards are presented annually to the owner, trainer and jockey with the highest number of victories during the year at Kentucky tracks and are sponsored by the KTM in conjunction with The Jockey Information Systems, which provides data for determining the winners.

Pulitzer Prize-winning poet and translator Henry Taylor will lead the 1998 Bluegrass Summer Writers Workshop at Churchill Downs and at various Thoroughbred breeding farms in the Lexington region from June 7-14. The seminars are presented by the Writers Project, Inc., a non-profit, educational foundation that offers unique programs that allow creative writers to fully experience the lifestyles of farmers, ranchers and racetrack people. Local News, Turfway:

Daniel My Brother (Runaway Groom), the winner of the Battaglia Memorial S. at Turfway March 7, will make his next start in the March 29 \$600,000 GII Jim Beam S. in lieu of the April 11 \$500,000 GII Wood Memorial at Aqueduct as previously announced, according to Star Stables' John Perrotta. The Board of Directors of Churchill Downs Incorporated approved a range of initiatives designed to enhance shareholder value and help propel the Company's growth in racing-related businesses. The board unanimously approved a two-for-one split of the Company's common stock in the form of a stock dividend, an increase in its line of credit from \$20 million to \$50 million, the implementation of a shareholder rights plan and a proposal to double the number of authorized shares of common stock to 20 million.
